

“Who am I to refuse God’s Purpose?”

God the Redeemer

Abraham Lincoln, the former president of the United States of America, saw a pig floundering in the mud on his way to Congress. He signaled the driver to stop the vehicle and saw if the driver could save the pig out of the gutter but in vain. Therefore he himself got into the rescue mission ignoring the expensive clothes that he was wearing. He got into the gutter and saved the pig out of the mess. In the same way our Lord we worship today is alive and He cares about us. **He sees**

FROM THE GENERAL SECRETARY...

Dear Partners in the mission of reaching the un-reached,

Many times, I have read Mark 10: 43, but when I read it yet again few days back, the Holy Spirit put the verse in a new light. The background of this verse started with the request of John and James to Jesus Christ that He had to do whatever they ask. They wanted the prime position among Jesus' disciples. As a reply to their request Jesus said in Mark 10:43, Not so with you. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be **your** servant. Jesus said that if you want to become great among a group of people, you must be **their** servant. It is not becoming servant to someone else or somewhere else but being a servant to the same people among whom the person wants to become great. Unless we emptied our pride, ego, positions etc. on the altar of the Lord completely, God may not fulfil His will in our lives.

Visit of Tamil Nadu Zonal missionaries, Evangelists, and churches:

Before Christmas, I visited Tamil Nadu zonal field missionaries and evangelists for four days for a time of fellowship. I shared the Word of God in three church Christmas programs. God blessed the visit.

Kodaikanal meeting: After Christmas, for two days I taught missiological insights to the missionaries of an indigenous Organization in Kodaikanal. The sessions were an enriching experience for me too along with the missionaries.

Punjab visit: From 4th January to 7th January, I visited the missionaries serving the Lord in the state of Punjab. SCAN meeting in Erode: Please pray for the SCAN meeting in Erode and other programs on 24th and 25th February.


CCC for Northern Zone missionaries:

Who Am I to refuse God's Purpose?

Introduction:

Often when God chooses us to do something great, our initial response will be to resist, pushing back against His plan. Resistance comes from our belief that we know the situation better than God does. We are happy to have God takes care of situations for us. We just do not want or hesitate to be His primary instrument. Moses was no exception. Moses received a direct call from the God of Abraham.

Background of Exodus 3:11:

The Israelites had been in Egypt for over 400 years, as God had told Abraham that would happen. However, God had promised Abraham that he would 'punish the nation' that mistreats his descendants, bring the fourth generation out of bondage and give them a land that was flowing with milk and honey (Genesis 15:13-16).

God had heard the cry of the Israelites and called Moses for the task. Moses clearly heard a voice from the burning bush calling out his name. Moses responded in a humble response "Here I Am" (Exodus 3:4-5). God told why Moses that He had seen the suffering of His people under the cruelty of the Egyptians and has heard their cries (Exodus 3:7). God called Moses to be the person He would work through to deliver His people from the bondage in Egypt (Exodus 3:10).

He did not doubt that his call was from the Most High God, because he heard it with his own ears. When God called Moses' name from the burning bush with a task for him, Moses answered God "Here I am" but whether out of apprehension, humility, fear or unwillingness, Moses questioned God "Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh, and bring the Israelites out of Egypt?" (Exodus 3:11) and he quickly added five excuses for not immediately doing as God asked.

1. Moses' first excuse was **I am Unworthy or I am not good enough** (Exodus 3:11). Moses said that he was not worthy of the great task to which God was calling him. He felt inadequate. By himself, he was inadequate, just as we are. God said in reply to Moses, "I will be with

you" (3:12). The deliverance of the people did not depend on the ability of Moses but on the presence, power and sufficiency of God.

2. Moses' second excuse was that **he did not have an answer concerning whose authority he had to be Israel's deliverer** (Exodus 3:13-22). God told Moses that He is Jehovah, the Self-Existent Creator, who is sending him to Egypt. The Infinite God of the universe would give him the authority to act in His Great Name: "I AM WHO I AM." Moses was to tell the Israelites in Egypt that God was going to deliver them from slavery and take them to the Promised Land that He had given to their ancestor Abraham.

3. Moses' third excuse to God (Exodus 4:1-9). He raised the possibility that none of the leaders in Israel would believe that God had sent him. God's response was through the ability to manifest three supernatural miracles, which would prove that God had sent him.

a. The first sign was of the rod turning into a serpent. In the very act of his picking up the serpent by the tail as God told, Moses was learning obedience to God's commands. Moses was learning that it was not going to be by Egyptian reasoning or logic that he would deliver Israel, but

it would have to be by God's Word and Spirit.

b. The second sign was of his hand becoming leprous.

c. The third sign was of the water turning to blood.

In each of these signs, a spiritual lesson is learned. These signs illustrated the conversion of the natural into the supernatural, and the normal into the miraculous. By these signs, God demonstrated to Moses the power by which he was to deliver the children of Israel. Moses was still belligerent and gave God another excuse.

4. Moses' fourth excuse (Exodus 4:10-12). Moses said that he was not an eloquent speaker and had problems in speaking. It is interesting to note that Acts 7:22 states that when Moses was in Egypt before his exile, he was "mighty in words." Moses either had lost his ability to speak or was just making another excuse. God answered Moses and told him that He would enable him to speak and teach him what to say.

5. Moses' fifth and final excuse. Moses simply told God that he was unqualified for the task and that He should get a better-qualified person to do it (Exodus 4:13-17). At this point, the Bible states that God got angry with Moses. God's answer was that He would allow his older brother,

Aaron, to assist him but that Moses would still be God's choice to be Israel's deliverer from slavery.

Application:

God ultimately had Redemption in His mind and wanted to redeem His people out of the slavery, for which God often chooses the most unlikely persons to fulfil His work and mission. Jonah, Gideon, David, Peter, you and me. He sees past the man or woman standing before Him and sees eternity. He doesn't see our ability (Skill, money, beauty...) but our availability for Him to fulfil His ultimate purpose for His glory.

Conclusion:

When God calls us to a task, don't we often ask the same question? "Who am I that you would send me?" We start listing our perceived failures and telling God all the reasons that He should choose someone else. We never pause to take the time to

look back in our lives on those very experiences that were "failures" to see how God might have been equipping us for just this moment.

If the God of the universe and the creator of the world who is omniscient (all-knowing) and omnipotent (all-powerful) is calling your name, then He certainly knows your failures, your strengths, your weaknesses... and they all are perfectly in line for the task to which He is calling you. In fact, those very experiences you are questioning – the ones you see as failures – are the ones God has been using you to equip you, prepare you, and train you for what He is now asking you to do. So change your question: "Who am I that you would send me?" to a statement: "Here I am Lord, send me!" If He is calling you, then you are the perfect person for the task.

Prayer - The secret weapon

At around 2:30 that morning, our missionary Alex and his family returned home in an Omni car after dedicating a Church built at a peint mission field in Moty Palsan village in Maharashtra state. The car they were traveling in stumbled to avoid a head-on collision with a speeding vehicle ahead in the hilly terrain but got to the right position within seconds. They reached their home at 4 O'clock that morning. Our Honorary Mobilization Secretary Mr. Sakthivel, is Alex's sponsor. At 2.30 am that night he was moved by the Lord to pray for the safety of his Missionary. When he contacted Alex, early that morning he praised God for the wonderful protection that God had bestowed.

On 19.10.2023 we left Chennai towards Maharashtra and landed in Jawahar Mission field. After

enjoying the missionaries' warm welcome, we went to Bedpa Children Home where the Varli People Group received us with their welcome dance. We participated in the half-day fasting prayer in Poshera Church and met the children in CDC. We heard the stories from the believers of the miracles that happened in their lives. Missionary Biography

Early Life

Mr. Mohan was born in a non-Christian family on the 15th of June 1988, in Namanddahalli, a small village in Dharmapuri district. His father Mr. Raman earned daily wages and somehow fed the family. His mother was Muniamma Lydia, a housewife. Even though they were very poor, his father decided to send him to the School. Mohan joined in the Panchapalli Government High School and he finished his 10thStd (SSLC) in 2004. However, the family's financial woes persisted. Though he joined the Government Polytechnic College in Krishnagiri in 2010, he left it within two months. As he had the passion for the higher studies, he tried his best, finally, by the grace of the Lord, he did his higher secondary privately and passed the examination with good marks in 2016.

Salvation Experience

Mohan's mother Muniamma Lydia became a Christian and attended a nearby Church. Mohan had an opportunity to read the Bible as he was encouraged by his mother. First, he did not understand anything mentioned in the Bible. Anyhow he continued reading it. There were many questions that troubled his mind. Why does God need to die? How can God die as a human? After reading the Bible regularly, the spirit of God led him to the truth. He totally

believed the work of Christ on the cross and accepted Jesus as his personal Saviour. He attended an Independent Church regularly and began to grow in the Lord.

Call to the Missionary work

One day when he was reading the bible passage John 12:25-26 “Anyone who loves their life will lose it, while anyone who hates their life in this world will keep it for eternal life. Whoever serves me must follow me; and where I am, my servant also will be. My Father will honor the one who serves me.” The spirit of God taught him the cost of discipleship and the need of serving the Supreme God. He was encouraged by the God's promise that **God the Father will honor the one who serves Him.** This passage motivated him to follow Jesus and to serve Him.

Mohan used to go to the Library and used to read many biographies, especially the biographies of missionaries. That prompted him to do something for the Lord. So, he joined the Gospel Group of his church and started to preach the Gospel to others along with his friends. He distributed tracts and thus earned little experience in the ministry. One day he got an opportunity to read 'Araikoaval' and the magazine attracted him and also challenged him to do the ministry to reach the unreached. He had a burden for the perishing soul and committed his life for full-time ministry. In 2015 he attended the training conducted by the SALT INSTITUTE, CHENNAI. This training also helped him to grow in the Lord and to do the ministry. So, he applied for the missionary work in FMPB. He was called to the interview in 2017 and was selected as a missionary candidate. He went to the National Institute of Missions, Jhansi, for one year training and completed his training in 2018.

Ministry in North India

After completing the training at NIM Jhansi, he was sent to Rajasthan Jeep Team. He did ministry along with other co-workers based at Tapukara field, Alwar, Rajasthan. He was a very calm and sincere worker. He maintained a good relationship with his fellow workers. And he worked in Tapukara field from June 2018 to Jan 2021. On 2019, September 27th Mohan got married to Miss. Archana at Royakottai, Krishnagiri district. Miss. Archana was born on 3rd December 1993 in a village called Madhepalli of Krishnagiri district. Her parents -father Mr. Muniappa and mother

Valliammal- accepted Christ through the ministry of FMPB. Her father died earlier, her mother Valliammal worked hard for the study of her daughter, with her little income. Archana finished her school and joined a college for her higher study. And she finished her B.com degree with good marks. She also pursued her computer course and waited for a job. When she was very young, she accepted Jesus Christ in one of the FMPB meetings. She involved herself in the ministry like Sunday school, VBS, Youth meetings and so on through the local Church of Pandikuri. She had a burden to reach the people around her, especially all those village people. During one of the FMPB meetings she committed her life to full time missionary work. The local FMPB worker Mr. Abraham Thimmappa also helped her to grow in the Lord and motivated her for the ministry. So, the Mohan family began their ministry from January 2021. God blessed their married life with a boy baby Jason Jenish. Jason was born on 29th August 2020.

Last Days

Mr. Mohan and his wife Archana started their new ministry among the Hindi speaking people in Kanpur area. They came to Uttar Pradesh and began their ministry based at Bhagya nagar of Kanpur region. Within three months, the Covid 19 pandemic spread to the region surrounding Kanpur. Many village people were affected and they did not have good hospital facilities. It was virulent and many died. In the due course Mr. Mohan was also infected with Covid. Within a short period, the infection was so high that it affected his

lungs. He was taken to the Star Hospital and all treatment was given to him, but nothing worked out in his favour. From the 1st of May onward he found it very difficult to breath and his oxygen level went down on 2nd May 2021. The doctors of Star Hospital advised the family to take him to Kanpur City. So, our missionaries took him to Narayana Medical College and Research Centre, Kanpur.

Before he was admitted and taken inside the hospital, he entered into glory leaving his young wife and eight month old baby boy. Our senior missionaries and the Presbyterian Church Pastor Xavier helped for the funeral service and his body was laid down in the Christian burial ground at Kanpur. Within a short span of life Mohan did what he could do for the Lord.

Jhansibai faced health challenges, yet she persevered until she victoriously completed her earthly journey on December 27, 2023, at the age of 79. TRAIL BLAZERS

Father Damien or St. Jozef Damien De Veuster of Molokai, or Saint Damien, was a Roman Catholic priest from Belgium. He was recognised for his ministry, which he led from 1873 until his death in 1889, in the Kingdom of Hawaii to people with leprosy (Hansen's disease) who lived in government-mandated medical quarantine in a settlement on the Kalaupapa Peninsula of Molokai.

Early Days:

Damien De Veuster was born in rural Belgium as the youngest of seven children to a Flemish corn merchant, Joannes Franciscus De Veuster and his wife Anne-Catherine Wouters on January 3, 1840. He was forced to quit school at age 13 to work on the family farm. He was educated at the college of Braine-le-Comte, and in 1858 he joined the Society of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary (Picpus Fathers) at Leuven, Belgium. in 1858, inspired by a mission given by the Redemptorists.

Religious Vocation:

Damien entered the novitiate of

the Fathers of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and Mary at Louvain and took part in religion. He was admitted to the religious profession on October 7, 1860. During his religious studies, Damien prayed daily with a missionary zeal to be sent on a mission. Three years later, Damien replaced his brother, Father Pamphile (Auguste), as he couldn't travel to Hawaii as a missionary because of illness. As we read about Damien, we can't stop realising how the hand of God was silently active in His life.

Life in Hawaii:

On March 19, 1864, Damien arrived at Honolulu Harbour in O'ahu. He was ordained into the priesthood on May 21, 1864. In 1865, Damien was

assigned to the Catholic Mission in North Kohala on the island of Hawaii. While he was serving in several parishes in O'ahu, the Kingdom of Hawaii was struggling with labour shortage and public health crisis. Many of the Native Hawaiian parishioners had high mortality rates due to infectious diseases such as leprosy, smallpox, cholera, influenza, syphilis, and whooping cough, brought to the Hawaiian Islands by foreign traders, sailors and immigrants. Thousands of Hawaiians died of such diseases, to which they had not acquired immunity. While Bishop Louis Désiré Maigret realised that this assignment had a high risk, he did not want to send any one person "in the name of obedience." After much prayer, four priests volunteered to go; among them on was Father Damien. The Bishop planned for the volunteers to take turns, assisting the inhabitants.

Ministry of Father Damien:

On May 10, 1873, the first volunteer, Father Damien, arrived at the isolated settlement at Kalaupapa, where there were then 600 lepers. Damien worked with them to build a Church and establish the Church of Saint Philomena. In addition to serving as a priest, he built reservoir, homes made furniture, coffins, and dug graves. Six months after he arrived at Kalawao, he wrote to his brother, Pamphile, in Europe: "I make myself a leper with the lepers

to gain all to Jesus Christ." During this time, Father Damien cared for the lepers and established leaders within the community to improve the quality of life. He ate food by hand with the lepers and lived with them as equals. Father Damien aided the colony by teaching, painting houses, organizing farms, and organizing the construction of roads, hospitals, and Churches. Father Damien also served as a priest during this time. Father Damien told the lepers that, despite what the outside world thought of them, they were always precious in the eyes of God. Some historians believed that Father Damien was a catalyst for a turning point in the community. Under his leadership, basic laws were enforced, shacks were upgraded and improved as painted houses, working farms were organized, and schools were established. At his request and of the lepers, Father Damien remained in Molokai.

Recognition of His Work:

King David Kalākaua bestowed on Damien the honor of "Knight Commander of the Royal Order of Kalākaua." Crown Princess Lydia Lili uokalani shared her experience, acclaiming Damien's efforts. Consequently, Damien became internationally known in the United States and Europe. American Protestants raised large sums of money for the missionary's work. The Church of England sent food, medicine, clothing, and supplies to the settlement. It is

believed that Damien never wore the royal medal, although it was placed by his side during his funeral.

Illnesses and Death:

Father Damien worked in Hawaii for 16 years, providing comfort to the lepers of Kalaupapa. In December 1884, while he was preparing to bathe, Damien inadvertently put his foot into steaming water, causing his skin to blister. He felt nothing and realized that he had contracted leprosy after working in the colony for 11 years. This was a common way for people to discover that they had been infected with leprosy. Despite his illness, Damien worked even harder. Even though the illness was slowing his body down, Damien engaged in a flurry of activities during his last years. With his remaining time, he

tried to advance and complete as many projects as possible. During his last stages, four volunteers came to help him in his everyday work and life. Conrardy took up Damien's pastoral duties. Cope organized a working hospital. Dutton attended to the construction and maintenance of the community's buildings. Sinnott nursed Damien during the last phases of his illness. With an arm in a sling, a foot in bandages, and his leg dragging, Damien knew that his death was near. He was bedridden on March 23, 1889. Damien died at the age of 49 on April 15, 1889, of leprosy at 8:00 a.m. Damien was laid to rest under the same Pandanus tree where he first slept upon his arrival on Moloka'i.

Kerju Church History

GENERAL

Kerju village is in Sitapur Taluk- Surguja district- Chhattisgarh.

As per the Population Census 2011, there are total 696 families residing in the village Kerju. The total population of Kerju is 3,372 out of which 1,677 are males and 1,695 are females thus the Average Sex Ratio of Kerju is 1,011. As per the Census 2011, the literacy rate of Kerju is 56.9%. As per constitution of India and Panchayati Raaj Act (Amendment 1998), Kerju village is administrated by Sarpanch (Head of Village) who is elected representative of the village. The Schedule Caste (SC) constitutes 5.4% while Schedule Tribe (ST) is 83.3% of total population in Kerju village. Kerju is a village situated in Sitapur tehsil of Surguja district in Chhattisgarh.

THE BEGINNING

FMPB began its ministry among the Oraon tribe in April 1993 in Ludeg mission field. The pioneers for the Oraon people group from FMPB are Rev. Karunakaran and Late David Daniel. In the year 2000, Ludeg field had 20 congregations. So Ludeg field was bifurcated into 4 fields: Ludeg, Pathalgaon, Sitapur and Bahicha. On March 1st 2005 Tapkara mission field was opened. The first missionaries to Tapkara field were Mr. Tenny Sing Tepp and Mr. Kokani Pravin Bhai. In June 2010, Mr. Kokani Pravin Bhai, his wife, Mrs. Kokani Paruben and their little son, Mast. Prince Kumar fell as a grain of wheat in the Tapkara soil. Only their daughter, Ms. Prashansa Kumari made good her escape.

The gospel was taken to Kerju village by the local FMPB evangelists Mr. Samuel Khalko and Mr. Ranjith. They took a room on rent in the Kerju village in the neighborhood of Mr. Bachan Lakada. The first believer of Kerju congregation is Mr. Bachan Lakada. He narrates how he accepted Christ in his own words.

"My wife, Subasu Kerketta was suffering from hip pain for several years. One night she went outside to relieve herself. When she tried to move to get back to the house, she realized that she was unable to stretch herself and get up. She started crying and called me for help. I heard her weeping and I lifted her back to the house. That whole night we did not sleep. Early in the next day morning I decided to call the evangelists, Samuel and Ranjith to pray for my wife. I felt that going to the hospital for treatment was only a waste of money. I approached the evangelists and brought them to my house. The evangelists prayed for my wife with much tears. When I saw the tears in their eyes, I was touched. I realized the love of Jesus through their tears. They prayed for my wife thrice and they asked me to apply prayer oil on her body. After that they asked my wife to get up and walk. Immediately she put her legs down and began to walk freely without any pain in her body. That same day I accepted Jesus Christ as the only true God "

The very first prayer meeting was conducted by Evangelist. Samuel Khalko at Bachan Lakada's house. Only five members of his family took part in the prayer meeting.

CHURCH GROWTH

As the prayer meetings continued in

Bachan Lakada's house, his neighbor, Jitender and Jeshwar also accepted Christ after a healing miracle and they too joined the worship services. Through many miracles, many people became Christians. From 2005 to Jan 2016, 18 families accepted Christ and took baptism. For 7 years the congregation gathered at the first believer, Bachan Lakada's house. From Feb 2007 the Sunday school was started in the Kerju Congregation. Every summer VBS programme was conducted for the children. The first fruit festival was also celebrated by the members of the church.

The first church elder (mandali pastor) who led the church was Suthan Tigga. He led the church vibrantly till 2009. After 2009 he joined FMPB as a local evangelist. After that, Jitender Toppo took the leadership. The Kerju church congregation grew in number through many healing miracles and power encounters.

IMPORTANT INCIDENTS IN THE HISTORY OF KERJU CHURCH

Shivnath Ekka from Kerju village was a great devotee of a god. He was very religious and he followed all the customs and rituals. In 2003 he was affected by paralysis. Both his hands and legs got bent inwardly. His family approached the magicians and he got well but not permanently. Whenever he toiled in his agricultural field his health was good. But later he was affected by paralysis. Again they had to call the magicians for his healing. Their earnings from the toilsome labour went in vain. This continued till 2015. In 2015, his wife approached the local evangelist, Mr. Noharsai Lakada. The evangelist prayed earnestly for Shivnath

Ekka. From July 2015 God completely healed him from paralysis. Even after accepting Christ, he fell sick. He was unable to eat anything or drink water but because of his steadfast faith in the Lord he got healed. Praise God.

Mr. Sukhrithi Toppo is from Kumunsia village. Before accepting Christ he was following the "Red flag" group. The guru of that group used to chant spells to stop the demonic atrocities in his house. After the guru died the satanic atrocities increased in his house. Suddenly many stones and sand used to fall from the roof top and terrible sounds were heard in his house. His house became haunted. For 4 years his family was living in fear. Helplessly he approached the local evangelist to be prayed for. The evangelist prayed for his house and within 4 days all the demonic activities ceased.

"My name is Hari Ekka. I was worshipping a goddess for 12 years. I had an idol of the goddess in my house and every day I worshipped it sincerely. Even after being very devoted to the goddess, I had no peace in my heart. I suffered from various ailments in my body. My daughter and son-in-law were believers. They were leading a happy and peaceful life. Their lifestyle

led me to accept Christ. My son-in-law, Gopal prayed for me and I was healed from my ailments and I was filled with the peace that passes all understanding. From then on I accepted Christ wholeheartedly. On 9.1.2016 I took baptism along with 5 members of my family".

THE CHURCH LAND

The Kerju congregation believers gathered for worship at the house of the first believer, Bachan Lakada for 7 years. Bachan Lakada voluntarily came forward and gave his land for building a church. The piece of land that he donated was adjacent to the road but when the village sarpanch opposed, he donated another piece of land that was little far away from the road.

MAJOR EVENTS OF CONSTRUCTION

The foundation of the church was laid in January 2011. A stay order was issued by the local authority. The panchayat president, Boktho Ekka hindered the church construction through the village registrar. But his evil plans were thwarted by God. Mr. Suthan gave 500 bricks freely. The members of the congregation worked for 50% wages. The church was dedicated on 1.1.2012. The size of the church is 40 X 30ft. The church's name is "Naya Jeevan Church".

OFFERINGS

The monthly offering ranges from Rs. 1000 to Rs. 2000. Kinds of offerings: First fruit offerings, thanksgiving offerings etc. The annual subscription for a family is Rs. 150. Suthan Tigga is working as an evangelist in Tapkara field. 25 to 30 people attend the worship meetings. Church elder leads the worship meetings.

In obedience to this, I planned to distribute during this Christmas season a 14-page evangelistic booklet in Hindi titled, 'Mol Unmol' in the towns of Madhepura, Supaul and Saharsa with the permission of the SDOs concerned. I was overcome with fear but God strengthened me through Jere 20:11. God enabled us to distribute a total of 21055 of these booklets. We started this distribution from the district court complexes in each of these districts. Apart from lawyers who gladly accepted these booklets, there were litigants from various villages who happily received these; some of them took extra copies for their neighbours. One of the lawyers seeing a person hesitant to take the booklet said to him, 'Take the booklet, go home and read it. There are words of wisdom and a lot of good teaching in it'. Pray that in the days to come we would be able to see people being led to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.
