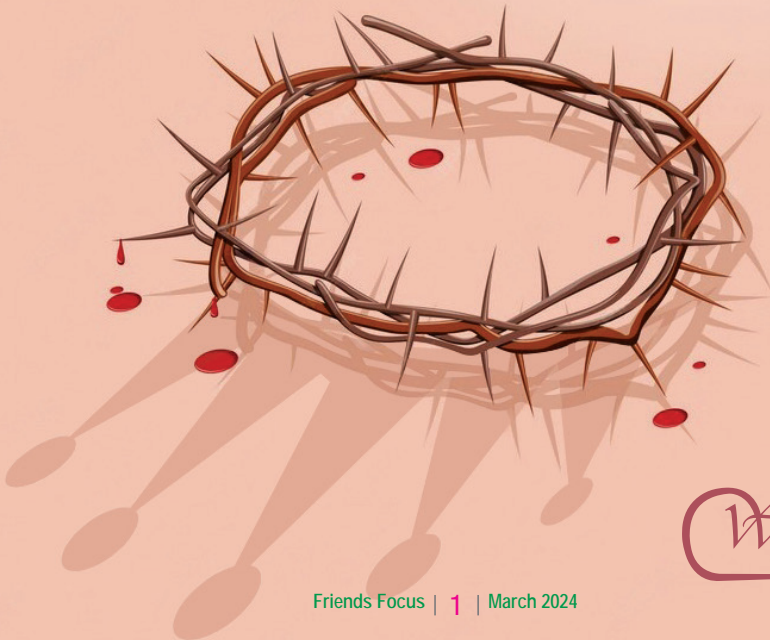

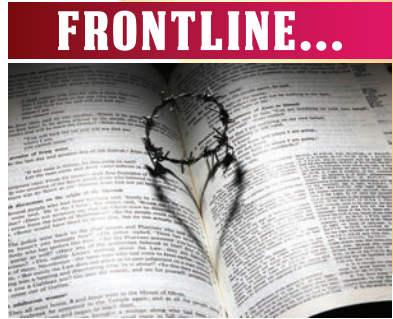

Who am I for this unmerited Love?

One of the deepest needs of our hearts is to be loved by others. Not only do we want to be loved, but we also desire that others make that love known to us. We seek a demonstration of their love, a tangible expression that lets us know they care. We long that others should act in our best interest and to surround us with understanding. Born in 1938 to parents deeply involved in witchcraft in Puerto Rico, Nicky Cruz suffered severe abuses from his 18 siblings, including being labeled the "Son of Satan" by his mother during a spiritual trance. At age 9, he attempted suicide. By 15, exiled to New York City, he joined the infamous Ma Mau gang, facing repeated arrests and a bleak future. However, the words of an evangelist named David Wilkerson among the gangsters, "Nicky, Jesus loves you," resonated with him, transforming his notorious life into one of evangelism for gangsters like himself in New York City. This world is in desperate need of love. Yet, the love offered by this world is conditional and temporary. Nevertheless, the Bible speaks of a love that is unconditional and eternal, as in Romans 5:8: "But God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." The verse begins with "But God," highlighting the contrast between our sinful state and God's redeeming love. It shows that despite our powerlessness, ungodliness, unrighteousness, and ingratitude, God chose to demonstrate His love for us. The verse continues, "demonstrates His own love for us," illustrating the ***love of a Potter for His pottery**. Instead of discarding us, God continues to work with us, reshaping and refining us into vessels of usefulness. It portrays the ***love of a Shepherd for His lost sheep**, as He seeks and saves the lost, providing protection and care. Like ***a gardener nurturing a barren tree**, God gives us another chance to bear fruit. This love was acted out to the extent of sacrificing His son for us that also while we were yet sinners. And if God did all this for us when we were still His enemies, how much more will He save us from the wrath to come now that we are his friends through Christ Jesus our Lord. Who are we for this unmerited love that He has lavished upon us. Christianity is a joyful way of living, because we have received forgiveness and reconciliation free of cost. We have been brought back into the relationship with our Great and Loving God. This Easter let's share this Love with those that long for this loving touch from a God who loves them.

From the General Secretary...

Dear Partners in the mission of reaching the unreached,

We give praises and glory to God to bring us into the third month of 2024. God might have taken us through various life situations for all of them we may not know the reasons or the result. Acts chapter 16:36 says "The jailer told Paul, "The magistrates have ordered that you and Silas be released. Now you can leave. Go in peace," and that points out that Paul and Silas were in the prison till even after the conversion of the Jailer. Then the question arises why did the earthquake take place and the jail doors were opened? In a deep study we can understand that the opening of the prison is not for making Paul and Silas to escape safely, but for the conversion of Roman jailer. Miracles in our lives are not always for the deliverance of us, but sometime for the deliverance of others like the Roman Jailer. God wants us to submit ourselves, so that He can use us for the blessing of someone else.

Seed Company visit: Seed Company used to help our Bible Translation Projects for some years before, and then the relationship was not continued as it was. Seed Company representative visited Headquarters and we discussed to resume our partnership.

Visiting leaders in Salem: I visited the mobilization leaders through three pocket meetings in different places of the town. I discussed the mobilization roadmap with the leaders and they accepted wholeheartedly.

The ordination service was a great blessing. The Delhi Diocese Bishop and our former Vice President Rt. Rev. Paul Swarup also was present in the service. We thank the dear Bishops for this great help to the ministry

Meeting with Bible Society of India: The Bible Society of India's Associate Director for Media and Special Audience and the Secretary for Tamil Nadu Auxiliary visited our office on 6th. And we discussed the possibilities to work in closer relationship in Translation and in scripture usage.

National Planning Conference 2024: The National Planning Conference 2024 was held in Gurukul, Chennai on 10th & 11th February. 259 leaders and secretaries participated in the meeting. 9th was observed as a 12 hours fasting and prayer day. The reporting time and the

Introduction:

A missionary family worked in a remote village where a dam was located. Once, the

missionary's wife and her three children went to the dam for a visit. People in the surrounding knew that the water in the dam was deep and it is dangerous to step into the water and there were many drowned deaths reported every year. The missionary family was not aware of that and one of the children entered into the current and was about to sink. Seeing the danger, mother risked her life by entering into the current and saved her child.

Love is not selfish. It seeks the welfare of others. Yes. Jesus Christ showed His love on the cross. Isaiah says, "surely he has borne our infirmities and carried our diseases; yet we accounted Him stricken, struck down by God, and afflicted. But He was wounded for our transgressions, crushed for our iniquities; upon Him was the punishment that made us whole, and by His bruises we are healed". (Isaiah 53: 4-5) God did not love us by looking at our perfection but He loved us when we were

unworthy, disgraceful, and in a pathetic condition. King David acknowledged it. He says God lifted me out of the slimy pit, out of the mud and mire; He set my feet on a rock and gave me a firm place to stand. Psalms 40: 2.

True love is selfless

Apostle John frequently points out God's love in his Gospel writings and in the epistles. He loved the Lord so much and it is believed that John was the one "who reclined upon the bosom of the Lord. He was the beloved disciple and was both a witness and a teacher. John uses the word love' 57 times in his Gospel which is comparatively more than the other gospel writers. In his first epistle he uses 56 times which indicates his focus on God's love. It could be the reason the Gospel of John changed the lives of many.

In John 15: 13 Apostle John speaks about Jesus' exhortation about love of a friend. True friends will demonstrate the love not only by words but also in action. King David puts God's love in the following verses. God does not deal with us as our sins deserve or repay us according to our iniquities. For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is His love for those who fear Him; Palm 103: 10 - 11. We are most privileged to be loved so much. When we grow in this love we will also reflect it in our daily life. Do we love others who offend us or ill-treat us? We are expected to love others without any reservation.

We see that David and Jonathan's love for each other was so deep and they were thick fiends until death departed each other. Saul tried to kill David, but Jonathan remained as a faithful friend to David and warned him of Saul's anger to kill him. When two of them met for the last time in the Wilderness of Ziph, they planned that David would be the next king of God's people Israel and Jonathan his minister (1 Samuel 23:16 -18). Jonathan was Prince yet he was not worried about his position. We read Jonathan presented gifts to his dear friend David (I Samuel 18: 4) and both made covenant with one another. David mourned when his friend was killed by the enemies in the battle field. (II Samuel 1: 11- 12)

True love accepts the sinner

God's love is so deep and wide to the level of forgiving the traitor or accepting a criminal who was condemned by the society to be crucified. This love accepts the repented sinner into the family of God. God the Father's love is portrayed in the prodigal son story. The father waited for his son to come back to him although he wasted the wealth and brought defamation to his father. The Father ran to the street to welcome the son who lived a pitiable life and not deserved the right to be called his son. Father initiated the home calling and celebration of the sinner. I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent. (Luke 15: 7). When we go

to Eucharist table we understand that God accept the home coming of repented sinner into his family. No one has ever explained the love of God than St. John in his Gospel. For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life'. (John 3: 16). Pharisees were jealous of Jesus Christ because He accepted the sinners whereas the so called religious people were not doing it. They had "I am holier than you" attitude which made them to feel proud about their religious practice such as observing fasting prayers, rituals, offering tithes, and careful in following religious laws.

Martin Luther coined the term 'grace alone'. We do not earn salvation experience through our efforts and practice but we become holy by the grace of God only. For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God not by works, so that no one can boast. (Galatians 2: 8 - 9)

Jesus Christ just did not end up teaching the crowd to show love of God, but He Himself was a role model to His follower. We too talk so much about God's love and often find it difficult to forgive others and unwilling to accept them as they are. We set norms for someone to be loved. Jesus Christ could forgive Peter, thief and all that have crucified Him. As we spend hours in penitence during these Lenten days we must decide and practice to love one

another and accept one another throughout our lives. This is how we know who the children of God are and who the children of the devil are: Anyone who does not do what is right is not God's child, nor is anyone who does not love their brother and sister. (I John 3:11)

True love gives one's own life

Few years back I read in the newspaper that a son and his father were crossing the railway track. Father was old and had lost his hearing. Therefore he moved to the track without noticing the fast approaching train. His son ran and pushed his father from the track. Father was safe but his son fell on the track and was run over by the speeding train and died. If human beings are so affectionate towards the others, how much God's love would be?

In the recent days we hear that believers are driven away from their home and beaten by the persecutors for their faith. The love of God makes them to stand firm in their faith despite severe threatening from every corner. The amount of sacrifice Jesus Christ made for us is nothing comparable to the sufferings we endure. Also Bible teaches us to endure suffering and prove our love for God.

Jesus said, "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. (John 10:11). Usually shepherds use the sheep for its wool, meat, milk etc. On the contrary Jesus Christ teaches that He loves the sheep and therefore He will lay down

His own life for the sheep. The life span of sheep is ten to twelve years. God is eternal and human beings are mortal. God's love is amazing that He gave Himself to save the perishing lives of human. Apostle John reminds us that "Jesus died for our sins and that God loved us so much that He sent Christ for us. God sent His only begotten son to save us through a cruel death on the cross" (1 John 4:10). Holy God had to take the punishment of us on Himself otherwise salvation would not be possible for us. We often forget His costly gift and end up in forgetting the loving sacrifice of God's son.

Conclusion:

How do we show our love to this world which is longing for someone to be loved by others? Martin Luther King Junior

said, "Love is the only force capable of transforming an enemy into a friend." As Christians we need to understand who I am to be loved so much? We are expected to show our love to others as Jesus Christ did. Jesus Christ literally cried for His people who rejected Him. **The Words of Jesus:** "Jerusalem, Jerusalem . . . how often have I desired to gather your children together as a mother hen gathers her brood under her wings." (Matt. 23:37)

In Isaiah 49:15, God says, "'Can a woman forget her nursing child, or show no compassion for the child of her womb? . . . so I will not forget you,' says the Lord." Let us remain loyal to the sacrificial love of God.

NATIONAL PLANNING CONFERENCE



The National Planning Conference of Friends Missionary Prayer Band for the year 2024 was held at Gurukul Theological Seminary - Auditorium, Chennai, on the 10th and 11th of February. The theme of the conference was “Who Am I?” (2 Samuel 7:18). The invitees, including full-time missionaries, honorary staff, prayer group members, and leaders totalling 259 persons from across the nation, participated in the Planning Conference.

Prior to the Planning Conference, on February 9th, 2024, a twelve-hour Fasting prayer was conducted from 7 am to 7 pm. Almost 150 persons joined together and prayed for various concerns of our ministry, nation, and the blessings of the Planning

Conference 2024. Rev. Kalanchiyam, shared the Word of God. The Divisional and Zonal Secretaries of FMPB brought prayer concerns that illustrated the wonderful deeds of God in the mission fields amidst many challenges and oppositions.

In the Planning Conference - our missionary kids, under the leadership of Mr. Immanuel, the Honorary Secretary - Youth Wing, Chennai, commenced the opening session with lively songs in English, Hindi, and Tamil. Mr. C. Reginald, the President of FMPB, presided over the conference with a keynote address. Mr. J.S.A. Julius, a retired Deputy Commissioner - Customs, the former Chairman of UESI, delivered the Word of God based on the theme (2 Samuel 7:18), drawing from his experience, which enabled the participants to vividly

understand the theme. The General Secretary and the Treasurer presented their ministerial report to the forum following which the Divisional Heads presented their reports with required explanations that enabled the participants to praise God. The participants were divided into ten groups and engaged in a brainstorming session on the given ten questions.

The second day of the conference commenced with a Holy Communion Service overseen by Rev. Robinson Hasdak, the Secretary of Mobilization Ministry - North & North East India. Following this, Brother J.S.A. Julius delivered a message rooted in the scripture passage Luke 24:13-35, focusing on the Emmaus experience. This sharing from the Word of God served to fortify and revitalize the faith of all the participants, enriching their spiritual journey throughout the conference. Following that, the teaser of Malto tele film and 2 training books for our local evangelists and Church elders were dedicated for the glory of God. Then the leaders of all ten groups presented their insights and expectations based on their group discussions. The thrust of the year was projected by the General Secretary, Rev. John Berlin, which led the participants to sharpen and focus their thinking and actions on the theme very clearly.

The Prayer of Commitment, led by Mr. James Dharmabalan, the vice-President of FMPB, emphasized participants' roles in advancing the movement, followed by closing remarks from the President Mr. C. Reginald. The conference was concluded with a vote of thanks by Rev. Dr. J.J. Harris, the Secretary - HQ., following which the final prayer, and benediction was given by the General Secretary

Bro. G. Kumar, born on 17.07.1978, in Kanyakumari to parents Mr. Gopal and Mrs. Lalitha, was a devout follower of Hinduism from his childhood. Despite participating in religious rituals, a profound realization led him to accept Jesus Christ as the living God for eternal life. His sister, a believer in Jesus, played a role in introducing him to church services. With a burning desire to share the love of Christ, Bro. G. Kumar became a volunteer in the Gospel Ratham team from 2004 to 2008. Subsequently, he joined FMPB as a missionary, undergoing training at UP Jhansi NIM for a year. In 2010, he married Ms. Savithri, and together

they served among the Maltos in the mission field of Kairajodi, Jharkhand. Concerned for the welfare of children in the region, he faced numerous challenges to establish a Day Care Children Centre in the village of Kolikoda. The center aimed to provide education and proper nutrition to the underprivileged children. Concurrently, as the Gospel Ratham ministry gained momentum, Bro. G. Kumar translated scripts into Hindi, actively engaging in presenting the Gospel in the heart language of the people. This effort reached approximately 25,000 individuals in Uttar Pradesh, as the program was broadcast continuously for 45 days. In 2015, due to health issues, Bro. G. Kumar was relocated to South India, with his base in Sulerpettai, near the Andhra border. While undergoing treatment in Chennai, he remained actively involved in the Gospel Ratham ministry. On 17.01.2024, he answered the divine call to enter into eternal life. Bro. G. Kumar was known for his calmness, patience, and unwavering commitment to strict discipline and perfection in all endeavors. Let us extend our heartfelt condolences to his wife Savithri and their children Abisekh and Aanika, who are currently studying in the 4th standard at Dohnavur Santhosa Vidhyalaya.

A team of 12 members including the Honorary Mobilization Secretary, prayer group leaders and supporting members started in order to visit Gujarat mission Fields on 19.10.2023. On the second day we prayed for the children in Randha Home and for all the 16 children who had committed for

full time ministry and for the Varli people groups. The next day we worshipped the Lord in Kavcha village Church of Silvassa mission field and also in the Baptism service. In the evening we joined in the dedication service of Simion Church in Dishti village. With much burden we interceded for the ministries in Madhuban mission field. We were also burdened to pray daily for the evil works of Satan- eg. the clothing of women kept in a certain place gets lost and found in another place after a few days, etc., On the final day we visited the Andharpada mission field and prayed for them. We proceeded to Surat and from there we returned to our places on 26.10.2023.

TRAIL BLAZERS

Joanne Shetler served among the Balangao people in the Philippines for over 20 years. She translated the New Testament into the people's native language, persevered in the face of personal danger, and overcame evil spirits by God's power.

Early Life and Call to Missions

Joanne Shelter born in California in 1936, growing up on a farm in rural America, she never dreamed of serving as a missionary, instead she wanted to be a nurse, and have a house full of happy people. At the age of 11, Joanne accepted Christ as her Saviour at a Bible club meeting.

One Sunday morning a visiting missionary in her congregation said that, only 10 percent of Christian workers were serving the other 90% of people who had never heard about Jesus. Joanne felt a definite call to missions, but she wasn't ready to give up her dream. She wrestled with God, but surrendered her future to His will and was willing to go anywhere. After completing her high school, Joanne chose to take a linguistics subject in Biola University and soon became very interested in Bible translation.

Ministry in the Philippines

After graduating from Biola University, God led Joanne to begin work with a partner Anne Fetzer, in a remote area called Balangao of the northern Philippines. It was 1962 when they arrived in Balangao, the people who

had never heard the Good News also were in need of linguistics expert to come and write down their language. In addition to linguistic work, the missionaries were also translating the New Testament and provided medical help for the locals. However, Joanne and Anne were in major culture shock. The people of Balangao were headhunters and they still fought violent tribal wars where many were killed.

The Lord had sent them to do more than just translate the Bible. The mortality rate in childbirth was very high. She was able to help many women in childbirth. The people were under serious oppression by evil spirits and did many sacrifices to pacify them. Because of their ministry, they often encountered spiritual resistance and attack. However, they overcame the evil spirits by the power of God and prayer. When the people realized that the God of the missionaries was stronger than the evil spirits, they began to seek God, and Joanne's Bible study group grew from 60 people to over 200 people.

In 1982 Joanne was able to finish translating the New Testament into the people's language. As a result, local churches were established, and she had the joy of seeing a few thousand people come to Christ. The Bible was taught in public schools, youth camps, and Bible conferences. Bible-preaching churches had sprung up in every village in the Balangao Valley. The Balangao people have begun outreach work in neighboring regions, and have even sent out a few missionaries to other parts of Asia.

In 1982 she returned to the US for furlough and speaking tours. Visiting the JAARS Center in North Carolina, she realized that it was a place where she could care for her mother in her last days of her widowhood and yet complete her Balangao work. JAARS is able to transport Bibles, medical supplies, mail and food to the missionaries in most remote locations.

Joanne began translating the Old Testament by 2006 and returned to Balangao in 2010. JAARS provided her with two-way single sideband radio communication, and the generator to run it. But JAARS realized that their most valuable resource for serving the people, saving time and energy would be air transportation. When they finally found a relatively flat spot, Balangao men hammered away at massive boulders, built drainage ditches for two natural springs and built an 11-meter extension on flat spot. A year later that giant eagle-in-the-sky (airplane) landed in Balangao!

The whole world of Balangao had waited breathlessly for the coming of an airplane—that “magic” from another world. A new church was born in Balangao.

JAARS had the technological support that would help her continue working on the Old Testament and remotely carry out field responsibilities. The Vernacular Media department could convert the Balangao text to audio and make video presentations.

Present Ministry

In her late 50s, Joanne did her Master's degree in intercultural studies. After graduation, she began to train church leaders and share her burden for unreached people groups. She received the 'Clyde Cook Missions Award' from Biola University in 2016. Today, she is based in North Carolina and travels around the world for speaking engagements. She had the joy of sharing from her years of experience with future translation workers when they come to JAARS for cultural training.

Joanne told Decision Magazine in 2006, The Balangaos are just one example of how the power of God's Word in a people's heart language can change them forever. We have God's Word in our own language but many have never heard the Gospel in their own language. The question is, what does God want us to do about it? Perhaps He wants us to go or to give to this work. He certainly wants us to pray! “The harvest is plentiful, but the labourers are few”. Matthew 9:37

Joanne Shetler wrote in her book, AND THE WORD CAME WITH POWER as follows:

“I've never quite figured out how to bring God the glory. But I have learned to surrender my dreams to Him. And He has made the reality of living according to His plan even better than my greatest dreams.”

CHURCH DEDICATION – Nurol

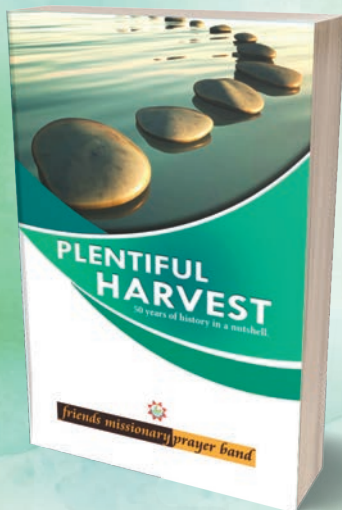
