June 9, 1967 the first missionary set his feet in the dense jungle village of Bettamugilalam situated in the Dharmapuri district of Tamil Nadu, with which a missionary movement started moving. God made that small step, taken into the unknown as a giant leap forward in mission annals. God blessed that small step and took the mission into 24 states of our beloved nation with 1000 missionaries.

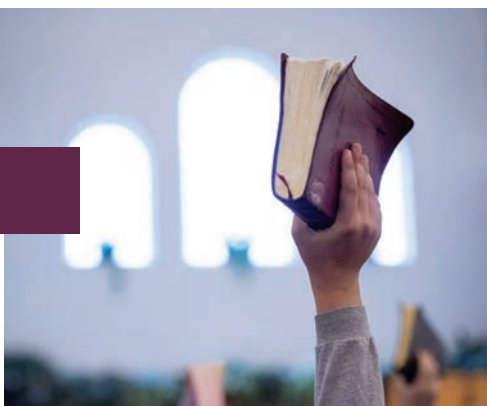
PROCLAIM

“But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light”. (1 Pet 2:9)

When the town crier or herald proclaims a message he is in no way impacted or emotionally attached to it. Whereas, when we proclaim the gospel it is not just a message that we shout out. In the Bible what we proclaim is not just the message but also about the author of the message namely Jesus Christ, The Holy Spirit and God the Father. The messenger is one who has experienced the message and has been impacted by it.

The Credentials of the Messenger

According to 1 Peter 2:9 we, the messengers are a specially chosen people. Being a specially chosen people implies not just a privilege but to a greater extent an onerous responsibility as well. As ones belonging to God, the king of kings, we are royalty. The next defining analogy is that of a priestly role. Priesthood is a mediatory role in which the priest represents people before God and mediates God's blessings and directions to the people. We are further described as a holy nation. We are to stand out as a unique and separate community in a positive way with God given values and principles. We



are people who have been moved out of darkness and brought to light.

The reason for our being chosen is that we may declare or proclaim the praises of God. As people chosen to declare the praises of God are we defined by the afore mentioned characteristics. As chosen people, called out people, a holy community, are we defined only by the names we give our children, the way we dress, the food we eat, the way we worship, the language we speak and the festivals we celebrate? Are we aware of the implications of being called to be different?

Proclamation: Verbalized and demonstrated

Proclamation is primarily verbal. Jesus proclaimed the good news of the kingdom of God, Paul proclaimed the good news among non-Jewish people. This does not preclude the important principle of exemplifying and demonstrating the message through our lives. In order for the proclamation to be fruitful and impactful the following factors need to be kept in mind:

a) The world view Factor

Anthropological insights and world view considerations of the community the gospel

is being proclaimed to must be factored in so that the message impacts the listeners in a meaningful way. We have examples for this in Paul's proclamation in Athens (Acts 17:16-34). The way John begins to proclaim the good news in the opening chapter of His Gospel is another example where the world view of the target audience is taken into consideration. The people we are proclaiming the gospel to may have a different perception of important theological concepts like sin, salvation, life after death etc. and so will understand Biblical truths through the filter of their world view. It is therefore important that we study and know their world view so that the intended meaning of the author is not only communicated without distortion but is also understood by our hearers as the author intended it to be. For example you may be preaching about the salvation that Christ offers us, namely forgiveness from the punishment for our sins and eternal life in the presence of God. The hearer may understand salvation to mean freedom from the cycle of birth and rebirth and merging into the paramatman.

b) The language Factor

The proclamation of the Gospel should ideally be in the mother tongue of the people. Depending on whom he is addressing Paul switches between Greek and Hebrew. Multiplicity of languages should be seen as an opportunity rather than as a nuisance. Language diversity ought to be celebrated and preserved rather than being wished away. Our sloppiness in learning new languages should not be a reason to proclaim spiritual truths in a language that the people are less proficient in.

c) The life testimony Factor

The message being proclaimed must be backed by the messenger's life witness. In Mathew 5:16 we learn that when our light shines in the form of good deeds, the ones watching us will offer praises to the Father. Even when no words are uttered the truth about God and notions of right and wrong are revealed through God's creation. Paul makes this point in Romans 1:18-20. In verse twenty he says, "... since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities, his eternal power and divine power and divine nature - have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made so that men are without excuse". The Psalmist says, "The heavens declare the glory of God, the skies proclaim the work of his hands yet their voice goes out into all the Earth, their words to the ends of the world". (Ps 19:1-4)

These are instances of non-verbal proclamation or revelation of God's character. Just as God's creation reflects his character and awesomeness do our lives manifest God's love, holiness, compassion, mercy and power? When our way of living contradicts the verbal proclamation we make, it renders our proclamation less effective, less convincing or less appealing. In 2 Chronicles 15:9 we read that many from the Northern kingdom of Israel crossed over to Judah when they saw that the Lord, the God of Asa was with him.

d) Analogies and Parables

The use of apt tangible analogies in proclaiming the gospel will help people understand abstract spiritual concepts. Jesus himself used a lot of analogies to explain the truths of the Gospel. This is

in keeping with the traditions of the East where Gurus use analogies to drive home philosophical concepts to people both educated and uneducated.

e) Knowledge of other faiths and beliefs

As people proclaiming the Gospel we also need to listen to and understand the beliefs and philosophical foundations of other faiths. The more we understand the other points of view the more we get to appreciate our own faith. It also helps to foster a healthy relationship with people of all faiths without animosity or an attitude of superiority. It helps us engage in meaningful dialogues and explain our faith with reference to concepts and vocabulary they are familiar with. It renders greater credibility to our choice of the faith we owe allegiance to because others will know that the choice of

our faith is not born out of ignorance but with the awareness of alternate beliefs.

f) Dependence on God's Spirit

As people chosen and called to proclaim the good news we are not to depend only on our wisdom and power of persuasion but on the power of God's Spirit. The subject of our proclamation ought to be Christ. The credibility of our proclamation is greatly determined by the life we live. Let our proclamation both verbal and non-verbal impact and transform lives so that God's name may be glorified. In 1 Cor.2: 4 & 5 Paul writes, 'My message and my preaching were not with wise and persuasive words but with a demonstration of the Spirit's power, so that your faith may not rest on human wisdom but on God's power'.

AN OPEN LETTER FROM THE GENERAL SECRETARY

Dear subscribers, supporters and sponsors of FMPB Ministry,
Greetings in the wonderful Name of Lord Jesus Christ.

It has come to our notice that a malicious mail is sent by a self-declared supporter of FMPB without ascertaining the factual position. The issues raised in the so-called mail were general in nature and without any specific instances. One of the senior leaders of the FMPB wrote in response to the previous communication and requested him to come for a meeting with specific cases of allegations, so that they could be discussed to make things clear.

As an organisation, FMPB is committed to follow the “Ethos” and to follow certain established practices. Discipline amongst its Missionaries are paramount. So far FMPB has never compromised from its principles. A generic complaint against the current leadership is thrown which cannot be responded. When asked for specific instances, nothing was brought out which could be discussed in the Executive Committee for addressing the suitable issues.

With active participation from the members of the Executive Committee, decisions are taken from time to time. Some of the issues were discussed and actions are in hand for improving the working for the benefit of all stake holders. While some of the issues are acknowledged, it is also important for an organisation to enforce discipline amongst its workforce. Decisions are taken based on the performance of the individual Missionary, feedback from their supervisor and actual result of the work of the individual.

FMPB is committed to the maintenance of financial discipline and moral discipline amongst the Missionaries. FMPB also appreciates the sensitiveness of the issues whenever brought to its notice directly or indirectly. Actions are taken based on a detailed examination and findings, as can be seen the time taken for the final decisions.

FMPB is fortunate to have a believer as its lawyer who charges minimum amount to represent FMPB in the Courts. It is a malicious contention that FMPB is spending more amount on the lawyers which is totally untrue. As a matter of principle, FMPB doesn't prefer to file a case and we are defending the cases filed by the disgruntled missionaries who have left FMPB.

FMPB would like to alley the mis-information that FMPB did not take care of its Missionaries during COVID period. This is totally untrue. All possible support was provided to each and every Missionary during pre and post-COVID period including all possible medical help.

FMPB assures to each and every one that every Missionary is treated fairly and ensures transparency in managing its activities. FMPB is open for any meaningful suggestions or improvements within the declared “Ethos” and for the glory of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

We appreciate your continuous prayer and support to the ministry of FMPB. Praying for you all.

the Santhals and Maltos in Jharkhand.



Here is the interview!

Dr. Mrs. L. Willset: Will you please share about your salvation experience and your call for ministry.

I belong to CSI Church of Kanyakumari district. While in school, I have never missed any Church worship, even during my SSLC & HSC board exams. During my first year of studying Medicine, I came into the salvation experience. Obeying the Bible teachings was my priority and, working for His kingdom and helping the least in the society through my medical education was my dream. I lost my father during the school days. Even though, there was a burden at shouldering the responsibility upon me regarding my younger sisters and brother's education and marriages, God had protected me from all distractions and kept me moving in the right direction.

Dr. Mrs. L. Willset: You could have served in a big hospital and could have lived comfortably. But you have chosen to serve these tribal people. Why?

After MD in OG, I got married in 1999 and settled in Cochin. There I worked in a 1200 bedded Christian hospital, Lisie Hospital Institution for 10 years. There I gained practical knowledge about the good work culture and strong Christian ethical practice of Medicine.

We were part of the FMPB field trip team from Kochi in 2007 to Jharkhand. During one of the village night meetings one 7 month pregnant lady served tea for us. I was hurt when we heard the news that she died because of cerebral malaria in the subsequent week. My husband and I made a commitment that we would go and work in this area for one year. For various reasons it got delayed up to 2013. At one point of time in 2013, I never wanted to go to Malto area. Then God spoke clearly that if I could Love these people as He loves them and serve them. I said yes to God's call and started preparing towards it.

Dr. Mrs. L. Willset: Were you able to come over immediately? What were the challenges you faced?

No. Greatest challenge was my son's education, finding a hostel for him, leaving my old and sick mother who raised us up single handed with much difficulty. I resigned from my job 2014 March, waited on God for 2 yrs. From 2016 March onwards doors started to open up. Joined in FMPB in 2016 July and started working.

Dr. Mrs. L. Willset: How is the plight of the people while you work among them?

Main challenges are 1. Quarks exploiting the people, 2. People's ignorance, 3. Poverty,

4. Primitive healing practices like Jadiputti, Oja practices, and 5. Very poor road facility to the Malto people group as they live in hilly terrains. People walk for 2-3 hrs to our clinic was the usual practice. On the other side, believers in humanly difficult situation, trust God and pray fervently during sickness. We see miracles happening as we also join with them in treatment.



Dr. D Thomas: Brother, Can you please brief us about your salvation experience and ministerial call?

I accepted Lord Jesus as my saviour through Bro. Augustine Jebakumar's message during my 12th standard. After my Engineering studies, I got job in NPOL, Defence Research Development organization, Cochin. I was involved in church youth ministries and mission activities. After my marriage, as a family we involved in the FMPB, Ernakulam, mobilization ministry; forming prayer groups and introducing the ministry to both the Tamil and Malayalam congregations. Later, when my wife moved to Jharkhand in the year 2016, I was supporting her from Cochin. In the year 2021, I applied VRS from DRDO and subsequently moved over to Jharkhand to continue the ministry along with my wife.



Dr. Mrs. L. Willset: Can you briefly share about your ministry in Jharkhand now?

We started the work with weekly functioning in 3 village clinics and a base hospital with one driver and two SSLC girls. Slowly God added up people with us. Every year we treat approximately 10,000 to 12,000 out patients and 200 – 300 in patients. Many people were healed, comforted, strengthened in their faiths that resulted in giving Glory to God's name. FMPB had opened a hospital with 10 beds, Labour room, and an operation theatre in 2020.

Dr. Mrs. L. Willset: What is your urgent need?

Maternal mortality is high here along with so many sicknesses. We need skilled medical personnel with spiritual orientation to address the need. In the three districts; Pakur, Godda and Sahibganj, already we have covered 600 Malto villages and 8 lakhs Santhal people have been reached with the Gospel. We need more Doctors, Nurses and paramedical from all over India to prepare a group of people to meet our God. More than the professional motivation, it is spiritually motivated; with spiritual priorities for a holistic healing of this people group. Suffering now, must result in as much care to be given now as the threat of lost eternity will result in evangelism.

Dr. Mrs. L. Willset: How do you feel working among these people?

"It is a joy to walk with the LORD through rough roads, to see the least and lost one comforted, healed and lives turning back to their creator God"

We strongly believe that this interview we had with you will make an impact among the young people. Their Son Hudson Samuel is just completed his B Tech., at IIT Bhubaneswar. Let's uphold this family in our daily prayers.

Periyamalai Day 2023

Dearest beloved Prayer Partners in Christ Jesus,

Let God's name be glorified for your meaningful contributions of going and **sending** towards reaching our goal **"Go or Send"**.

FMPB is a movement that was established solely for the purpose of reaching the unreached Indians with Indian personnel (we). Our first mission field, Periyamalai, is the basement of this movement. Each year we celebrate June 9th as Periyamalai Day, giving thanks to our Lord Jesus for guiding us with his planning principles and achieving the same in miraculous ways. The main cause for this was starting the ministry in Periyamalai, among the marginalised people spread across the Dharmapuri District, in 1967. Today, this ministry has widened and spread throughout the 24 states of our country, India.

In these 56 years of completion, this place with 45 congregations shines as Denkanikotai Region in fulfilling the Biblical saying, "Who shall abhor the day of small beginning?" This area is a witness to the upliftment of the society whose eyes of knowledge have been opened and who have experienced many miracles, wonders, and deliverance from the hand of the Lord, who is being worshipped here ceaselessly, and have gained acceptance and fulfilment among others. Not only have many accepted Christ, but for four generations they have acknowledged Jesus as their God and are proclaiming Him to others. 27 youth, both men and women, reared in this area are serving our Lord Jesus through our nation and other organisations too. 40 others are serving as evangelists along with us. At this date, the Tamil Nadu Zone is functioning as three regions. In Pettamukilam Church, regular services are being conducted by the workers of Periyamalai, and even the Prayer Partners gather here for intercessory prayers. The gatherings and training of all three regions are conducted here systematically.

We have planned to proclaim the Gospel to 4,40,000 persons, and cover 880 villages with the Gospel and to establish 88 worshipping groups, 44 Congregations and to raise 44 full time workers and to bring 4,400 persons into God's fold. We sincerely thank you for upholding this cause in your prayers.

Mr. K. Thiagarajan
(1944 - 2023)

Mr. Thiagarajan from Sivakasi was born on 10th May 1944 to Mr. Kandasamy and Mrs. Mary ammal. His father served in the Indian Army and had settled in Secunderabad. They were from other faith.

Mr. Thiagarajan after his SSLC, finished his technical course Diploma in Mechanical Engineering. His father encouraged him to join the Indian Air force. Mr. Thiagarajan joined the Air force in 1964. During his Air force Training at Tambaram, he had an opportunity to attend the Gospel meeting conducted by Laymen Evangelical Fellowship. He had gone to the meeting as a non-Christian young man and returned as a follower of the Lord Jesus. In that spiritual meeting he experienced the saving knowledge of the Lord Jesus and became His child. He attended the CPM Church and began to grow in the Lord.

He was posted at Air Force Station at Kalikunda, Andra Pradesh. As he did not have any Christian fellowship, he drifted from the faith. On 16th August of 1965 the Spirit of God spoke to him personally and he confessed his sins and renewed himself in the Lord. He attended the Bible study group and shared the Gospel with his fellow workers in the Air force. He helped his mother to accept Christ as her personal saviour. Thus he worked in the Air force for 18 years.

Mr. Thiagarajan married Mrs. Jeyakumari on 21.07.1975. She was a graduate and a follower of the Lord Jesus. God blessed their married life with a boy child Jereme Jebaraj on 17.01.1977.

Mr. Thiagarajan heard about FMPB and attended the prayer cell and all the missionary challenging meetings. In one of the meetings God called him for His service, so he committed himself to work full time. He joined FMPB as a family on first June 1984. He was involved in the mobilization ministry at Hyderabad till 1993 and after serving the Lord in the mobilization ministry, along with Hema Chandran annan they were sent to Mumbai promotional ministry in 1991. He served the Lord in the promotional ministry until his retirement at the age of 65 on 31st May 2009.

He did his best in mobilizing resources for the missionary work in Mumbai. On 2nd May 2023 at the age of 79, he got his home call from the Lord and entered into glory. We thank God for his wonderful life well lived. Please pray for his wife Mrs. Jeyakumari, Son Mr. Jereme and his family.

TRILOKPURI CHURCH HISTORY

**PATPARGANJ FIELD,
HARYANA REGION,**

Trilokpuri is a locality in East Delhi in the nation capital territory of Delhi, India. It is a well-connected area with enhanced connectivity to major parts of Delhi, Noida and Ghaziabad. Trilokpuri is a resettlement colony of residents which were rehabilitated when the nearby slums were cleared out. At present Trilokpuri is a congested urban sprawl, with 36 blocks. On 15.8.1976 the Patparganj mission field was officially opened by Mr. Lazarus and his wife Mrs. Chandra along with the single sisters - Ms. Daisy, Ms. Jeyaseeli and Ms. Florance, after hearing that East Delhi had never heard the Gospel. Peaching under a pertomax and signing, "Pongi varum arul manitharai matridudhe" was the beginning of the missionary work. As days went by, they met the women who were touched during the meetings in the morning and taught the kids from textbooks as they were left unsupervised. Later, the missionaries found that most of the men of that house were thieves.

Mrs. Thangammal, Mrs. Amaravathi and Mrs. Vellaithai were the very first ones to accept the Gospel and confessed it with 13 others. Sunday services were conducted in thangammal's hut where 40 to 50 people gathered every Sunday.

***Testimony of Mrs. Amaravathi's
son Mr. Arumugam:***



“Our native is Arupukottai. Before coming to Delhi, we were weavers. As my father became ill we took him to many temples in a hope, that he would recover. We lost all our money for buying medicines and visiting temples. After my father’s death, we came to Delhi to earn our living. In 1976 Lazarus annan and few others came to Trilokpuri and proclaimed the gospel. My mother, Mrs. Amaravathy @ Annal and my aunt Mrs. Thangammal @ Leethiyal heard the gospel through them. My mother used to dance whenever she heard the sound of drums from the temple. As days went by, my mother got delivered from the evil spirit which caused her to dance. Through continuous hearing of the gospel we accepted Christ. In 1978 my family boldly confessed their faith in God. After accepting Christ my mother who had the habit of quarrelling with other people became a calm person. People who saw her felt the change and they came to our house to be prayed for. As for me, I was a namesake Christian eve after accepting Jesus in 1978. I became an alcohol addict as I worked where it was prepared and also had the habit of buying lottery tickets. During a New Year’s service I decided to leave all this sin behind, but was still a namesake Christian. One day as I was trying to give electricity connection to our house from the electric pole I lost balance and was

about to fall, but as I prayed I felt somebody lifting me up and making me stand upright. After that incident God changed me as a true Christian.”

Many missionaries joined the ministry, while Mr. Lazarus and family left to Salem to pursue higher studies in 1979. Ms. Benita Evangeline, daughter of Patparganj missionary Mr. T Ponnusamy was a favorite because for her energetic and enthusiastic character. On 12.10.1981 she became sick and she passed away on the next day morning. Her death caused a major impact in the lives of the locals of Trilokpuri. After her sudden death, the songs and the Bible verses that she sang and recited in the worship touched the hearts of many believers and non-believers. Though it was a heavy blow for Mr. Ponnusamy & Mrs. Esther, their approach to Benita’s death that, “God has given and God has taken away” touched many more lives. People began to think that the missionary couple has faced the great loss only for them as they have come all the way from Tamil Nadu. After that a revival occurred in the area and many people accepted Christ and are still firm in the Lord till today.

The present Church elder, was an alcoholic and used to abuse his wife. But Benita’s sudden death affected and changed him since he was very fond of her. After hearing her death he rushed to Patparganj and fell on the

coffin box and said, “Benita ma, I know Jesus laid down His life for us but you laid down your life for me”. Little Benita was a grain of wheat in Trilokpuri field.

As the Gospel started to spread wide and deep, many North Indians also started to attend to Sunday Services. Therefore Hindi service was newly started in the evenings. Fasting prayers were started in 1994, this helped believers who had backslidden to return to faith.

Mrs. Pramila Vijay, after giving birth to a girl child had to face continuous death of her newborns. After finding no solution in temples and in Masjids, she got to know the Gospel from her neighbor. Pramila attended Church regularly and accepted Jesus as her savior and received Joel after many years. When Joel was two years old, while playing in a playground, he was brutally bitten by pigs. He was picked up unconscious and was rushed to the Lal Bahadur Shastri hospital where the doctors pronounced him dead. Joel's mother Mrs. Pramila told her husband to take him to Anmol hospital which was a private one. The doctor who attended Joel told his mother not to cry and he promised her that he would bring back her son alive. He insisted her not to cry. The doctor took the boy inside a room and closed the door behind her and as he said, he brought back her son alive after some time. Joel's wounds were bandaged. The

doctor told Joel's mother, Mrs. Pramila not to admit Joel in the hospital as she would be asked to pay heavy fees. She was asked to bring her son every morning and evening to apply medicines and for redressing. The next day when Joel was taken to the hospital, the doctor who attended him was nowhere found in the hospital. Joel's mother recollects the doctor as “Jesus in the form of a doctor saved my son” Many people who saw the incident gave glory to God. Today Joel is a teenage boy, who worships the Lord at Good Shepherd church. Many such miracles have taken place; due to non-stop prayers and is still happening.

The small Church that started in a hut is now turned into a 4 floor building after a lot of sacrifices and efforts from both the missionaries and the believers. The Good Shepard Church was dedicated on 26.11.2016, by the CNI Bishop of Delhi diocese, Rt. Rev. Warris K Masih. The Baptism tank, Mezzanine floor and Parsonage was dedicated by the men of God. 400 people were present during the dedication programme, along with the President, General Secretary, Prayer Group Leader, Field Secretary, PPA Secretary, Northern Zone Secretary and many other missionaries. The Church is still going strong with fasting prayer, cottage prayer and different prayer cells. Many missionaries have also risen from this Church.

Missionary Biography



Mrs. Vimala Stephen
(1969- 2015)

Early Days

Ms. Vimala was the first daughter of Mr. Lazarus and Mrs. Pusparajam of Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh. She was born on 24th October 1969 in this Christian family. Vimala had two more brothers and two sisters. Her mother Mrs. Pusparajam was a prayerful, God fearing woman and took efforts to rear her children in Godly ways. In her teen, she had a lot of friends in her school, most of them being non-Christians. Their fellowship drifted Vimala away from the Lord. At home, her mother used to emphasize the importance of personal prayer, family prayer and Bible reading. But Vimala turned a deaf ear to her mother's advice. She thought of all her pieces of advice as personal intrusions and did not like any of them.

Born-again Experience

While she was continuing her high school studies, she had an attack of typhoid. She needed to undergo the treatment for a long time. She had to take rest for many days and was unable to go to school. While she was in the sickbed she prayed to God for her healing. The spirit of God convicted her of her sins, so she confessed the sins and surrendered her life to Christ and became His child on 17th September 1989. She started to read the Bible in the morning and evening. Her prayer time was from 5 a.m to 6 a.m. daily. Her mother was happy and she encouraged her. She formed a youth prayer cell and prayed together with other interested girls. She proclaimed the love of Christ to her friends in the school. Ms. Vimala joined the college for her higher studies. She shared the Gospel to her friends in the college too. In the meantime she was actively involved in the Church activities, Sunday school, VBS and youth meetings. And she finished B.Com successfully and waited for the Lord's leading.

Call of God to the Mission

Mrs. Pushparajam had already committed her first born child to the Lord's ministry. Ms. Vimala attended a mission challenging meeting. There they shared about the unreached people of India and the need for missionaries to reach them with the Gospel. There are hundreds of people in Andhra Pradesh to proclaim the Good News whereas very few people

to proclaim the Gospel of Christ in North India. This camp made an impact in the life of Ms. Vimala who had a passion to pray for the perishing souls. While reading the Bible she had God calling her for the ministry. She began to pray about it and it was again and again confirmed. She shared it with her mother; Mrs. Pushparajam was happy to send her first born to the ministry. She told Vimala that she was a privileged mother indeed to send a missionary to the needy place.

In the meantime she attended a meeting of FMPB and came to know more about the North India missionary work. She prayed and decided to go as a missionary through FMPB. She applied to go as a missionary and was called by FMPB for an interview on 24th June 1996. Vimala was selected as a missionary candidate and was sent for the missionary training in the FMPB Training centre, Jhansi. Ms. Vimala led a simple lifestyle. She was a good singer, loved others and was friendly. She always had a smiling face.

Marriage

After finishing her missionary training in Jhansi, she was sent to Gonda children's home. She started her ministry happily with other co-workers. Her parents found a suitable bridegroom Mr. John Stephen. The marriage of Mr. John Stephen, an FMPB missionary, and Miss. Vimala was solemnized on 22nd December 1997.

Ministry in FMPB

After the marriage Mr. John Stephen's family was sent to Jharkhand to serve the Lord among the Malto people group. Then, they were transferred to Basti, the first North India mission field. After their ministry for some time, they were placed in the Jhansi Regional Office. God blessed their marriage life with two daughters Blessina and Ida Grace. Now Blessina is doing MBA final year and Ida Grace is in 12th grade.

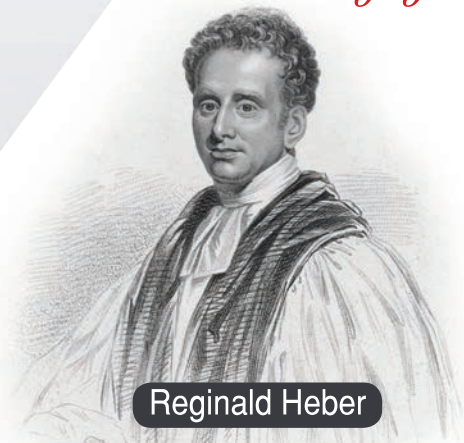
Last Days

During their ministry, Mrs. Vimala was infected in her blood and became very sick. Due to her sickness, they were again transferred to Chittoor, Andhra Pradesh, to do the Promotional ministry. In the month of August she was admitted in the hospital for her treatment. Though the doctors gave their best treatment, she was unable to recover completely from her sickness. She went to be with the Lord on 21st August, 2015. It was a great shock for Mr. John Stephen and his daughters. The family members were much worried as Mrs. Vimala left her two little daughters and the husband in her early age. Her body was buried in Vijayawada with the hope of the resurrection. Thus, Vimala finished the God given race for His glory in a short life span but with a powerful testimony. Let's remember the family in our prayers.

Holy Holy Holy Lord God Almighty



Reginald Heber

*"And a vision appeared to Paul in the night;
There stood a man of Macedonia, and prayed
him, saying, Come over into Macedonia,
and help us." Acts 16:9*

On 1 June 1823 Reginald Heber was formally consecrated as Bishop of Calcutta at Lambeth Palace, by the Archbishop of Canterbury. Two weeks later he departed for India. Heber was born into wealth and affluence. His father was the Lord of Matron Manor, Yorkshire. By the age of five, he had read the Bible so thoroughly that he could give chapter and verse for chance quotations. He accepted God as a student at Oxford University. Having been

ordained in 1807, he took up his first service in Hodnet in Shropshire. For sixteen years, here, he preached and served the people in the true Spirit of Christ. He possessed a kind disposition, a prayerful spirit, a tender compassion, and great devotion to Christ. It was during those sixteen years that he wrote his famous missionary hymns.

Even from an early age Heber had a deep longing to go to India. Many a times he imagined himself as a missionary and traced on the map Indian journeys, and had been tempted to wish himself, Bishop of Calcutta. The allusions to "India's coral strand" and "Ceylon's isle" in his hymn "From Greenland's icy mountains" are an indication of the longings that were running through his mind. His earnest prayers were answered in 1822, when at the age of forty he was called as the bishop of Calcutta. The parish of Hodnet grieved at losing their beloved pastor but both rich and poor joined together to give a fitting farewell for their beloved pastor, as a testimonial of their love and gratitude.

In 1823 Heber started for his long-cherished dreams of working as a missionary, serving Christ in India. He spent three years as Bishop in India. It was filled with ceaseless travels and apostolic enthusiasm to encourage churches and to bring India to foot of the cross of Christ. His first missionary journey ranged through Bengal, Bombay, and Ceylon visiting churches and involving in the mission work. His second missionary journey took him through Madras Presidency to Trichinopoly, where on April 3, 1826 he died suddenly in his bath, stricken with apoplexy. It is said that the day just before he died, he has baptised 42 people in all. his sudden loss was deeply felt by all.

He was the one who wrote the famous hymn "Holy Holy Holy," and it is said that no memory of Indian annals was holier than that of those three years of his service as the Bishop of Calcutta. His early sacrificial death as Missionary Bishop of India made his life "as a precious ointment poured forth" at the feet of our Lord in his service. Dr. Sam Kamaleson, who studied later in Bishop Heber School, in Trichinopoly commenting on his life said, "it is hard not to think of the influence of Bishop Heber every time we sang 'Holy Holy Holy,' the greatest worship hymn that was ever written." Perhaps no missionary has ever left on his surroundings so deep an impression of his personality in so short a time.

In his hymn, "From Greenland's icy mountains," he sings "they call us to deliver their land from error's chain," as if he is seeing the heathen in a vision calling him to come. It was similar to that of the vision Paul saw at Troas. That Macedonian man to Paul, represented Europe, and his cry for help is Europe's need of Christ. Paul recognised in it a Divine summons. In this passage of Paul, from Asia to Europe, a great providential decision was taking effect, of which, all children of the west, cannot think without the profoundest thankfulness.

Similarly, when Heber had his vision of "India's coral strand," a great providential decision took effect. In God's providence, it was time for the Gospel to visit the wandering tribes of India, piercing its way down through the passes of the Himalayas, on the banks of the Ganges, the Indus, and the Godavari. And we cannot think of it without the profoundest thankfulness. They believed that in carrying Christianity to a land, they were carrying that

which would best rectify disorders, alleviate distresses, assuage sorrows, and multiply eternal happiness. And, therefore, they never stopped to consider whether they had at their disposal the particular engine which, on a human computation, might be suited for counteracting a particular evil - enough that they had the gospel to preach.

Let us learn, from the example of St. Paul and Bishop Heber, to set a higher value on the gospel: whether it is as a group or as individuals that we are called upon by the Macedonian for help. A Christian should have no will of his own - he is the servant of a Master in heaven, and the only thing for him to ascertain is where that Master would have him work, and what He would have him do. Has the night vision come to him? Then he ought not to confer with flesh and blood. This having been done, there is no room for hesitation. And are we not summoned to Macedonia? And is not the voice for assistance more exhilarating and more nostalgic than that which fell, in night visions, on the ear of St. Paul? For we not only have visions but Scriptures, hymns and missionary history by which the voice can come calling!

Reginald Heber's hymns are a treasure to the church and the missionary movement following nineteenth century. If "Holy, Holy, Holy, Lord God Almighty" founded on the majestic anthem of the glory of God, set the church in awe of God's glory, his authorship of the most popular missionary hymn "From Greenland's Icy Mountains" is the noblest expression of the missionary fervour which in his day sent the faithful marching from "shore to shore" in Immanuel's name. May we follow their trial.
