CHOSEN AS WITNESSES

Frontline...

The core message is based on Isaiah 43, centered on this year's theme - "I have chosen you - Haggai 2:23". Isaiah 43:10 says "You are my witnesses," declares the Lord, "and my servant whom I have chosen, that you may know and believe me and understand that I am He." This verse answers essential questions such as - who are chosen as witnesses? Why are they chosen? And what are their responsibilities? The apostles Peter and John, who had lived, understood and known our Lord Jesus Christ, while witnessing for Christ in Acts 4:20 said, "For we cannot but speak of what we have seen and heard". Similarly, God expects His children, who have accepted him as their personal saviour, to be a witness for Him through our words and deeds. But, the Jewish converts (people of The Way) who were scattered amongst the Gentiles after the death of Stephen, didn't proclaim the gospel to them, thus failing to accomplish God's plan of witnessing to the Gentiles (Acts 1:8). Despite this, God chose Barnabas, a man full of Holy Spirit, faith and one who had a good testimony among the people, to lead many people to Christ (Acts 11:24). This witnessing life of Barnabas was a lesson to the people in Antioch of that day and even for the Christians of today.



More than being a witness for God, He also brought back Paul from Tarsus and took him as his co-worker for Christ (Acts 11:25). Likewise, we must make our families, people around us live a witnessing life for God. Barnabas' life in Antioch, set an example of a faithful living for Christ, thus paving a way for God to execute His plans in Antioch. This made the disciples in Antioch to be called as "Christians" (the Greek word *Christianos* means a follower of Christ). The Christians of that period demonstrated the nature and attributes of Christ to others by their faithful living, which made many people come into God's fold. So, the committed life of one man Barnabas transformed many souls in Antioch. A similar transformation can happen in our families, Churches and in our country when an individual exhibits Christ's nature in his living. Let us thus examine and consider the current state of our life. We have been chosen by God to live a faithful life, which begins from our house, extends to our workplace, Churches, society, nation, and ultimately to the world (Acts 1:8). We have only one life, which passes quickly. So let us live a committed life which God expects us to live, by reflecting Christ in our daily life. We have been chosen for this very purpose. Let us grasp this and be a witness for Christ in this world. Let us all live a life that displays Jesus to others, and be a salt, a sweet-smelling aroma, a living sacrifice, and a light that shines in the dark. May God help us achieve that!

CHOSEN TO BE A WITNESS

The 3G's of being a Witness - Isaiah 43

Chosen to be a Witness is the theme of this month's issue. Let us picture the imagery of a Court Hall. Witness is to mean presenting the evidence. Witness refers to those who have seen/know the truth and are willing to testify to the truth without fear and with evidence. **Leviticus 5:1 says "If you are called to testify about something you have seen or that you know about, it is sinful to refuse to testify, and you will be punished for your sin."** Hence, we shall meditate on what kind of life should we live as witnesses based on the Scriptures.

The word 'chosen' in Hebrew according to Isaiah 43:10 mean one who is examined, tested and his character, attitude, usefulness and efficiency known and is set apart for a specific purpose.

Who are called to be a Witness?

We read from Isaiah 43:10 that a chosen witness is one who knows, believes and understands the one who has chosen him. The Lord himself has 1.Created 2. Moulded 3.Redeemed 4.Called us by name 5. And declared 'You are Mine' those whom He has chosen as we read in Isaiah 43:1. In the Holy Bible wherever the word 'Jacob' is written, it refers to the chosen one's old life and those who are washed by the blood of Jesus Christ in the new covenant. Wherever we read the word 'Israel', it refers to the chosen 12 tribes.

The Blessings of those called to be a Witness.

The Lord has given great promises as His blessings to those who are called to be a witness as found in Isaiah 43.1 Why, Where and When we should share the blessings that we have received from Him is characterized by the word 'Give'. And those who have given out His blessings to others, He also commands them to 'Guide' or in other words 'Go - bring forth' others unto Him.

Let us prayerfully ponder over the 3 G's of being called to be a witness.

1. GIVEN / WILL GIVE - Isaiah 43: 3-5 - Promise and Vision

The God who has called us to be a witness, does not ask us to do anything significant before equipping us with something specific to do the task. He has given us his precious and beloved Son Jesus. He alone is our Word, our Life. Let us look at the 3 aspects of what the Lord has given/ will give to those who are called to be His witnesses as found in Isaiah 43:3-5

a. Given His Great Promises. [Isaiah 43:1,2]

When we cross through the waters [v2] : When we, the chosen ones have to navigate our lives through challenges which may seem as big as the Red Sea, or appear like the floods of Jericho, His promises assures us that we will not be overwhelmed. **When we walk through the fire [v3] :** As mentioned in the book of Daniel, when God's chosen people encounter life situations which may be like a

small fire or as intense as an inferno, He has promised that it will not engulf us.

b. Given us The Life giving Word – Jesus. [Eph 1:4-6]

God has granted us all the spiritual blessings in Christ, and when we choose to believe in His son Jesus Christ, we can claim all the blessings that are in Christ. Jesus has given us New Life and this Life is found by faith in His Word. For this reason, God so loved the world that he sent His only beloved son Jesus Christ in whom God's word became flesh and dwelt amongst mankind.

c. Given a Ransom for us [Is 43:3,4]

In order to redeem the chosen ones from the bondage of Sin, the Lord declares '**I give Egypt for your ransom, Cush and Seba in your stead**'. And if God's giving up the Egyptians to destruction - as an atonement - in order to save His chosen people, was a proof of His love for them, how much greater is the demonstration of His love when He gives His own holy Son to the bitter pains of death on a cross, in order that His church may be redeemed! How much more faithful we should be as witness to God's son Jesus who was the Ransom for our Salvation.

2. GIVE - Isaiah 43:5,6

Many times we tend to forget the Giver and focus our life more on what we have received. Let us reflect on the three aspects of what the Lord desires for the chosen ones to Give.

a. Give unto the Giver.

We may sometimes feel as though God who has promised 'It will be given' wants us to give back to Him what He has given to us. Little do we realise that our giving back is a bigger blessing. Many times when we testify for the Lord, we mostly speak of the blessings of health and materialistic needs that God has granted us. For all the blessings that God

has granted us, how much gratitude have we shown by giving back to the Lord? The extent of our blessedness and thankfulness is proportional to our giving back to the Lord. What do you mean by blessings? The worldly blessings are a fivefold 1. A beautiful spouse 2. Two blessed children 3. A glorious triple bedroom house 4. A costly four wheeler and 5. A monthly salary of 5 digits. In contrast the term 'Godly blessings' in the root language is called "Barak". One of its meanings implies "To be loaded in order to unload". All the blessings that we have are in a sense loaded on to us by the Lord. Wherever God leads us to give away or share those blessings, we have to unload them in obedience. In the nation of Israel, camels are reared to carry loads. The fishermen will load their catch of fish and will take them into the city of Jerusalem through the fish gate for trading. If the camel assumes that the whole load of fish belongs to it, and refuses to be unloaded it would only end up in the whole fish load getting rotten and the camel being chased out of Jerusalem. Just as a camel is loaded so that it will be unloaded in some designated place, all the blessings that are granted to us by the Lord has to be given up at some point to someone when asked for by the Lord.

b. Give unto God the Best of your Life.

Apart from sharing our materialistic blessings, we ought to share the spiritual blessings that we have received from the Lord too. Psalms 118:17 says '**I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the LORD**'. We must strive to give the best to the Lord who has blessed us. **1. We must give our priority time to the Lord:** Some of us feel contented in just giving the remaining available time or our retirement time for the Lord's service. Every day, the early morning time and the time before we retire to our beds is to be

dedicated to the Lord. Parents must have the courage to dedicate the best skill sets of their children for the Lord's service. Pastors must motivate their youth to give the prime of their life towards the ministry of soul winning.

2. We must give our prime treasures to the Lord: If all that we have received is from the Lord, we ought to give not sparingly, but rather abundantly. God does not deserve our leftovers of life, but rather the best of our life, time, skills, talents and treasures for His service.

c. Give unto the North and don't hoard it in the South: Share your blessings with the north imply the unified Kingdom of Israel being split. Under the leadership of Saul, David and Solomon the Kingdom of Israel was united. But after them, the Kingdom was divided into Northern Kingdom(10 tribes) and Southern Kingdom (2 tribes). It was essential for those blessed in the southern Kingdom to share with the North. Likewise what a blessing to India when Thomas, one amongst the 12 disciples of Jesus, came all the way to our Nation to share the good news of Jesus Christ with us. When the good news about Jesus is still unknown to so many perishing souls in North India, the Lord reminds the people of South India not to hoard up our materialistic and spiritual blessings down in the south, but rather direct it towards His Kingdom growth in the North.

3. GO AND BRING FORTH - Isaiah 43:6-8 **- The Gospel and Witnesses**

a. Bring the blind and the deaf: The Lord has ordained us to guide His sons and daughters, those who are called by His name from far off places unto Him. God has a chosen remnant, that still bear His name and seek Him amongst the many who try to seek the Lord with eyes that fail to see and ears that fail to hear & know the one true

Living God. The Lord invites us to take up the responsibility to be a lighthouse, guiding the chosen remnant towards Jesus Christ by our witnessing life.

b. Bring the Multitudes: God has ordained his chosen ones to be a witness and prepare a great multitude of souls to receive the Lord Jesus Christ in His second coming. He has ordained this task of evangelisation not to angels, but to ordinary mortals like you and me who are washed by the blood of Jesus Christ. Among the Israelites it has been ordained for 144,000 to be chosen by the Lord - 12000 representing each tribe. But for a vast multitude to receive the Lord on his second coming, God invites each one of us to be a testimony so that, on the Judgement day people from every tribe, every language group, every nation, a countless multitude wearing a shining white robe, waving the palm branches and standing before the Lamb upon the throne, will be receiving Him with great rejoicing. [Rev 7:4-9]

c. Bring Witnesses for the Lord: If we are identified as a 'Christian ', it is imperative that our words and actions, our lives and lifestyles reflect the image and glory of Jesus Christ. Our witnessing life for Christ must encourage others to choose being a witness for the Lord.

Consequences of failing to be a Witness: When we fail to live a witnessing life for the Lord, it is a curse upon us, as the scriptures say in Isaiah 43:28. When we fail to be a fragrant offering, a witness for the Lord, we become responsible for those who profane the most Holy name of our Lord and heap curses upon our Nation. Hence with great trembling and fear, we must strive to shine as a witness, as light and salt, to lead many towards the Calvary Hill. May the Lord help us to accomplish this.



Field Visit and Witness

We eagerly started our mission field trip to visit the FMPB Missionaries working among the Malto and Santhali tribes living in the Rajmahal hilly terrain, to witness the Churches they have planted and take part in the Spiritual gathering they conducted. It was a great privilege to have the Bishop of Tirunelveli Rt. Rev. A.R.G.S.T. Barnabas and his family participated for 2 days in the 3 days Santali Spiritual gathering which was organized.

We were astonished to see the spiritual maturity of about 6700 Santhalis who participated with Christian discipline and patience. In the blazing sun, these people even waited patiently in lines when lunch was being served, in stark contrast to the sad state of our city Church congregations who will rush forward even when communion is being served. It was a glorious sight to behold during the Sunday worship service when these Santhalis offered their offertories with great godliness and took part in the communion with reverence.

The Bishop consecrated two new Churches and the consecration services were a blessing. The Lord also enabled us to declare open few class rooms of an Elementary school, a Kitchen and a Hostel warden's residence facility. We were also able to participate in a Field Spiritual gathering of Malto people, to have fellowship with the missionaries working among Malto and Santhali people groups, to see a few children's Hostels, the Pantheni School, a community welfare campus and the Chandikola Hospital campus. We prayerfully dedicated and opened the Operation Theatre and a few essential services in the Hospital.



We returned back from Jharkhand with a great satisfaction. Even though my wife faced a little sickness during the visit, the Lord blessed her with good health during the return journey. I too had my share of sickness with cough and breathlessness which caused me to suffer. On my return to Chennai I had to be hospitalized in the



intensive care unit. I do not remember the days I spent in the ICU. But I am not able to forget the days when I was surrounded by Malto and Santhali people who joyfully sang unto the Lord. I am not able to discern whether it was in real or a dream. Afterwards I was shifted to the ward and later discharged with my health restored. My cough had subsided but I still had difficulties in breathing. A few days later, I developed sudden bleeding through my nose and mouth. I was immediately admitted to the Apollo Hospital and after an intensive care treatment; I was discharged from the hospital.

The Lord has allowed this storm of sickness to rock my family and it did cause us to suffer. But the Lord was with us and he saved us from the midst of roaring lions. The victory that was accomplished by the Lord on the cross, gave our family strength to come out victorious amidst our trials and sufferings. We were healed. Continue to pray for us. The Lord has given me, an undeserving person, people who pray, enquire, comfort and guide me through the family of FMPB. I praise God for this great blessing I have received in my life.

On the 4th of March, the team reached Pakur, Jharkhand. The missionaries Rev. Daniel Arulmani, Rev. Henry & his wife were with us throughout the trip. From Pakur, the team travelled to Dangra. We were warmly welcomed with music, dancing, garlands and washing of our feet. The team was truly humbled by their warm welcome. The Lord enabled us to minister to about five families who were gathered there. We were challenged when a young boy recited scripture verses by heart; they also sang a special song for us.

After returning to the FMPB LTI campus, we watched a presentation of photos and videos of the boys in the Bhagaiya hostel which we were unfortunately not able to visit. Missionary Bro Kennedy briefed us about the struggles the boys face. We prayed with him. The team travelled to the Dumka Spritual gathering in the evening for the inauguration. We were once again warmly welcomed with music, dancing, garlands, and washing of our feet according to their custom. The Lord enabled us to minister there with singing and sharing of the Word, to over 4000 people who had come to the Spritual gathering. We were much encouraged by the believers worshipping the Lord sincerely and receiving the Scriptures with utmost concentration. We stayed at the boys' hostel in Chandna that night and were blessed to minister to the boys there. The next morning, the team sang a song in Bengali & made the boys sing along & do the actions. The Word of God was again shared before traveling to the Dumka Spritual gathering again. The team taught a Bengali song, performed a skit, and the Word of God was shared in the Spritual gathering. The team was filled with admiration for the people there and the thirst they had for God. We were also amazed to see the way the missionaries had pioneered all these years. We were blessed to meet many missionaries and had the privilege of having fellowship dinner and lunch with them at the Spritual gathering. The team interacted with missionaries there and was challenged when we heard of the hardships and struggles they had faced.

The team reached Chennai on the 6th of March. This trip was truly an immense blessing for each member of the team. We returned with a new sense of enthusiasm and passion to serve the Lord and to pray for the ministry in Jharkhand. Each of us were challenged and humbled. We have come back with a great burden to raise funds for the purchase of a school van for students of the Bhagaiya hostel who travel 4 km to school through stone quarry, dust and grime.

Mr. Victor Murugesan

(1952 - 2023)

Mr. Victor Murugesan hails from a Non-Christian background and later committed his life to become a cross-cultural missionary in FMPB. He served the Lord for 40 years. God called him to His glory at the age of 71.

Mr. Victor Murugesan was born on November 1, 1952, in a village called Vaikalipatti, near Kadayam, Tenkasi district of Tamilnadu. His father was Mr. Moses Mayavan, and his mother, Mrs. Grace Packiathai, later accepted Christ as his personal Saviour. He had four more brothers and one sister. After his SSLC, he joined CIT, Guindy, for two years of ITI Moulder's course and two years of Instructor training (ITI Teacher Training).

In 1973, late Mr. Boominathan of FMPB shared about Jesus and what He did on the cross. So, Mr. Victor Murugesan started to read the Bible whenever he was free. One day when he was sleeping, God reminded him of a Bible verse from Matthew 9:6: **"The Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins"**. Then,

the spirit of God convicted him of his sins, and Mr. Victor Murugesan confessed his sins and got the assurance that Jesus had forgiven his sins. Mr. D. Sunderraj, Mr. D.K. David, and Mr. John Tyre helped Mr. Victor Murugesan grow in the Lord.

In 1975, Mr. Victor Murugesan attended FMPB Gideonites' meet at Nellikuppam. In this missionary camp, the songs, missionary sharing, and mission challenging messages made a great impact in the life of Mr. Victor Murugesan. And thus, Mr. Victor Murugesan committed his life to full time ministry and prepared himself to go as a missionary. Again, God confirmed his call through Psalm 4:3. **Know that the Lord has set apart his faithful servant for himself; the Lord hears when I call to him.** As per the call of the Lord, he joined FMPB on July 15, 1977. After one year of missionary training in BBI, Danishpet, he was sent to the Operation Mobilisation team for practical evangelism training in 1979. After six months of practical training, FMPB placed Mr. Victor in Akkalkuwa, Nandurbar district, Maharashtra. The pioneer missionary was Rev. Nathaniel Logaraj and Mr. Victor joined him as his co-worker in June 1979. They learned the language and preached the Gospel in village after village. God blessed their ministry and many were baptised. The first baptism was in Ambilipari village, due to the miracle of a deaf and dumb boy who was healed completely by the prayer of our missionaries.

The fiancée was from Alankulam, Ms. Amala. She was sent to KBS Allahabad for short training before the marriage in 1981. Mr. Victor Murugesan and Ms. Amala's marriage was held on December 28th, 1981, at Alankulam. God blessed their married life with two girl children, namely Persis Packiavathy and Shekina. Mrs. Persis Packiavathy finished her M.Sc in Agriculture, and Mrs. Shakina finished her M.Sc. in Nursing. Both their daughters got married and settled in Chennai and other cities.

After the marriage of Mr. Victor Murugesan and Mrs. Amala, they moved to Selamba in Gujarat and started the Church planting ministry among the Vasava people. God blessed their ministry with many souls and congregations. At present, because of these missionaries and local evangelists, God has blessed FMPB with more than 44000 people worshipping the Lord in 360 congregations. From 1993 onwards, Rev. Victor was given the responsibility of Regional Secretary, South West Region II and started his ministry based in Vyara, Gujarat. In 2004, he was posted at Waghai as the administrator for the South West Zone. Along with the leaders of FMPB, he actively took part in integrating the 211 churches planted by FMPB in Gujarat with the CNI-Gujarat Diocese in the presence of thousands of believers. In 2010, he was appointed field secretary for South Asia, based at the Nagpur field office. From April 2012, he served as the Secretary of Property and Project based at H.Q. of FMPB Chennai, until his superannuation in 2017.

Rev. Victor Murugesan was staying with his second daughter, Mrs. Shakina, in Chennai. In January 2023, he moved to Tiruchendur and lived with his first daughter, Mrs. Persis Allwin. On March 23, he was travelling to Coimbatore with his daughter's family for the family get-together. On the morning of the 24th, when the train was crossing the Maniyatchi railway station, while going to the restroom, he fell off the train and no one noticed it. Due to this accident, he went to be with the Lord. His body was recovered on March 25, and his mortal remains were buried in Thirumullaivoyal graveyard on March 26 with the hope of resurrection. Let us thank God for his life, well lived as a pioneer, Church planter, mission administrator, and educator.

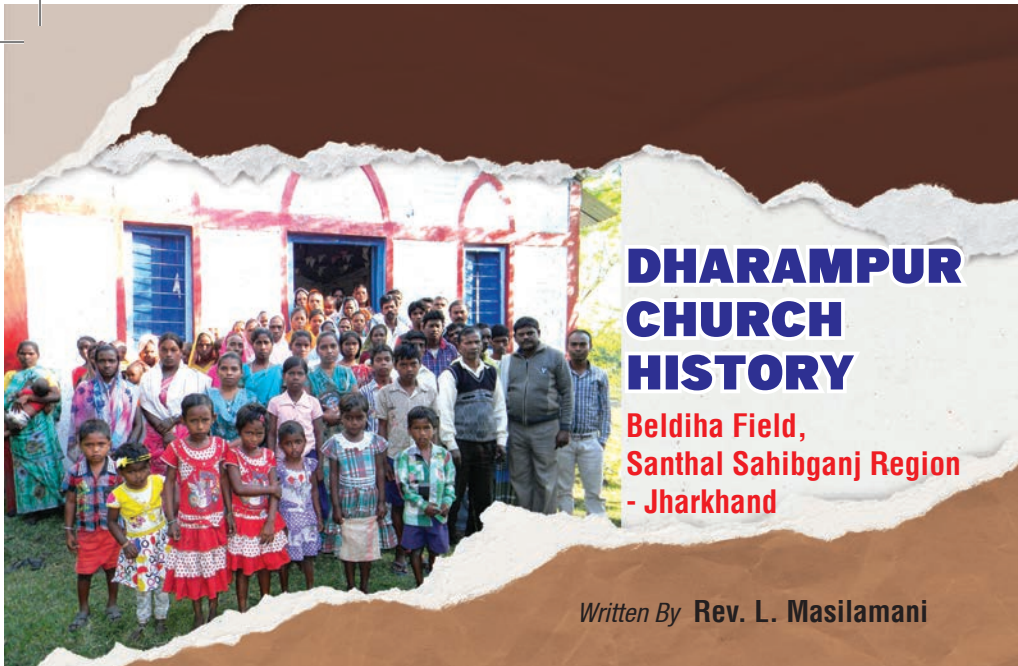

DHARAMPUR CHURCH HISTORY

**Beldiha Field,
Santhal Sahibganj Region
- Jharkhand**

Dharampur is a small village located in Hiranpur Block of Pakur district, Jharkhand in which 68 families are residing. The Dharampur village has a population of 354 of which 176 are males and 178 are females. Dharampur village has a lower literacy rate compared to Jharkhand. In 2011, the literacy rate of Dharampur village was 38.32% compared to 66.41% of Jharkhand. As per the constitution of India and Panchyati Raaj Act, Dharampur village is administrated by Sarpanch (Head of the Village) who is the elected representative of the Village Gram Panchayat. The name of the Dharampur village is Kendua. The nearest Town to the Dharampur village is Pakur which is 12 km away. In Dharampur village, most of the village population is from Schedule Tribe (ST). They are around 96.05% of the total population in Dharampur

village. They work as Agriculture Labourers, cultivators (owner or co-owner) and other Marginal labourers.

The Beginning

Dharampur village comes under Beldiha mission field, which was created when Mahespur mission field was divided into two fields in 1997, one named as Mahespur and another as Beldiha. Mahespur field was opened by the end of May 1991. Rev. Prabakara Sarathay's family was the first missionaries of this mission field till they took up the responsibility of the Regional field Secretary of Godda Region by the end of 1996. During the time of Sarathay's family Gospel seeds were sown in the Dharampur village. Rev. Arulanandam took up the responsibility of Mahespur field in 1997 and the congregation in Dharampur was established in his time. From April 1998

onwards Beldiha field was established under the leadership of Rev. Arulanandan family who were the first missionaries to this newly started Beldiha mission field. He continued up to 2006. Then A. Solomon family took charge of this field.



Johan Soren

The first believer and the first Church elder **Johan Marandi** describes the initial history of how FMPB ministry was started in his village: “My old name is Boloi Soren. Now my name is Johan Soren. Evangelist Immanuel Malto, Church elder Abraham Kadoja, Gideon and Solomon Hansda brought the Gospel to our village. They came to my house and shared the Gospel when a night meeting was conducted in the street. I heard the Gospel for the first time. I understood Christ as the Savior of the world and accepted Him into my life. My wife was not willing to confirm her faith. But I told my wife that I have accepted Christ and I would like to confirm my faith. Then my wife too agreed. 15 persons were added to the fold of Jesus in the first faith confirming service in November 1997. At that time I was in poverty and hardly we had anything to eat. Today, God has blessed us with enough money and food for the family”.

Church Growth

Johan Marandi: “The congregation gathered in the house of Kapra Marandi, for

two weeks. Then the meeting was shifted to Thilma Kisku’s home. In the first meeting 15 persons participated. I conducted the first meeting. As the number increased, believers gathered under a mango tree. They continued to worship for three years under the mango tree. I attended the training in Bahaya. God has blessed my house because of such ministries.”

Miraculous Healing to Duli Soren:

“I belong to Mundan village. I had much pain in my stomach. I was taken to Rampur hospital. I was told that my womb has gone down and it requires immediate operation. I did not have money for the operation. So I prayed for my health. It was in May 2013, God healed me miraculously. I gave an offering of Rs.500/ to the Church.

Church Construction



Marang Murmu

Believers felt the need of a Church building. Church Construction work started in February 1999. Foundation was laid by the field missionaries. The land for the

Church was donated by Marang Murmu. He describes why he donated his land for the Church and how he was blessed by God by his action: “My name is Marang Murmu. I had accepted Jesus Christ before the FMPB’s ministry in my village. I had confirmed my faith through the Swedish Mission. I thought that if there is a Church in my village, many people would come to faith. So I donated my land for the Church. My three children had died before I donated this land. I prayed to God that children should not die any more. Once, a prayer meeting was conducted in our Church. Two by two we were asked to pray for each other’s needs. One person prayed for my prayer request for God to save my remaining children from death. God had answered that prayer and now I have five children.”

No opposition was there during the time of the Church construction. Church members worked freely to construct the Church. Sometimes they received only 15 percentages of the laborers’ wages of sixty rupees per day. Church elder donated stones for laying the foundation. It is a pucca Church with ACC roof. The Dharampur Church was dedicated on 28-10-2001 by missionaries Rev. Sudhakaran and Rev. Henry. They both participated along with their families. The Village level school was started in Dharampur village in May 2003.

There are nearly 25 families with approximately 150 members. Believers attend this Church from Chota Mulgan

and Dharampur villages. Today only 25 to 30 persons attend the Sunday services, because some people have backslidden. Ladies attend the services and the Gents don’t attend because they go to work in coal mines. Bisnath leads the Church services. This year none confirmed their faith in the Lord. Sunday Services and small group gatherings are conducted. Sunday classes and the Wednesday fasting prayers are yet to begin. Evangelists Markus Malto, Immanuel Mirdha, Gagri Paulos, David, Reuben, Ladson Murmu and Joseph Malto are in this Church. The Church Elders were Johan Soren, Bisnath Hansda and at present it is Seedaa Murmu. Two families have backslidden, because one has moved to other village and the other has joined the RC Church. Sulad Kisku is leading a small group which gathers on Saturdays, alternatively in every house held from 10 am onwards at least for two hours. Only ladies attend these meetings. Ten to twenty ladies gather. They intercede for the sick people, poor people, for those who live in spiritual darkness, to know Jesus Christ as Saviour.

(1953 - 2023)

T.J. Thomas was born on 20th November 1953, in the Vadaserikara village of Pathanamthitta district of Kerala. His parents Mr. M.A. Joseph and mother Mrs. Annamma were pious Christians. His father was a Telephone Line Inspector and mother was a homemaker. God blessed Mr. T.J. Thomas with one Brother T.J. George and two sisters - T.J. Mariamma and T.J. Alice. From childhood onwards the parents reared the children in God fearing ways. Mr. T.J. Thomas finished his SSLC in the Government High School at Vadaserikara in 1970. He pursued his higher studies in the nearby Catholicate College, Pathanamthitta and finished his B.A., degree in 1977. He also learned type writing and shorthand. He was just a nominal Christian. At the age of seventeen he attended a convention with his friends in the year 1970 at Vadaserikara. The spirit of God convicted him. He confessed his sins and accepted Jesus as his personal saviour in that meeting along with his friends. Visible changes were obvious in his life.

His heart was inclined to the missionary work and was regular in attending the prayers conducted by FMPB to pray for the perishing souls. While he was meditating on the Bible, he heard God's call to the ministry, but he wanted to find a

secular job and do the ministry but God shut all the doors. Finally He decided to join FMPB and joined on 15th December 1978. He was sent to Bethel Bible Institute Danishpet, Salem for one year missionary training. Then, he was placed in Sirsa field of Haryana state. The climatic condition was not suitable. Later he assisted the field Director Mr. Ebenezer Sunder Raj in the field office from 11th December 1981. In 1982 he was transferred to the South West Zone office at Vyara to take care of the office work.

T.J. Thomas married Ms. Saramma on 11th April 1983 at St. John's Marthoma Church, Vadaserikara. God blessed this couple with two girl children. Anila Ruth Thomas was born on 28th Dec. 1984 and Beryl Roselin Thomas was born on 6th Feb. 1991. After their studies both are married and were leading a witnessing life. The couple, Mr. T.J. Thomas and Mrs. Saramma Thomas were sent to Bhatinda in Punjab. Again they were transferred to the Jhansi field office to help in the administrative works. Due to their health issues, they were transferred to FMPB HQs, Chennai in 1987. Mr. T.J. Thomas served in the Finance Department for many years as the cashier, in the accounts section, payment section etc. Due to the need of the Organization, Mr. T.J. Thomas was given the responsibility to mobilize Malayalam speaking Christians for the mission from October 1996. God raised many praying partners, members and sponsors. The Bishop of CNI East Himalayan Diocese ordained Mr. T.J. Thomas as a Presbyter on 15th May 2005.

Rev. T.J. Thomas retired on 30th November 2018 at the age of 65. He continued his mission mobilization ministry among the Malayalam speaking Christians in Chennai city. Rev. T.J. Thomas became very weak as he developed many complications in his body. He was hospitalized and after a month long treatment, there was not much improvement in his health. He entered into God's glory on 25th February 2023. On 28th February his mortal remains were buried with the hope of resurrection at the Marthoma Church Cemetery at Minjur. Please uphold Mrs. Saramma and her daughters' families in your prayers.

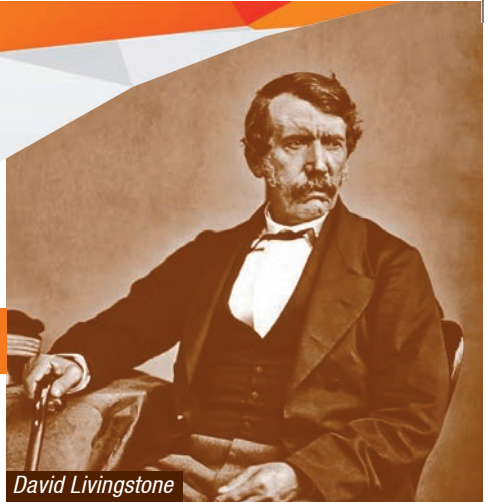
TRAIL BLAZERS

Highway of Holiness

*A highway will be there, a roadway,
And it will be called the Highway of
Holiness. Isa. 35:8*

On the morning of May 1, 1873, at 4am, the boys who kept watch at David Livingstone's door beheld their master. By the candle still burning they saw him, not in bed; but kneeling at the bedside, with his head buried in his hands upon the pillow. The sad, yet not unexpected truth soon became evident; he died the way he lived; in the act of prayer, -prayer often offered in that reverent attitude; commending his own spirit, into the hands of his Saviour; and commending Africa, his own dear Africa, with all her woes and sins and wrongs, into the hands of the Redeemer of the lost.

Born in a poor family in Blantyre, Scotland, young David Livingstone heard of missionaries from his childhood, and had always been deeply interested in them; but it was an appeal on behalf of China, issued by the famous Dr. Gutzlaff, which inspired him with the desire to become himself a missionary. Before he was 21, he had committed his life to Christ as a medical missionary and studied medicine and theology in Glasgow. At 27 he was sent by the London Missionary Society to

Africa as both a doctor and a missionary. For the next 10 years Livingstone was an enthusiastic missionary. He wrote enthusiastically: "I am a missionary.... In this service I hope to live; in it I wish to die."

But Livingstone soon found God calling him for another purpose. He was to explore Africa for others to come in. Those days nobody ventured into the vast interior of Africa. It was a dark blank for the whole world. NO one knew who lived inside or how to reach them. He believed that by opening up Africa for missionaries, he would do much greater service for the kingdom of Christ. He often said "the end of the exploration (of Africa) is the beginning of the (missionary) enterprise." So began his life of explorations into the interior of Africa. Through his expeditions he envisioned Africa rising to the light of the Gospel from her night of darkness. He mapped sites for mission stations, preached the Gospel and prepared the "highway of holiness" for others to follow. He healed the sick, wrote letters and contributed articles to periodicals

in England. His accounts of the native people and the atrocities of the slave-trade stirred the whole world, inspiring people like John Newton, William Wilberforce and others to take up his cause and end what he called “the open sour of the world.”

On March 19, 1872, on his last birthday, when fifty-nine years old he wrote, “My birthday! My Jesus, my King, my Life, my All. I again dedicate my whole self to Thee.” April 29 was his last day of travel. He had reached the village of Chitambo, in Ilala, on Lake Bangweolo. Here, sick unto death, he made observations, carefully brought his maps and journal up to date. April 30 he had a rare quiet day. On May 1st, he entered his heavenly rest and joined the ranks of John the Baptist and others who prepared the way for their beloved Lord. Almost to the last day of his life, he laboured faithfully for his Master. How heroic was the spirit in him to the last! When he died, his beloved and faithful servants removed his heart from the body and buried it under a tree near the place where he died. They dried the body in the sun, tied it to a pole and then walked nine months to reach the coast, and shipped it to England. The world had never known a love or a loyalty of its kind nor a funeral of its glory.

On April 18, 1874, Great Britain came to a stand still. The greatest son of her soil was laid to rest among great and noble men of England, in Westminster Abbey, London. In the years to follow, the news of Livingston’s heroic life and death quickened the heart-beat of the whole world and roused many thousands to accept his missionary call bringing his own words to pass, that “the end of the

exploration (of Africa) is the beginning of the (missionary) enterprise.” Famous missionary pioneers such as Alexander Mackay (Uganda), Melvin Fraser (Cameroon), Mary Slessor (Nigeria), were all touched by Livingstone’s death and followed his footsteps to Africa. Africa became at once the favored field for missionaries and his maps became priceless in pointing out mission fields all over Africa for all the missionaries who came in to flood the Dark Continent with the glorious light of Christ.

When, the old prophet Isaiah, looking along the line of his craving, in which he represented the craving of humanity, the craving for light as to what death meant and of instruction in human duties, saw a happy day ahead. He saw a day when ignorance should give place to understanding, and the fear born of it, and the torment born of the fear, should harass men no more. He saw a day when the way of holiness should be so plain that the wayfaring man, though a fool, should not err therein; that is, when not only the wise should find it readily, but when those whose intellects were unassisted by education, and whose abilities to discern between right and wrong were not extraordinary, should easily distinguish between good and evil. When Christ was born the sun arose; when missionaries came up from the west and brought life and immortality to light, the clock of ages struck the hour of mid-day in the mission fields, and the Sun of Righteousness stood full-orbed. But there are still people waiting in the darkness for the sun to rise on them. Shall we pray, go or send missionaries to these lands!

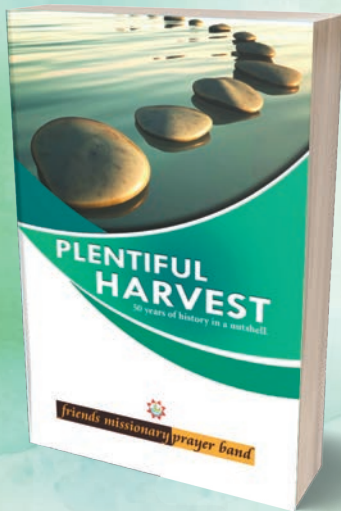

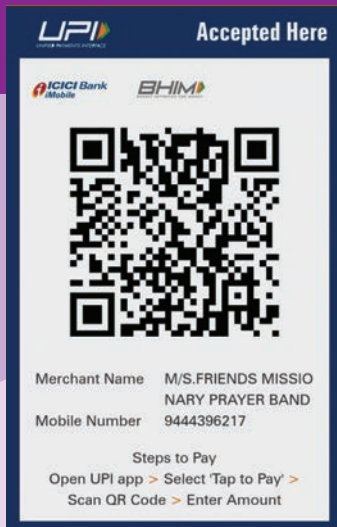
