## Willing to bear the Cross?

A man was on a journey, carrying a heavy cross. Initially, he felt that he was all alone on that journey. Later, he realized that there were others who were carrying the cross too. But it looked like they were all carrying their crosses easily. So he began to grumble and complain, and he decided to cut a small portion of the cross. Then he continued his journey. Again, he felt that his cross was too heavy for him, so he cut another portion of it to be cut away. Again, the Lord cut it down.

Now it was easy for him to carry it, so he happily continued his journey. He reached a spot where each individual had to cross a valley placing the cross he/she carried across the valley. But this person, who cut the cross twice, was dismayed when he realized that his cross was not long enough to reach over to the other side. Now helplessly he went back to the Lord, and the Lord helped him to cross to the other side. We are chosen to carry the cross that is meant for us every day. Lk 9:23. The day we accepted the Lord is the day of our salvation, and we need to grow in our salvation every day and have to move on to the next level of discipleship, for which we must deny ourselves, take up our cross, and follow Him daily. Lk 14:27 says, "And whoever does not carry their cross and follow me cannot be my disciple." It is to the cross that a Christian is challenged to follow his Master, where he conquered sin and death. Following Jesus means enduring suffering and pain for His sake (Jn 15:19). The cost of following is total self-denial, sacrificing the earthly desires (Mat 8:18-22; Lk 14:26-33), but the reward will be glorious (Mat 19:27-29; Mk 10:29-30; 1 Pet 1:3-9). Christianity has always insisted that the cross we bear always precedes the crown we wear-Martin Luther King, because there is no crown without the cross (2 Tim 2:7-12). Perhaps we will stumble; perhaps we will fall, but God is always ready to answer us when we call Him to our aid. The Saviour is waiting to give us His grace and His love, which heal all our hurts. As we travel along with the Lord, bearing our cross, let us lift those who have fallen along the way to salvation (Rom 15:1) and uphold all those that are in the forefront, directing those who go astray towards the Cross. Let's lay our sorrows, sicknesses, pains, failures and sins down at the cross and instead take, joy, healing, victory and Salvation!

# The purpose and impact of the Chosen

## I. I Have Chosen You: *Intent*

God's promise to Zerubbabel is I will make you like a signet ring; for I have chosen you. (Haggai 2:23). Zerubbabel is mentioned in the ancestors list of Lord Jesus by Matthew, the line of Lord Jesus adaptive father, Joseph. (Matthew 1:12) He was the grandson of King Jeconiah, the descendant of Solomon. Though he did not reign as king of Judah, God gave him authority of a signet ring which was comparable to throne, or crown or scepter. God has chosen his people, whom he knew will respond to his call, even before the foundation of the world. (Ephesians 1:4)

**You did not choose me:** The initiative came from God. (John 15:16). There are people who choose their leaders or celebrities as idols or sportsperson as role model or intellectuals as mentors. Being one among those followers does not have any value. God took the initiative to love us and chose us. (John 15:16)

Let's understand the purpose of God choosing us first rather than we choosing Him. **What if we had chosen him? Not known:** Will the celebrity know the individual? Not likely. God has loved us and chosen us means: He has called us out, by name and it is an invitation for a special relationship. (Isaiah 43:1; I Peter 2:9) Believers hairs are numbered, tear accounted for, and more precious than birds. (Luke 12:7, Psalms 56:8; Matthew 10:31).

**Not connected:** The great personalities of the world could be beyond reach. It is a sort of a distant relationship. Their personal phone numbers or other contact details are not easily available. They could be connected in public domain as a fan or follower. Disciples are children of the Living God, with privileges, rights and responsibilities. (John 1:12). **No covenant:** There is no contract between a fan and the celebrity. Disciples are people of New Covenant that is sealed by the Blood of Lord Jesus Christ. (Luke 22:20). Even in the covenant it is God who makes the covenant with us and he helps us to remain in it. If we make we will fail in it. **No conversation:** Celebrities tend to communicate through public media. They are one way communication, not possible to respond in a way that would reach them. Loving Father speaks to each believer. As a sheep of the Good shepherd, it is possible to hear his voice. (John 10:27) Lord listens to prayers; the whole humanity comes to him (Psalms 65:2). That's why God has given us the Living words through which

He communicate with us and we in turn communicate with Him through prayer. **No care:** One cine actor fan was excited when a new movie was released; he celebrated that by dancing on a moving truck. Fell and was dead. Did anyone care for him or the bereaved family? Peter writes God cares for His disciples (I Peter 5:7). Not only during the time of accident but every time we go to Him, He care about it and addresses that problem. **No Comfort:** God always comforts His people (II Corinthians 1:3). God is near to the broken hearted (Psalm 34:18). His love, wisdom, and protection are his children's unfailing comfort. The celebrities rarely comfort a common man that also they do it through the media only. **No Confidence:** These human heroes have feet of clay and will fail, will not be able to even protect themselves. But Eternal God the Rock is the refuge of His people (Deuteronomy 33:27). God's faithfulness is the safety net.

**In God's Service (IGS):** Indian Administrative Service (IAS) officers are proud of their appointment, opportunity to serve the nation. All IAS officers would not become Chief Secretary to State Government or Principal Secretary to Prime Minister. However, each officer is considered as an asset for the government. All officers have their appropriate level of service, based on their expertise, experience, and need. All believers, both men and women are In God's Service (IGS) irrespective of their age, experience, education, and context.

**Pray:** All believers are expected to pray, intercede for harvesters to be sent for harvest. "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore, pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers

into his harvest." (Luke 10:2). Pray for new harvesters and toiling harvesters on the field. **Witness:** All born-again people of God are His witnesses in the world (Acts 1:8). Their words, deeds, behavior, attitude, relationships and lifestyle should reflect God's attributes of love, wisdom, grace and goodness. In other words, they are the light of the world, and salt of earth (Matthew 5: 14-16)

**Make Disciples:** Disciples are called to be disciple-making disciples. (Matthew 28:18-20) God's desire is for all humans to repent and receive Him. (II Peter 3:9). Disciples from all tribes, people group, language, nations will be in heaven worshipping the Lord. (Revelation 7:9). Making disciples should be the desire, the passion, the priority, and the life purpose.

## II. I have chosen you: *The Impact*

**No random choice:** God's choice is not a random choice or multiple choice but specific choice. God chooses each of his children uniquely, specifically and for the Kingdom purpose.

**Chosen to do God's will:** Ananias said to Saul: The God of our father has chosen you. (Acts 22:14). An unlikely candidate is chosen. One who harassed, intimidated, imprisoned, injured and killed the disciples of Lord Jesus Christ was chosen. The choice was not to pacify and silence, the hyperactive and restless Saul. He was now chosen for doing God's will in accordance with the purpose of the Kingdom of God

**Set Apart for Him:** Holy means, to be consecrated or set apart. (I Peter 1:15-16).



Chosen people are for set apart from others, marked by God. Soldiers cannot indulge in civilian affairs. (II Timothy 2:4). Soldiers are a few, compared with the whole population. There are many things that are permissible, lawful, morally right, even good, nevertheless, they are not for those who are set apart. (I Corinthians 6:12: 10:23)

**Such a time like this:** Mordecai said to Esther that she had become a queen for such a time like this. (Esther 4:14). All believers, including Esther are chosen 'according to the purpose of him who works all things according to the counsel of his will.' (Ephesians 1:11). Esther did not become a queen by accident or random events that happened around her. She was placed by God in that context and position. Esther was chosen to be a queen by the Lord for a special task. Therefore we need to know the purpose for which He has chosen us in such a time as this and make an impact in this society.

**1. Sense of urgency:** The harvest, when ripe should be reaped. Delay could make the grains to over ripe and then rot. In local churches, delay means people grow up and fail to receive vision. Children grow up fast, so do young people. Children in the congregation could grow up without learning missionary biographies. Young people may grow without getting information or exposure to missions. Most do not know the importance, significance, and priority of mission.

**2. Opportunity factor:** Open doors ought to be used immediately. It is applicable to the field as well as those who could go. Young

people when established in profession and getting married may find it difficult to go. So whenever we get an opportunity to serve God let us make the best use of it to serve Him.

**3. National context:** There are several factors that keep changing. Some provide opportunity for the growth of the Kingdom of God, and some may become hindrance to the gospel. For example, Anti-conversion law could be an obstruction to the preaching and disciple making efforts. People migrate looking for opportunities. Labourers from states like Uttar Pradesh migrate seeking jobs in Tamil Nadu. Such migrants are open to the Gospel. Let us resolve to gain these souls for the Lord.

**4. Global context:** The Church is global and so are the missions. Lord Jesus Christ and gospel is for whole humanity. When God provides opportunity to take the gospel to faraway lands, while travelling for education or job or business.

As we have understood the purpose of God choosing us and the impact we need to make as chosen ones, let us know His will and bear our cross daily and follow His footsteps. God invites us for this cause. We who follow Him have two choices. One is to follow Him as a fan till the end of our lives; the second choice is to be a disciple who bears the cross. Let us pray and work so that there will be ripples of changes in this needy nation when God chooses us to be His disciple and we make an impact in this society as the chosen one. May the Lord's name be glorified!

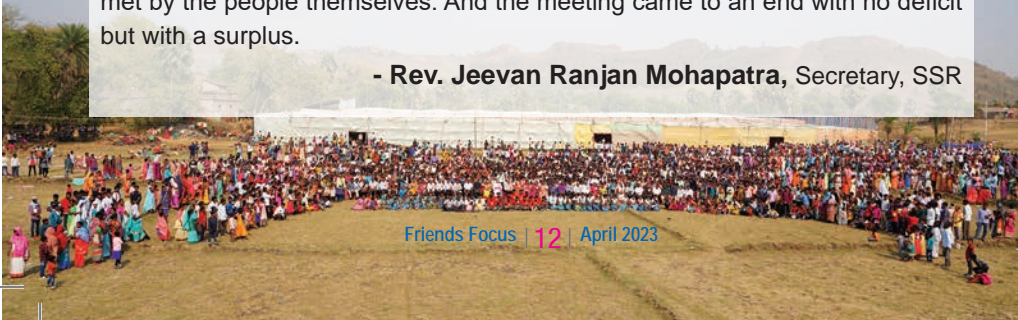

We thank God for his mighty deeds and blessings showered on us. Due to covid 19, the last two years we could not conduct the annual convention (Mela) in our Santal Sahibganj Region (SSR). After a gap of three years, our SSR's Annual convention was conducted at Telbita village of Pathna Field from 24th to 26th of February 2023. It is a milestone in the history of FMPB. More than 6700 believers participated, among them 1400 youth and 1500 children. The convention was presided over by the Bishop of Tirunelveli, Rt. Rev. A.R.G.S.T. Barnabas, the FMPB president (Mr. Reginald), the vice president (Mr. James Dharmabalan), the General Secretary (Rev. John Berlin), the Field Secretary (Rev. Solomon Gnanasekar), Rev. Baneswar Tudu (Pastor AG), and Rev. Paulraj (Secretary-NEZ). The members from prayer groups, the PPA department, the Youth department and the Communication department too were present.

The meeting was inaugurated by Rev. John Berlin and Mr. James Dharmabalan by lighting of the candles, followed by the inaugural speech by Rev. John Berlin. The entire programme was led by a wonderful choir team, with melodious songs and cultural dances. Mr. Reginald shared God's Word on the theme, "I have chosen you."

## Missionary Biography



**Rev. Bethuel Bardhan**  
(1961-2017)

It was very hard to digest the news about the sudden demise of our beloved missionary Rev. Bethuel Bardhan on 1st July 2017, who was working as Promotional Secretary in Cuttak area of Odisha, due to his sickness.

### EARLY DAYS

Rev. Bethuel Bardhan was born in a Christian family of Chellikada village of Gajapathy district of Odisha. His parents were Mr. Barun Bardhan and Mrs. Elisaba Bardhan. As he was born in a Christian family, right from his childhood he attended the Church regularly and took part in the Sunday school activities. He had absolute faith in God but did not have a personal relationship with the Lord. He had three brothers namely Bayel, Bahumila, Sunil Kumar and a sister named Sukhasini. When he grew up into a young man; he had a lot of friends. In due course they led him astray and he found himself involved in many unchristian activities. He moved away from the Lord.

### SALVATION EXPERIENCE

One of his brothers took a lot of efforts for the repentance and conversion of Bethuel. But Mr. Bethuel did not yield to his counsel, and continued with his old life. One day his brother took him to a prayer meeting, Bethuel went with him because of his brother's compulsion. People in the prayer meeting sang songs with joy, worshiped the Lord with gladness and prayed earnestly. What he witnessed had an impact on the life of Mr. Bethuel. Someone in the assembly sincerely prayed for Mr. Bethuel's salvation. He liked the meeting, still he felt like a fish out of water. Then on another occasion his brother invited him to attend a prayer meeting, Mr. Bethuel without saying any excuse went along with him. A guest speaker was called to deliver the sermon. He spoke from the Bible passage Mathew 3:10-12. God ministered to him through this verse "The axe is already at the root of the trees, and every tree that does not produce good fruit will be cut down and thrown into the fire". This verse touched his heart and Mr. Bethuel confessed his sins, repented for his sins and accepted Jesus as his personal saviour on that day. His brother was happy and encouraged Mr. Bethuel to read and meditate upon the verses in the Bible regularly. Mr. Bethuel started attending the youth meetings and joined in the prayer meetings. This Christian fellowship helped him to grow in the Lord. The whole family was filled with joy. He joined his Christian friends like Jeevaratna Beero and Philemon and prayed sincerely. He learned from them many spiritual things.

### MARRIAGE

When he was in the high school, Mr. Bethuel lost his father. Since the family lost its breadwinner he had to find a job to



support the family financially. His studies came to an end and he never went to the college. But he got a job in Khadi Kraft. As an employed person he helped the family. He actively participated in the Church affairs and became the Secretary of the local Church. Later he became the Treasurer of the Church. His mom had concerns for him. She took initiative and found a suitable bride in Ms. Sukanti for him. Mr. Bethuel Bardhan and Ms. Sukanti got married in the Baptist Church on 19th June 1981. God blessed their married life with two daughters – Sujatha and Sunitha - and a boy Sangram.

## **GOD'S CALL TO THE MISSION**

Mr. Bethuel and his friends used to pray for the missionaries who were doing the ministry through FMPB. His friends shared about the ministry of Friends Missionary Prayer Band. Pangajlal Bardhan and Jeevaratna Beero joined FMPB and went to North India as missionaries. Whenever they visited Odisha, they shared their experiences in the mission fields in North India in the prayer meetings and in the Church. Mr. Bethuel was highly motivated to involve in the ministry of FMPB. Later, God ministered to him and he committed his life for the missionary work. As a bread winner of the family, he was not able to go as a missionary immediately. But God continued to work in his heart, his friends also encouraged him to obey God and his missionary friends urged him to join them. In the midst of his family responsibilities, he took a bold decision to go as a missionary. In 1991, as a family they attended the interview conducted by FMPB at Hyderabad. They were selected and sent for one year training in Bethel Bible Institute, Danishpet. After their training, they went to Gonda for language and practical training.

## **CHURCH PLANTING MINISTRY**

Mrs. and Mr Bethuel were sent to Karkadi field of Gujarat state. They spent time to learn the local language of the people and started their ministry. They admitted their children in the Santhosha Vidhyala, Dohnavur. Along with the other kids of the missionaries, they continued their studies. Once, the parents travelled from their field to Nagpur to drop their children in school. When they got off from the train with their children and tried to board another train, they noticed their important suitcase was missing. They were shocked and discouraged knowing that it was stolen in the train. Then they reached the Field Office Nagpur with the hand luggage. The other missionaries shared their dresses with them. The children also got the needed dress. In the beginning days of their ministry they faced a trying incident like this. In the midst of crisis, they also learned about the grace of the Lord through the love of fellow missionaries. When they began their missionary work at Kakkadi, they found a very small house for their stay. There was no electricity or toilet and no access to drinking water. Besides that part was not connected by road or transport facilities. The village was located in the interior place of a jungle. But the Lord God who is Emmanuel was with them. After learning the language of the people, they started to share the love of God. Many responded and Mrs and Mr. Bethuel sincerely prayed for the sick and needy people. God did miracles and confirmed the Word of God through miracle. One day, a villager called on him and requested him to pray for his buffalo which was yielding good quantity of milk till recently. This family depended on the buffalo milk for their livelihood. Suddenly the buffalo stopped to yield milk and became

sick. This family was reduced to poverty and there was no food at home for them to eat. They requested the missionaries to help them to come out of this situation. Mr. Bethuel prayed earnestly and God healed the buffalo and it began to yield milk. So, this family accepted Christ. The ministry started flourishing and very soon people from different villages accepted Christ. They continued to conduct night meetings. As a result, four congregations were established. Hundreds of people worshipped the Lord in the newly built Churches. Some jealous anti-Christians started working against the missionaries. They even foisted false cases against them. From 1996-98, they started their ministry from Pimpalner mission field. Here a local magician accepted Christ, and God did a miracle in his life. He had a problem in his leg and he was not able to walk. He took a lot of efforts for the healing by conducting poojas, but nothing worked in his favour. But day by day the pain in his leg increased and the muscles were damaged. Mr. Bethuel was called to pray for him; he prayed for the healing of this local magician. God heard the prayer and healed the man. He began to walk and started doing his regular work. So, he accepted the Lord and the village people who witnessed this miracle also put their faith in Lord Jesus. In that area, within a few years more than three thousand people were baptized and four big Churches were built. In 1996, the CNI Diocese of Bolangir ordained Mr. Bethuel as a presbyter. From 1998 onwards, Rev. Bethuel was given the responsibility to officiate as Regional Secretary. Then, he was in charge of the Leadership Training Institute at Pipalwada and trained many Church elders and local

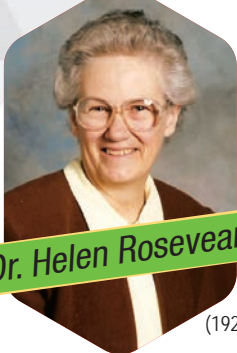
evangelists. After that for the next six years he led the Prayer and Revival ministry based at Pipalwada. In 2006, he was again given the regional responsibility and he started his ministry from Chandrapur, Maharashtra.

## LAST DAYS

Rev. Bethuel served the Lord among the Kukna tribe in Gujarat and brought the Gospel to Bhil people of Maharashtra border as pioneer missionary. He served the Lord in different capacities such as Secretary of South West Region II, Secretary of RARE Center of Pimpalner, Secretary of Leadership Training Institute in Pipalwada and Secretary of Odisha Promotional ministry. Finally, he participated in National Missionary Conference at Coimbatore as family and went back to Odisha and continued his promotional ministry. He was admitted in one of the hospitals at Bhubaneswar for Gall Bladder stones removal on 10/06/17. The operation was successful. However, he was suffering from high blood pressure and had breathing troubles. The doctors said that his kidneys and liver had stopped functioning because of jaundice. With no further result to the treatment, Rev. Bethuel Bardhan entered into glory on 01/07/17. Rev. Bethuel, always had a smile on his face and was a man of very pleasing demeanour. With enthusiasm and burden for souls, he was prepared to move to an entirely new area for preaching the Gospel whenever he was asked to shift his base. Remember his wife Suganthi and two daughters Sujatha and Sunitha, who are married, and the son Sankram Kesari in your prayers

## TRAIL BLAZERS



Dr. Helen Roseveare

(1925-2016)

**H**elen Roseveare was born in 1925 at Haileybury College (Hertfordshire, England), where her father taught mathematics. Raised in a high Anglican church, Helen's Sunday school teacher once told their class about India, and Helen resolved to herself that she would one day be a missionary. Despite the Christian heritage of her family, and faithful attendance at church, Helen sensed a void in her life and distance from God.

She enrolled in Newnham College at Cambridge University to study medicine. There she joined the Cambridge Inter-Collegiate Christian Union (CICCU) through the invitation of a student named Dorothy. She became an active participant in the prayer meetings and Bible studies, reading the New Testament for the first time. But she later said that her understanding of Christianity was more head knowledge than heart engagement.

In the winter of 1945, the Lord seemed to meet her in a personal way during a student retreat. She gave her testimony on the final evening, and Bible teacher Graham Scroggie wrote Philippians 3:10 in her new Bible, and told her: Tonight you've entered into the first part of the verse, "That I may know Him." This is only the beginning, and there's a long journey ahead. My prayer for you is that you will go on through the verse to know "the power of His resurrection" and also, God willing, one day perhaps, "the fellowship of His sufferings, being made conformable unto His death."

She felt an increased sense of calling toward missions, and publicly declared during a missionary gathering in North England, "I'll go anywhere God wants me to, whatever the cost." After graduating from Cambridge with her doctorate in medicine, Helen studied for six months at the Worldwide Evangelization Crusade college at Crystal Palace. In Mid-March of 1953, at the age of 28, she arrived in the north-eastern region of the Congo (later named Zaire).

In the first two years, she founded a training school for nurses, training women to serve as nurse-evangelists, who in turn would run clinics and dispensaries in different regions. In October 1955, she was asked to transfer seven miles away to run an abandoned maternity and leprosy center in Nebobongo. Working with local Africans, Helen helped to transform the center into a hospital with 100 beds, serving mothers, lepers, and children, along with a training school for paramedics and 48 rural clinics. Outside of these facilities, there was no other medical help for 150 miles in any direction.

Exhausted, Helen returned to England in 1958 for a furlough, during which time she

received further medical training. The Congo became independent from Belgium in 1960, and civil war broke out in 1964. All of the medical facilities they had established were destroyed. Helen was among ten Protestant missionaries put under house arrest by the rebel forces for several weeks, after which time they were moved and imprisoned. From there she tried to escape. As a result she was found, dragged, struck over her head and shoulder, kicked, tooth broken, yelled at, insulted, cursed etc. Her captors, she wrote, “were brutal and drunken.

Helen Roseveare was brutally raped. On that dreadful night, beaten and bruised, terrified and tormented, unutterably alone, she felt that God had failed her. Surely He could have stepped in earlier; surely things need not have gone that far. She had reached what seemed to be the ultimate depth of despairing nothingness.

In that darkness, however, she sensed the Lord saying to her: You asked Me, when you were first converted, for the privilege of being a missionary. This is it. Don't you want it? . . . These are not your sufferings. They're Mine. All I ask of you is the loan of your body. She eventually received an “overwhelming sense of privilege that Almighty God would stoop to ask of me, a mere nobody in a forest clearing in the jungles of Africa, something He needed.”

One word became unbelievably clear, and that word was privilege. He didn't take away pain or cruelty or humiliation. No! It was all there, but now it was altogether different. It was with him, for him, in him. He was actually offering me the inestimable privileged of sharing in some little way the edge of the fellowship of his suffering.

After returning to African in 1966, she soon left Nebobongo to establish a new medical center in Nyankunde in northeastern Zaire, producing a 250-bed hospital, maternity ward, training college for doctors, a center for leprosy, and other endeavors. There, too, she experienced several trials and relational difficulties. She never claimed to see visions or hear the voice of the Lord, but she did sense him rebuking her attitude. On one occasion, her conviction from the Lord went as follows: You no longer want Jesus only, but Jesus plus . . . plus respect, popularity, public opinion, success and pride. You wanted to go out with all the trumpets blaring, from a farewell-do that you organized for yourself with photographs and tape-recordings to show and play at home, just to reveal what you had achieved. You wanted to feel needed and respected. You wanted the other missionaries to be worried about how they'll ever carry on after you've gone. You'd like letters when you go home to tell how much they realize they owe to you, how much they miss you. All this and more. Jesus plus. . . . No, you can't have it. Either it must be “Jesus only” or you'll find you have no Jesus. You'll substitute Helen Roseveare.

In 1973, Helen returned to the UK for health reasons, settling in Northern Ireland. She traveled, wrote several books, and served as a missionary advocate. She went to be with her Lord, from whom she counted it a privilege to suffer, on December 7, 2016, at the age of 91. “God never uses a person greatly until He has wounded him deeply. The privilege He offers you is greater than the price you have to pay. The privilege is greater than the price - Helen Roseveare

# Bawan Church History

GHATAMPUR FIELD,  
KANPUR REGION,

**B**awan is a medium size village located in Ghatampur Tehsil of Kanpur Nagar district, Uttar Pradesh with total 258 families residing. The Bawan village has population of 1434 of which 781 are males while 653 are females as per Population Census 2011. It is located 50 KM towards South from District headquarters, Kanpur.

Under the leadership of Mr. Paul Daya Singh the pioneer missionaries of Ghatampur mission field Mr. Azariah Raj Kumar and Mr. Raja Edwin Moses opened this field in the month of March 1991.

Mrs. Geetha from Thaga village heard the Gospel and accepted Christ through the people of another organization met Mr. C R George and confessed the faith along with her husband, Shiv Kumar on 11.6.2005 at Ghatampur. Through her prayers her nephew and niece who were suffering from some kind

of sickness were healed. Inspired by this, she started conducting worship in the school (Koriyamode, near Bawan village) where she was residing and teaching. 40 to 50 people gathered for worship there. People who came to the satsung were healed and became believers. Soon she joined FMPB as casual volunteer (was made a local evangelist later) and was taking care of Koriya sub-center along with another woman, Mrs. Shakuntala.



Mrs. Gudia's sister-in-law. Through her Mrs. Gudia from Bawan village heard of the



satsung and experienced a miracle in her son's life. Here she narrates her testimony. I met Geethadidi and asked her to pray for Kamal. She gave us some prayer oil and we applied it on Kamal's neck. Through prayers our son got healed and from then on we decided to accept Christ. Mr. Pratap who had a wound in his feet too was healed and relieved from his pain. Local evangelist, Mrs. Geetha went village by village riding her bicycle reaching along with the missionaries' wives for ministry. Another one Geetha who was also a tailor before heard the Gospel and her husband who was jobless got a job and there was a change in his character. As the attendance increased, the worship was shifted to Ajith's house at Bawan village. The worship continued there for 2 years.



In fulfillment of her vow Priyanka who secured more than 70% marks, she confessed her faith on 21.6.2011 and was growing in the Lord. She started reading the Bible every morning and evening and whenever she got time. One evening, her father saw her reading the Bible and he scolded her. He threatened to tear the Bible if she did the same. That same night when her father went out of the house, he saw a bright light above a neem tree. In the middle of the bright light he saw Jesus Christ. He fainted and fell down

immediately. When he came to his senses, he asked pardon and promised not to oppose Priyanka anymore."



Due to frequent quarrelling at Ajith's house the worship was shifted to the house of Raguraj and then to the house of Gore. Again due to backsliding or some issues the worshipping place was further shifted to another believer's house. The worship continued there till the Church was built. So the Bawan congregation believers prayed for a suitable church land at their village and the Lord heard them. A 4 biswa (4500 sqft) land was purchased from Mr. Ram Lakhan for Rs. 2,50,000. The Bawan Church land was registered in Jan 2013. The Bawan Church believers helped in the Church construction by doing labour work. After the dedication of Bawan Church, the neighboring landlord, Mr. Lakhan Singh Thakur opposed the compound wall construction. He claimed that the Church was constructed on his land. Missionary, Mr. Suresh Malto brought the lekhpal (a clerk who maintains the village records) twice to solve the problem. But Mr. Lakhan Singh Thakur refused to accept any solution. After 3 years of Church construction, the dispute came to an end and the compound wall was built in 2018.

In 2016, Mrs. Geetha's husband, Mr. Shiv Kumar joined as local evangelist in her place. This couple vibrantly leads the Bawan Church till today.

**God's hand was always on his people who enjoyed His protection.**

Believer, Daya Shankar is from Asgaha village while on his way to Kanpur ran and caught hold of one of the bars of the moving train and lost his balance. He fell on the tracks. Immediately he felt like someone lifting him from the tracks and made him sit aside safely. He presumed that his legs were cut by the train but he faced no harm. A traveler in the train saw him and shouted at Daya Shankar that he got escaped by a hair's breath.



In another incident in July 2011, Believer, Daya Shankar along with a team went to attend a marriage function in a jeep. Suddenly the jeep they were traveling collided with a truck and The Jeep driver jumped out and escaped. The jeep moved forward without the driver and stopped. Through Daya Shankar the only Christian, God protected

everybody. Believer Vijayalakshmi in whose house the worship was held, had decided to go to the Sakar viswa Hari satsung. But she lost her eyesight in a day or two. She heard a voice which told her to pray so that her eyesight would be restored. She did similarly and her eyesight was restored and she opened her house for worship once again. On 27.3.2013, Chandravathi from Bawan village and her mother were walking for a long distance and they sat under a tree to have some rest. Suddenly, Chandravathi felt like someone speaking to her to vacate the place immediately. She caught hold of her mom and ran away from the tree. All of a sudden, the tree under which they were sitting was attacked by lightning and the tree got burnt. This incident occurred at Saidapur village. God saved Chandravathi and her mother that day. The Keontra village believers worshipped the Lord at two places. After a long time, as a result of their incessant prayers, they worship together.

The total strength of the Bawan church is 164. More than 25 people have backslidden. The backslidden people have joined
