Beware!

There is a word in English called "Drift". It means be carried away. Steering and a source of power are essential in a ship or a boat. Without rudder that is connected to the steering, we are dragged along by the winds and currents. Perhaps without a source of power to divert direction we will fail to reach our destination. Along with these two, Anchor and Compass are also necessary. These will show us the direction we should go. Sometimes small changes in the compass are caused by wind and currents conditions around the ship. If the captain fails to observe this, the ship will have to travel slightly in a different direction from the direction it is supposed to be going. This is called drift. In Hebrews 2: 1 it is written that we should take heed with great care, lest we drift from the things which we have heard. We read in Matthew 24: 24 that in our Christian life, we are deceived by many false teachers and false prophets and wander away from Christ without knowing this situation. Why we are deceived is because satan gives us his lies through attractive (Sugar Coated Pills) and fake human teachings or situations. In Genesis chapter 3, satan deceived our first mother, Eve, with three tricks. First, in Genesis (3:1) Did God say that you must not eat the fruit of every tree in the garden? is questioning whether what God said here is true. Second (3:4) blatantly contradicts God's statement that you shall never die. Third (3:5) twists the word of God by saying God knows in the day you taste it, your eyes will be opened. From that day to this satan uses this same trick on men because we are deceived by the same thing. He makes us doubt God's truth, denies it, distorts it, and we can escape from this deception by knowing well what God has truly said and persevering in it, knowing how satan distorts the truth.

Therefore in order to escape from this deception we need to follow the 3F method i.e. we need to have the **Word of God as our foundation**, have strong **faith in God above it**, and based on these two **our feelings**. But nowadays many are being deceived by satan and go against the Word of God. God warns us to beware of satan's deceptions by keeping His Word, be strong in our faith in Him alone, thereby save ourselves and those around us.

on the chosen ones to devour them. Deception is a silent killer, without realizing even the chosen ones are deceived, separated from the true way of God and follows a way which seemed to be true and correct.

The possible dangers of deception are from the following ways:

There shall rise false Christs, false prophets and shall show great signs and wonders. We could also come across false teachers, false brothers and deceitful workers II Cor.11: 13. The characteristics of such people are: They hate sound doctrines; they are obsessed with disputes and arguments, walk in disorderly manner and shows false humility. In Col.2:19 Paul warns Timothy against such people.

Fake Spirituality:

Recent time's true spirituality is missing. The chosen ones get into the crowd and falls into nominalism, showiness and false Christian values without real commitment, and are stressed with unnecessary religious activities. Jesus warns them as blind

We have been meditating on a wonderful topic "You are chosen" with deep study on various heading every month. Even in the National Missionaries Conference we had the privilege of studying on this topic. It is a great privilege that we are chosen by God Himself. 2 Thess: 2:13 it is said that God has chosen us from the beginning. It is not an accidental event. But our chosenness is from the beginning.

This month we are going to study on the topic that deals with "The Chosen ones also can be deceived."

Mathew 24:24 says "If it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect. We are living in the last days and it is described as evil. Chosen people are the ones who are targeted for deception. Because, in the last days even the chosen are susceptible to deception! Apostle Peter in his epistle writes that satan has an eye

guides. Their activities are attractive and decisive leading the chosen ones into hypocrisy which is the peak of all sins. A classic example is Ananiah and Sapphira. They saw Barnabas' act of charity of selling all the properties and placing the total money at the feet of the Apostles gained him good name and fame in the apostolic team. Now Ananiah also did the same and tried to show that they have placed the full sold amount at the apostles feet while withholding little amount from it. For them honour and fame were more dominating than telling the truth and being transparent. They told a lie and thought they could hide the real things and could gain false honour. God wants truth in the heart. God cannot be cheated because we are going to stand before His presence on the judgment day – the great day is going to come. We should realize that Ananiah and Saphirah could not stand before just a human being Apostle Simon Peter. Clear and true conscience is necessary to help us to keep us from false spirituality.

Fruitless Christians:

A real Christian life is marked by the fruit of the spirit they bear in their lives. The deceived ones do not bother about the fruit of the spirit. Their only aim is to become famous. Fruit of the spirit decorates a spirit filled person with Godly characters like humility, love, meekness, patience and Godliness. Christianity is not

following a set of rules but a love relationship with God. Present day Christians are attracted towards spiritual gifts which are necessary, but the foremost thing needed is the fruit of the Holy Spirit. I Corinthians 13th chapter brings a clear picture of having the fruit of the Spirit without which the gifts of the Holy Spirit such as speaking in tongues of men and angels, prophecy, understanding all mysteries, all knowledge and all faith that moves mountains, bestow all my goods to feed the poor and give the body to be burned would profit nothing. Are we longing for fruit of the Spirit showing Christ likeness through our words, deeds and walk of life?

Foolish arguments:

The chosen ones could be deceived by arguments which are foolish and end up in heresies. By this they invite followers and have a mentality of thinking themselves super spiritual, and such deception do not allow them to listen to pure doctrines - II Timothy 4:3, 4. They do not endure sound doctrines and listen to teachings according to their own lusts, having itching ears, turn away their ears from the truth to fables.

Another important aspect is from the life of Judas Iscariot: In John 6:70 Jesus said, "Have I not chosen you twelve? Yet one of you is a devil. A chosen one became a devil. An Apostle has turned to be a devil. In this whole

chapter we could find out the attitude of the Jewish people hearing the teaching of Jesus Christ. John 6:41 - Jewish people were murmuring. John 6:52 - Jewish people began to argue sharply among themselves; John 6:60 - Jewish people commented, "It is a hard teaching; who will hear"; John 6: 61 - Jesus asked, "Does this offend you?" John 6:64 - Some did not believe; John 6:66 - Many of His disciples went back and walked no more with Him. John 6: 67 - Will you also go away?

Seeing the situation mentioned above, Jesus commented that Judas is a devil. Judas is compared to a devil which is unimaginable and horrible spiritual status of a disciple in his deception. Just being in Jesus' team does not help but it is highly necessary to obey Jesus' teaching and accept His Lordship. It helps a chosen one to keep on the safe track in spiritual life. Judas was in the team but he was working against His master due to deception of sliding from the integrity in finance as he was holding the money bag. He listened to the devil and not to the warnings of Jesus. Proverbs 29:1 says "He, that being often reproved hardens his neck, suddenly be destroyed without remedy."

How can we keep ourselves from deception? We, the chosen ones are easily caught up and get into

deception in these last days. The list Paul mentioned in II Timothy3: 2-5 covers nearly 20 sins. It is clearly written that having the form of godliness but denying the power therefore. Form of godliness is very easy to maintain without having the real walk with Jesus Christ.

1. The chosen ones should be careful about their fellowship and doctrines.
2. A disciplined Bible study is very necessary to keep from false teachers, false doctrines.
3. Withdraw from people who walk in disorderly ways. Avoid foolish disputes which are unprofitable and useless.
4. Need discernment of spirits identifying good from the evil. Know them by their fruits.
5. Pleasing God in all the walks of life and not pleasing people
6. Longing for the fruit of the Spirit.
7. Avoid anything that disturb our time, disciplines, personal quite time in the morning.
8. Worldliness and hypocrisy are the dangerous signs of deception.

The chosen ones should be alert and careful. In 1 Corinth 10:12 we read "let him who thinks he stands take heed lest he fall."

As a result of our efforts, many churches have been established in North India. The demand for ordained ministers to administer sacraments, such as the Eucharist, has been steadily increasing.

On September 2, 2023, The Bishop of Church of North India - Gujarat Rt. Rev. Silvans S. Christian, conducted a significant ordination ceremony at our founding Church in Netrang, Gujarat. He ordained 29 missionaries from our Friends Missionary Prayer Band. Just as the river Narmada flows through the Vindhya Satpura Mountains, the spirit of unity in mission work is thriving between the Church of North India and the Friends Missionary Prayer Band.

During this special occasion, our Friends Missionary Prayer Band General Secretary, Rev. John Berlin, Field Secretary Rev. Solomon, along with our Gujarat District In-charge Isaac Raja, Rev. Joseph and Rev. Ruben, volunteered and warmly welcomed Rt. Rev. Silvans S. Christian and other esteemed guests with flowers. The choir of CNI Khaidipada Church filled the air with songs and dances, glorifying the Lord.

The ordination service was conducted in the presence of God and was deeply meaningful. The 29 individuals, prepared for ordination, followed the Bishop into the Church. They stood in their seats and solemnly recited their vows before being anointed for their priestly ministry by the Bishop. The Bishop blessed and bestowed upon them the vestments (Cassock, Girdle, and The Holy Bible) symbolizing their ordination. The Bibeka Sundi family, residing in the village of Balisai in Barajamda, Jharkhand, has been instrumental in the development of the Barajamda Church and our FMPB ministry. Bibeka Sundi serves as the vice president of the Barajamda Church committee and consistently leads a daily evening small group, which has brought numerous new souls into the Barajamda Church. However, adversity struck when, at around 1 am one midnight, individuals opposing the ministry deliberately set fire to Bibeka's grocery shop. The losses amounted to around 3 lakhs worth of items, including the shop itself, a portion of their house, and personal belongings. In the face of this devastating situation, the Sundi family displayed unwavering faith and continued to run their small group without fail. Rev. S. Abraham Christopher

19.10.1947 - 18.08.2023

Rev. S. Abraham Christopher, a retired missionary of Friends Missionary Prayer Band, entered into glory on 18th August 2023, at the age of 76. He devoted his life to serving the Lord as a cross-cultural missionary in Rajasthan and Chennai, particularly among the slum dwellers, where he established a Church in Annai Sathy Nagar.

Rev. S. Abraham Christopher was born into a Christian family on 19th October 1947, in the village of Mathavankuruchi, Christianagaram. His parents were Mr. Swamiyadian and Mrs. Anna Nagaretinam. His father held the roles of both a teacher and a catechist in the local Church. Alongside three sisters, he had a younger brother.

At the age of 16, he attended a youth meeting organized by Youth for Christ in 1966. Inspired by the Bible verse 1

Corinthians 5:17, he underwent a spiritual transformation in Christ. These experiences led him to diligently study and meditate on the Scriptures, fostering his spiritual growth. In 1967, he participated in the 'Gideonite's Meet,' a missionary camp held by FMPB (Friends Missionary Prayer Band) at Pannavillai. It was here that he committed his life to becoming a cross-cultural missionary, with a calling to spread the Gospel in the un-reached areas of India. Concurrently, he worked as a warden at the CSI School for the Deaf in Santhome, Chennai. He engaged in ministry with the Madras Bible League, sharing the Gospel in various villages.

Following the Lord's guidance, he officially joined FMPB as a full-time missionary on 1st August 1976. After receiving training, he was stationed in Hanumangarh, Rajasthan, where he initiated his ministry. After several years of service in North India, he was transferred to Chennai and continued his ministry among the slum dwellers. In 2005, he was ordained as a Presbyter by the Eastern Himalaya Diocese. After 36 years of dedicated ministry, he retired on 31st October 2012.

Rev. S. Abraham Christopher married Mrs. Gnanammal on 11th February 1982. Their union was blessed with three sons. The eldest, Charles Moses Jesudoss, is employed and is married. The second son, Aaron Wesley, pursued a career as a veterinary doctor and is also married. The youngest, Dickson Livingston, completed his MBA and is employed at a private bank. Let us remember this family in our prayers and express gratitude for Rev. S. A. Christopher's faithful and impactful service, as he completed his race for the glory of the Lord.

GHANTPAHADI

Church History

Beldiha Field,
Santhal Pargana

General Information

Ghantpahadi is a small village located in Hirapur Block of Pakur district, Jharkhand with a total of 38 families residing. The Ghantpahadi village has a population of 174 of which 97 are males while 77 are females. Ghantpahadi village has lower literacy rate compared to Jharkhand.. In Ghantpahadi Male literacy stands at 50.65 % while female literacy rate was 30.51 %. Most of the village population is from Schedule Tribe (ST). There is no Schedule Caste (SC).

The Beginning

Ghantpahadi village comes under Beldiha mission field. Beldiha mission field was created when Mahespur mission field was divided into two fields in 1997, one was named as Mahespur and another as Beldiha. Mahespur field was opened by the end of May 1991. Rev. Prabakara Sarathay family were the

first missionaries to this mission field till they took up the responsibility of the Regional Field Secretary of Godda Region by the end of 1996. During the time of Rev. Sarathy family and evangelist Immanuel Malto the Ghantpahadi village was reached with the Gospel. Rev. Arulanandam took up the responsibility of Mahespur field in 1997 and the congregation in Ghantpahadi was established in his time. From April 1998 onwards Beldiha field was created and Rev. Arulanandan family became the first missionaries of this newly created Beldiha mission field. They continued up to 2006. Then Missionaries A. Solomon family took in charge of Beldiha field. They went to Johan Tudu's home and shared the Gospel. He became the first believer in this village. Johan Tudu narrates how the Gospel was brought by Rev. Prabakara Sarathy and then how he believed in the Gospel:



"Missionary Sarathy came to our home with evangelist Immanuel Malto and shared the Gospel with the rest of the Ghantpahadi village. Then they went to the village and preached the Gospel. Though I was not a Christian at that time, my children were studying in a Catholic school and they used to speak some Christian words regarding Christian faith. When I heard the Gospel through the missionary and the evangelist, I decided to follow Christian faith. The first service to confess their faith was conducted in a river near to this village to add the believers to the flock of Jesus. On that day, believers from Asamjola, Pokhria, Pochla, came to this place and were added to the flock of Jesus. It was a great celebration. This service was conducted by missionary Arulanandam when he was a bachelor. When I was added to the flock of Jesus, two more families joined me. A total of sixteen people were added to the flock of Jesus on that day. We attended the worship services in the Church in Kalajhor village for four years. Afterwards the first worship service was conducted in my home in 2003 in Ghantpahadi. This continued for four years." Eight families were participating in this worship services. Thirty believers were attending these worship meetings. Johan Tudu and Mathias were conducting these services.

Church Growth:

Some miraculous healings took place in answer to the prayers of believers during the Church services in Johan Tudu's home.

● One woman from Bado village was sick and she was bedridden for some years. The old members of her house tried their traditional gurus (shamans). But she was not cured. At last she was healed and was able to walk when she came to the worship service in Johan Tudu's home.

● Manthan Marandi was Johan Tudu's neighbor. He was sick and he felt that he was near to his death. They called Christian believers to pray for him. Believers went to pray for him three or four times. He was healed. They were all added to the flock of Jesus.

● Mansing Marandi was a robber for 10 years and was into all evil things. During that time his son had a paralytic attack. He was on the bed for some days. Many believers prayed for that boy. God healed him. Seeing all these things Mansing Marandi left all the evil things and robbery and accepted Christ and his whole family was added to the flock of Jesus.

Johan Tudu and the Church believers were praying for the village people who were in darkness to come to Christian faith. God helped them to bring many people to Christian faith. Once when they returned from Bisnathpur, Johan Tudu prayed for five families to be added to the flock of Jesus. God heard his prayers and gave five families.

Church Construction

Land donation for church construction:



Robert Kisku was the land owner. His wife's name is Rojbel Murmu. The reason for them to give the land for Church construction was because they found it very difficult to sit in a small house to worship the Lord. Therefore they wanted to build a separate building for the worship service.

Church Elder Isaac Murmu describes about Church construction in Ghantpahadi village: "People took the initiative for the Church construction. The construction work was started in 2006. There were some obstacles for the Church construction. The land owner gave little trouble. Missionary Arulanandam solved the problems. Local people gave free labour for digging the foundation and gave bamboos freely. Afterwards they labored at the rate of Rs.30 per day while outside Rs.80 was the labour charge." Church construction work was finished in January 2007. But its dedication was much delayed. This church was dedicated on 14-3-2011 by Dohnavur prayer group leader Miss Lissi and Dohnavur Prayer group members were present on that occasion.

Details of Church Activities and Ministries:

There were around 34 families (250 believers). The Church will be filled with believers each Sunday. More than hundred believers attend the Sunday services. The believers are from Sahrampur and Ghantpahadi villages. Believers from other pastorates too attend this Church service. Isaac Murmu and Johan Tudu are the church elders of this church. They conduct the worship services. Yearly 30 new people are being added to the flock of Jesus.

Various Meetings and ministries:

Isaac Murmu and his wife are leading the small group meetings on all Wednesdays. Women's meetings are conducted. Once in a month believers' camp is conducted. VBS is conducted twice in a year. Small prayer cells gather weekly on Wednesdays. Meetings for men are conducted four times a year. Sunday school was conducted earlier. But now due to the unavailability of teacher Sunday class is not conducted. Once in a month meeting is conducted in a pastorate center when pastorate service is conducted. They are doing outreach ministry in Sahrampur, Goda and Badu villages covered by this church. 17 families are led to faith in Sahrampur village. As they take permissions from the village people before starting their ministry, there is no opposition. Anis Tudu from this Church is a teacher in Bible school in Ranchi. He is the son of Johan Tudu. Mathias Kisku who is a native evangelist in Dham Dhamia field is also from this Church.

Present Evangelist Paulous Marandi:

Devilal was a guru in Soge village. Weekly nearly two hundred people used to gather in his house. His daughter in law became sick. He could not cure her. Many of his households were also sick. Then they called native evangelist for prayer. He went and prayed for all of them. God healed all of them. They all believed in Jesus Christ and took baptism. They attend the church in Jirli village.



Missionary Biography



Rev. Rajan Andrews

Our retired missionary Rev. Rajan Andrews died at the age of 76 as he went through prolonged sickness in Erode on 18th May 2021.

The Australian missionary Antony Watson Brough, missionary Herbert Arthur Popley and missionary Ellis were the LMS missionaries working in and around Erode. They established hospitals and Schools. One of the schools was established in Perunthalaiyur. By the ministry of these missionaries many Churches were established. Many people accepted Jesus Christ from the village Perunthalaiyur. Today, there is a big CSI Church in Perunthalaiyur. God raised many cross-cultural missionaries like Mr. Rajan Andrews, Mr. and Mrs. Devanesan,

Mr. Anandasekar and Mr. Johnson Shankar who had joined FMPB and did ministry throughout India.

Early Life

Mr. Rajan Andrews was born on the 5th of October 1944 in a village called Perunthalaiyur. His father Mr. Chinnaian and mother Nagammal were farmers. Mr. Rajan Andrews studied in the Christian School, where he came to know about Jesus Christ. After finishing (Old SSLC) his School final, he was seeking a job to help the poor family. He had two more sisters; so the responsibility of bread winning for the family rested on the shoulders of Mr. Rajan Andrews. He got a job in the Sakthi Sugar Mills in the nearby town as a machine operator. The family was quite happy about this.

Salvation Experience

While Mr. Rajan Andrews was working in Sakthi Sugar factory, he had an opportunity to attend a Gospel meeting. Mr. Rajan Andrews had a chance to meet the well-known evangelist Dr. Pushparaj from Salem. He helped Mr. Rajan Andrews to accept the Lord Jesus as his personal Savior and to grow in the Lord. From that day onward he paid much attention to read the Bible and pray which helped him to grow in the Lord. He also regularly attended the Church and the fellowship of the Church helped him a lot.

God's call to the missionary work

Mr. Rajan Andrews worked in the Sakthi Sugars for 18 years. He actively

participated in the Evangelical ministry along with his friends. The cross bearer evangelical team motivated Mr. Rajan Andrews to do the ministry. One day Mr. Rajan Andrews was spending time with God on the Bhavani riverbed. He was attracted by some dragonflies. One dragonfly fell into the river and it was noticed by another fly. So, the dragonfly tried many times to lift the one which had fallen in the river. It failed in the first few attempts. Finally, it helped the fly to escape from the water current; both the flies flew away happily. This incident made a great impact on the life of Mr. Rajan Andrews who was spending time in reading, meditating, and praying on the Bhavani River side. God spoke to him, "Look at the dragonfly! Even it tried hard and saved another fly from possible death. Why can't you help the people who are perishing without the Gospel?" So, Mr. Rajan Andrews obeyed the small voice of God and committed his life to do full-time ministry.

Marriage and Ministry

Mr. Rajan Andrews came to know about FMPB and applied to it to go as a missionary. On 20th May 1979 he joined FMPB as a missionary. On the 20th of November 1980, he married Nirmala in the presence of the then General Secretary Mr. M. Patrick Joshua. Then they were sent to Bethel Bible Institute for one-year missionary training. After completing the training, they were sent to

the mission field. From 1981, they began their ministry from the first FMPB mission field Periyamalai. God blessed their married life with a son Mano Samuel and with a daughter Blessy Ranjitham. After the studies Mano Samuel was employed in a private company in South Korea and Blessy finished her CA.

Rev. Rajan Andrews' family served the Lord based at Periyamalai for two and half years. Then, from 1983 they started a new mission field at Perigai. Hundreds of people accepted the Lord, and many Churches were planted in and around this area. Later, God enabled them to build Churches in Panthikuri, Jodi Kolathur, Thimmachattram, Pillakkottai, B. Agragaram, Kalagoundanur, Ariyur, Mantharall, Pethathampatti, Nambipatti, Sundaikaipatti, Gnaphathypatti, Jadaiyam-patti and Thala nattham. Then they did the ministry for seven years based at Harur and established many congregations. Thus, this couple served the Lord faithfully for about thirty years in our various mission fields. God honoured him with the presbyter ordination that helped him to celebrate the communion in the congregations and give baptism. After a prolonged battle with sickness, he was promoted to glory on 18th May 2021 at Erode. We thank God for his wonderful life and ministry. Kindly uphold the family in your prayers.

TRAIL BLAZERS



Johann Philip Fabricius

Johann Philip Fabricius was born in a place called Klipark near Prask Port in Germany on the 22nd of January 1711. His parents brought him up, along with his seven brothers, to fear and worship God. He completed his school education in Ghesan and studied theology at Halley College. He was ordained as a priest of the Lutheran Church on October 23, 1739, after completing his theological studies. Several of the students who studied theology at Halley College crossed the seas to go abroad to serve as missionaries. Fabricius also prayed with a burden that he should be able to preach the Gospel to those who did not know Christ. After he was ordained as a priest, a pastor proclaimed that missionaries were necessary to preach the Gospel in India and minister to the people there. Fabricius willingly expressed his readiness to go to India and surrender himself to fulfill the

will of God. After receiving permission to go to India, he promptly began making the necessary preparations to go abroad. Two other missionaries, Kiarnanthar and Jeplin, also joined him to go to South India, and they all arrived in Tharangambadi.

Preparations for the Ministry: Fabricius stayed in Tharangambadi for 2 years and learned both Tamil and Portuguese languages. He immersed himself in Tamil culture, making friends with the locals and gaining an understanding of their way of life. In his diary, Fabricius noted that the Tamilians were peace-loving, intelligent, generous in entertaining others, and compassionate. In these qualities, no other people excelled them.

Ministry in Chennai: Fabricius began his ministry humbly in Chennai in 1742, relying on the Lord and His grace. The condition of the new believers in Chennai and the surrounding villages was dire. Some of them were enslaved by the wealthy, while others lived in segregated areas, working as servants for Europeans. At the time, the British and the French were at war, and the French attacked and conquered Fort St. George in Chennai. During that time, Fabricius, along with the children he cared for in a hostel and the local poor Christians, fled to Palaverkadu, a place 20 miles from Chennai. For two years, they resided in Sudumanal. Instead of wasting his time, Fabricius began to translate the Bible into Tamil during this period.

Translation of the Bible into Tamil: Proficient in Hebrew and Tamil, Fabricius embarked on translating the Bible and devotional songs into Tamil. Fabricius continued this important work, translating many portions of the Bible, including the Old Testament from Genesis to the book of Ruth, the four Gospels of the New Testament,

and a significant portion of the Acts of the Apostles. Under Fabricius's supervision, the first printing press in Madras was installed in 1761. Initially, he faced challenges importing paper from Europe, but this was resolved when Indians in Madras began manufacturing their own paper, leading to the establishment of the first paper industry in Madras. After Fabricius, missionary Benjamin Sulsey completed the translation of the rest of the Old Testament, the letters of the New Testament, and the book of Revelation. In 1728, the Tamil Church had its first Bible translated into its mother tongue. However, as this translation was not perfect, Fabricius painstakingly worked for 20 years, comparing and correcting the Tamil version of the Bible, ultimately publishing the corrected version in 1772. His translation became the foundation for all future translations of the Bible into Tamil. His service to the Tamil Christians through translation work was remarkable. In 1779 he published the first Tamil to English dictionary. He devoted a third of his services to the poor people who lived with him in the village. Throughout his life, Fabricius not only engaged in ministry but also alleviated the suffering of the people he served.

Ministry in Vepery: When Fort St. George in Chennai was attacked, a large garden, houses, and a Church were provided for Fabricius's ministry. Vepery became the center of his activities. From 1752 onward, the ministry of the Word proceeded without disturbance in Chennai. Through Fabricius's efforts, government officials provided a printing press and large quantities of paper to the mission in Vepery. This enabled the publication of the Tamil Bible and other scriptural books in Tamil. The printing press also provided employment to some poor believers, improving their living conditions. In 1763, when cholera broke out in Chennai and surrounding villages, Fabricius

actively engaged in welfare schemes to help the affected people. Observing his unselfish service, the local people named him "Sanyasa Guru." In 1771, Fabricius went to Chengalpat and Kancheepuram to preach the Gospel. He ministered to about 500 soldiers and their families in the Vellore Fort, some of whom had married Indian brides. Recognizing the need, he appointed an evangelist to work among these families. Christians began conducting church services in their homes, and in 1773, Fabricius used funds from the Society for the Propagation of the Christian Gospel, along with materials provided by the local community, to build and dedicate a church in the area.

Patience in the Time of Tribulation: Fabricius faced many troubles and challenges in his ministry. Towards the end of his life, an accountant who managed his accounts for loans given to the poor misappropriated some funds, leading to a case filed against Fabricius. He was imprisoned for 18 months and emerged from prison in poor health. He translated Christian devotional songs from German into Tamil. His endurance in the face of adversity allowed him to translate devotional songs with deep feeling and earnestness, which continue to inspire and move people. These devotional songs are cherished by all church workers. In memory of Fabricius, a high school in Vepery bears his name.

Passing into Glory: Johann Philip Fabricius passed away on January 22, 1791, at the age of 80. His life serves as a challenge to those living in modern times, who enjoy far more comforts than people of the 16th century. His example inspires us to reach out to the millions of people who still do not know Jesus as their Savior. Indeed, the exemplary life of Fabricius continues to challenge us to do so.

The notice cited a life-threatening charge against him, seemingly brought forth by someone with malicious intent. On the appointed date, Sakal Tudu duly appeared at the Police Station, where the authorities issued him an ultimatum. They demanded that he should bring another individual who was also facing the same charges, or else he would be incarcerated. Without delay, Sakal Tudu took another person with him to the Police Station the very next day. Upon investigation, the police could find no wrongdoing on the part of Sakal Tudu. However, they persisted in demanding a sum of Rs. 20,000/- to resolve the case. It was during this critical moment that another prominent church elder, Jisu Marandi, arrived at the Police Station. He firmly asserted that Sakal Tudu was innocent and that the charges against him were false. In response to Jisu Marandi's intervention, Sakal Tudu was released without paying a single rupee. We give heartfelt praise and thanks to God for answering our prayers and demonstrating His role as the ultimate Righteous Judge, ensuring justice and protection for His faithful servants like Sakal Tudu.

Elesh Vasave was born on February 15, 1985, to Mr. Prabhu Boga Vasave and Mrs. Sukma Prabhu Vasave in Navagoan, Nandurbar district, Maharashtra. Elesh's parents embraced Christ in 1980 through the ministry of our pioneer missionary to the Vasava people group, Rev. Victor Murugeson, leading to their salvation.

Upon expressing this to her, she informed him that only heaven lacks sin, inspiring him to probe into Scripture to learn more. The hostel wardens also guided the children toward Christ. On

January 27, during a sermon based on Acts 4:12 about salvation through Jesus Christ and the afterlife, Elesh received the assurance of salvation. He attended a youth seminar in February 2001, organized by FMPB for hostel students, where he was inspired by missionary biographies and the call to missions, reflection of Isaiah's calling in Isaiah 6:8. During prayer, he committed to answering God's call to serve.

Ms. Sunita was born to Mr. Vechya Vasave and Mrs. Kasu Vasave in Nvapada, Nandurbar district, Maharashtra. She was a member of Tean Trust Ministries Church in Navapur and actively engaged in youth programs and spiritual activities. In 2002, she attended a youth conference in Karanji Budhrukh, where she accepted Christ and dedicated herself to His mission. Her plan to attend a Bible college in Yewatmal, Maharashtra, was met with strong opposition from her father and brothers, as only she and her mother were believers. Trusting God's guidance, she left her future in His hands, ready to serve in whatever capacity He chose. Mr. Elesh and Ms. Sunita were married on April 5, 2005. Sharing a passion for reaching the un-reached, they decided to embark on a ministry journey together.

In 2008, as a family, they underwent interview in FMPB, subsequently attending BBI and NIM before spending three months in the Balarsha area's Lakadkot village. Later, they moved to Jammu, dedicating seven years to serving the Rajput, Ramdashi, and Mahsa people groups in the Nowsherra field before relocating to the Basholi field to serve the Mahsa people. Elesh is the Regional Secretary for the Jammu Region for the past five years.

Their family has been blessed with two sons. Aaradhy, born on November 14, 2014, is currently in the third grade at Santhosha Vidhyalaya, Dhonavur, while Ivan, born on May 31, 2021, is their younger child. Let's remember this family in our prayers.
