

SOS

A sinking cruise ship only had time to send a SOS (Save Our Souls / Save Our Ship). It is a Morse code which is used as a distress code to signal danger. It signals that a person is in danger and needs immediate help before it went down. Thousands of passengers floated in the water and clung to the hope of being rescued. Then, when all seemed lost, a charter boat sailed into view. Soon skipper and crew were throwing down lifelines and hoisting people safely on to the deck. However, time was running out and there were still so many who needed to be saved. The skipper turned around and called out to those who had been rescued to lend a hand. But few bothered. Most were too busy getting themselves comfortable on the deckchairs- now that they were saved they only wanted to continue their cruise.



When we believe in the Lord Jesus Christ and are rescued from eternal damnation, it's natural to have a tremendous sense of relief. However, once saved, we have the option of making ourselves comfortable and continuing our life of cruise - or we can get off our deckchairs and lend a hand with the rescue mission of those still in deadly peril of eternal damnation. These days, with mounting criticism against Christianity, it's so much easier to hide our beliefs and cruises through life. Amidst it, God has given us an amazing opportunity to be part of the biggest rescue mission for eternity. It's time we all got off our deckchairs and lend a hand, or more importantly 'bend a knee' in prayer for missionaries, evangelist and teachers of the Word.

God saved Paul and chose him to carry the Gospel to the gentiles, Kings and children of Israel (Acts 9:15). FROM THE GENERAL SECRETARY...

Dear Partners in the mission of reaching the unreached,

Greetings to you in the mighty Name of our Lord of the harvest.

I write this editorial from Delhi as I am returning from the Jammu and Punjab visit. Our missionaries are doing the ministry entrusted God with enthusiasm and commitment. The Word of God in John 3:27 says that, "To this John replied, "A person can receive only what is given them from heaven". This verse teaches us a profound truth to be content and grateful to God for what we have or what we have not. This is John the Baptist's reply to his disciples when they said that Jesus is baptizing and every one is going with Him. Jealousy, discouragement and unhappiness in our hearts will disappear if the truth is applied in our lives that no one can take away what God wants to give to us and no one can give to us what God doesn't want to give. The conference was attended by the retired missionaries, missionaries and the children of missionaries in large numbers. Throughout the conference a family atmosphere could be seen and experienced. Many missionary children attended with their families. When some retired missionaries could not attend due to their health situation, their children families attended. That showed the relationship of our missionaries with the organisation continues to the next generations. My sincere and heartfelt thanks to the Organising committee and the sub committees who worked with deep dedication to make the conference a blessed and beautiful event.

Deccan Region Visit: God enabled me to visit the missionaries of Deccan Region in their mission field homes along with the Field leaders. The visit was a great encouragement to know the work of God through our missionaries. I could meet some of the believers who were transformed by the gospel.

Jammu visit: In the second week of October I participated in a believer's convention in

Secondly on 16th October the Khai church was dedicated for the glory of God. Following that the Field Secretary and I met the missionary families of Budhlada Region. We had a wonderful time of learning and discussion with the beautiful servants of God.

Chosen to Proclaim Christ to The Un-reached

This fiscal year, we have been meditating on the theme "I have chosen You." Many characters in the scriptures were chosen by God for a specific purpose. God chose Moses to free the Israelites from slavery in Egypt. He asked King Solomon to build a temple in Jerusalem. The Lord has recognized us all as His children (John 1:12). What a great blessing this is! In Acts 9:15, the Lord chose Paul to evangelize the Gentiles (nations and kings) who did not know Christ. Paul realized this and fulfilled it completely. He made evangelistic voyages by sea three times and preached the Gospel to many countries. He established churches among the Gentiles. Paul saw this as a "duty that fell upon him." "Woe to me if I do not preach the Gospel." He was not ashamed to proclaim the Gospel, and he considered it an obligation imposed upon him.

Like Paul, we must live as instruments to proclaim the Gospel to people who do not know Christ. This is why God has chosen us.

A Paul's Total Commitment:

Paul was born in the genealogy of the tribe of Benjamin in Israel. King

Saul also belonged to the same lineage, which is why he had this name. As he was a Roman, his name was Latinized to "Paul." As a Roman citizen, his family must have held high status. He was a scholar taught by Gamaliel, the celebrated scholar in Jerusalem. As a zealous Jew, Paul persecuted Christians because he did not recognize Jesus as the Messiah. He encountered Jesus on his way to Damascus while seeking to capture the followers of the way. Saul heard the voice of Jesus and responded by saying, "Lord, what do you want me to do? I will do whatever you say." This is how Paul committed his life to obeying the calling of Christ.

A notable example of commitment is the story of Phulan Devi, a notorious bandit imprisoned in the 1980s for murder and robbery. Former Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh, Mr. Mulayam Singh Yadav, forgave her and appointed her as a Member of Parliament. When reporters interviewed her and asked what she would do for Mr. Mulayam Singh's help, she said, "I am fully committed to doing whatever he says." Can we also be equally committed in our lives for Christ?

B Paul's Faithfulness:

In 1 Timothy 1:12, Paul mentions that he considered the Lord to be faithful and appointed him to the

ministry. Paul was faithful to Judaism before encountering Christ. He lived blamelessly according to the righteousness of the law. That's why the Lord trusted him and made him an apostle to the Gentiles. True to his calling, Paul immediately preached that Jesus was the Son of God after his conversion. He felt obliged to preach the Gospel to the Jew, the Greek, and all the Gentiles. Instead of building evangelism on the foundation of others, he tirelessly worked to proclaim the Gospel where the name of Jesus was not mentioned. He did not preach about himself; his chief duty was to proclaim that Jesus was the Lord, and he faithfully carried out his ministry throughout his life. Despite many hardships, he fulfilled his ministry without wavering.

Paul lived faithfully not only in his ministry but also in his personal life. He did not seek material wealth like silver or gold. He worked for his basic needs, such as the clothes he wore. He also helped the poor by collecting alms by himself. He did not own a house and lived in a rented one. He consistently maintained a blameless and virtuous life before God and man. Let us also be faithful to the Lord in our ministry and personal life.

C Paul's Prayer Life:

Paul was a dedicated prayer warrior. When he encountered Jesus, he was in the house of Judas, and it is said that he spent time in prayer after this life-changing event. When reading his

epistles, we can see that he prayed for the churches (Romans 1:9, Ephesians 1:16, Philippians 1:11, Colossians 1:5, 1 Thessalonians 1:4). He even prayed for the Galatians when they were turning away from the truth (Galatians 4:19). In Romans 10:1, we see Paul's burden for the salvation of souls, particularly for Israel. He prayed with others in various places, including in prison, by the river, and with fellow believers.

During a remembrance prayer meeting for the former General Secretary of FMPB (late) Patrick Joshua, many remembered him as a prayerful man. Patrick Annan's son shared that his father suffered greatly from diabetes in his final days. Nevertheless, he continued to fast and pray, disregarding medical advice. When questioned about it, his consistent reply was, "My nation is perishing. How can I live without fasting and prayer?" Can we also be committed to praying for those who are perishing without knowing Jesus and for missionary work?

Prayer:

Lord, we commit ourselves to being fully dedicated to evangelizing those who do not know You, just as Paul was. We pledge to live and work faithfully before You until our last breath. We dedicate ourselves to individual and group prayer for all the concerns that burden Your heart. Amen.

NATIONAL MISSIONARIES' CONFERENCE 2023



Holding a teacup in one hand, two missionaries gathered at their Regional meeting continued their conversation. "Have you reserved tickets to Chennai, brother?" "Oh, yes, we reserved the tickets for both ways as soon as we received the news from HQ."

The servants of God engaged in the Lord's ministry throughout India were in a jubilant mood upon learning about the National Missionaries' Conference, which is held once every five years and was going to take place near Chennai. This news brought joy to all the missionaries of FMPB, one of the largest mission organizations in Asia. Every region began practicing dances, songs, and short plays to depict their Regional colors.

As September 30th approached, eagerly awaited by all, the missionaries embarked on their long journeys to Chennai from their respective places. "Brother, I am very new to Chennai. Will any arrangements be made to receive us and take us to the meeting place?" A young missionary with his wife and child inquired with his superior. "Don't worry, brother. Have you not read the letter from HQ that contains all the answers to your questions? Vehicles are arranged from Chennai Central, Egmore railway stations, and Chengalpattu Bus bay to the meeting place," the Regional Secretary replied with a smile.



The participants disembarked from their trains after a long and tiresome journey. They were warmly welcomed and provided with hospitality, including tea, snacks, and smiles, by Brother Ranjit and Xavier's team. The receiving team's graciousness relieved the fatigue of the participants resulting from their long travels. Vehicles from various locations, with songs filling the air, began to enter the meeting venue, which was owned by Trans World Radio at Paramankeni, near Mahabalipuram, which is located on the seashore.

"Brother, I thought it would take a long time to find our accommodations. But as soon as we arrived, the people at the reception took our names and provided us with essential items like bed sheets, water bottles, pillows, and suitcases. It's a fine practice," praised a North Indian missionary who was attending such a gathering for the first time. Brother Edison, Rubertson, and the Treasurer- Nelson annan, orchestrated this marvelously.

After a short rest with tea, the missionaries prepared to attend the inaugural session of the meeting. Children of the missionaries studying in Santhosa Vidyalaya were brought in by a special bus. The missionaries and the children expressed their immense joy by hugging their loved ones. The President cut the ribbon and initiated the missionary parade. The Field Secretary and his wife led the procession, raising the National Flag and the FMPB Flag. Regional Secretaries and their colleagues followed with songs, placards, and dances representing their people groups. Every Region was well-represented. The procession entered the auditorium while singing "Onward Marching Soldiers." The President, Vice President, Treasurer, and General Secretary, who were on stage, conveyed the vision statement and ethos of FMPB to the participants, strengthening their faith in God and the organization. The president welcomed the delegates, provided instructions, and the event commenced with a prayer. After a delicious dinner, the missionaries gathered again in the auditorium for a time of prayer led by the South Mobilization Secretary.



Mr. Longway, the host for all three days, did a wonderful job of informing, guiding, and encouraging the missionaries into various sessions. The camp on the Theme "I have Chosen you" began when the sun's rays began to pierce the venue. It commenced with the morning devotion led by Dr. Jemila Koshi. After the worship, the delegates were divided into eight groups for group activities. Bro. CB Samuel delivered a message from God. The delegates attended their first workshop on various topics, including Mental Health by Dr. Jamila Koshy, Integrity by Dr. Anand Samuel, Spiritual Warfare by Bro. Sandeep Daniel, and Parenting and Family by Bro. CB Samuel. In the afternoon, the second workshops took place, followed by indoor group activities led by Mr. Sudhan David and Mrs. Megha.

At dusk, Bro. CB Samuel delivered another message from God during the sandhya. "We are used to North Indian food, and I was worried about the kind of food that would be served at the camp. But, to my surprise, we were served all kinds of delicacies," said another missionary.


"The arrangements made to care for the senior missionaries by providing food and accommodations are to be noted and appreciated," commented a senior missionary.

Missionary Biography



NIJWM MUCHAHARY

(1985-2021)

The COVID-19 pandemic has had a devastating impact on the world, causing serious consequences for communities and individuals. Spreading rapidly across borders, it has paralyzed societies, economies, and the way of life we once knew. The pandemic has led to a tragic loss of human life worldwide, and India has not been exempt from its effects. Thousands of people in India lost their lives to COVID-19, including a young missionary, Mr. Nijwm Muchahary, who traveled to Punjab to spread the Gospel of Jesus Christ. He was one of the victims of this formidable virus and passed away on July 13, 2021, in Punjab.

Early Life: Nijwm Muchahary was born on August 15, 1985, in the small village of Dolootpara in the state of Assam. His father, Mr. Chinot Muchahary, was a farmer, and his mother, Mrs. Noni Bala, was a homemaker who also assisted with farming. They were not Christians initially but converted to Christianity after a miraculous healing in their family. Their daughter was seriously ill and on the verge of death. Despite their non-Christian background, they had tried various rituals and visited temples, but nothing had worked. They were introduced to Jesus by a Christian friend, who prayed for their sick daughter, and she was miraculously healed. In gratitude, the entire family decided to follow the Lord Jesus Christ. Nijwm had two sisters, Thabitha and Chompa, and they worshiped together in the Northern Evangelical Lutheran Church in Gongia.

Salvation Experience: Though economically disadvantaged, Nijwm's parents sent their children to school until 2005. Nijwm himself accepted Christ as his personal savior at the age of 18 in 2003, after a meeting with an evangelist. Verses such as Romans 3:23, 10:9, and 1 Corinthians 6:30 had a profound impact on him, leading him to confess his sins and accept Christ. He completed his Higher Secondary education at Janata College, Serfanguri, in 2011. As he grew in his faith, he also became involved in ministry among children and youth in his church, which helped him lead a victorious Christian life.

Call to God's Mission: Through church ministry, particularly missionary meetings, Nijwm developed a strong burden for the salvation of souls. He felt a calling to proclaim the Gospel of Christ to others, and he believed that God confirmed this calling through verses like Matthew 28:18-19 and Romans 12:11. To prepare for his future ministry, he enrolled in the B.Th. degree course at South India Bible College in Bangalore, which he completed in 2010. He then commenced his ministry within his church.

Ministry with Friends Missionary Prayer Band: Nijwm Muchahary later became aware of the Friends Missionary Prayer Band and felt called to serve as a cross-cultural missionary. He was selected as a missionary candidate and received one year of training at the National Institute of Missions in Jhansi, starting in June 2012. Subsequently, he was assigned to the Budhlada mission field as a bachelor and joined the Jeep team ministry in 2013. He dedicated himself to proclaiming the Gospel from village to village.

Marriage and Church Planting Ministry in Punjab: Nijwm Muchahary married Ms. Sarojoni Narzary, who was born in Suribari village, Assam, on May 20, 2014. She was selected as a fiancée and received missionary training in June 2013. After completing her training, she married Nijwm Muchahary. As a family, they were placed in the Baghapurana mission field. Nijwm learned Punjabi

and preached the Gospel to un-reached people, having a strong command of Hindi. In September 2015, they initiated their ministry in the Nihal Singwala field of Punjab, where they developed the church and strengthened the faith of believers. With the help of fellow believers, he acquired additional land for the church and built a boundary wall. Nijwm was also gifted in singing and playing the guitar, which he used to glorify God and benefit the congregation. He was known for his dedication and hard work as a missionary.

Home Call: Tragically, Nijwm Muchahary contracted COVID-19, and while initially experiencing mild symptoms, the virus quickly affected his lungs, making it difficult for him to breathe. He received treatment at home for a week, but his condition worsened, leading to his hospitalization. In early July, there was a brief improvement in his health, but he subsequently struggled to breathe normally, requiring ventilator support. His oxygen levels dropped, and he passed away on July 14, 2021. Nearby missionaries rushed to the hospital, and his body was laid to rest with the hope of resurrection in Faridkot. TRAIL BLAZERS

HENRY KNOTT

Missionary to the South Pacific Islands

(1774 - 1844)

Henry Knott was born in 1774 in Bromsgrove, England. He was one of the pioneering missionaries sent out by the emerging London Missionary Society. This society was dedicated to sending missionaries from England to underdeveloped countries, setting it apart from other missionary organizations. This unique mission inspired many to join the London Missionary Society, including Knott himself. At the age of 22, in September 1796, Henry Knott embarked on his missionary voyage to the South Pacific Islands. On March 5, 1797, he arrived on the island of Tahiti. Unlike the popular tourist destination it is today, Tahiti was marred by the immorality and superstitions of its inhabitants. The Tahitians were deeply entrenched in idolatrous customs due to their ignorance and superstitions.

Upon their arrival on the island, the missionaries were welcomed by King



Bamaro, who showed more interest in their tools and equipment than their intentions. Bamaro, initially oblivious to their mission, offered them generous accommodation, and the missionaries enthusiastically began their work. On March 1, 1797, Knight conducted the first Christian service with the assistance of a non-Christian translator. However, their equipment was forcibly confiscated by Bamaro, and the islanders were more interested in the gifts from the missionaries, causing a scarcity of materials. Robbery was widespread and even accepted as part of their religion, worshipping a god called 'Thief's guard.' Although they heard the word of God, their hearts remained shrouded in darkness, and they clung to material possessions.

The islanders were notorious for their violent battles and murders, considering peace a shame. They practiced gruesome forms of revenge, such as wearing the flayed corpses of their enemies as garments. Human sacrifice was prevalent, with one in three children falling victim to their parents or child murderers. Some children were even thrown into the sea or a volcano as offerings to atone for sins. The islanders were often driven to madness by drunkenness, and sick and elderly people were buried alive to relieve the burden on others. Their practices were beyond imagination and deeply disturbing.

The number of missionaries dwindled over time as they struggled with the heavy workload and the challenges of their mission. Some missionaries abandoned their work to seek alternative sources of income, and one was tragically killed. Despite these hardships, Henry Knott remained dedicated and persevered. On March 10, 1801, he preached in the local language, becoming the first missionary to learn and preach in their tongue. Support materials were dispatched only twice in seven years, and on one occasion, they were lost in a shipwreck. In 1803, King Bamaro died after sacrificing an estimated 2,000 people without ever knowing the Lord. His son, Bamaro II, succeeded him.

In 1805, six missionaries decided to leave the island, and in 1808, their residence was completely destroyed, with their possessions looted. The remaining missionaries also left, leaving Knight alone on the island. Henry Knott took it upon himself to translate the Bible into the Tahitian language and distributed it to the people. He made repeated efforts to share the Gospel with Bamaro II. In 1813, the first Church was built. In 1815, Bamaro II eradicated all idols and temples from the island, putting an end to the customary practices of the islanders. Witnessing this transformation, several missionaries who had left earlier returned to the island.

On May 11, 1819, the first Church was dedicated by the Royal Missionary Society, and a Christian-based legal system was declared to govern the people from the following day. Knight authored this law, and it was later adopted by other South Pacific islands. In 1819, Henry Knott baptized the first person, none other than Bamaro II himself. Following this, hundreds of islanders were baptized, and many became missionaries, spreading the Gospel to nearby islands. After dedicating 47 years of his life to the mission in Tahiti, Henry Knott entered his eternal home on May 2, 1844.

Dear sister, would you be available to spend some time with me? I have a special reason to introduce someone to you who can provide support and guidance in various life situations. This exchange was initiated by Sister Jemima, who was unwavering in her dedication to gathering souls for the Kingdom of God since her college days in Coimbatore. Thanks to her introduction of Jesus to a lost soul, that person was rescued from eternal doom and found salvation, ultimately becoming a part of the faith community.

Sister Jemima, born on October 31, 1948, grew up like any other child in an orthodox family, leading a purposeless life. However, at the age of 15, during a youth meeting, she accepted Jesus as her savior and recognized her primary calling to save souls for the Lord. Upon completing her schooling and entering college, she

established prayer groups and guided her fellow students toward the path of light even before her college days were over.

After graduating, she declined numerous job opportunities, remaining resolute in her mission, and continued her work in Salem as part of the Coimbatore Diocese. In 1977, she married Mr. Gersome, a missionary with FMPB, and together they began on their journey to proclaim the Gospel in the Hanumangarh field of Rajasthan.

The mission they started flourished and continued successfully until their retirement in 2007. In addition to their missionary work, she also organized separate gatherings for women, counseling camps, and provided support in various ways. Even after being relocated from Rajasthan to Chennai and Kannpur, they carried on their mission successfully.

One remarkable aspect of Sister Jemima was her constant smile and her ability to connect with people through it. In her 76th year, she participated in the National Missionary Conference, where she reunited with old missionary friends and made new ones, offering prayers with them. Mrs. Jemima continued to preach about God's love until her last breath. Tragically, she met her end in an accident while returning from Chennai to Bangalore with her husband and son's family on October 3, 2023.

Let us join together in prayer for the comfort of her husband, Mr. Gersome, her sons: Raja Selvin and Inbakumar Joshua, her daughters-in-law, and her grandchildren. Furthermore, let us give thanks to God for the beautiful and meaningful life led by Mrs. Jemima Gersome.



ODHAN CHURCH HISTORY

KALANWALI FIELD,
HARYANA REGION,
NORTHERN ZONE

Odhan is a large village located in the Dabwali Tehsil of Sirsa district in Haryana. According to the constitution of India and the Panchayat Raj Act, Odhan village is administered by a Sarpanch (Head of the Village), who is an elected representative of the village. Odhan village in Sirsa has a significant population of Scheduled Caste. However, the village of Odhan does not currently have any Scheduled Tribe (ST) population.

BEGINNING

The Jeevan Nagar mission field in Haryana was established in 2013. Mr. Bibhaba Pani and Mrs. Bithika Pani were the first missionaries in this field. Gospel was introduced to the Odhan village, the tenure of the Kalanwali field missionary, Mr. V Johnson, and his family. The first believer from the Odhan area was Ms. Sunitha from the Ode Rajput community. Her relative, Mrs. Seetho Arjun, is also a

believer from Kalanwali. Sunitha's family learned about Christ through her, when she had been experiencing bleeding and was believed to be possessed by an evil spirit. Missionary Mr. V Johnson was invited to her house to pray for her, and through prayers, God healed her and delivered her from the evil spirit. She, along with her family, started attending the Kalanwali Church for worship. Even her father, who had initially been against the ministry, accepted Christ due to the miracle in his daughter's life. Worship initially took place in their house in Odhan, with a prayer meeting held there every Thursday for about a year.

In June 2011, Odhan was designated as a sub-center of the Kalanwali mission field, and a local evangelist, Mr. Jagdeesh, was stationed in Odhan. Mr. Dharmender Singh, a relative of local evangelist Mr. Jagdeesh, had been suffering from seizures for seven years. Despite trying various medicines, he did not find relief. Mr. Jagdeesh introduced him to Christ, and after putting their faith in the Lord, Mr. Dharmender and his family

experienced healing within a few days. They embraced Christianity and joined the Church. In 2012, 22 people in Odhan became part of the Church. Later, the worship, initially held at Ms. Sunitha's house, was moved to a rented house provided by the local evangelist, where worship continued until the Church building was constructed. In 2013, after the Jeevan Nagar field was opened, the Odhan congregation became part of the Jeevan Nagar field.

CHURCH GROWTH

God worked wonders in the lives of the people through the local evangelist, Mr. Jagdeesh, who cared for the Odhan Church. As a result, people's lives were transformed, and they became part of the Church. Here are some testimonies from believers:



Saraswati: "I am Saraswati from Odhan. My husband frequently suffered from various illnesses and was even believed to be demon-possessed. My neighbor, Mrs. Surjeet, introduced me to Christ. When I shared this with my husband, he initially resisted but eventually attended the satsang conducted by Pastor Jagdeesh in our village. God healed my husband, and in 2013, our entire family accepted Christ."



Mrs. Rajini: "I am Rajini from Sirsa. I've known about Christ since my childhood. My husband and I were diagnosed with AIDS after getting married in 2010. Doctors advised us to abort our child due to the risk of HIV transmission, but we chose not to. God blessed us with a healthy boy, and by His grace, our health has remained good. I started attending this Church in 2016 and professed my faith in Jesus."

Missionary Mr. S David shared the miraculous healing of Mrs. Sikandra's daughter in Kalanwali: "Mr. Keval of Odhan did not have children, so he adopted his brother's child, who had a lump on the head. Doctors recommended surgical removal when the child turned five. However, after prayer at the Church, the lump disappeared within a few months."

CHURCH BUILDING

The Odhan Church, which was under the Jeevan Nagar mission field since 2013, was later merged with the Kalanwali mission field in 2019. The Church land in Odhan was purchased for Rupees 10.5 lakhs, measuring 63X39 ft. The Odhan congregation members hail from various villages, including Bhagsar, Salamkheda, Sahuwala, Ghukawali, Chormar Kheda, Fatehpuriyan, Banwala and Odhan. They come from the Ode Rajput and Balmik communities. The foundation for the Church was laid in 2015, and a solid 40X20 ft. Church building was constructed. Believers actively participated in the labor work. The sponsorship for this project came from CSI Christ Church, Coimbatore. On January 28, 2017, the Odhan Church was dedicated for the glory of God, with Mr. Paul David cutting the ribbon and leading the dedication ceremony. Some prayer group members from Coimbatore, 300 believers,

Haryana missionaries, and local evangelists participated in it. During the construction and dedication of the Odhan Church, Mr. Bibhaba Pani served as the Jeevan Nagar field missionary.

CHURCH ACTIVITIES AND INFORMATION

The Church in Odhan is led by Mr. Ranvir and Mr. Amrit Pal, who serve as elders. Some believers accompany the local evangelist on outreach ministry endeavors. Approximately thirty people attend Sunday worship services, which are led by the local evangelist. The total congregation size in Odhan is 120.



November 14th is celebrated as National children's day. Every November 20 is celebrated as Universal Children's day all around the world. As we all know, children are the future and they hold the key to our society. These days aim to promote children's welfare and encourages government and individuals to work together to protect rights of the children worldwide.

Achievements: India's growth over the last two decades has contributed phenomenally to global human development. Extreme poverty in India is reduced to 21%, infant mortality is halves; and two million fewer children are out of school. These are significant achievements yet India's economic successes especially for women and children are still remaining a challenge.

Challenges:

- 1. For children to get nutritious food-** India has high levels of malnutrition (38.4 per cent children are stunted).
- 2. For the all round development of the children-** India has the largest adolescent population of 253 million, and every fifth person is between 10 -19 years. India stands to benefit socially, politically and economically if this large number of adolescents are safe, healthy, educated and equipped with information and life skills to support the country's continued development.
- 3. For the protection of the children-** 60-80 percent girls face sexual harassment/violence in public places.
- 4. For Child marriages to be eradicated-** India ranks fourth among the eight South Asian countries in terms of child marriage prevalence. Early marriage and childbearing affects their ability to live empowered healthy lives which in turns affects the next generation.
- 5. For the children in our FMPB homes and schools** children to grow physically, socially and spiritually. And the Children wing of our organization that goes around meeting kids and leading them towards Christ.
