Holy unto the Lord

Ermines are peculiar little animals that live in the

European and Asian forests. Their fur changes into a pure white colour during the winter, and they strive to keep it spotless. The hunters hunt these ermines for their fur. They are not caught using nooses or traps but by heaping filth at the entrance of their burrows. Then the hunting dogs are let loose to chase those little animals towards its burrow. But when it sees the filth at the entrance of its burrow, it decides to get caught by the dogs rather than make their pure fur dirty. The Hebrew term for Holiness is "Kadesh," which means "set apart, cut off." God has chosen us to be holy (Eph.1:4) and has set us apart to be holy (Lev.20:26). A call to live a holy life, then, refers to a life set apart and chosen by God for a special and noble purpose. For this, God chooses individuals, families, and nations. When God chooses us for a life of holiness, He expects the same kind of purity that we see among the ermines, which choose purity over life. God expects us to be holy like Joseph, an individual who had the zeal to keep himself pure (Gen.39:1-20), like the Rechabite family, of whom the Lord Himself gave witness about their purity (Jer.35:1-19), and like Pinehas, when God chose the Israelites to be a holy nation for Himself (Deu.7:6; Num.22-25), but when they were deceived by Balaam and his words, the kind of zeal that was seen in Pinehas when he sensed the unholy act among the people of Israel should be seen in us too. I should expect "being holy unto the Lord" to begin with me, then with my family, and only then with my nation. God chooses those who have a zeal for holiness. He sets them apart and uses them. Dear partners in the mission of reaching the unreached Indians,

Greetings to you all in the everlasting Name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Mark 3:2 & 3 gives an important aspect of Jesus life on earth. "Some of them were looking for a reason to accuse Jesus, so they watched him closely to see if he would heal him on the Sabbath. Jesus said to the man with the shriveled hand, "Stand up in front of everyone."

Jesus went into a synagogue where a man with shriveled hand was sitting. Jesus knew that people are watching him to find a reason to accuse him. If he heals the man, they would blame Jesus that He violates the sabbatical law. Jesus had other options to heal the man and to evade that accusation. One was to heal the man after sabbatical restriction time, so that the people waiting to accuse Jesus may not have anything to say against Him. But Jesus who always depended on the Father, did not do any such gimmick. Knowing that they would plot to kill Him as mentioned in verse 6 "Then the Pharisees went out and began to plot with the Herodians how they might kill Jesus". Jesus healed the man. HE HAS CHOSEN YOU UP TO BE HOLY

Ephesians 1:4

When did He chose you?

He chose us before the foundation of this world. Surely I was sinful at birth, sinful from the time my mother conceived me (Ps 5:1) says David. How can one be chosen before the foundation of this world to be holy? There is a funny story of a baby which was born in a hospital. The nurses took the child to be cleaned. The right palm of the child was clenched. Unable to open the nurse called the doctor. The doctor bent over the child. The child opened the palm and caught hold of the long golden chain that was hanging from the doctors neck. At the same time a golden ring fell off from the tightly fisted hand of the child. That ring belonged to the nurse who was in charge of the delivery. So the Doctor enquired about the child's parents and found that the father was a thief. Yes the father was a thief, so the infant boy too was born a thief. How is it possible for a person to be chosen to live holy even before the foundation of the world, if a child is born with a sinful attitude and chracteristic of a parent?

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith-and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God, not by works, so that no one can boast. (Eph 2: 8-9). ... the Lamb who was slain from the creation of the world (Rev 13:8) and according to (Rom 6: 8) this is possible because He even



when we were yet sinners Jesus Christ died on the cross and reavealed His love inorder He might show the incomparable riches of His grace expressed in His kindness to us in Christ Jesus (Eph 2: 7). So all the people who believe on Lord Jesus Christ and confessed their sins submitting themselves to live a holy life is chosen to stand in the line of the holy ones. If you have received this blessing it is good. If not today you believe on Christ Jesus and confess your sins and leave it to live a holy life and posses the place with God in eternity.

Even today many miracles and signs might happen. Yet among them if they do not decide to hold on to holiness, still appear to be clownish preachers. So let us stay strong in a our calling as his chosen ones, and be very careful till the day we will be meeting Jesus Christ face-to-face.

Obituary

(07.05.1944 - 06.01.2023)

Brother Paul Duraisamy (aged 78) has passed away on 6th January 2023. His mortal remains were laid to rest on 8th Jan '23 at Madathur, his native place, with hope of ressurection. Mr. Paul Duraisamy took charge as the 4th district leader of Tirunelveli in the year 1978 while he was working as a head master of a school in Tenkasi. He along with

Mr. Chelladurai who was also a teacher in Udumalaipettai availed leave for one year from May 1979 to May 1980 inorder to promote the ministries of fmpb at state level and specifically in the districts of Madurai and Ramanathapuram. With all limitations he stayed in the school buildings, verandhas of simple houses, conducted missionary challenge meetings in Churches and several home gatherings. He took efforts in developing and encouraging several prayer group

leaders and added new members to support the mission. He called youngsters with respect and encouraged them spiritually to become committed leaders, mission activists and fulltime missionaries. He was winsome and with his affable nature roped in new members, started prayer groups, raised funds for the ministries. He built and led teams of volunteers with his exemplery leadership skills and organizing abilities to expand the support base. He was frank and outspoken vet accepted counter points with an open mind. A zealot who lived with a vision to see India know the love of Jesus Christ also dedicated his daughter, a post graduate software professional to join the band of missionaries. He contributed his ideas very well in the Executive Committee, General Body and National planning conference meetings and served as the state representative for Tamil Nadu. As an educationist he mooted the idea of starting low budget primary schools to provide standard education for Malto children during a mission trip and served as the chairman of the first committee for floating Rajmahal Christian Primary Study Centres. He also played a crucial role as the convenor of the search committee in selecting the 8th General Secretary of FMPB. We thank God for his life well lived.

We pray for his wife Mrs.Kamalam Jebakani, families of their daughters Hephzibha Packiam, Daisy Porchelvi, son Samraj Porpatham and the grandchildren to consoled and comforted in their bereaved hearts.


The hour of Action:

In the year 1990, while I was just walking down a lane in Siwan. Bihar: I saw people were in festive mood and got immersed in gala celebrations. I was moved on seeing people offering puias to a particular deity, lavishly spending money, even though they were living abject poverty. Suddenly a burden to pray for them gripped me firmly so I just stood in the corner of the lane and was interceding for the poor people who were spending a lot of money even in their state of abysmal poverty. Wondering, why I felt such a heavy burden, I prayed on the spot that God should change their state of poverty and that they should move from darkness to light and returned back to home. shared this with my wife and we prayed as a family. Days passed, After a few months, a believer by name Surendhar brought home a person named Dasarat from the same lane in which I stood and prayed a few months back. I was surprised to see a person in my house from

the community for whom I prayed with great burden. When I shared with Him the love of Jesus Christ, he sharply refused saying that he was a worshipper of a particular deity and told me that he does not need Jesus. After a period of time due to an incident that had happened in the life of my friend, a great change in the attitude of Dasarat was seen. So he came back and voluntarily told me that he needed Jesus and listened to me carefully when I shared

about Jesus Christ. Today he is a worker in the vineyard of Jesus Christ in the same district. Along with Dasarath more than 100 persons have tasted the love of Jesus Christ. So whenever our Lord lays a great burden on our hearts, we too need to stand in the corner of a lane and pray for the particular cause to see that a Dasarat is being touched and in turn many may experience salvation in their lives. This is an unforgettable incident in my missionary journey. When the Spirit of God lay His burden in our hearts and nudges us to pray, we can see a big harvest in each mission field and in the neighborhoods where we live. The need of the hour is a life soaked with spontaneous intercession offered at anywhere and anytime without hesitation or delay



TRAIL BLAZERS

Morning Star of Reformation



These shall make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb shall overcome them: for he is Lord of lords, and King of kings: and they that are with him are called, and chosen, and faithful. Rev. 17:14

John Wyclif was a Yorkshireman, who was born in 1330 and died on December 31, 1384. He was educated at Oxford, and had become famous there as a teacher of philosophy before he began to show any difference of opinions from those which were common in the Church. Ever since the time when King John disgusted his people by his shameful submission to the pope, there had been a strong feeling against the papacy in England; and it had been provoked more and more, partly because the popes were always drawing money from people,

and thrusting foreigners into the richer places of the English Church. These foreigners squeezed all that they could out of their parishes or offices in England; but they never went near them, and would have been unable to do much good if they had gone, because they did not understand the English language.

And another complaint was, that, while the popes lived at Avignon, they were so much in the hands of their neighbours, the kings of France, that the English had no chance of fair play if any question arose between the two nations, and the pope could make himself the judge. And thus, the English had been made ready enough to give a hearing to anvone who might teach them that the popes had no right to the power which they claimed. There had always been a great unwillingness to pay the tribute which King John had promised to the Roman see. If the king was weak, he paid it; if he was strong, he was more likely to refuse it. And thus, it was that the money had been refused by Edward I., paid by Edward II., and


again refused by Edward III., whom Pope Urban V., in 1366, asked to pay up for thirty-three years at once.

In this case, Wyclif took the side of his king, and maintained that the tribute was not rightly due to the pope. And from this he went on to attack the corruptions of the Church in general. He set himself against the begging friars, who had come to great power, themselves worming everywhere. so that they had brought most of the poorer people to look only to them as spiritual guides, and to think nothing of the parish clergy. In order to oppose the friars, Wyclif sent about the country a set of men whom he called poor priests. These were very like the friars in their rough dress and simple manner of living, but taught more according to a plain understanding of the Scriptures than to the doctrines of the Roman Church.

In those days almost all books were written in Latin, so that none but learned people could read them. But Wyclif, although he wrote some books in Latin for the learned, took to writing other books in good, plain English, such as everyone could understand; and thus, his opinions became known to people of all classes. But the greatest thing that he did was the translation of the Bible into English. The Roman Church would not allow the Scriptures to be turned into the language of the country, but wished to keep the knowledge of it for those who could read Latin, and expected the common people to content themselves with what the Church taught. But Wyclif, with others who worked under him, translated the whole Bible into English, so that all might understand it. We must remember, however, that there was no such thing as printing in his days, so that every single book had to be written with the pen, and of course books were still very dear, and could not be at all common.

It is said that once, when Wycliff was very ill, and was supposed to be dying, some friars went to him in the hope of getting him to confess that he repented of what he had spoken and written and done against them. But Wyclif, gathering all his strength, rose up in his bed, and said, in words which were partly taken from the 118th Psalm, "I shall not die but live, and declare the evil deeds of the friars." He was several times brought before assemblies of bishops and clergy, to answer for his opinions; but he found powerful friends to protect him, and always came off without hurt. Pope Urban V. summoned Wyclif to appear before him at Rome; but Wyclif, who was old, and had been very ill, excused himself from going; and soon after this he died, on the last day of the year 1384, the soldiers of the Lord are faithful. "They follow the Lamb whithersoever He goeth," and nothing shall ever separate them from His love and from His service. So it was with John Wycliffe and so it will be with all who truly follow the Captain of their salvation.

(1963 - 1990)

The family of FMPB lost one of its very young missionaries named Mr. Edward Gnanamuthu in an accident in the mission field. It was particularly sorrowful as he was newly married and went to be with the Lord too early in life. "He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death' or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away."

Early Life

Edward Gnanamuthu was born on the 11th of January 1963, in Thissaiyanvillai of Tamilnadu. His parents were Mr. Gnanaiah and Mrs. Balasundaram. Edward Gnanamuthu from the childhood onward proved himself to be very active and naughty. He studied in an elementary school in Thissaiyanvillai, but continued his higher studies from Sirkali where his mother along with the other children shifted. He returned to Tissaiyanvillai to finish the final year of his schooling as the family shifted back to their native.

College Life

Edward Gnanamuthu pursued his college studies in Bishop Heber College, Tiruchirapalli as a hosteler. Even though he was taught the Christian ways of life by the parents, he felt emboldened as he was out of the sight of his parents in the hostel. He did things according to his heart's desires. His friends led him to many sinful activities. He had the gift of writing poems. He wrote many poems just to please his friends.

Salvation

After finishing his undergraduate degree, he came to Chennai seeking a job. When he was in Chennai, he was attracted by the writings on Communism and began to read books written by communist ideologues. So, he used to raise his voice and confess that "there is no God" along with his friends. But his mother sincerely prayed to God for the salvation of his son. One day he attended a prayer meeting out of compulsion. Then, he criticised the prayer meeting and discouraged his friend too. That night, he found a New Testament in his room and started reading it. The Spirit of God ministered unto him through the portion he read. When he continued to read it. God convicted him of his sins. Then he cried to the Lord and confessed all his transgressions and invited Jesus to his heart. The peace of God filled his heart. He loved the Word of God so much that he made it a habit to read the Bible and meditate daily.

Call of God

Few years later he came to his home town on study leave. When his mother invited him for the family prayer, he told her that he had to study for the forthcoming examination and shut the door. Now, God transformed him completely; he joined with young people and began to pray as a group. His interest in attending the spiritual meetings conducted by Church grew everyday. Soon, his job took him to Coimbatore City. There he joined the local evangelist team and proclaimed the Gospel. He had the passion to become a missionary and preach the Gospel to the unreached. So, he left the job and came back to his native. He met the Church catechist and shared about his interest. Along with the catechist he went to nearby villages to share the Gospel. He joined the Bethel home at Thissaivanvillai as a warden. And there he shared with the students the love of God every day. He was transferred to Pasumlai Bethel children's home, where he continued the ministry among the home boys. At that time he heard about the North India ministry of FMPB. And he cultivated the passion to pray for the missionaries. While reading the Bible, God called him to the mission field. He committed his life to go as a missionary at that very instant. He joined FMPB in the year 1987 and received missionary training for a vear. After finishing his training, he was sent to Himachal Pradesh and then to Haryana.

Marriage

Mr. Edward Gnanamuthu's parents chose Ms. Deborah Vijayarani, an FMPB missionary from Gujarat, as the bride for him. Ms. Deborah Vijayarani's parents were Mr. Navamani and Mrs Darling, firm FMPB supporters of Kalakadu. The marriage was held on the 9th of May 1990. They travelled back to the mission field within a few days of marriage. They were sent to Hanumangarh of Rajasthan. Before they left for Rajasthan, as a family they went to Manimutharu Reservoir for a picnic. On the way back as


a family they met with an accident but God miraculously saved everyone. At that time, Edward's mother and sister were sick, so they requested the newly married couple to postpone their travel to North India. As they hesitated to extend their leave, his mother bid them farewell with tears and prayers.

Ministry and Early Home Call

As a young couple Mrs and Mr. Edward Gnanamuthu reached Hanumangarh and started their ministry from a rented house. They started their ministry prayerfully and happily did the ministry. On the 7th of July 1990, he posted a letter in the postbox and while returning home. Then he tried to cross the railway track near the Hanumangarh railway station. But his shoe got struck under the railway line. Before he could take it out. a passing train hit him. Obviously, he did not notice the oncoming train. There was a heavy loss of blood and he lost his life. He met with this accident two months after their marriage. As a family they had lived only for a very short time. During this time this tragedy happened in their life. It shook the whole family of FMPB. All the missionaries living nearby rushed to the spot and he was buried with the hope of resurrection. Mrs. Deborah Viiavarani, as a missionary, strengthened herself in Christ as no one could comfort her in this situation.

After some time, Ms. Deborah Vijayarani continued her ministry in Gujarat. She did a fruitful ministry among the children and women. Now she is involved in the full Bible translation in the Vasava language. Even though Mr. Edward Gnanamuthu lived a short span of life he did his best for the glory of God.

Naktia Hanwat is a medium size village located in Dangs Taluk of Dangs district, Gujarat state. In 2011, the literacy rate of Naktia Hanwat village was 55.96 % compared to 78.03 % of Gujarat. As per the Constitution of India and Panchavat Rai Act, Naktia Hanwat village is administrated by Sarpanch (Head of Village) who is the elected representative of the village. In Naktia Hanwat village, Schedule Tribe (ST) constitutes 99.11 % of the total population. There is no population of Schedule Caste (SC) in this village. Of the 477 workers engaged in various works, 449 were cultivators (owner or co-owner) while 3 were Agricultural labourers

The Beginning:

On 8-5-1981, L. Masilamani, his wife Mrs. Vanmathi and their first son M. John Kingsly (two years and eight months old) opened the Ahwa field and settled in a rented house in Pipaldahad village. Soon they found out that people were receptive in the nearby Junnar village and they moved to Junnar village on

30-11-1981. Very soon opposition brewing in Junnar village, made the missionary family move to Ahwa on 30-8-1982. The Ahwa CNI Church Pastor Rev. T. V. Gaikwad helped them much during this opposition time. As the Dolyambar village headman and Manu Bhai invited the missionaries to their village, Missionaries went to live in the Dolyambar village on 12-3-1983. This village became a strategic place to spread the Gospel to the nearby villages. The believers sought the help of FMPB missionaries to develop the ministry in their nearby villages.

Naktia Hanwat village comes under the hills of Sahyadri in the eastern border of Dangs district. Next to this village after crossing the hills through a hilly road comes Dhule district of Maharashtra. Damu Bhai Ramtu Bhai was the first Christian from this village who worked for the founding of the Church in this village. He narrates his story of how he became a Christian:

"I was smoking, drinking liquor and worshipping the idols, which led me to a life

of poverty. I did not have peace in my soul and there was no peace in my family. My wife was suffering from chest pain and she used to have shivering due to cold in her leas and hands. I tried many ways for her to be healed. I called the shamans (bhagats) and gave him fowls and goat for the sacrifice. But she did not get any cure from this. Then I tried to heal her through medicines by consulting doctors and also gave her herbal medicines. But she was not getting better by all these efforts. There was one Christian named Punya Bhai in Bilbari village. He told me to believe in Jesus Christ for my wife's healing. I asked Punya Bhai to pray for my wife. Punya Bhai prayed for my wife and she became well. I heard about missionary L. Masilamani ministering in Dolyambar village. I went and met him in Dolyambar. I joined the Church. I have been serving as a Church elder from the beginning of the Church in Naktihanwat village."

After getting healing, Damu Bhai was attending the Sunday services in Jhari village. FMPB evangelist Bharat Bhai started conducting night meetings in Damu Bhai's home every Friday. There were five families in the first meeting. Slowly the village people heard about the healing power of Jesus Christ through this meeting. Nathu Bhai Gangajiya Bhai was one such man who was searching for a cure for his wife's sickness. He narrates his story:



"My name is Nathu Bhai Gangaji Bhai. My wife had bleeding problem and asthma. We tried the bhagats and spent much on them. But she did improve. Doctors prescribed her tablets. These tablets caused much vomiting for her. So she stopped taking the tablets. There was one religious sect doing satsang (bhajan). One of our relatives was doing this. We went there. He said that this disease is a big one. You have to try something else to get healing for her."

At this point Nathu Bhai's wife tells how she got delivered from all her sicknesses.

"My son Balya was a small boy. I could not walk. I told that I will be with my children. There was one Christian in our village named Dhamu Bhai. Evangelist Bharat Bhai used to come to his house. I told my husband that I would like to go to the Christian meeting. Village people told me that in Christian religion people will not weep when one dies. They discouraged me. But I had the confidence of aetting cured in that meeting. So I attended that meeting. Believers, elders and evangelists prayed for me. Their prayers healed me. Then we believed in Jesus Christ and joined the Church at Karkhadi. Every Friday night meeting was going on in Dhamu Bhai's house. For Sunday service we went to Jhari village."

Thus people started attending the Friday night meetings conducted by FMPB evangelists in Damu Bhai's home from 1987. For one and a half years the meetings were going on in Dhamu Bhai's house. Bharat Bhai and Sampath Bhai were coming to conduct those meetings. Many people were brought to faith by these evangelists and Church elders Dhamu Bhai and Nathu Bhai. For Sunday services, believers were going to Jhari Church

Church Growth in the midst of opposition:

Nathu Bhai tells about an opposition caused by his village people with the support of a local politician.

"Our village people went to Dhedu Bhai, a leader in the political party and a leader in the Wood Cutters Co-operative society and told him to stop the Christian meetings in the village. He called us and I went with Dhamu Bhai with a missionary in Ahwa. He told us not to create division in that village. He told us to contribute money for the celebration for the festivals. We told him that we will not be able to do that. We will support any other social concerns of the village."

Rev. L. Masilamani wrote in the Field history about this meeting of Dhedu Bhai:

In connection with the Naktia Hanwat opposition by one man called Maharya Bhai, L. Masilamani met Dhedu Bhai with Damu Bhai and another believer in his jungle mandali's office in Ahwa. He talked with the missionary very harshly and tried to convince the believers to follow their traditional faith."

After one and a half years, Bhatya Bhai built a new house near the present Church. As the room in Dhamu Bhai's home was small, the meeting place was shifted to Bhatya Bhai's house in 1988. Bhatya Bhai sought healing for his sick daughter. But after hearing the Gospel in the meetings he decided to continue in faith even if his daughter would die. He also faced opposition in his village for the Christian faith. He narrates his experiences:



"I myself was making liquor and I drank a lot of liquor and smoked tobacco. My life became very poor and broken. There was no peace in our house. My daughter was suffering from a sickness. Her legs and hands became straight and her eyes also looked differently. We tried to get healing through our ancestral faith methods like offering sacrifices of cocks, goats to our gods and goddesses through the bhagats. In spite of spending much on medicines and other things my daughter did not get well. I saw many people following Christian faith in my village for the sake of getting well from illnesses and we decided that we too would become Christians. We told the Church elder Damu Bhai that we are ready to accept Jesus Christ. Then the elder prayed for my daughter. God heard that prayer and my daughter became very well. Seeing this miracle we started believing in Jesus Christ. Then we joined the Church. We were attending the Friday meetings in the village and the Sunday services in Jhari. Within three weeks she became fully well. After ten years my daughter got sick again. She was taken to many hospitals in big cities like Dhule, Ahwa, Chinchpada, Bardoli etc. She was not cured. I decided to continue in faith even if my daughter dies. My daughter died But I decided to continue the Christian meeting in my house and I thought that I would go to heaven to meet my daughter and I did not give up my faith. One day opponents started conducting a meeting very close to our meeting place. The Panchayat President was leading that meeting. I told him to stop the meeting. They stopped that meeting. After one year the village people came against us. A meeting was convened in the house of the village head man. They threatened us. I asked them to point out any mistakes in the lives of Christians. I told them that I was working in the houses of village people. I asked them to find any fault with us. They repeatedly told us that Christianity was not needed in this village. Then they planned to beat me as I did not agree with them. I told them to beat me if they found fault in my activities. They accused me of rowdyism. I declared that we would not leave faith even if we were beaten. I challenged them to beat me if they found fault in me. They stopped opposing us for three years. Again after three years they asked us to contribute money for their festivals. I told them that we would give a contribution to their festivals on the condition that they should give a contribution to our festivals. Then they stopped opposing us "

For two years the night meeting was going on in Bhatya Bhai's home. After one year, one kacha Church was constructed with a pucca stone foundation in Nathu Bhai's land.

Church Construction:

Rs. 20,000 was received for Church construction in Naktia Hanwat village in February 1992. A semi-pucca Church was built in 1992 in the land of Nathu Bhai

Gangajiya Bhai. Believers gave their free labour with one time food for this Church construction. This Church was dedicated by Rev. Thangasamy from Coimbatore on 21-10-1992 and the sponsor of this first Church was Mr.Gnanapragasam of Tindivanam. This Church was dedicated at midnight. About this Church dedication the field history register reads:

"On 21-10-1992, Coimbatore sponsors Rev. Thangasamy, Mr. Devadurai and Mr. Dominic went with L. Masilamani by a jeep to Naktia Hanwat without any prior notice. Believers were brought to the Church at around 10 pm. Suvarthik Gopichand Bhai was brought from Amsarpada village (where he conducted night meetings). At 11 pm the Naktia Hanwat Church was dedicated by Rev. Thangasamy. All of them returned to Ahwa at 2.30 am in the mid night"

Church Demolished in 1998 Opposition:

There was an organized opposition during Christmas time of 1998 under the leadership of a sadhu who was heading a fanatic group and instigating the natives to oppose Christians. As a result of this, opposition thirty three Churches were demolished in Dangs district. This Church was also demolished on 29-12-1998 in the 1998 opposition.

Nathu Bhai recollects this incident:

"In the year 1998 during Christmas time anti-Christian forces demolished our Church in our village. They threatened us and told us not to follow the Christian religion. We made a complaint to the police and the Collector.

Missionary D. Abraham guided us in these matters. The District Collector came to our village and told the village people not to give trouble to the Christians and everyone should be allowed to practice their own religion in the village. From that time onwards there has been no opposition in our village."

After the demolition of the Church the congregation gathered in the veranda of Nathu Bhai's son Ratan Bhai's house. A new Church is built in the same place. Money was received for a new Church construction in 2000. Government gave Rs.16.000 as a subsidy to construct the Church due to the demolition in 1998. It was finished in 2001. This new pucca Church was dedicated in 2003. The Church was dedicated by leaders from Mumbai. The Panchayat President told us not to build the Church in the village. But believers insisted on constructing the Church in the same place where the old Church was. The length of the Church is 38 feet and width 27 feet.

Information about Ministry and Church:

Total members of the Church are 190. During persecution 50% of believers were backslidden. Now 110 people from 32 families are in faith. Believers from three families from Khel village attend the Naktia Hanwat Church. 80 to 85 people attend the Sunday service.

Naktia Hanwat is a Pastorate Centre. Vahutia, Dumriya and Haripada congregations come under this pastorate. In September 2016, Rev. Dhansukh was the pastor of this pastorate. Weekly night meetings were conducted in Khel village. Believers from Naktia Hanwat attend this meeting. One or two families join the Church because of these meetings. Three families joined the Church in 2016. Prayer meetings are being conducted from 8 pm to 9.30 pm. every Friday night. 20 to 25 people participate in this prayer meeting which is conducted by Church elders. Pastor comes occasionally.

Missionaries who worked in this field are Rev. L. Masilamani, Rev. Bethuel Bardhan and Rev. D. Abraham families. CNI Pastors who worked in this Church are Rev. Balya Bhai, Rev. Chiman Bhai and Rev. Dhansukh Bhai. The Church received offerings of Rs. 1500 to 2000 per month through thanksgiving offering, cottage prayer meeting (yearly conducted in each house), Sunday services, tithes, harvest festival, first fruits etc. Due to migration of Christians for around 8 months in an year in the sugarcane fields, offering would be less.

Prayer Concerns:

- Jugar play (playing cards) with money among the youth is a problem.
- Backslidden believers should return to the Church.
- New people should taste the love of Jesus.
- Migration of believers happen due to unemployment in the village to distant places. 75% believers leave the village to eight months for work elsewhere.
 Only 25% believers remain in the village.

He was severely injured in his stomach leading to excessive internal bleeding. The doctors did not give any hope for his survival. But believers joined together and prayed fervently to the Lord. The Lord saved him miraculously and today he is doing well. Hallelujah!
