God's Courtroom

In our country, we constantly hear about crime in all fields, and we see that the number of accused criminals is increasing day by day. However, those who have accepted Jesus Christ, the Righteous Judge, are called to live blameless life. Satan's purpose is to accuse the sanctified, but Jesus Christ is diligently protecting them. Both tirelessly plead for our souls in the court of God in heaven. Can we imagine this? In Revelation 12:10, Satan is described as the accuser of the brethren. However, according to Eph 4:14, Jesus, the Great High Priest, intercedes for us, as stated in Rom 8:34. Both parties present their cases before our Righteous Judge. Satan brings numerous accusations about our old sinful lives before God. In Job 1:9-11, we see how Satan accused Job. We cannot defend ourselves against him because, often, he is right about us. We have lived outside the law and therefore deserve to be punished. He accuses us just as he accused Job.

In contrast, Jesus Christ, glorified before the Father, shows His hands, feet, and the scars on His head, affirming that everything is finished and the punishment for sin has been paid in full. The Father, who loves His Son, Jesus, also loves us, His children, made Holy and righteous by His blood. No matter how much Satan accuses and cries out for justice, God has executed His justice because His own Son bore our punishment. Jesus Christ intercedes with the Father to bless us, emphasizing His pain, while Satan tries to push us into guilt and diminish the significance of Jesus' sacrifice.

This Righteous Judge will judge us according to the Scriptures, as mentioned in Jhn12:48. His righteousness applies to everyone, as stated in Heb 9:27. His throne is established by justice Ps 89:14. Our God is not a merciless judge but one who executes justice on our behalf. According to Scripture, the guilty will not go unpunished, and we get our justice at the Calvary. Who are we and what is our righteousness before this Righteous Judge? Our righteousness is just a filthy rag, the most important reason for our righteousness is the priceless righteousness of Jesus Christ, freely given to us.

We are called to proclaim this pure Gospel to the people of our country so that we, too, will be found righteous before the Righteous Judge and lead many to righteousness. The Lord, who will hold us accountable for each soul that we come across will come back as a Righteous Judge. Will we stand with an empty hands?




Missionaries Dedication

6 ← Tn our world, injustice can seem Irampant, leading us to question why unfairness exists in our lives and communities. Yet, amidst these challenges, we must remember that there is a Righteous Judge who sees all and will ultimately bring justice. One of His names is "Jehovah Sitkenu", meaning 'the Righteous Lord.' In Jeremiah 23:5-6. "when I will raise up for David a righteous Branch, a King who will reign wisely and do what is just and right in the land. In his days Judah will be saved and Israel will live in safety. This is the name by which he will be called: The LORD Our Righteousness". Yes, our Lord is righteous in all His deeds. He is the Righteous Judge. That's why He is also known by the name Jehovah-Shaphat derives its meaning from two Hebrew words, "Jehovah" and "Shaphat." Jehovah means "the self-existing one, I AM." while Shaphat means "to judge. to defend the cause of." This assurance reminds us that even today, we have a Righteous Judge overseeing our lives."

The Righteous Judge to individuals:

The book of Job holds immense significance for believers facing adversity. Its narrative offers profound encouragement, hope. and courage during difficult times. Job's dialogue in Job 9:14-15 captures the essence of his faith and struggle. expressing a deep longing for justice and understanding in the face of immense suffering. Despite his righteousness, Job feels the weight of his plight and yearns for a fair judgment. The Lord's testimony of Job as a righteous man who fears God and shuns evil, reinforces Job's integrity and devotion (Job 1:8). Job's profound understanding of God's attributes are evident in his acknowledgment of God's wisdom, strength, and sovereignty over creation (Job 9:4-13). +His wisdom is profound ◆His power is vast ◆He moves mountains without their knowing it and overturns them in his anger +He shakes the earth from its place and makes its pillars tremble +He speaks to the sun and it does not shine . He seals off the light of the stars . He alone stretches out the heavens and treads on the waves of the sea . He is the Maker of the Bear and Orion, the Pleiades and the constellations of the south .He performs wonders that cannot be fathomed, miracles that cannot be counted. Job knows that such an Almighty God is a Righteous Judge, so he says, who am I, that I should try to answer God or even reason with him? He sees himself very little in the eyes of God so trusting in His divine justice despite his trials. Job's example teaches us to seek refuge in God's justice rather than worldly systems, believing that God examines all things and administers justice in His perfect timing. Just as God delivered justice to individuals like Daniel and Joseph in their times of trial, we are called to place our trust in God's righteous judgment. This assurance allows us to find rest and strength in God's embrace, knowing that He sees our circumstances and will act justly on our behalf.

The Righteous Judge to the families:

God inquired about the injustice done by David, the king of a nation, a worship leader who was known to be after God's own heart, to the family of Uriah, an ordinary citizen. There was no one to intercede, plead or seek justice for the dead Uriah. But we read in 1Samuel 12: 10-18 that God was not blind and pointed out David's mistake at the right time and did justice for Uriah's family. In Psalm 9: 8 we read about God, the Righteous Judge, that He will judge the earth in righteousness and will do justice to all peoples and in Psalm 96: 13 that He is coming to judge the earth. This made it clear that He is a God who does justice to families.

The Righteous Judge to the Nations:

God chose the nation of Israel and loved it (Deuteronomy 7:6). But when that nation neglected God's love and went far away, God tried to bring it back to Himself. He warned Israel, when it would not be reconciled

and conflicted and then punished and proved His justice (Ezekiel 5; 20:8; We read in passages like Isaiah 1). We read of the same God punishing nations when Nations attacked Israel and hindered them, Amalekites in 1 Samuel 15, seven nations in the book of Amos, and judging many nations in many books such as Ezekiel. Our God is the king of all the earth and will judge the nations as a Righteous Judge Isaiah 2:4; Psalm 110:6.

The Righteous Judge of all the worlds:


Genesis 18:25 Far be it from you to do such a thing-to kill the righteous with the wicked, treating the righteous and the wicked alike. Far be it from you! Will not the Judge of all the earth do right?" Here we see our forefather Abraham pleads with God as the Judge of all the worlds who does justice. There is no forgiveness of sins without the shedding of blood according to the law. So an unblemished lamb must be offered as a sacrifice. As a Righteous Judge, our God gave His own Son as an unblemished sacrifice and justly paid the whole price on the cross and fulfilled the law and freed us from sin and iniquity and made us righteous by believing in His blood and proved that He is the Righteous Judge of the whole world.

The Lord who intercedes for us:

The Son Jesus Christ acts as mediator between us and the Father while the Father is the righteous judge (1John 2:1; Heb 7:25) 1 Tim 2:5 says, For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, and we were condemned because we were in sin and iniquity. But Jesus Christ acted as our mediator and carried our sins and iniquities on the cross and reconciled us to the Father in Romans 8:34. In Acts 10:42 we can see Peter testifying that Jesus Christ is the judge established by God for the living and the dead. So, we are redeemed and made righteous by the blood of Jesus Christ. But we should remember that all our righteous acts are only a filthy rags. We are not only redeemed but will also be rewarded if we live a life pleasing to this Judge. In 2 Timothy 4:8, the apostle Paul gives us a great hope that the now there is in store for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the Righteous Judge, will award to me on that day-and not only to me, but also to all who have longed for his appearing.

The Righteous Judge will soon come again to judge the whole world. "Look, I am coming soon! My reward is with me, and I will give to each person according to what they have done (Rev 22: 12). Are we ready for this? Let us engage ourselves more and work more for Him, in the task of taking such a powerful God, the Righteous Judge, to the people who are trapped in sin, curse, fear of death, disease, ignorance and slavery and prepare them to see the judge who is coming again. Be prepared and prepare the others to meet this Righteous Judge" - Amen.

on June 9, 1967, Pertamukilalam had its first mission field in our organization. It was started in a village called Periya Malai. On the coming dates of June 8th and 9th (Saturday and Sunday), the Tamil Nadu zone workers are planning to gather at Perivamalai campus. Plan to participate in this Thanksgiving gathering.

We praise God for the contribution of all of you who are going and sending and supporting having the organization's motto "Go or Send" as your basis. God has given us visions and plans to meet Indians who are multi-lingual and have many great cultures who have not been met by the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Periyamalai was the first mission field that started as a prayer group and grew into an evangelical movement by some friends. Who could ignore this humble beginning? Accordingly, every year we remember the 9th of June as Periyamalai Day and give thanks to God.

The evangelical ministry that started in 1967 in a very backward village that never knew Jesus after listening to the yearning question of a mountain man that "wont you stay with us and proclaim Jesus Christ?" has now spread across 24 states in India. On June 9th. Perivamalai Mission will complete 57 years and it will be in Denkanikottai Region with 45 Churches. Here many ethnic people like Irular, Lingayat, Adi Dravida, Arunthathiyar, Vannivar, and Vellalar Gounder have heard the Gospel and got saved and are worshiping God together in the Churches. God, by His miracles and wonders, has freed everyone from the clutches of the evil one, opened their minds, granted salvation from sin, and elevated them to live with spiritual health and good recognition in the society. Today, our believers have accepted Christ as their personal Saviour for four generations and are living as witnesses in their areas and proclaiming Jesus. More than 27 of the children of our believers from our Periyamalai Region are serving God in the Northern India through our organization and through other organizations too. There are more than 55

people who are working with us as local evangelists.

The ministry in Periyamalai, which started in 1967, has grown into Tamil Nadu Zone and is functioning in three Regions. The Denkanikottai Region has been indigenised and the Churches are functioning on its own. The Vacation Bible School is self-sustaining, not relying on the aid from the organisation for congregational events, evangelism, and contributing to the needs of indigenous workers. Believers here are partners in our movement supporting the missionaries and the children from the field through their prayer and offerings.

In the Leadership Training Center, the formal training of the missionaries of the three Regions, the fasting prayers of the prayer group members and many other training are taking place. By 2030, we plan to evangelize 4,40,000 people, evangelize 880 villages, 88 worship groups, 44 Churches, 22 local evangelists and 22 full-time missionaries, and to add 4,400 people to the fold of Christ. Kindly pray for this.

The Names of God

ehovah-Shaphat: The name Jehovah-UShaphat derives its meaning from two Hebrew words, "Jehovah" and "Shaphat." Jehovah means "the self-existing one, I AM," while Shaphat means "to judge, to defend the cause of." When both these words come together, they form the name Jehovah-Shaphat, meaning "the Lord our judge," Therefore, this name is one of God's attributes that exemplifies His role as a divine judge. The Bible is full of stories of justice being delivered by God, from bringing down giants such as Goliath to punishing the oppressors of the Israelites. God's judgment is not arbitrary, but rather always serves a purpose. Furthermore. Jehovah-Shaphat is not only a judge but also a defender of the oppressed. We see this in Exodus 3:7, where He promises to rescue the Israelites from their oppressors.

Moreover, God's judgment is righteous and fair. This means that He judges based not only on actions but also on the intent behind those actions. God sees through to the heart of the matter. Therefore, as Christians, we can trust that when our case comes before God, He will judge righteously. Additionally, the name Jehovah-Shaphat reminds us that we don't have to take justice into our own hands. As Christians, we are called to forgive and love our neighbors, even those who have wronged us. Trusting God to be our judge allows us to let go of the need for revenge and to love our enemies, as instructed by Jesus in Matthew 5:44



Lastly, Jehovah-Shaphat gives us hope for the final judgment. As Christians, we believe that there will be a day when all things will be made right, and the righteous will be rewarded while the wicked will be punished. Believing in Jehovah-Shaphat allows us to hold on to this hope, even in the face of injustice in our world today. In conclusion, Jehovah-Shaphat is more than just a name; it's an attribute of God that speaks to His role as our judge and defender. This attribute gives us hope in the face of injustice and reminds us that we don't have to take matters into our own hands. Rather, we can trust God to judge righteously and deliver justice in His perfect timing. As Christians, let us find comfort in the name Jehovah-Shaphat and the promise of justice to come.

Jehovah-Tsidkenu: The name Jehovah-Tsidkenu appears only once in the Bible, in Jeremiah 23:6. In this passage, the prophet prophesies about the coming of the Messiah: "In His days Judah will be saved, and Israel will dwell safely; Now this is His name by which He will be called: Jehovah-Tsidkenu." The name itself is a compound word made up of two Hebrew words: Jehovah, the personal name of God, and Tsidkenu, which means righteousness. So what does it mean for God to be called the Lord our righteousness? It means that He is the source of our righteousness. Our

own attempts at righteousness are like filthy rags compared to the perfect righteousness of Jesus Christ. It is only through faith in Jesus Christ and His work on the cross that we can be declared righteous before God. In other words, God is our righteousness because He is the one who provided it when He became flesh and died for our sins.

But it goes beyond that. Not only does God provide righteousness for us, but He also empowers us to live righteously. Through the Holy Spirit, we can walk in righteousness, not as a means of earning God's favor but as a natural response to the grace that has been given to us. 2 Corinthians 5:21 says, "For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him." Through our union with Christ, we are made new creations, and we can now walk in the righteousness that He has given us. Furthermore, the name Jehovah-Tsidkenu

reminds us that our righteousness is not our

own but Christ's. We can boast in the fact that we have been clothed in His righteousness. but we must also recognize that it came at a great cost. The perfect, sinless Son of God took on our sin and became sin for us so that we could be made righteous in Him. When we understand the gravity of what Christ has done for us, it should humble us and cause us to live our lives in reverence and holy fear of God. In conclusion, the name Jehovah-Tsidkenu is a beautiful reminder of the righteousness that we have been given through Christ. It reminds us that our own attempts at righteousness are futile and that our only hope is in the perfect righteousness of Christ. It also reminds us that our righteousness is not our own but that of Jesus Christ, and that we must live our lives in gratitude and reverence for what He has done for us. May we always remember that "in Him we live and move and have our being" (Acts 17:28) and that it is only through Him that we can be declared righteous before God.

(Missionary's Son)

Samuel Johson was born in 1979 to FMPB Missionaries Late Rev K Israel and Mrs. Uttamsri who hail from Andhra Pradesh. He did his schooling in Yatvamal, along with other missionaries' kids away from parents, BCA in Nandyal then MBA from Karunya University, Coimbatore and PHD from VIT University. Was a diligent son, went on a 2nd hand bicycle for his college, during his BCA, worked hard for his Interview and jobs by supporting himself during those days.



Dr. Samuel Johnson was working as an Assistant Director - Centre for Teaching and Learning - CTL - VIT-AP University and also as a Faculty with VIT-AP School of Business (VSB). Johnson was passionate about education and was a renowned coach, corporate trainer and advisor specially focusing on digital education, e-learning and faculty development. Johnson was a strong supporter of FMPB and took multiple other mission initiatives both nationally and internationally. He was a vibrant personality and was well known for his ability to connect with people from all walks of life and provide career guidance and encouragement to many who lacked direction and clarity in their early education and career. Johnson was a responsible son who took care of his parents and family members and always was proud of their work for God and supported their ministry. On 25th April early morning Johnson had his sudden home call due to health reasons. Mr Joel Selwyn (Missionary's Son)



Mr. Joel, the son of our late senior missionaries Mr. Chellappa and Mrs. Shantha Chellappa, passed away on 2/5/2024, Joel was born on 31/12/1968. He had a deep desire to serve God and was passionate about video coverage and music industry. In 2000, while working in Chennai, he suffered a heart attack. Following this, he worked for a period at the Trichy FMPB Mobilization office along with his wife, Shanthi. Joel took a keen interest in the SCAN ministry and established a shop with the intention of distributing Gospel tracts to customers. Unfortunately, on the day the shop opened, he suffered a stroke. Despite nerve damage, he received

treatment and recovered. Subsequently, he engaged in village ministry in Thuraiyur for a brief period. On his birthday in 2013, Joel experienced another stroke, leading him to become bedridden. Medical intervention enabled his recovery, but he faced another period of being bedridden in 2021 due to gallstones. In 2024, he was hospitalized due to breathing difficulty caused by mucus buildup in his lungs, Sadly, on 2nd May 2024, he suffered a fatal heart arrest, Even during his illness, Joel remained devoted to family prayer, Zoom prayer meetings, and expressed his devotion to God through songs. A BEETLE IN THE HAND OF GOD



Thomas Alexander Lambie was a missionary medical doctor who became an Ethiopian citizen, being responsible for several early medical efforts in Ethiopia. He was born in 1885, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, United States. He was a devout Presbyterian and went out to Africa under the United Presbyterian Mission Board to the Anglo-Egyptian Sudan in 1907. While passing through Alexandria, Egypt, he met a lovely, young, single lady missionary, Charlotte Claney, whom he married a few years later. He worked as a medical missionary with his family in Sudan among the Nuer and Anuak people, and then sailed through Baro River into Ethiopia in 1918, becoming the first American missionaries in Ethiopia.

His Ministry:

While on the Sobat, relatively close to the Ethiopian border, he felt the call of God to evangelize that great closed country. He settled just inside the "back door" of Ethiopia for a few years and then pressed on to Addis (the capital and largest city of Ethiopia). Early in the 1920s, Dr. Lambie, with wife and team, were trekking by mule from the south of Ethiopia toward Addis Ababa through dangerous territory ruled by local warlords and robber bands. Wakened one night, they were confronted with a large band of heavily armed men. Their chief Ras Tessema Nadew was in great distress. An insect had gotten into his ear, and he was sure it would kill him. Dr. Lambie was able to remove the offending beetle, much to the relief of the chief who was certain that if it had not been removed. it would hav e bored right through his head causing death.

Later this chief Ras Tessema became Lambie's escort to Addis Ababa, where he introduced him to his cousin Ras Tafrai, Regent to the empress who later took the title of Haile Salassie, the emperor of Ethiopia. Lambie became a friend and confidant of the emperor. So it was that a small rhinoceros beetle helped open Ethiopia to the Gospel.He labored under very difficult circumstances in Ethiopia for a number of years and learned some very valuable lessons both in regard to the medical work and church planting. He said "I have always felt that for the missionary doctor, prayer is at least equal in importance to sterile instruments. Prayer is no substitute for shoddy work, but I would as soon operate without prayer as I would without boiling my instruments or putting on rubber gloves." He saw the importance of not pauperizing the natives; so fees were charged for the medical work, even if it was a goat or grain from their fields. When it came to church buildings, he learned that "A simple building erected by the converts themselves is ten times better than an exotic structure erected for them with funds sent from England or America."

His achievements:

When the Lambie family traveled to Addis Ababa, Ras Tafari requested that Dr. Lambie build a hospital there, offering him a land of 12 acres in size at Gullele outside the city. Upon his return to the United States, Dr. Lambie approached his board for help with this endeavor. Although they recognized the need for a hospital the board was unable to provide him with the necessary funds, which led Lambie to embark on a fund-raising tour of his country. God met this need

through a successful businessman W.S. George in a small town in Ohio, who provided him with US\$ 70,000 to build the hospital. Construction on the hospital began in 1922, which became the biggest building in Ethiopia at the time. In 1932, Dr. Lambie built a leprosy hospital on the edge of Addis Ababa, . At the urging of Ras Kassa, Dr. Lambie investigated building a hospital in Lalibela in 1934, but the outbreak of the war prevented this.

His final days:

Dr. Lambie left Ethiopia; because he had acquired Ethiopian citizenship in order to own the property his hospital was built. He went on to work in Nigeria, Sudan, and in Palestine where he built the 90 bed Berachah Tuberculosis Sanitarium in Bethlehem and started Baraka Bible Presbyterian Church, Bethlehem in 1953. For a number of years Dr. Lambie had been the invited preacher for the sunrise service held on Easter Sunday at the Garden Tomb iust outside Jerusalem. On Good Friday in 1954. Dr. Lambie went to the Garden to meditate upon the message he would bring the following Resurrection Sunday morning, and there he died of a heart attack. He died at Christ's tomb, on April 14, 1954. If God could use such trivial animals such as fish and Rhinoceros Beetles to fulfil His purpose in Nineveh and a to Ethiopia. God use His specially created such as you and I to fill this Nation with the Gospel.

Missionary Biography

Early Days:

Chellappa Gnanasekaran S. born on 11.02.1937 in Karur. His parents were Mr. Swamidoss and Mrs. Inbam. His parents were teachers. Mr. Chellappa had five siblings, four elder brothers and one younger brother. Though born in a devoted Christian family, he never bothered to establish a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and so he lived a life of shallow faith. It is said that his immoral friends were the cause for Mr. Chellappa failing to develop a close relationship with Jesus Christ. He was attracted to worldly pleasures. Since his parents were teachers, they made him undergo teacher training and soon he became a teacher

Salvation and Marital life:

Mr. Chellappa tied the knot to Hepzibah Santhakumari on 16.09.1966. Santhakumari's parents Mr. Manickam and Mrs. Rukmani were residents of Musiri. Sister Santhakumari worked as a typist with the Government. Her parents embraced Christianity giving up their old religion. Mrs. Santhakumari was a Christian by name only. The newly married couple Mr. Chellappa and Mrs. Santhakumari started their family life residing in Karur. Though happiness prevailed in their life, they did not enjoy the desired life of contentment. On 10.06.1972, Mr. Chellappa had decided to see a movie in a cinema hall. He had

to cross the CSI school campus where a Christian Spiritual Convention was being held. He just entered the school to observe what had been going on. He thought that he could enjoy some fun there; but soon he was listening to the message seriously. It was the day, appointed by God in the life of Mr. Chellappa. Bro. Emil Jebasingh, the then General Secretary of FMPB was sharing God's message with the participants of the convention. The message did attract Mr. Chellappa and he gave his ears to the message with all seriousness. The Holv Spirit made Mr. Chellappa understand that he had been a sinner. On realizing that Christ alone was the saviour, he confessed his sins and received forgiveness for his sins. Mr. Chellappa returned home joyously. At home, the Holy Spirit reminded Mr. Chellappa of Ephesians 2:1-8. At this juncture, Mr. Chellappa realized the fact that he had led a sinful life and so he committed himself to holy life.

Mrs. Santhakumari was also a nominal Christian. In April 1972, she had the privilege of attending Gideonite camp conducted by FMPB in Karur. Mr. P. Samuel was the chief speaker. Mrs. Santhakumari listened to the evening message by P. Samuel and committed her life to Jesus Christ and accepted his lordship. She gave the prime place to Christ in her life and decided to live for Christ alone.

Call to Ministry:

Being born in a Christian family, Mr. Chellappa used to accompany the Gospel Team. This habit accelerated his interest towards proclaiming Good News. In 1973, Mr. Chellappa attended the youth camp held at Hare's Island. (Muyal Theevu near Tuticorin). God intervened in his life. During the evening message, the Lord God spoke to him through II Timothy 4:9: 2:15.19 and as a result he committed his life to ministry. To confirm his calling, he prayed and read the Bible. God again intervened through I Thessalonians. 5:24; I Timothy 6:12; Il Timothy 4:5. Mr. Chellappa and his wife Mrs. Santhakumari decided to commit their lives to God that evening.

Ministry through FMPB:

Mr. Chellappa's family joined FMPB in March 1975. They were sent to the Treasurer's Office in Veerapandianpattinam and then to Gujarat to minister among Thodia People Group In July 1976. They reached Dharampur field in Gujarat. They completed linguistic training in Gujarathi and started ministering there. Many people came to the fold through their

ministry and declared their faith in Jesus Christ through baptism from 1977. During the baptism service held on 31.07.1978 at Panikadag village, many people accepted the Lordship of Jesus Christ.

The family was sent to Bethel Bible College in Danishpet, Salem for a short term course in Theology in July 1979, and they completed the course in May 1980. Mr. Chellappa was caught in a minor accident and underwent treatment and got healed. After medical leave, he was sent to Vyara. Later he was placed in Soneghat. Again he was transferred to Vyara and he worked in the field office from February 1983 onwards; he took charge of the field development Ministry In 1985: later he was transferred to Coimbatore. He worked with mission vision mobilization and so he had to visit churches in Coimbatore to make them aware of the Missionary work, prayers and prayer groups. From April 1988, he worked with the communication department in the Headquarters in Chennai for a few years.

Final Days:

Mr. Chellappa had been undergoing medical treatment in the hospital for a while because of sickness. After being healed, he continued the ministry in Chennai. On 12.03.1996, he suffered a heart attack and passed away at 7:30 a.m. The funeral service was held at CSI St. James' Church, Ayanavaram. His mortal remains were laid to rest at Kilpauk cemetery.

Let us praise and thank God for enabling Mr. Chellappa Gnanasekaran to complete the race successfully.

BEGINNING

The Denkanikottai mission field was opened in April 1983 and Mr. V Thomas and Mrs. Vasantha Thomas were the first missionaries of this field. The Gospel seed was sown at Anusonai village many times by the workers of God but the first fruit appeared in 1983 when Mr. Venugopal from Anusonai village experienced a miracle in his life.

The miracle experienced by Mr. David Venugopal is narrated in his own words



"I am David Venugopal from Anusonai village. I accepted Christ in 1983 through the missionary, Mr. V Thomas. Earlier, many

preached the Gospel in our village but I did not accept Christ then. We were running a tea shop at our village. One of my hands was paralyzed so I was lying on a cot outside the shop. Missionary Mr. V Thomas came to drink tea in our shop. He saw me and shared the Gospel of Christ. My heart was filled with joy when I heard the Gospel and the disability in my hand got well. Thomas annan told us to come to the church on Sunday if we were interested. My mother brought injection from Bangalore regularly. That day, she asked me to take the injection but I declined telling that I already got healed. The next day morning my mother insisted the same but I gave the same reply. Earlier due to the pain in my hand I used to consume alcohol every day. But after I got healed I stopped drinking. From that Sunday on, our whole family (I, my mother, wife and children) attended the church at Kelamangalam regularly. My whole family took baptism at Bettamugilalam.

As I was from Lingayat community, I was also the Hindu priest at Ram and Hanuman temples for two to three villages. After

accepting Christ, I stopped doing pooja. God saw and gave me a railway job in 1984. We did not have any lands before but God helped us to purchase later".

Mr. Ramamurthy Matthew



I am from Anusonai village. In 1995 my mother got me enrolled in a Christian hostel at Hosur, During a vacation, when I came home I fell sick. My mother took me to the government hospital where the doctors advised her to take me to a private hospital. She did not have money, she did not know what to do. Though I studied in a Christian hostel. I did not know about Christ because I was a small boy then. A believer told my mother about Christ and asked her to pray to Jesus. By then my stomach had swollen and I was not able to excrete. My mother prayed to Jesus and God healed me miraculously. So my mother accepted Christ and after her I too accepted Christ, I took baptism at Anusonai church. I got married to a Hindu girl but she too accepted Christ after marriage".

Mr. Chandran



"I am Chandran from Chikkanakunta village near Anusonai. After my marriage there was frequent quarreling in our house. A friend of mine named Ankarai told about Jesus. He led me to the AG church at Kelamangalam. I regularly started attending the worship there and I accepted Christ and took baptism. But my wife did not participate in the worship. One day I came to Anusonai for a construction work. I developed chest pain then. Immediately I came to this church and prayed to the Lord and received healing. After that when I went to the AG church I was remembering this church only. So I started attending the worship here and it was nearby too. My wife was refusing to attend the worship but I prayed to the Lord for her and as days went by she too accompanied me to the worship. She too accepted Christ and took baptism at FMPB church. She was baptized by pastor Raniith Kumar."

CHURCH GROWTH

The early believers of Anusonai were attending the church at Kelamangalam which was 6 kilometers away from Anusonai village. In June 1984 a worshiping group was started at Anusonai at the house of the first believer, Mr. David Venugopal. The worship was started by missionary, Mr. V Thomas. There were 10 participants. The Anusonai believers took their neighbours who were under bondage and ailments to the prayer meetings where they experienced miraculous healing and deliverance. In November 1988 Missionary, Mr. Raian Andrews took charge of Denkanikottai mission field after the transfer of Mr. V Thomas.

Denkanikottai field bifurcated

In August 1989 missionary Mr. Paul Nagarajan was posted at Denkanikottai field in the place of Mr. Rajan Andrews. In August 1991, Denkanikottai field was bifurcated into two as Kelamangalam field and Denkanikottai field. Mr. Paul Nagarajan took charge of Kelamangalam field under which the Anusonai church was funtioning.

THE CHURCH LAND AND CONSTRUCTION

The first believer, Mr. David Venugopal had a strong desire to have a church at his own village. Anusonai as it was difficult to attend the church at Kelamangalam due to less bus facility. In 1999, he donated his 10 cents land to FMPB. The Anusonai congregation members are from Anusonai and Chikkanakunta villages. The members are from Lingavat and Adi Dravidar communities. The Church is named as Christ Church. The foundation was laid in 1999. It is a pucca church with ACC roof of size: 40X20 ft. It was dedicated on 5.12.1999 by Rev. John Kirubakaran, the then Regional Secretary, Rev. Varadharajan and field missionary Rev. Paul Nagarajan were also present. Nearly 150 people were present during the church dedication ceremony. On 14.1.2009 prayer was offered and bore well was dug at Anusonai church. Thus the water needs of the Anusonai church is being met. Approximately 110 people took baptism under Anusonai church.

Opposition

As the climate was summer during the church construction, the flooring work was done at night. So the villagers claimed

that the work stealthily and started using abusive language against Mr. Venugopal. In the morning, Mr. Paul Nagarajan and the believers filed a complaint at the police station and the opposite party gave in writing that they would not disturb further. The stones that was kept for making the boundary wall were stolen at night. Twelve families living around the church opposed the church construction. They tried to stop the labourers from doing the work.

Prayer Points

- Pray for the first believer's son who backslid from faith to return back to the Lord.
- 2. Pray for all the backsliders who were baptized in the name of our Triune God from Anusonai church to be restored in Christian faith
