go to Sunday School?" asked the man in a friendly manner. "Yes, sir," replied the boy. The man, thinking to have some fun with the lad, asked "tell me where God is, and I'll give you an apple. "The boy looked up sharply at the man and promptly replied, "I will give you a whole barrel of apples if you will tell me where He is not."

An attribute of our God alone is the quality of being present in all places at all times (Jeremiah 23:23,24, Colossians 1:16-17). That's why Solomon says But will God indeed dwell on the earth? behold, the heaven and heaven of heavens cannot contain Thee; how much less this house that I have built? 1 Kings 8:27. He is not bound by time and space. This does not mean that nature is a part of God and is, therefore, to be worshiped. Creation is separate from God, but not independent of Him. Thus, our God is an Omni God. The "Omni" words reveal truth about God's character and nature. The three Omni-attributes of God are:

Omnipotence - It is the unlimited power or authority... "...for the Lord God omnipotent reigneth" (Revelation 19:6 NKJV). That means He has the power, authority, and ability to answer our prayers and to protect us from all perils of life. There is nothing difficult for Him.

Omnipresence - Present everywhere simultaneously. Omnipresence is described in Jeremiah 23:23-24: "Am I a God at hand, saith the Lord, and not a God afar off? Can any hide himself in secret places that I shall not see him? saith the Lord. Do not I fill heaven and earth? saith the Lord." and Proverbs 15:3. That means he is also right now with you and me.

Omniscience - Total knowledge; knowing everything. Omniscience is described in Matthew 6:32: "... for your heavenly Father know that ye have need of all these things" (Matthew 6:32), Romans 8:27, and 1 John 3:20. That means that He also knows you and me-personally, completely, and every minute detail.

Isn't it encouraging to realise that such a God is our God and He is with us. But who are we for all these? God's omnipresence encourages believers and gives hope to the hopeless. An Active consideration of God's omniscience and how that impacts us will give us a new outlook on life. Obstacles that seem overwhelming will fade. Temptations will be less alluring. Even our thought life may be refined. His presence can guide, encourage, comfort and strengthen us to live a life for Him. This Omni God is enough to take us through all our dire situations in our families and ministry!

Who has measured the waters in the hollow of his hand, or with the breadth of his hand marked off the heavens? Who has held the dust of the earth in a basket, or weighed the mountains on the scales and the hills in a balance?

May 1 is being celebrated as Labour Day all across the world. The first Labour Day was celebrated on May 1, 1889 as the International Workers Day. The celebrations were declared to commemorate the Haymarket Riot in Chicago. The riots are also known as the Haymarket Affair, which occurred in 1886.



While he offers a prayer of dedication he confesses the greatness of God and asks himself how can this God, who cannot be contained in heavens, dwell in the temple that he had built (1 Kings 8:27). Though the splendour of the Temple was so marvellous. King Solomon compare and contrast with the God and temple he built. Though the limited human mind cannot fully comprehend the infinite God, as we study, may the Lord help us to understand the glimpse of His greatness and why He expects a place to worship Him.

GOD IS OMNIPRESENT

Omnipresence means God is present everywhere, fully present every time in all His creation and fills all space. It means there is no location where he does not inhabit - Isaiah 57:15, Psalm 139:1-13. Keeping watch on the evil and the good - Proverbs 15:3, transcendent - Psalm 123:1, Most High over all the earth -Psalm 97:9, Lord sitting on a throne, high and exalted - Isaiah 6:1, dwell in the high and holy place - Isaiah 57:15, present in every realm of heaven and earth - Jeremiah 23:23-24. even in the uttermost parts of the universe - Psalm 139:7-10, dwells in very high and very low place Isaiah 57:15, enthroned high above the heavens and looks at the heavens and the earth - Psalm 113:4-6, nothing is hidden for Him - Hehrews 4·13

GOD IS OMNISCIENT

God knows everything, about all moments of all times, past, present, and future. Nothing that is not known to God. He need not learn anything from anyone or from anywhere - Isaiah 40:13, Psalm 33:13-15. 147:4. He knew everything in advance. eternally, perfectly comprehensively. He comprehends all things of past, present, and future.

God is having perfect self-knowledge within the trinity. Matthew 11:26, John 10:15, 1 Corinthians 2:11. There is no gap between their understanding. He has perfect knowledge of everything accurately as it is - Job 37:16, nothing is hidden to Him - 1 John 1:5, He sees what human cannot see -Psalm 147:5, Job 36:4-5, has eternal Knowledge - Isaiah 46:9-10, Acts 15:18, has intimate knowledge - Romans 11:33-35, watches over everyone and know their heart and thoughts - Proverbs 5:21, 15:3, 1 Chronicles 28:9.

GOD IS OMNIPOTENT

God is All-powerful, has supreme power, no limitations and the source of all power. Though He sets limits for all His creation, He is limitless in strength, wisdom, love, holiness, and ability to perform His sovereign will. His power is unfathomable but we get a glimpse of His might through His creation - Isa 40:15, Hebrews 1:3. Everything is possible for Him - Matthew 19:26, Luke 1:37, Job 42:2, nothing is hard for Him - Jeremiah 32:27, able to do far more than all we ask or think - Ephesians 3:20.

God's power cannot be comprehended by human wisdom - Psalm 147:5, His understanding is unsearchable - Isaiah 40:28, exists from the very beginning and will be till the end of the universe -Revelation 1:8.

Why does an Omni God need a place for worship:

God created everything primarily to worship Him - Colossians 1:16-17, He does not share His glory to anything else - Isaiah 42:8, even to the angels - Isaiah 14:12-15, Ezekiel 28:16-17, Jude 1:6. As man started worshiping various things, God wanted to have His visible presence on earth so that people may be able to experience His presence.

A. Omni God expects men to worship Him alone:

God expects honour, reverence, homage, from His people in a reverential attitude of heart, mind and body. God expects us to seek Him with all our soul and with all our strength - Deuteronomy 6:4-5. From

the very beginning angels were anointed to worship God continuously. When the guardian angel tried to equate himself with God, God pulled him down - Ezekiel 28:11-17 & Isaiah 14:12-15. Because God alone is to be worshiped. Psalms 29:1-2, 1 Chronicles 16:29, Isaiah 42:8.

Human account of worship began with Cain & Abel. They worshiped with the best of what they had. Noah built an altar and worshiped God after the flood with sacrifice. Abraham worshiped by building an altar to the Lord - Gen 12:8; 13:18. God asked to bring out His people to worship Him in the wilderness - Exodus 5:1-23. After receiving the commandment the Israelites were worshiping on the 7th day of the week.

When the Israelites were entering into the promised land, God asked His people to remove the Canaanites who were wicked and were worshiping baal, because God expected all His people to worship Him alone - Deuteronomy 9:4,5. Thus they were worshiping God as a community in Israel.

Disciples of Jesus who had personal encounter with the Lord Jesus Christ, started to gather as a community to worship the Triune God on the first day of the week – resurrection day. God's desire is that everyone should worship and experience the free gift of redemption through His death and resurrection.

FMPB works towards achieving God's desire and we invite all who personally experienced the forgiveness of their sin through Jesus Christ to join as groups to

pray for the salvation of the people who have not heard the Gospel and to be part of the effects taken to bless individual lives through Jesus Christ that they also may worship this Omni God.

B. Omni God wants His physical presence among His people

Though the Omni God is present everywhere He wants His visible presence among His people. God wanted a disparate place for His people to worship Him so that He could manifest, give His grace, blessing to all who come to Him. Church is the visible presence of this Omni God.

The place of worship originated by building an Altar for sacrifice. Noah erected the altar after the flood - Genesis 8:20, then Abraham - Genesis 12:7, 13:4, 22:9, then by Isaac - Gen. 26:25, then by Jacob - Gen 33:20, 35:1,3 and by Moses -Exodus 17:15. During the time of bondage in Egypt, the Israelites had no specific place for worship. When they came out of Egypt, during their wilderness journey, God asked Moses to erect a Tabernacle giving Him the pattern - Exodus 25:9. Paul reveals that the pattern of the Tabernacle was a shadow of the Sanctuary, which is the heaven - Hebrew 8:5.

The Tabernacle was the place where God met with His people -Exodus 29:42, sacrifice continued in it. It was also called Tabernacle of testimony - Exodus 38:21. Number 1:50, ark of testament - Exodus 25:16,22; Number 9:15, tabernacle of witness - Number 17:8, house of the Lord - Deuteronomy 23:18 - Temple of the Lord - Joshua 6:24 and Sanctuary - Exodus 25.8

Building a permanent structure was a desire of king David but God did not permit him to build with his blood-stained hands. Solomon built and dedicated a magnificent temple for God - 1 Kings 8:13 as he was guided by God 1 Kings 6 & 7:13-51; 2 Chronicles 3 & 4. This temple was a very important place for worship and social life of Jewish people.

When Solomon's temple was destroyed in 586 BC, people started gathering in private houses for worship, then the synagogues came into existence. When the second temple was destroyed by Roman emperor Titus in 70 AD, temple sacrifice and Jewish priesthood were terminated.

Synagogue was used frequently by Jesus and His disciples - Matt 13:54, Acts 13:5, 15, 44; 14:1; 17:2-4, 19:8. Early Christians were also going to the synagogues as well as gathering in the believers' houses for fellowship - Acts 2:46. But later when the disciples of Jesus increased, unbelieving Jews stood against believers to excommunicate them from the synagogues - John 9:22; 12:42; 16:2. Thus Christians started gathering separately taking the model of synagogue for Christian worship. Now Church is the visible presence of God. We have so many testimonies how God answers and blesses people who come into the Church and pray

to Him. We also have the testimonies how God deals with people who stand against the Church.

Though the Church is a called out invisible. community. universal and everlasting, the Church also has a visible structure to exhibit God's visible presence to the people. Therefore, when people come to know Christ through our ministry, we help young believers to make a place of worship where believers experience the presence of God.

C. Omni God wants to live within us and make us His witness

Omni God who is present everywhere cannot be limited to Church alone. Jesus during His ministry told the Samaritan woman "true worshipers will worship the Father in the Spirit and in Truth ..." John 4: 23-24. God wants to live with us and in us. 1 Corinthians 3:16 says we are the temple of God. When we receive Jesus into our hearts we not only receive Him as our God but as the master of our life. Thus God becomes the Master or owner of our life - 1 Corinthians 6:19. Paul is telling us that the spiritual act of true worship is to offer our bodies as living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God - Romans 12:1.

God expects people who worship Him to also help others to know Him and worship Him by involving themselves in sharing this life transforming Gospel to our friends, neighbors, relatives and all others. One who experiences this transformation cannot stop but to share the Gospel with the others - John 4:14. This Omni God cannot be limited within us when we receive Him, He expects that the joy of salvation to overflow into the lives of others - 1 Corinthians 9:16

David had a desire to build a temple for this Omni God. Today building a temple for god is winning souls for Him. Because Paul in his epistle writes that "you are that temple of the holy spirit". God invites us to make place for him in the hearts of the Indians. For this the Omni God has given His promise to be with us to the end of the age (Mat 28:20). No doubt He will be with us throughout eternity.



OBITUARY

Mrs. P. Mary Ratna Bai (Mrs.C.V.K)

Mrs. Mary Ratna Bai fondly called as Mrs. C.V.K, was born to Mr. and Mrs. P. Dhyryanandam, in a Roman Catholic family. After her marriage with Mr. C. Vijay Kumar, she received Jesus as her personal saviour. Mr. C. Vijaya Kumar, employed as a lecturer, introduced FMPB to Machilipatnam. He tirelessly worked towards its growth from 1980 onwards, serving

as an honorary promotional secretary for 21 years. After her husband's death in 2001, she prayerfully embarked on her journey into the FMPB ministry, undertaking pioneering efforts for the Lord's mission. Concurrently, she served as a social welfare officer in the government sector. Since then, she used to visit every house personally, prayed for them and collected contribution every month. She organized FMPB prayer cells, preached the word of God and conducted fasting prayers every month. Every year, she teamed up with local FMPB leaders to organize the FMPB Family retreat. Under her humble and prayerful leadership, new members were consistently added and new missionary dedications steadily increased. She would walk to each member's house, sharing God's love and offering prayers for their families. She played a pivotal role in launching the FMPB ministry in Gudivada. Together with local FMPB team leaders, she would visit the homes of every FMPB member to sing carols and collect the Christmas gift for the missionaries. She toiled relentlessly until her final moments in the Lord's vineyard, fulfilling the role of an honorary promotional secretary through the avenues provided by FMPB. She offered herself unto the Lord, leaving behind a fragrant legacy to be celebrated and cherished by generations to come.



TRAIL BLAZERS

Saved for a Purpose: Born to second-generation missionaries to China, John Dudley Woodberry's grandparents left their motherland to serve as a chaplain for Chinese POWs (Prisoners of War) during the Korean War. Having first become a Christian "in a childlike way" when he was three years old, Dudley says that the freezing waters of the Yantai Harbor catalyzed his faith in the winter of 1939. Five-year-old Dudley fell through the ice, which led to pneumonia. Barely surviving the illness, Dudley became convinced that divine intervention saved his life. Even at the age of five, "I had a sense," he says, "that I had been saved for a purpose."

God's grace continued to flow through their lives and two years later, when the Japanese bombed Pearl Harbor and declared war on the United States, Dudley and his family were made prisoners of war by the occupying Japanese army in China. Parents and children were separated; Dudley and his siblings became POWs in a different part of the country from their parents. Months later, a civilian prisoner exchange was negotiated between the United States and Japan. Once reunited with their parents, through ships and finally reached the shores of New York encountering many perils in their journey.

LEARNING TO GO

Dudley discovered that "something" at age 13, when he heard the pioneer missionary Samuel Zwemer say, "If you want the most difficult but most rewarding work in the world, minister among Muslims."

In 1955 Dudley enrolled in the Bachelor of Divinity program at Fuller, which gave the opportunity for two students from each school to travel to a mission field and complete studies in indigenous cultures. Dudley was selected to study at the American University of Beirut.

He met his wife and partner in ministry, Roberta in Lebanon, where she was studying at Beirut College for Women. Westerners often saw Muslims as an unsophisticated people, completely ignoring their highly varied and developed cultures rich with art, tradition, and theological reflection. Dudley still had the heart of a missionary, but his time in Lebanon convinced him that rigorous intellectual preparation would lead to more effective witnessing.

Building Bridges: When he graduated from Fuller, Harvard accepted him to study under the preeminent Western scholar of Islam Sir Hamilton Gibb. Dudley did well in his studies, writing his dissertation on the theology of Hasan al-Banna, His commitment to missions was sometimes frowned upon as he was expected to appreciate Arab culture, not convert

it. Dudley learned to love and appreciate the indigenous culture of the Islamic nations for what they were, while still yearning to bring the redeeming love and light of Christ to them.

After years of training and discernment along with his two children, Dudley and Roberta became full-time missionaries to Pakistan, funded by the Presbyterian Church. Dudley worked at the Christian Study Centre in Rawalpindi and made great progress in building bridges between Christianity and Islam which led to developing mutual respect but also bringing Muslims to the Christian faith.

SCHOLAR, PASTOR, ADVOCATE

Dudley's scholastic endeavors also unexpectedly proved crucial for his own safety and the safety of others. During his first tour in Afghanistan, two missionaries were arrested for distributing copies of the Gospel of Luke. Though he never appeared in court, Dudley hired a defense lawyer and developed the defense himself, based on Qur'anic verses that allowed Christians and Muslims to coexist peacefully. The missionaries were released.

A similar situation presented itself in Saudi Arabia, where Dudley was called to serve as the first sanctioned resident pastor in the Arabian interior since shortly after the Islamic conquests of the seventh century. The Church in the capital of Riyadh and elsewhere grew at an astounding rate, to an extent that made the government uncomfortable. To help ease tensions, Dudley showed them letters ascribed to Muhammad that gave Christians the right to worship in their own Churches as long as they were loval and met certain financial and other obligations. The Christians were then allowed to continue a lower-profile worship. When Dudley and his family returned to the United States because of Roberta's health and their children's educational needs-after 11 years of ministry in Pakistan, Afghanistan, and Saudi Arabia-King Khalid thanked him for his work.

Though he oversaw key initiatives in the School of World Mission (SWM) as its dean from 1992 to 1999, Dudley's impact was perhaps greatest in the study of Muslims and their contexts. He further oversaw research in South Asia and West and East Africa demonstrating that Muslims were coming to faith in Christ not only in an "attractional model"-being attracted to a Church or to Christians-but also in a "transformational model": studying the Bible stories of people mentioned in the Qur'an within trusted groups of fellow Muslims, and thus gradually coming to faith in Christ as Savior.

After Dudley retired from the deanship of SWM, Roberta accepted a request to teach their grandson and other expatriate children during the academic year at a school in Pakistan. During this time Fuller became very involved in peacebuilding with Muslims both in the United States and overseas. Because Dudley is quick to tell a story and slow to take credit, it bears telling that he influenced movements in missions, academia, and diplomacy that affect the discussion of how Christians and the West interact with Muslims.

STILL ON THE JOURNEY

The tale of Dudley's incredible life is exceeded only by the extraordinary depth of his work. It's been suggested that he write a memoir: three arrests in three countries, hitchhiking from New York to Ecuador and through Iran, Pakistan, and India, working as a deckhand for passage from Panama to the United States, negotiating on behalf of hostages, weaving through civil wars and revolutions: all this surely warrants some sort of literary commemoration.

"Oh, no," says Dudley, shaking his head. "I don't think I'll have time. I have too much work to do."

MRS. D. AGNES EDWARD



Rajaund is a large village located in Kaithal Tehsil of Kaithal district, Haryana. As per constitution of India and Panchyati Raaj Act, Rajaund village is administrated by Sarpanch (Head of the Village) who is the elected representative of the village. Schedule Caste (SC) constitutes 23.99 % of total population in Rajaund village. The village Rajaund currently doesn't have any Schedule Tribe (ST) population. They are cultivators (owner or co-owner) while some are working as Agricultural labourers.

BEGINNING

In January 2007 Pehowa mission field was opened by Mr. Sarat Chandra Digal and Mrs. Lovely. The Rajaund sub-center was opened in June 2012. Local evangelist Mr. Ashok Samuel was stationed at Rajaund. There were some believers who had accepted Christ through independent pastors but were unable to regularly participate in the worship due to distance constraint. So when Sunday worship was started by local evangelist



Mr. Ashok at his rented house, the local believers joined the worship as it was near to their houses.

Some testimonies:



"I am Beera from Rajaund village. Before knowing Christ I was a follower of Sirsa baba (Ram Rahim). My daughter-in-law was tormented by evil spirit. So we took her to a pastoress at Kaithal. The pastoress took us to a church at Rampura. Later we participated in the satsung. We accepted Christ and took baptism. I prayed to the Lord to give us a pastor to teach us to walk in His ways. FMPB local evangelist, Mr. Ashok got my contact and he came to our house. Started attending the worship conducted at his rented house."

Mrs. Komal: "I am Komal from Batha village. After my marriage, I was under the bondage of satan. I had very severe pain in my hip that I was not able to walk, stand or even move my body. I was always on the bed unable to do any of my household chores. I approached the magicians which was of no use. I was taken to Ludiana. The pastor prayed for me and gave me a Bible to read. He introduced us to pastor Mr. Suresh at Rajaund. In 2018 I was brought to the worship at Rajaund in a vehicle. I had to be carried by people inside the church. On the first day itself God healed me through prayers. I went home walking by myself. I believed in the Lord and I and my husband took baptism in March 2019. God has helped me to do all my works and has enabled me to run a shop also. Praise God."



Mrs. Ram Rathi: "I am Ram Rathi from Rajaund. I was suffering from pain in my hands and legs. I used to do household works in a house at Rajaund. My mistress was a believer. She gave me a New Testament and a gospel booklet. She told me to get it read through my children. She also told me about Jesus Christ as a healer. My eldest son and daughter-in-law, Prinka who were also believers got prayed for me through pastor Kartikeyan. They were staying at Kaithal and were participating in the worship at Kaithal. Through Pastor Kartikeyan, we got the contact of pastor Suresh (Local evangelist

at Rajaund). Pastor Suresh and family visited our house and prayed for me. I began to put my hope in the Lord and God healed me gradually through prayers. My husband Amarjeet was also affected by black jaundice and God healed him through prayers. Also God changed all the chaotic situations in our son's marriage and has enabled us to do his marriage happily. From 2020 we have been participating in the worship."

CHURCH GROWTH

Rajaund Church has brought many Christians who were scattered and irregular to one common place of worship. After the departure of local evangelist Mr. Ashok Samuel, Mr. Suresh & family were placed at Rajaund. Through his ministry many new people have also accepted Christ and joined the Church. Some of the testimonies are given below.

WORSHIP DETAILS

The Sunday worship was started at Rajaund in August 2012 at the rented house of the local evangelist, Mr. Ashok Samuel. Due to opposition, the worship was shifted to the houses of the believers till the church was built. The Rajaund church land was purchased and registered in December 2014. The Rajaund congregation members are from the following villages: Baata, Gohana, Asandh, Kharka, Indra colony and Rajaund. All of them are from Balmiki, Chamar and Kashyap communities.

CHURCH CONSTRUCTION

The foundation for the Prayer House, Rajaund was laid in January 2016. A Pucca church was built for 40X18ft. In spite of the opposition by the anti-Christian elements the church compound wall work was completed at Raiaund, Christian leaders from Ambala city along with the media persons came on 16th Jan to the local police station and spoke on behalf of the missionaries and believers. The church construction work restarted in July 2016. Again the people in the neighbourhood opposed the church construction. They took away some of the building materials from the construction site. The Raiaund church construction was stopped by the anti-Christian elements and filed a complaint at the SP office. Missionaries Mr. Kartikevan, Mr. Sarath and Mr. Alivakim Jena had a talk with SP. Finally the Rajaund church construction restarted again in January 2017. As the land was in a low lying area, every believers' families contributed a trolley of sand to raise the ground level. The painting work was completely contributed by the believers. Some bought construction materials and some helped in the labour work. Mr. Beera was very helpful during church construction. By God's grace, the Raiaund church was dedicated on 29.1.2017 by the pastor of Christ Church Coimbatore. The Sunday service that was stopped for two months due to opposition also resumed after , dedication.

MIRACLES AND IMPORTANT EVENTS FROM RAJAUND CONGREGATION

Mr. Beera was delivered from evil spirit. Ms. Mukesh from Rajaund was healed from throat cancer. Mr. Mohan who opposed the Rajaund church construction repented of his ways. Mr. Ram Pal who threatened the local evangelist felt sorry for his mistake.

CHURCH ACTIVITIES AND INFORMATION



Mr. Suresh and family is the Present local evangelist while Mr. Sompal and Mrs. Reena are the Church elders. 25 to 30 people attend the worship every Sunday. The total strength of the Raigund church is 51. In the second or third week of every month, ladies meeting is being conducted in the church or in the houses of believers. Local evangelist's wife. Mrs. Vimla. Mrs. Reena and Mrs. Krishna are the leaders. On Tuesdays children class is being conducted at the house of believer Mrs. Asha at Rajaund and on Saturdays another children class is being conducted at the house of believer Mr. Naresh and Mrs. Reena at Rajaund. Local evangelist's wife conducts the children classes. In each class twenty five to forty children participate. Let us uphold this congregation in our prayers.

Eyesight restored!

Missionary Blography

Mr. Packianatharaj was born to Christian parents on December 15, 1941 in Kanyakumari district, Tamilnadu. The family comprised his parents Mr. George and Kanagammal, his sisters Gloria Sironmani and Joy Celin Saroja and his brothers Thangaraj and David Selveraj.

Early Period:

Packianatharaj's parents nurtured him with Christian values and teaching. They also encouraged him to go to the local Church regularly. And also they inspired him to read and meditate on the Bible every day. After finishing his school final in the local School. he joined a Polytechnic College and got training in Mechanical engineering. He was regular to the Sunday school where he learned the Bible and its precious teaching. During a Church convention, he accepted Jesus Christ as his personal Saviour.

Married Life:

After completing his studies successfully, he moved to Ooty

seeking job and very soon found a job in the Hindustan Photo Film Company. As a child of God, he was so sincere in his duties that his superior noticed his faithful work and promoted him. Parents encouraged him to get married and fixed a right life partner for him. Miss. Joyce was a medically trained compounder working in the Government hospital in Ooty. Mr. Packianatharaj got married to Ms. Joyce on the 12th of May 1971. God blessed their married life with two sons namely Golden Jeba George and Golden Victor George.

Call to the Ministry:

There was a great transformation in the life of Mr. Packianatharaj after accepting Christ as his Saviour. He had a passion to do ministry. especially rescuing the souls from the darkness. Whenever he got an opportunity, he was involved in the evangelistic ministry along with his friends and the Church. In the meantime, he learned about the ministry of Friends Missionary Prayer Band in North India. Then, he joined the prayer groups and began to pray regularly for the missionaries. He began to attend the mission conventions conducted by FMPB and listened with conviction the sharing of missionaries from North India. His heart was fully committed to the missionary work. While he was reading the Bible, God spoke to him through the verses from Psalm 91 and he committed his life for full time ministry. Moreover, he shared his assurance with his wife; she too was willing to obey God. Following the guidance of God, on January 30, 1980 they joined FMPB as missionary candidates.

North India Ministry:

Initially, they went through missionary training at Bethel Bible Institute, Danishpet. After finishing the one year training successfully, they were sent to Gujarat as crosscultural missionaries. They reached the state of Gujarat, where the ministry among the Kukna people was flourishing. And he joined the band of missionaries who were doing ministry among the Kukna in south Gujarat. They began their ministry based at Pipalwada in Dangs district and later moved to Uchhal and continued the ministry among the Kukna people.

1988, along with another missionary Mr. Perinbadoss. they arranged a Mela for all the new believers at a village namely Navkam Gujarat near Maharashtra and horder Mr Surjayamsi and the then General Secretary of FMPB Mr. M. Patrick Joshua were the special speakers for the Mela. Hundreds of new converts gathered for the mela. Moreover, the believers did all the arrangements under the guidance of our missionaries. They started the Mela as per the schedule. During the meetings, some anti-Christian elements disturbed the meetings by pelting stones. Some of our Local evangelists and missionaries were wounded during stone pelting. Then another mob of anti-social elements entered the venue and set fire to the shamiyana. Mrs. Joyce Pakianatharaj took the two special speakers Mr. M. Patrick Joshua and Mr. Suriavamsi, hid them in a house, and saved them from the angry mob. The mob severely thrashed nine of our people and tied them to the poles for further actions. Mr. Packianatharaj was one among the persons who were beaten severely and got internal wounds in his stomach and chest areas. The driver who came to pick up the guests saw the fire, lodged a complaint in the nearby police station, and also brought police personnel to the spot. They rescued the believers and the missionaries from the deadly attack. In midst of the persecution God gave us hundreds of believers who were very strong in their faith in Christ.

Last Days:

Mr. Packianatharaj received severe internal wounds. As a result, his heart started bulging. From 1989 onwards, he suffered from heart problems. Once he had a heart attack and was admitted in a hospital and given the needed treatment. On medical leave, he went to his own village called Thoppur for recuperation. Again, in 1990, in the month of May he became very sick and was admitted to a hospital. All the efforts of the Doctors failed and he received the

home call. Mr. Packianathraj did his ministry well and entered into the glory of God on the 12th of May 1990

After his death, his wife Mrs. Joyce ioined the Mumbai mobilization ministry and did the ministry among the believers, raising prayer groups and support. Her elder son Golden Jeba George got a job in the city of Mumbai. Mrs. Packianatharai found a suitable partner for him and he got married. Golden Jeba George was very active in his Church ministries. Within a few years, he died of electrocution while doing the electrical repairing work in a Church at Mumbai. She already lost her younger son Golden Victor George, in one of the FMPB Annual Camp at Danishpet. During the nighttime, he fell into a well which did not have any parapet wall around it. With a heavy heart, Mrs. Joyce continued the ministry in Mumbai taking care of the grandchildren. In 2009, Mrs. Joyce Packianatharaj retired from FMPB after reaching the age of sixty five. Now she is doing ministry in her hometown near Nagercoil. This family did their best for God with their abilities. Let us thank God for this family.
