Makarios...

Makarios, was the name of an island in Greece. The Greek word Makarios is "blessed". It got its name blessed island because it was self-contained

and self-sustained without having to run to another island to get their needs met. The natural resources of the island were so thick, so rich, so fruitful, and so productive that everything they needed to enjoy in their lives was already built in. Likewise we read in Psalms 33:12 Blessed is the nation whose God is the LORD, the people He chose for His inheritance. Jesus is that blessed Island. We are blessed "in Christ". 

FROM THE GENERAL SECRETARY...



Dear Partners in the mission of reaching the un-reached,

Season's greetings to you in the mighty Name of the Lord of harvest.

On behalf of all missionaries, believers and prayer warriors of FMPB, I bring Christmas greetings to you all in the Name of our Lord who was born in Bethlehem to redeem the mankind from sin and to reconcile them with the Father. One important point of Christmas is God made His Son very vulnerable by bringing Him as a Child in an obscure family of Joseph. But God the Father's protection was on Jesus from the beginning. This protection is manifested by God's guidance to Joseph to take the Child to Egypt to secure from Herod who was searching to kill Jesus (Matthew 2:13). Most of us don't want to be vulnerable in anything to anybody. So, to be stronger it is quite natural on our efforts to try to secure us, family, children, health and financial position. But Christmas teaches us that security is not on our efforts but in the hands of the Lord. Release of Rev. Jangkhun Touthang:

By the grace of God and all your prayers Rev. Jangkhun Touthang, our U.P. missionary was granted bail on 27th October and released from the jail on 4th November after 23 days of imprisonment.

CCC classes in NIM: God helped me to teach Cross Cultural Communication to the missionary trainees in National Institute of Mission in Jhansi from 23rd to 29th October 2023. Some basic sessions of the large workshop was taught to the missionary trainees and it is very useful for their future ministry.

Graduation service: Eleven God selected Missionary trainees completed their 5 months field exposure and 10 months training and graduated as missionaries on the 29th October 2023. Parents, relatives, Church believers from Jhansi and other places, Pastors of different denominations, convents and FMPB leaders witnessed the glorious graduation service where our missionaries surrendered their lives to fulfill the great commission of the Lord and were dedicated by the servants of God. FMPB's Secretary HRD and other field leaders also participated which encouraged the missionaries. FMPB thank the Dean of NIM, Rev. N. Rajadurai family for equipping the missionaries to be great instruments in the hands of the Lord. Please pray for the missionaries who have gone into the allotted ministerial places.

Divisional Heads meeting: The team of Divisional Secretaries gathered for 2 days fasting and prayer and 2 days of discussion from 3rd to 6th November in the Vision land of Periyamalai. Sitting at the feet of God in prayer was a great blessing spiritually to all of us and the discussion was very productive.

Zonal and Regional Secretaries meeting: Following the divisional secretaries meeting, the Field Zonal Secretaries gathered for two days and they and the Field Regional Secretaries gathered for another two days 7th-10th November. These meetings were conducted in a cordial and serene atmosphere and had heart to heart open discussions. Pray that the Lord may bless all the decisions taken.

Pawra NT dedication: As I have written in my last month editorial, the New Testament in Pawra language was dedicated in Boradi of Maharashtra on 14th November 2023. It was dedicated in a large gathering of believers and among many relatives of the translator. The event was very emotional because the Translator Rev. Immanuel Iraipitchai could not witness the historic occasion in person as he is with the Lord. His wife and our missionary Mrs. Jane Iraipitchai continues the ministry. We praise God for the life and ministry of Rev. Immanuel and praying for his family. The detail report could not be published in this issue due to space crunch and will be published in the next issue.

Cross Cultural Communication work shop: We have planned to extend this workshop to all field missionaries; it will be conducted in the 1st week of December for the missionaries of North Eastern and Eastern Zone. Please pray for the workshop to be beneficial to the missionaries and their ministry.

Mobilization Christmas meetings in Andhra Pradesh: I will be attending three meetings for celebrating Christmas. Blessed

**are those
who are chosen
by the Lord**

(Psalms 33:12)

In the Bible, the terms "blessed" and "blessings" are used intermittently. In the Old Testament, the term "blessing" is often associated with the prosperity of material things (Deuteronomy 28:3-6, 8). David elaborates in Psalms 1:2, stating that those who delight in the law of the LORD and meditate on it day and night are considered blessed. Jesus, who is from the genealogy of David, blesses His people based on the theme of the Kingdom of God, as seen in Matthew 5:3-11. The blessings described in (Deuteronomy 8:7-9) are considered a shadow of the blessings of the Almighty God mentioned in (Genesis 14:18-19). The blessings of Canaan were given to Abraham as an eternal promise, revolving around the concept of the New Jerusalem. The Old Canaan promise of blessing, as

outlined in (Deuteronomy 11:18), is limited to the old heaven and earth. However, with the advent of the new heaven, earth, and Jerusalem, as described in (Revelation 21:1-2), a new promise of eternal blessing emerges, revolving around the new heaven and new earth. That is the land of Canaan promised to Abraham by God (Psalms 105: 8-11).

The inheritance of our Lord belongs to Abraham's descendants (Galatians 3:29):

The gap in the cordial relationship between God and Adam paved the way for another eternal relationship with mankind. God's plan was fulfilled in choosing Abraham and establishing a dynasty of a royal priesthood (Deuteronomy 7:6), a plan further realized in Jesus Christ (1 Peter 2:9). Although this lineage spans many generations, God refers to it as one generation (Genesis 12:3, 17:7). Paul identifies this generation as Christ in Galatians 3:6. In Matthew 1:1, we see this generation beginning with Abraham and concluding with Jesus Christ, the son of David. The revelation that even the Gentiles are included in this generation was hidden for a long time but is now revealed to the apostle Paul (Ephesians 3:3). Paul, appointed as an apostle for the Gentiles, emphasizes in Romans 11:13 that even the Gentiles are equal inheritors of the Kingdom of God. In his writings in Galatians 3:28, Paul states that Jews, Greeks, slaves, males, and females are all co-inheritors in Christ Jesus. Those who have been baptized

in Christ Jesus belong to Jesus and are descendants of Abraham (Galatians 3:27, 29). Prophecies, such as those in Isaiah, affirm this reality, describing them as blessed people (Isaiah 61:9), and prophesying blessings for their descendants as well (Isaiah 65:1, 23).

God's Inheritance Belongs to the Predestined Ones

(Ephesians 1:12):

God's inheritance is reserved for the predestined ones, chosen even before their creation. Ecclesiastes 6:10 suggests that everyone is named before birth, and in Matthew 25:34, Jesus teaches through parables that individuals are marked to inherit the Kingdom of God before the formation of the world. The predestined ones, as emphasized in Ephesians 1:4, will not perish but have everlasting life (John 3:16). This predestination extends to Christ himself, who was destined before the foundation of the world to be crucified (1 Peter 1:20, Revelation 13:8a). Those predestined to inherit eternal life are the chosen ones, and the phrase "In Christ" is recurrent in Ephesians 1:3-13 and throughout the epistles. Christ, as the mediator of a new covenant, secures the promised eternal inheritance for those called, having died as a ransom to set them free from sins committed under the first covenant (Hebrews 9:15). The predestined ones have received salvation and forgiveness of sins in Christ (Ephesians 1:7), are sealed (Ephesians 1:13, Revelation 7:4), and are God's own and anointed ones (2 Corinthians 1:21, 22). The Holy Spirit guides them until the final day of

redemption (Ephesians 4:30), urging believers to remain fervent in the Spirit.

The Lord's Inheritance Belongs to God's Children (Proverbs 19:14a):

God's children are those who have accepted Christ Jesus and confessed Him as Lord (John 1:12). They are approved by God, granted authority, and become children of God through faith, distinct from worldly people. Born of God, they receive the right as His children (John 1:12-13) and are new creations (2 Corinthians 5:17). Led by the Spirit of God (Romans 8:14), they crucify the flesh with its passions and desires on the cross (Galatians 5:24) and are set apart from the world (John 17:16). Chosen to be His people (Deuteronomy 14:1a, 2), they are comparable to the tribe of Judah, placed in the line of children to inherit a good land (Jeremiah 3:19). God's promise to David regarding his eternal house, kingdom, and throne, established forever (2 Samuel 7:16), finds its fulfillment in the vision of Jesus Christ, the Son of God, who belongs to His children. The commitment expressed in 1 Chronicles 17:13, "I will be his father, and he will be my son," mirrors the everlasting love God has for His chosen ones.

God's Children are His Adopted Sons: Ephesians 1:6

God, in His infinite mercy, has chosen us as His adopted sons according to His will. He has created and molded

sons and daughters for Himself from the ends of the earth. Those who have taken His name are referred to as His adopted sons (Isaiah 43:6-7). In Hosea 1:10, the author calls them His children. Predestined to be transformed into the image of His Son (Romans 8:29), believers are urged to be like Him, for when Christ appears, they shall see Him as He is (1 John 3:2). Paul expresses in Galatians 4:19 how he labors until Christ is formed in believers. Galatians 6:17, where Paul speaks of bearing on his body the marks of Jesus, serves as a model and admonition. As children, believers are heirs-co-heirs with Christ (Romans 8:17). Flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God, and the perishable cannot inherit the imperishable (1 Corinthians 15:50). The call is to clothe oneself in His likeness and participate in His inheritance.

The Adopted Sons are Privileged (Romans 8:15):

Believers are no longer foreigners and strangers but fellow citizens with God's people, members of His household (Ephesians 2:19). God has rescued them from the power of darkness and brought them into the kingdom of His Son (Colossians 1:12-13). Privileged to have received the Spirit of adoption, believers cry, "Abba, Father." They are not slaves to the world but children of their Father (Galatians 4:6, 7). While the Roman Empire was considered great, believers, by calling God "Abba Father," declare their citizenship in

heaven (Philippians 3:20). Blessed in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ (Ephesians 1:3), victorious believers are promised the right to sit with Christ on His throne (Revelation 3:21). Even as adopted sons, believers are co-heirs along with the Son of God. The act of adoption, as noted by J.J. Packer, is considered the greatest privilege through the Gospel. As examples, the narrative mentions Augustus Caesar, adopted by Julius Caesar's daughter-in-law, rising to become a famous Emperor. Moses, adopted by Pharaoh's daughter, rejected the privileges of the palace to suffer with his people and appeared as a shadow of Christ (Hebrews 11:25-26). The exhortation is to suffer with Christ to reign with Him (2 Timothy 2:12). The cautionary tales of Judas Iscariot and Esau serve as warnings not to lose the heavenly inheritance (Matthew 19:28, Hebrews 12:16, 1 Peter 1:5).

"We, chosen to be part of the royal priesthood, will not have an inheritance in this earthly land (Numbers 18:20) because we are set apart in this world. Our promised inheritance is confirmed in Jesus Christ. The Father sent His beloved Son into this world over 2000 years ago so that we can inherit this sonship. Let us live in Christ with Him and, during this Christmas season, proclaim to the world the good news that we are joint heirs with Jesus Christ."

A loving tribute to Dr Edward Raja ...a faithful disciple of Jesus



He was an epitome of zeal, compassion and commitment for God's mission and love for the people of our nation. He hailed from Elayirampennai, a small hamlet in Virudhunagar district, near Madurai, Tamil Nadu. Born in 1948 to a farmer and businessman family he was raised with strong Christian faith and Bible teachings. He did his Under-graduation (B.Sc.) from Coimbatore University and Post-graduation (M.Sc.) from Madurai University with distinction

in Agricultural Science. He earned his PhD in Agricultural at UAS. He worked as Principal Soil Scientist at Indian Institute of Horticultural Research, Bengaluru from 1976 to 2010. He mainly worked in soil science, developing two varieties of micronutrient fertilizers to treat deficient plants. He retired as the Head of Department of Soil Science. His contributions to Missions and the Nation are remarkable.

The encounter with God while attending a FMPB conference in 1983 changed his whole life demeanor and purpose. His perspective shifted from making money for his family to winning the perishing people for Jesus. His first step of involvement in FMPB as prayer group leader grew exponentially to even serving in the Executive Committees and also as the Vice-President of FMPB. He was one of the competent leaders who stood by the Biblical principles and Godly values in the governance and administration of FMPB. He was one of the Pioneers of FMPB Bangalore Professional's Forum ministries and by the dint of his hard and tireless work he mobilized resources for Agricultural and Animal husbandry projects. With God's grace and his technical knowledge, skills and expertise travelled extensively to introduce new farming technologies to the tribals and farmers across the country. He was a man of fervent prayer and was a great source of strength and comfort to many in need. His simple life of devotion and of discipline touched many in all spheres of influence.

He was indeed a warrior who fought a tough battle against Cancer and his days were filled with prayers, quiet moments, supplications, meditations and praise and worship as he transitioned to his heavenly home on October 25, 2023. During his memorial service on 9th November 2023 many testified that he was a true servant of God and a faithful disciple of Jesus. The influence and impact of the legacy of his faith in God, find expressions in the Church, Missions and Society. The hallmark of his simple life style, humility, sacrifice, obedience, passion and commitment as an able leader will be always remembered as ripple effects from generation to generation.

Through the life of Dr Edward Raja the Lord showed the insufficiency in our lives to serve HIM,

on the memorial service, many rededicated their life to His service in the legacy and foot prints of Dr Edward Raja.

We will miss him dearly... May the Lord's comforting presence engulf the bereaved family members in this great loss and grief. Urge your fervent prayers for his wife Mrs Ratnamala and two sons Mr Stephen Pradeep and Dr Simon Muthuraj families and grandchildren.

In remembering the manner of Dr Edward Raja's living and dying, a prayer written by **Theodore Parker Ferris** comes to mind...



**INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT ON FINANCIAL STATEMENTS**

To
The Members of
M/S. FRIENDS MISSIONARY PRAYER BAND

Report on the Financial Statements:

We have audited the Financial Statements of **M/S. FRIENDS MISSIONARY PRAYER BAND**, 29, High School Road, Ambattur, Chennai – 600 053 ("the Society"), which comprise of Balance Sheet as at 31st March 2023, the Income & Expenditure account and the Receipts and Payments account for the year ended 31st March 2023 and the notes to the financial statements consisting of summary of significant accounting policies.

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us,

Subject to our "Observations on Financial Systems and Statements" attached to this Report, these Financial Statements of accounts of **M/S. FRIENDS MISSIONARY PRAYER BAND** give a true and fair view of the financial position of the Society as at 31st March 2023 and of its financial performance for the year then ended in accordance with the Accounting Standards issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI).

Basis for Opinion:

We have conducted our audit in accordance with Standards on Auditing (SAs) issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the *Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statement* section of our report. We are independent of the "M/s. Friends Missionary Prayer Band, Chennai" in accordance with the Code of Ethics issued by the ICAI, and have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with the Code of Ethics. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

Responsibilities of Management and those charged with Governance for the Financial Statement:

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these financial statements that give a true and fair view of the state of affairs and results of operations in accordance with the accounting principles generally accepted in India. This responsibility includes the design, implementation and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and presentation of these Financial Statements that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.



In preparing the financial statements, management is responsible for assessing the entity's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless management either intends to liquidate the entity or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

Those charged with governance are responsible for overseeing the Organization's financial reporting process.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statement:

Our objectives are to:

1. Obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing (SAs) will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these financial statements.

As part of an audit in accordance with SAs, we exercise professional judgment and maintain professional scepticism throughout the audit: identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of these Financial Statements, whether due to fraud or error; design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks; and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.

2. Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control.
3. Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates, if any, and related disclosures made by management.
4. Evaluate the overall presentation, structure and content of these Financial Statements, including the disclosures, and whether these financial statements

Statements represent the underlying transactions and events in a manner that achieves fair presentation.

5. We have communicated with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identified during our audit.

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these Financial Statements based on our audit.
