

A stone for every Goliath!

Derek Raymond, a retired British sprinter, was born on September 4, 1965. He won gold medals in the 400m and set records in the 4x400m relay. At the 1992 Olympics in Barcelona, tragedy struck when his hamstring tore with 250 meters to go in the 400m semi-final, causing him to fall to the ground in

excruciating pain. However, despite the agony, he resolved to finish the race. As he struggled to limp across the track, his father, Mr. Jim Raymond, rushed to his aid, crossing over the obstacles and supporting him as they crossed the finish line together. Moved by this display of paternal love and determination, the 65,000 spectators in the stadium rose to their feet, offering a standing ovation to the duo. This poignant moment serves as a powerful metaphor for the unwavering support and intervention of our Heavenly Father in our lives. Isaiah 64:4 reminds us of the incomparable nature of God's actions on behalf of those who trust in Him. Just as a loving father acts decisively for his child, God works tirelessly for those who wait upon Him. The struggles we face may seem overwhelming, similar to the giant Goliath, yet God has already prepared a solution for every challenge we encounter. The story of David and Goliath in 1 Samuel 17 illustrates that victory does not come through David's stone alone but through the power of God. Similarly, the deliverance of the Israelites from Egypt, as recounted in Exodus 2:23-25, demonstrates God's attentiveness to the cries of His people and His faithfulness to His promises. In times of trial, such as the fiery furnace faced by Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego in Daniel 3:25. God stands alongside His children, providing protection and deliverance. As we face the challenges of our nation, ministry, and personal lives, we can take solace in the assurance of God's presence and provision. Luke 18:7 assures us that God will bring about justice for His chosen ones. Like the earthly father who supported his son in completing the race, our Heavenly Father is with us every step of the way, guiding, comforting, and empowering us to overcome obstacles and fulfill our calling in ministry, family life, and society!

By the immense grace of God, we have entered into a new financial year. The faithfulness of God in providing and protecting our ministries in the past financial year encourages us to face the new financial year with confident and trust on God. What is stored for us in this new financial year is not known to us, but since we lean on God, we need not know it. God will lead us according to His will for the fulfilment of the vision given to FMPB.

Philip the Evangelist was chosen among the seven to serve the tables in Acts chapter 6:5 and later scattered from Jerusalem due to the persecution in the aftermath of the martyrdom of Philip's colleague Stephen. Philip was used mightily by God in a city in Samaria to the extent that his powerful message and miracles brought great joy in that city (Acts 8:8).

In the midst of a successful ministry God commanded Philip a task which didn't give him any clarity or purpose initially. Acts 8:26 says, "Now an angel of the Lord said to Philip, 'Go south to the road--the desert road--that goes down from Jerusalem to Gaza." Though God moved Philip from an amazing ministry without giving him any specific task, except asking him to go to a road. But end of that task awaited the conversion of a great man from Ethiopia. God expects that kind of obedience from us for the salvation of this nation.

Arrest of our Missionary Mr. Thangchin Lian

On 11th March our missionaries Mr. Thangchin Lian and his wife Mrs. Vungthianching went to pray in a believer's house in Chhattisgarh on their request. While they were praying a mob gathered and manhandled our missionary and the believer. Later the police took them into custody but released Mrs. Lian on that night itself. FIR was registered on Mr. Thangchin Lian. Our secretaries made the efforts with prayer and local people. God helped them to obtain bail and missionary was released within a day on bail by the Session Court. Praise God for God's act of deliverance.

North Eastern Zone New Jeep

A new jeep was bought and dedicated for the Santal Gospel Ratham ministry in Jharkhand. This vehicle was donated by our sponsor family in Erode. May the Lord bless the donor family.

Chengalpet Meetings

On 18th March, God helped me to speak in three meetings in Vallam area of Chengalpet. I thank the leaders of that area for their committed ministry.

Erode District Meetings

number of unreached people. I believe your



In the last part of David's life, he remembered God's love, guidance, and promises, and he pondered, "Who am I and my family, that you have brought me this far and given me a promise to build a house for me?" At the start of David's career, he asked his brother, "Is there no cause for my arrival?".

David's battle with Goliath: According to God's guidance, Samuel anointed David as God's chosen vessel. 1 Samuel 17 describes the war between the Israelites and the Philistines. The Israelite army feared the Philistine army. For almost 40 days, he alone came before the Israelite army and challenged them, saying, "this day I defy the ranks of Israel! Give me a man and let



us fight each other." Upon hearing this, Saul and all the Israelites were dismayed and greatly afraid till a young boy David came along. David came to deliver supplies to his brothers. When he heard Goliath's shouts in the battle ground, he was surprised to see soldiers fleeing in terror. When it became clear that everyone was too afraid to fight, David volunteered to face Goliath and won the battle with God's help. In our lives too, we face "Goliaths". The Goliaths we face can be any number of trials, challenges, and temptations. Here are some truths David knew that helped him defeat his Goliath, and they can help us defeat ours too.

There are three reasons why David fought with Goliath:

1. Spiritual Reasons

It's essential to first recognize that the spiritual aspect played a significant role in his decision. David was a man of faith. It wasn't just a part of his life; it was his life. It underpinned his worldview and influenced his actions.

His Faith in God (1 Samuel 17:37): The first and foremost reason is David's profound faith in God. When David presented himself before King Saul and volunteered to fight Goliath, he confidently stated, "The Lord who delivered me from the paw of the lion and the bear, will deliver me from the hand of this Philistine". David didn't see a terrifying giant; he saw a challenge that he knew his God could overcome. As a shepherd, David had faced bears and lions to protect his flock. In these encounters, he believed that it was God who had delivered him from danger. So, when faced with Goliath, David saw not a giant, but another threat that he could overcome with

God's help. How often do we see our giants/ threats through the lens of faith?

To Prove God's Power 1 Samuel 17:47: David fought Goliath to prove God's power. He sought to show that God's might far surpassed the strength of any human or idol. You might recall David's resounding declaration to Goliath: "All those gathered here will know that it is not by sword or spear that the LORD saves; for the battle is the LORD's, and he will give all of you into our hands" Battle with Goliath, David aimed to exhibit God's supreme power, proving that the God of Israel was mightier than the gods of the Philistines

To Defend God's Name 1 Samuel 17:26: David's fight with Goliath was a deeply spiritual motivator that resonated to the core of David's being. When he heard Goliath's scornful words against the God of Israel, David bristled with righteous indignation. Who was this Philistine, after all, who dared to defy the living God? Remember. David asked those around him. "Who is this uncircumcised Philistine that he should defy the armies of the living God?". So, when David took that step forward to confront Goliath, it was about more than defending his people. It was about upholding the honor of his God. The story of David and Goliath challenges us to take a stand for our faith. just as David did, and encourages us not to hide or remain calm in the face of anything that blasphemes the name of our God, wherever it may occur.

2. Personal Reasons Why David Fought Goliath

While David's spiritual motivations were the bedrock of his decision, there were also

personal factors at play. It was not just about David the believer but also about David the man — his courage, honor, and confidence. We'll find elements of his story that resonate with our own personal experiences.

Courage and Bravery: Imagine the courage it took for a young shepherd, with no formal military training, to stand up against a seasoned warrior twice his size. David's bravery was not rash or unthinking. It was a courage born out of faith, past experiences, and a strong sense of personal integrity.

Personal Honor (1 Samuel 17:28-29): When his eldest brother Eliab accused him David retorted, "Now what have I done? Can't I even speak?" (Is there no cause for my arrival?) Moreover, when David heard Goliath's defiant words, he asked the men standing near him, "What will be done for the man who kills this Philistine and removes this disgrace from Israel? Who is this uncircumcised that he should defy the armies of the living God?" (1 Samuel 17:26). David was incensed not only at the affront to Israel but also at the personal dishonor of God's army being defied. In standing against Goliath, David was also standing up for his personal honor. affirming his faith, and defending the honor of his people and his God.

Confidence in His Skills: As a shepherd, David had defended his flock against lions and bears using his trusty sling. His choice of weapon against Goliath? The same sling. David knew his strengths and how to use them effectively. This confidence in his skills was a significant factor in his decision to face Goliath. Each of these personal reasons contributed to David's decision to fight Goliath.

3. Social Reasons Why David Fought Goliath

As spiritual and personal reasons motivated David to fight Goliath, there were also social reasons at play.

Defence of His People 1 Samuel 17:32 The Philistine giant was not just mocking the armies of Israel but also threatening their freedom. David took it upon himself to protect his people, demonstrating a deep sense of responsibility. This was not just about personal courage or divine purpose; it was about safeguarding the dignity and welfare of his people.

Leadership Assertion: David was not yet king when he chose to fight Goliath, but he was already demonstrating qualities of a leader. By standing up when no one else would, he showed decisiveness, courage, and a willingness to put the needs of the many above his own. This act could be seen as the first public demonstration of the kind of leader he would become.


To Inspire Hope: At a time when morale was low, David's act of bravery sparked a glimmer of hope. And when he triumphed against Goliath, that hope was ignited into a burning fire. This hope was more than a fleeting emotion; it led to tangible action. David's act of bravery and his subsequent victory didn't just inspire; it ignited a newfound courage among the Israelites. 1 Samuel 17:52 tells us the fruits of this inspiration, "And the men of Israel and Judah rose with a shout and pursued the Philistines...so that the wounded Philistines

fell on the way..." David's courage was contagious, emboldening the Israelite army to pursue their fleeing enemies. This incident wasn't just about a single victory. It was a turning point that rekindled the morale and fighting spirit of an entire nation. His courage didn't just defeat a giant; it breathed life into the hope of a nation, inspiring them to take decisive action for their freedom, their dignity, and their hope.

Conclusion:

God has called us to live as good Christians, helping, modelling and encouraging others to live for God in the midst of trials in davto-day life. As we saw in David's life, his spiritual, personal, and social motivations influenced the Israelites' lives in the midst of battle: it teaches us about our responsibilities toward God's will and His people in the midst of trials like Goliath in the day-to-day life. By studying David's motivations, we've seen how faith, personal convictions, and societal responsibilities can inspire courage in the face of daunting challenges. FMPB sent number of missionaries to remote parts of India to do God's will, as a result many people group redeemed from the hand of Goliaths but it's not enough, till today India is facing number of Goliaths, Is there no excuse for my arrival?(chosen). As we face our own "Goliaths," may we draw inspiration from David - his faith, courage, and sense of responsibility. For each "Goliath" we face and overcome, may it strengthen us and give us the confidence to face the next.

Due to her husband's job transfer to Ayanavaram, Mrs. Esther became acquainted with the Friends Missionary Prayer Band. She volunteered her services, specializing in cooking at the quest house. Her love for missionaries in the field, mobilization, and headquarters was evident through her exemplary culinary skills. Regardless of status, she treated everyone with equal respect. In 1992, recognizing her outstanding qualities such as commitment, hard work, punctuality, accountability, stewardship, and hospitality to bachelor missionaries, the organization elevated her to a full-time worker. Even after her retirement in 2002. Mrs. Esther continued to willingly cook and serve whenever needed. Despite her own weaknesses, she remained engaged in the ministries and health of the missionaries. She possessed clear vision and maintained stability in her quick walk until her last days. On October 23rd, she suffered a fall in her house, breaking her hip, leading to several months of bedridden life. On January 29th, in the afternoon, she peacefully breathed her last and entered into glory. Her mortal remains were laid to rest on January 30th in the Kilpauk cemetery at 2 pm. Missionary Biography

Early Life

Rev. Philip Asirvatham was born on 19th March 1949 in a Christian family from Sivagiri of Tenkasi district. His father Mr. Devadoss was an assistant in a hospital and his mother Mrs. Packiam was a homemaker. God blessed this family with six children. Philip Asirvatham had two elder sisters and two younger brothers. As his father was the only breadwinner of the family, the family lived in dire need of the basic things. But they believed and trusted Jesus Christ and He met all the needs of the family. Along with the other children, Rev. Philip Asirvatham studied in the local Government School, He finished his High School Final (Old SSLC) that is, 11th standard and was waiting to join the Pre-University Course in the college. But the economic condition of his family did not allow him to join a college. Instead he joined an Industrial Training Institute at Coimbatore. By the grace of the Lord he finished the course successfully and found employment at Coimbatore itself.

Born Again Experience

After leaving the job and out of sheer helplessness, he started his own cycle repairing and rental shop at Sivagiri, his native place. He also sought the Lord wholeheartedly and attended the local Church Service regularly. The local pastor noted his interest and sincerity and wanted to help him. Rev. Edwin led Mr. Philip Asirvatham into the

fold of the Lord. He confessed his sins and accepted Jesus as his personal saviour and got the assurance of his salvation. He started accompanying the local Church Pastor to the villages to do evangelistic ministries. He was so helpful to the pastor that he received training to preach the Word of God in the village Churches.

Marriage

Miss. Gnanam was the daughter of Mr. Simon Devadoss and Mrs. Silammal of Sankarankoil town of Tenkasi district. He got married to Miss. Gnanam at Sivagiri on the 22nd of August 1975. On the 30th of September 1977, God blessed this couple with a boy child named Sam Renold.

Missionary call and Ministry

Even after the marriage, Philip Asirvatham continued to assist the local Pastor Rev.

Edwin in his Church ministries. The pastor encouraged Mr. Philip Asirvatham to undergo theological training and helped them to get a seat in the Bethel Bible Institute, Danishpet, Salem in 1979. During that period, Friends Missionary Prayer Band was regularly training missionary candidates at BBI. Every Wednesday they prayed for the Church Planting ministry in North India. Rev. Dr. Samuel Devadasan also shared with them often about the FMPB ministry in North India and its need. God spoke to Mr. Phillip Asirvatham about his responsibility for the perishing souls of North India. Mrs. and Mr. Asirvatham, in their personal and family prayers, sought the Lord's guidance and assurance for their future ministry. So. they approached Rev. Dr. Devadasan and expressed their interest to go as missionaries to North India. Thus, they joined FMPB in 1979 itself after the interview.

The pressing financial need of their family compelled him to go to the Middle East for a job. In the meantime, the calling of the Lord to North India missionary work pulled his heart towards that. So, he suffered for a while between these two conflicting pulls and found it difficult to take a stand. God reminded this couple of a verse from the Bible in Luke 9:62, Jesus replied, "No one who puts a hand to the plow and looks back is fit for service in the kingdom of God." So, they prayerfully decided to go as missionaries, but their families were very upset and not happy about their decision.

Church Planting Ministry

After the training at BBI, Mrs. and Mr. Philip Asirvatham were sent to the Periamalai field, which was the first FMPB mission field in the 1980s. Later, they started their new ministry

based at Iruthukottai. They preached the Gospel to the people around Iruthukottai for two years. Thus, they learned the art of Church Planting ministry. Later this couple were sent to Pokarayan mission field in the state of Uttar Pradesh in 1982. They learned the Hindi language and started the ministry in that area. Then they shifted their base to Datia in the state of Madhya Pradesh. And also they did ministry in and around Tikamgarh and Jhansi.

Sickness

In 1986, Mr. Philip Asirvatham was affected by the contagious disease Tuberculosis (TB) which was prevalent in that area. So, they came down to Chennai and stayed at FMPB HQ. He underwent treatment for TB. In 1987, they were sent to Uttar Pradesh again. As a family, they did the ministry in Pokarayan, Konch, Rura, preaching the Gospel village after village. God blessed their ministry. Then, he was placed in NSM Children Home at Jhansi for a year. Again, they did the ministry among the Hindi speaking people of Oraiya and Ittawa

Higher Studies

In the year 1991, FMPB decided to send this couple for their Theological Higher Studies. So, they joined the YCLT College at Yavatmal, Maharashtra. After completing their two year studies, they were posted in FES School Hostel, Chennai, to take care of the missionary kids and to do the ministry among the people living in slums. Again, they were placed in the Chennai Promotional ministry for two years from 1996 to 1998. In 1998, they were transferred to Delhi to work among the slum dwellers. Meanwhile, in Punjab, FMPB started a Leadership Training Institute in Ambala, to train Church elders and

Local Evangelists. So, they moved to Ambala and conducted the training programme for the Church elders and Evangelists. Then they shifted the training centre to Sikar and continued the ministry. God helped them to plant a few Churches in that area and to train many elders and Local Evangelists during Leadership Training Programme.


Last Days

Rev. Philip Asirvatham had the base at Sikar and conducted the training programmes. It was very hard to bring all the Church elders to one place and conduct the training. Instead, he went to their place and conducted the training for the Church elders. He arranged a two day training programme at Kalavalli of Haryana on the 3rd and the 4th of September 2008. God blessed the first day of the training in which many attended. On 4th September, when he was preparing for the training programme, a terrible pain pierced his chest. Around morning 8.30 he was taken to the Sirsa hospital for treatment. Emergency treatment was given as there was no medical

facility in that hospital. He was shifted to Bathinda city hospital. During the diagnosis, the doctors found blocks in the blood vessels leading to the heart. So, the doctors decided to do the angioplasty immediately. After the angioplasty was done, he felt a little better. Then, he developed some breathing problems. So they placed him in the ICU and gave the needed treatment. All the efforts of the doctor did not improve his health. On 6th September he breathed his last breath. On hearing this tragic news, senior leaders and other missionaries rushed to the place. And the next day his body was shifted to Delhi where the funeral service was conducted in the Cathedral Church of New Delhi and he was buried in the Church graveyard with the hope of resurrection. After finishing the God given task, Rev. Phillip Asirvatham takes rest in the Kingdom of God. His wife continues her ministry. She has been placed in the mobilization ministry at Coimbatore. Please pray for her and their son and his family.

GENERAL HISTORY

Matana is a large village located in Fatehabad district. Harvana in which 842 families reside. This belongs to the Hissar Division. The Matana village has population of 4460 people as per Census of 2011. The literacy rate of Matana village was 74.64%. The average Sex Ratio is 890. The literacy rate of male is 85.10% and females are 62.92%. As per the constitution of India and Panchayati Raaj Act, Matana village is administrated by Sarpanch (Head of the Village) who is the elected representative of village. Schedule Caste (SC) constitutes 11.14 % of total population in Matana village. And it currently doesn't have any Schedule Tribe (ST) population. People in Matana speak Punjabi, Hindi, and Bagri languages.

Beginning

The first mission field of FMPB in the state of Haryana was Sirsa and it was opened in

1974 by the missionaries Mr. James Kaiser Hosannah and Mr. D Antony. In April 1977 Mr. S Rajendran joined the Sirsa ministry. In 1979 the missionaries started ministry in Fatehabad with the help of a Christian Puniabi nurse named Mrs. Prakash Chand who was working at the civil hospital in Fatehabad. In 1980, ASHA Team (Accelarated Scheme for the Hindi Area) spread the Gospel in villages through literature evangelism. This team was led by Rev. L. Masilamani family and Bro. T.J. Thomas. They were involved in tract ministries. James Kaiser once took a bicycle by the bus to Sirsa, but some RSS people had followed him and took him to the police station accusing him as a cycle thief where he was beaten by police. Team members in Fatehabad too were arrested by the police. Later the Christians in Sirsa led a protesting procession and represented the reality to the collector. With the help of the nurse Mrs. Prakash Chand the team members were rescued.

In 1983 the Fatehabad mission field was opened and Mr. Joy Kutty & Mrs. Rosamma were placed as pioneer missionaries. Mr. Joy Kutty and Mr. I. K. Abraham went by bicycle to Matana village and distributed tracts. In spite of the toilsome work of the early missionaries, fruits were yielded only during the Rai Sikh movement which started from 1990. In 1991 Mr. Harnam Singh's family from Matana village, belonging to the Rai Sikh community heard the Gospel through one of their relatives named Mr. Hukum Singh.

TESTIMONIES

First believer of Matana village Mr. Jagga Singh:



I am Jagga Singh from Matana village. I was possessed by evil spirit and used to scream always since childhood. My father took me to many magicians and also called them home to deliver me but they couldn't help us. One of our relatives Mr. Hukum Singh (Kata Khedi village) who accepted Christ after his wife got delivered from an evil spirit; brought Missionary Deva Anbukkan, Pankaj Lal and Joseph Durairaj to our house. In a Dharmsala satsung conducted for 3 days by Dr. Devadas and T. Ponnusamy, all the members of our family took baptism after my total deliverance. We used to share the Gospel to our relatives. Once when I was travelling from Rajasthan to Fatehabad, the bus collided with a truck and three people died on the spot. God protected me as I called on Him for help. Praise God.

Mr. Balkar brother of Mr. Jagga Singh: I'm Balkar Singh. One day Missionaries came to our village and preached the Gospel and screened a film. I was touched by the Gospel and so I accepted Christ as my Saviour. In 1991 at Fatehabad three days satsung was conducted in which nearly 400 to 500 people were present. I and my brother and our families also participated in the satsung and prayed and my brother got total deliverance. That was the last day the evil spirit tormented us and then on there were no difficulties.

Mr. Surject Singh: lam Surject Singh from Matana village. Our family was suffering due to the torment of evilspirits. In our family there was alcoholic addictions, quarrelling. lack of peace in family, disobedience of children, demon possession of my wife. We through Harnam Singh came to know about Christ. When missionary Raja Edwin Moses conducted satsung, my wife became alright. So I accepted Christ and was baptised. Once I was affected by constant hiccups for 12 days. Injections and many local medicines were given but it did not stop. In the satsung conducted by Bibabha Pani the Lord healed me. Through this my faith in the Lord increased."

Mrs. Naseeb Kaur: I was worshipping a baba but when I came to know about Christ I accepted Him and got baptised at Dariyapur. Even though I got married to a non-Christian person, because of His grace I was able to continue in my faith. We named her Jyothi.

CHURCH GROWTH

The first Baptism service was held at Fatehabad on 1.3.1992 in which five people

including Balkar Singh from Jagga Singh family were baptized. The second Baptism was held on 23.8.1992 in which another brother of Mr. Jagga Singh, Mr. Ramesh Kumar and his father Mr. Harnam Singh and two others of Matana village got baptized. The worship that was conducted at Mr. Jagga Singh's house continued till the Church was built in 1996. Mr. Harnam Singh's family took the Gospel to the neighboring districts and state. When they accepted Christ, many of their Sikh community people mocked at them but they did not turn back. Another relative, Mr. Avatar Singh who lives at Alwar district of Rajasthan also accepted Christ and took baptism. He was delivered from an evil spirit that was tormenting him for seven years. He was a Sikh guru who was reading the Granth at Gurudwara." Mr. Avatar Singh joined FMPB as local evangelist and he served at Alwar field and took the Gospel to many villages in and around Alwar, Also, the first believer of Ratia field, Mr. Dalip Singh from Sotar village, MP also accepted Christ through the Matana believers. He was their close relative. Mr. Harnam Singh took the missionaries. Mr. Deva Anbukkan and Mr. Raja Edwin Moses to his relatives' house in Jan 1993 at Nathuwan Dani, Ratia Tehsil and the whole family who were under the torment of the evil spirit experienced deliverance and accepted Christ. They threw all the idols and pictures into the river and shouted "victory to Jesus" and were baptized in Feb 1993. In this way the Gospel spread far and wide from Matana village.

THE CHURCH CONSTRUCTION

When Mr. Harnam Singh's family accepted Christ, they felt the need of a worship place like other religious people. So Mr. Harnam Singh donated his 6 Marla (272 Sq. ft.)

land for Church construction in Oct 1993. The Matana Church land was registered in September1995 and the foundation laid on 1996. The believers are only from Matana village. They are from Rai Sikh and Kamboj communities. Fatehabad field missionary, Mr. Deva Anbukan initiated the Matana Church construction. They named the Church as 'Prabhu Yeshu Masih Satsung Bhavan'. The believers gave their free labor in the construction work. The mason was Mr. Major Singh who was a believer from, Ratia field, MP worked hard for a long time for less wages.

OPPOSITION

A Hindu priest from Matana village with the intent to oppose, gathered the villagers and made them believe that the Christians kill cows and sacrifice at their worship places and so it would bring a curse for the village. When they tried to stop the construction Mr. Harnam Singh, his son Mr. Ramesh and other believers took a strong stand saying that they can build anything as they wish in their land. So the opposition stopped.

In Feb 1996, Matana village leaders Mr. Ram Lal and Mr. Shyamlal became jealous of the Church construction and said the entrance of the Church faces the Hindu graveyard and so the entrance has to be rebuilt in some other side. The missionaries quietly prayed for this concern. So the opposition dropped.



- 1. Mrs. Meetho Bai I was suffering from severe throat pain and I was not able to drink even water. Satsung was conducted at my uncle's house. At the satsung, prayer was offered for me by pastor. God healed me and so I accepted Christ and was baptized.
- 2. June 1994 Ms. Chindo was possessed by four evil spirits. The Matana believers prayed for her during the Wednesday fasting prayer and the evil spirit left her. In April 1998 she was healed from her death bed through prayers.
- **3.** On 27.6.1996 Vishva Hindu group people accused the Matana believers that they have killed a calf of a cow. They gave a police complaint also. The missionaries met the police people and through prayers the evil plans of the opponents were thwarted.

CHURCH DEDICATION

The Matana Church was dedicated on 25.5.1996 for God's glory. 250 believers participated. Mr. Robert William was the Fatehabad field missionary during the time of Church construction. Rev. Ponnusamy, the Administrative Secretary along with Rev. Anbukan, the North West Regional Secretary and missionaries were present.

Prayer Points

The total strength of the Matana Church is 47. When the ministry started at Matana the Rai Sikh people came to the Lord and there was a steady growth. After sometime there was a decline. Missionaries along with evangelists are visiting the people and encouraging them. Let us pray for the revival of the Matana Church believers.



our visit, we visited various mission fields including Amalagachi, a Malto Village, Chapande boys hostel, Community college, Gangupada girls hostel, Pandeni School, and Sarjomohutu Santhal village. On the 24th, we participated in the dedication of a Church in Beldiha field, Taldih Village (Santhal), where Mr. Frederick Manuel from Dindigul generously had donated towards its construction. On the 28th, we attended another Church dedication ceremony in Maldah field, in Pitchilpada Malto Village, supported by the offering from Mr. Yesu Raj.
