"Fellowship with Jesus - my utmost priority"

A multitude consistently followed Jesus, seeking various benefits such as healing, sustenance or entertainment. Yet, Jesus Himself actively sought out crowds and engaged with them. In Mark 3:14, He carefully selected and appointed the Twelve Apostles, each for a specific purpose: 1. To be with Him and 2. To carry out the ministry after Him. In essence, the selection of the Twelve Apostles was a deliberate

act by Jesus to establish a foundation for the continuation of His mission and the growth of His teachings. This dual purpose underscores the significance of both intimate fellowship with Jesus and the active propagation of His purpose to come to this world.

Since the inception of humanity in the Garden of Eden, God's desire has been to establish a loving fellowship with mankind. This intent is evident in His visits to Adam and Eve, as depicted in Genesis 3:8. Consequently, Biblical passages such as 1 John 1:1, John 15:27, and Acts 22:15 underscore the personal encounters these individuals had with Jesus. Their association with Him led to spiritual sanctification, transforming their innate characters and molding them into influential leaders.

Today, the unique privilege of experiencing Jesus Christ as an exceptional leader, teacher, and Savior is extended to us through the Holy Spirit. This divine presence dwells within those who faithfully heed His Words and commands. He wants to commune with us as a friend, a guide and a father, Moreover; He seeks to carry out His earthly ministry through us. From the General Secretary...

Dear partners in the mission of reaching the un-reached Indians,

Greetings to you all in the Name of our Lord Jesus Christ which is above all names!

The calling of the twelve disciples and the purpose of their selection is given in detail in Mark chapter 3:13 which says “Jesus went up on a mountainside and called to him **those He wanted**, and they came to him”. This verse says that Jesus called those He wanted to be His disciples. The choice of joining Jesus belonged to Him and not to the individuals who joined Jesus. Often people misunderstand about the calling to serve God by thinking that it is they who decided to serve the Lord. But in reality it is the Lord who chooses anyone He wants to be in His team to serve Him. Our part is accepting His call in simple obedience. The implication of this truth is that the period of serving the Lord is not as I wanted but as long as God wants. We do not join God to do what I want to do but what God wants to do. May the truth dawn on us and strengthen us in His mission and service.

Dohnavur Building Dedication: God has graciously provided a new building in Dohnavur, Tirunelveli which will be used as a prayer centre and a place for the short stay of missionary parents who go to see their children studying in Santhosha Vidhyalaya, Dohnavur. This building was dedicated on 24th July in the presence of around 300 prayer group leaders from the 4 Southern Tamil Nadu districts. Rev. Mainraj, the then



Mobilization Secretary Valliyoor mobilized resources for the completion of the building.

Meeting the Manipur Church Leader:

The mission secretary of KBC, Rev. Lamkebmng visited on 29th July. We are providing relief materials and essential medicines to some needy people of Manipur.

Meeting with Global Head Start Mission:

On 31st July Mr. Azariah Jerry Manuel, S/o, our missionary Rev. E. Rajan, met me in Headquarters to explore the possibilities to help some of our hostel children in their higher studies through his organization called Global Head Start Mission. This mission is already involving in the ministry of providing school bags and shoes to our hostel children of our believers.

Meeting Field Zonal Secretaries:

The Field Zonal Secretaries gathered with their spouses in Alapalli, Maharashtra for 2 days prayer and 2 days planning from 1st August to 4th August. On the way I met a believer family who had an altar in his house to sacrifice goats and his wife used to be possessed by certain spirit. God healed the brother from his spinal problem when he was at the verge of having a surgery. After accepting Christ, the couple goes to many places to preach the Gospel for 10 to 15 days in a month leaving their business in others hands. Gospel transforms people.

Bengaluru Professional Forum Carnival:

The Bengaluru Professional Forum held a carnival program namely “United for Malto” with the help of mobilization leaders to raise support for the education of Malto children. God blessed the efforts of our leaders and the carnival was a blessing to the people.

Meeting Jharkhand and Chhattisgarh missionaries: In the first week of August with the field leaders I visited the missionaries in Ranchi, Manika, Palamu and Nagar areas of Jharkhand. The meeting was very fruitful. Following the Jharkhand visit, we visited missionaries in Chhattisgarh. The missionaries in Jharkhand and Chhattisgarh are doing the ministry with joy and deep commitment. Around 150 Church elders had gathered for a three days meeting in Tildega, Chhattisgarh.

Dedication of house built for the Evangelist by the believers: For the first time in FMPB, the believers of Tildega Church built a house for the evangelist to stay in the Church campus with their own resources. The house was dedicated for the glory of God on 12th August. By seeing this believers from different Churches want to build houses for their evangelists in their Churches too.

National Leader's Consultation-Yelagiri: 50 leaders and pastors from different organizations and ministries gathered in Yelagiri hills to think about the future ministry in India.

Hubli and Kolar Regions visit: God willing I will be ministering in Hubli and Kolar Regions of Karnataka from 14th to 18th of September.



Mark 3:14 Luke 6: 13

Introduction:

When Jesus selected His disciples for His ministry, the first and foremost thing He expected from them was nothing but to be with Him. Although He had the plan to send them for preaching and casting out demons etc., the major area of expectation was just to be with Him. I may do hundreds of things for Jesus in His name. But, if I am not ready to be with Him or spend time with Him then all my activities are in vain. I may achieve many things. But, they will not bring glory to God. Timothy Keller said this: **"If our identity is in our work, rather than Christ, success will go to our heads, and failure will go to our hearts."** So, let us see now why we

should be with the Lord. What is the purpose of our Lord in asking to be with Him?

1

To Love Him:

The main purpose to be with Jesus is to love Him. If I say I love someone, I am expected to spend sufficient time with that person. That may be husband, wife or children. Without spending time with a person I will not be able to love him or her. As Jesus loved His disciples He too expected them to love Him. Without spending time how can we love Him? Without loving Him how can we be His disciple? Mt. 22:37 says: "Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind." (KJV)

Even, before the time of crucifixion, when Jesus was in Gethsemane He expected His core team of disciples to be with Him. Couldn't you men keep watch with me for one hour?" He asked Peter. The disciples were unable to do even that. Being the disciple of the Lord I am expected to spend time with the Lord. Unless I spend time with Jesus I will not be able to love Him. The first thing expected by a person is the time given by the other one.

To Listen Him:

Listening is the most essential requirement of a disciple. Frank Laubach said this: **Listening to God is far more important than giving Him your ideas.**" If a disciple is not willing to listen to his Master, he will do everything according to his own wish and will. Nowadays in the modern world people are not at all interested in listening to others. All want to speak. Listening is one of the basic requirements of a leader. Unless and until I am ready to listen, I will not be able to fulfill the needs of my brothers and sisters. Our Lord is the best listener. Even though He is the busiest person in the World, how patiently He listens to all our words, sighs and heart cries. Do we have that sort of patience to listen to our Master? When we are with Him, naturally we will listen to Him. The disciple one whom Jesus loved more namely John was always sitting very close to Jesus (John 21: 20). He wanted to listen from His Master. Do we have the passion to listen from the Lord? Then we have to come closer to Him. Apart from that there is no other way to hear His voice. Because, often we read from the Word of God that His voice is very gentle. If we are not willing to come closer to Him we may miss to know the will of God. It will be very difficult to know the pain of His heart. As a child of God let us come closer to Him and let us try to be with Him always. When we are ready to

be with Him very easily we can listen Him. Eventually, that will lead us in the right path.

To Learn from Him:

If a disciple is willing to listen to his Master automatically he will be able to learn many things from him. Jesus is the best teacher in the World. Bible has the capacity to teach us so many important things which are very much necessary for our life. Jesus said, **"If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free. John 8: 31-32."** The difference between Jesus and other teachers is He practiced everything in His life first. He never taught anything without practicing. If I am not willing to learn from Him, my life will be in chaos. Life of Mary is a very good example from the New Testament. She had the habit of learning from Jesus. When Jesus came to her home she did not go anywhere. She just sat at His feet. Since she was very close to Jesus she was able to learn so many Heavenly things from Him. Do we give importance to learn from the Word of God? How often we try to escape from spending sufficient time to study the Word of God giving vague excuses. If we are very close to Him or if we are with Him, definitely we will be able to learn many things from our Lord. Many are tempted to teach others without learning. How is it possible to

teach others without learning? Jesus Himself was a good learner. Bible says clearly that from His childhood up to 30 years He was very obedient to His parents and was learning many things from them. Probably He might have learned His earthly father's carpentry work also. Not only that. He learned the Word of God even from His childhood. That's why He was able to discuss with the religious scholars very boldly. To become a teacher I should be a learner first. Jesus was a good learner. That's why He became the best teacher in the world. Many great leaders including some other religious scholars even liked the teaching of Jesus Christ. How was this possible in the life of Jesus? It's because, He was always close to His

Heavenly Father. If we are with the Lord we will also be good learners. When I am with Him I can learn many things from Him and I will put them into practice.

Conclusion:

From the above points we may be able to understand the importance of being with the Lord. As a child of God my first and foremost priority should be to be with Him. Let us not forget that our Lord needs us individually and not what we have with us. First of all let us try to give ourselves fully to Him. Then the Lord will be pleased with us. He will be happy on whatever we do for His glory.

NAGRAON CHURCH HISTORY

THANEDHAR FIELD -
HIMACHAL REGION, NORTH
WESTERN ZONE

GENERAL:

Nagraon is a small village located in Kumharsain Tehsil of Shimla district, Himachal Pradesh, with a total of 15 families residing. The village has a population of 63. Nagraon has a lower literacy rate compared to Himachal Pradesh, with a literacy rate of 81.82% as per the 2011 census. The village is administrated by a Sarpanch (Head of Village), who is an elected representative under the Panchayati Raj Act of the Indian Constitution.

BEGINNING:

The Thanadar Mission field was opened in 2011. Initially, Thanadar served as a sub-center of the Rampur mission field. In July 2010, Mr. Vum Biak Lal's family, who had been taking care of Thanadar sub-centre, was moved to the Rohru mission field. Subsequently, in June 2011, Thanadar was declared a separate mission field, and Mr. Thangse Sangtam family was assigned as field missionaries. Before the establishment of the Nagraon congregation, there was a small congregation in Naula village near Nagraon under the Rampur field, led by



Rev. Paul Madhivanan. However, after his tenure, the Church elder, Mr. Devender Negi, took the congregation away. For nearly 3 years, the congregation remained closed, and during this time, most of the believers backslid, leaving only two families still faithful. Worship resumed in 2013 with these two families.

FIRST BELIEVER'S TESTIMONY

(Mr. Rajesh Kumar): Mr. Rajesh Kumar, the first believer from Nagraon, shared his powerful testimony. He was suffering from TB since 2009 and sought healing through various gods and magicians, spending a considerable amount of money. Despite medical treatment, his condition deteriorated, and he started vomiting blood. Doctors gave him little hope of survival. In December 2013, he decided to try Jesus as a last resort and requested prayer from local believers and they prayed for him. Miraculously, he had a dream where he encountered the cross of Christ, and soon after, his blood vomiting stopped, and he was completely healed. This miraculous healing led him and his whole family to accept Christ. Many others in the village also accepted Christ due to the testimony of Mr. Rajesh and his healing. Mr. Rajesh's miraculous healing had a profound impact on the village, and many people turned to Christ including Mr. Jagdish a truck driver who was delivered from demon possession.

CHURCH GROWTH AND THE CHURCH LAND:

Among them was Bina Kumari, the wife of Mr. Jeetender from Jogini village, who accepted Christ after deliverance from demon possession. The land for building the Naya Jeevan Masih Satsung Bhavan Church was donated by Mr. Prem Chand and his wife Kanta Devi, who were our old believers. They gratefully offered their land as a gesture of thanksgiving for the blessings they received from God, including the healing of Mr. Prem Chand from Chest pain and also because the Lord blessed the work of their hands, their children's future and with 3 houses and lands.

THE CONGREGATION AND THE COMMUNITY:

The Nagraon congregation comprises members from several villages, including Nagraon, Amarnaal, Kupardhar, Nirath, Togli, and Naula. The members belong to Pahari and Nepali communities. The Church building, Naya Jeevan Masih Satsung Bhavan, has dimensions of 25X40ft and features ACC roofing. The foundation stone was laid in February 2017, and the Church was dedicated on August 13, 2017, in the presence of the sponsor Mr. P. Dharmadurai and various other dignitaries and believers. There was no opposition during the construction time. They wanted a Church near their house so they requested our missionary Rev. Thangse to choose a land from among their property and gifted it to build the Church. Kanta Devi was mocked by the villagers and family and was

discouraged for giving the land because she had a broken leg twice. In spite of all those problems she has a strong belief on Jesus and fully involves in Church ministries.

CHURCH ACTIVITIES:

The Nagraon Church Samiti was formed on May 20, 2018, with a three-year operational period until May 2021. The Samiti aimed to serve and extend the Church while safeguarding it from heresy, division, indiscipline, and financial indigenization. One of the regular activities organized by the Church is the women's fellowship, led by Ms. Pinki. This monthly gathering allows women from the congregation to connect, support each other, and strengthen their bonds as believers. The Church also conducts Holy Communion services once a month. The Nagraon congregation currently consists of 25-30 believers, some of whom have returned to their native land, Nepal, but there are no significant backslidden numbers.

Prayer points:

Missionary Biography



**Mrs. Gracelet
Arumainayagam**
(1957-2004)

Gracelet was born on the 29th of March 1957 in a Christian family. Her father Mr. Muthuraj and Mother Mrs. Leela were devout Christians. So, she was brought up in Christian discipline. She was regular to the Church and to the Sunday school. When she was young, she accepted Christ as her personal saviour.

MARRIAGE AND MINISTRY

Gracelet led a prayerful life, reading the Bible and strictly following the precepts of Jesus. The fellowship of the Church girls also helped her to grow in the Lord. She had a passion for missionary work. She prayed earnestly for the missionaries who were working in the mission fields in the North India. Even though she wanted to

go as a missionary she wasn't able to as she was young and unmarried. When she was grown up, her parents arranged her marriage. On hearing her prayer, God gave her a bridegroom, who was a missionary. Her parents with Gracelet's consent got her married to Mr. Arumainayagam, a cross cultural missionary. The marriage was held on the 11th of October 1978. Before her marriage as per the regulation of FMPB, she was sent for a short-term missionary training from July to September 1978. They as a family continued their missionary work in North India. God blessed their marriage with four children. They named their first daughter as Sophy Helena and the second daughter as Stella Shiny, third daughter was named as Jenishifa Priyanka and their last child was a boy child. They christened him as Benedict Paul.

CHURCH PLANTING MINISTRY IN NORTH INDIA

After their marriage, Mr. Arumainayagam's family moved to Sitamari of Bihar. They worked among the Hindi-speaking people who had never heard about the Lord. Then, they moved to Madhubani and Siwan area and did their ministry, preaching the Gospel of Christ. After some time, they again moved to Uttar Pradesh and began their ministry in a small town called Basti, which was the first North India Mission field of FMPB. They shifted to Muzaffarpur in Bihar after their stint at Basti. Due to the need of the ministry they were transferred to Jharkhand to work among the Malto people group. During that time, the Malto ministry was growing rapidly. Hundreds of people accepted Christ

and many congregations were formed. They learned the Malto language and did ministry among the Maltos, based at Barheit and Barharwa. Rev. Arumainayagam took up the Zonal leadership and led the ministry among the Maltos.

HIGHER STUDIES AND MOBILIZATION MINISTRY

To equip them for the ministry they were sent to theological studies in the seminary of Gospel for Asia mission, Thiruvalla, Kerala. They completed their theological studies and were given the new responsibility of mobilizing resources for the mission. They started their mobilization ministry based at Nazareth of Tuticorin district of Tamilnadu. They focused their attention on finding new members, leaders and started new prayer groups in that area. Also, they conducted a series of mission-challenging meetings.

LAST DAYS

On the 16th of August 2004, they as a family went to Coimbatore to attend the funeral service of one of their relatives. The long travel left Mrs Gracelet very tired. As she was a diabetic, the high sugar levels in her blood rendered her unconscious. Immediately she was rushed to a nearby hospital at Coimbatore. Doctors took every effort to save her life. But all their treatments became futile. There was no marked improvement in her health. She got the home call and entered into God's glory on the 16th of August 2004. Her mortal body was taken to her own village and buried there with the hope of resurrection. Thank God for her life and tireless ministry.



TRAIL BLAZERS

Evangelization of the world in our Generation The Missionary Kid - Robert Wilder

Robert Wilder was born on August 2, in Kolhapur, India in 1863 to missionary parents and grew up as the only white face in a sea of Marathi South Indians in the 1870's. One day, a cobra coiled itself under the piano in the Wilder home and Robert's father asked a servant to help kill the snake. The old man didn't budge. The elder Wilder crushed the head with his own slippered foot. When asked why he didn't help, the servant replied, "How do I know, perhaps my grandfather was in the snake." On hearing the spiritual condition and beliefs of this non-believer man, Robert Wilder decided that he must also serve in India as a missionary. This was a defining moment for Robert's calling. He could look back to this one event and know for sure that God had called him to India.

But after few years of missionary work by his father who suffered from ill health returned to America. Though senior Wilder went home, the mission field was always in his heart. He founded and edited the periodical, "The Missionary Review of the World" which gave the news of missionary



activity around the world. Here was born the vision, of "The Evangelization of The World In Our Generation." The faith of the father and the love for missions was shared by Robert Wilder. In due time he began his studies at Princeton. In later years remembering his college days, Robert wrote "Two things I did while in college: first Pray for awakening and revival, and second stir missionary interest wherever I went."

Wilder and his friends established the "Princeton Foreign Mission Society" on the campus. The society's constitution read, "any student of the College who is a professing Christian may become a member by subscribing to the following covenant: We, the undersigned, declare ourselves willing and desirous, God permitting, to go to the unevangelized portions of the world." Robert's sister Grace started a girl's student group at Mt. Holyoke where she was studying with a similar declaration, "We hold ourselves willing and desirous to do the Lord's work wherever He may call us, even if it be in a foreign land." At Mt. Holyoke thirty-four girls signed their names. When the

Princeton group met on Sunday afternoons, Grace was in another room praying for them.

Then, in the summer of 1886, D. L. Moody, the famous Evangelist, in conjunction with YMCA organized a one-month summer Bible conference for college students at Mt. Hermon in New York. Before Robert left for conference, his sister Grace prophesied that there would be one hundred student volunteers for the foreign mission field enlisted at the conference. Robert Wilder convinced D. L. Moody to hold a whole night meeting on worldwide mission one day. For that meeting he gathered nine other missionary kids like him to speak on the night about the great need for labourers in their respective countries that they represented. This meeting later came to be known as the “meeting of ten nations.” The meeting had a tremendous impact on the students and in the next several days, after much soul searching, a total of exactly 100 students made the pledge to serve in foreign missions. The “Student Volunteer Movement for Foreign Missions” or the SVM as it was simply called was on its way. America was awakened to foreign missions by its students. The students not only pledged themselves to go, but they went over America and challenged the American churches to do something towards world evangelisation and mission. Many churches repented of their long-standing sin of denying the “Great Commission,” of our Lord Jesus Christ. This resulted in what later came to be known as the “Forward Movement” of the churches.

In 1891, Wilder finished his studies at Union Seminary and was appointed by the Presbyterian Board of Foreign Missions for


student work in India. However, he delayed his travel to India in order to spend more than a year visiting students in Great Britain and Scandinavia. Armed with letters of reference from such stalwart dignitaries as Moody, Philip Schaff, A. J. Gordon, James McCosh and others, Wilder arrived in Britain with the goal of organising an SVM counterpart in the British universities. After his tour of several campuses and a special conference in Edinburgh in 1892, the stage was set for what became the Student Volunteer Missionary Union of Great Britain and Ireland. In Norway Wilder met Helene Olson and they were married in September 1892. The newly weds soon left for India and they ministered to students first in Calcutta and later in Pune.

The Wilders departed from India in 1897 to become SVM travelling Secretary. In 1899 he returned to India and traveled the country as traveling secretary for YMCA. In 1904, Wilder received an invitation from Student Christian Movement (SCM) to tour British Universities much as he had done in 1891. It was so impressive that he received an offer to hold the position for the next ten years. Wilder remained in London for the next ten years and traveled British Universities placing special emphasis on evangelism. When health forced him to retire, he still traveled and continued to promote the cause of missions until in 1938 he quietly went to receive his reward from the Lord. Sherwood Eddy, another product of SVM glory years aptly summed up his legacy: “Although the time was ripe and the occasion ideal, humanly speaking, the Student Volunteer Movement would not have come into being without Robert Wilder. The movement was the result of Wilder’s vision, Moody’s spiritual drive and Mott’s organizing genius.”

In the verse for quoted above, Paul here prays that he may be an instrument of converting souls at Jerusalem; "No," says Jesus, "but you shall be employed among the Gentiles," and "more shall be the children of the desolate than those of the married wife." It is God that appoints His labourers both their day and their place, and it is fit they should acquiesce in His appointment; though it may cross their own inclinations. Paul hankers

after Jerusalem; to be a preacher there, he studied and grew up there and it was the top of his ambition; but Christ designs him greater preferment; he shall not enter into other men's labours, (as the other apostles did, John 4:38) but shall break up new ground, and preach the Gospel there where Christ was not named.
