

The Mind of the Clay

"Oh, it's painful, don't take all this, don't step on me, my head is spinning, everything is blurry. No



fire!"-this may be the cry of a clay from the potter's backyard. To an observer, it might seem that choosing this clay would only bring suffering. However, the potter reassures, "I am handling you carefully. I have placed you on the wheel where you are being shaped. You are becoming beautiful and soft. It is my duty to protect you from cracking under pressure and from getting charred in the fire."The voice of the finished potteries coming from the room where they are displayed to be sold, conveys his care. Every action of the potter caused pain and agony to me, but today, I have transformed into something beautiful and soft. It is satisfying to think that I will soon be of use to someone.

Reflecting on this transformation, the clay's heart swells with gratitude. The potter found this once useless clay and patiently worked on, step by step, making it beautiful. Many such voices can be heard in that room. As Isaiah 64:8 reads, "We are the clay, You are the potter; we are all the work of Your hand." Yes! The Lord molds us. The Lord made David a significant king, taking him from tending the sheep. He chose David from the family that neglected him, allowed challenges from people like Saul, and developed in him the character of a great warrior, leader, and king who depended on the Lord in all his doings. That's why David writes in many of his psalms, "Praise be to the Lord who thinks of me in my low estate, who redeemed me from a miry clay." When David reflects on the fact that the Lord created the entire world and still remembers a man who is like a mere dot within it, he can't help but ask, "What is man that You are mindful of him?" (Psalm 8:4-9). Whether we think and plan for us or not, God is so mindful of us, plans and executes His will for us and through us.

God's blessings should lead us not to greed but to obedience and humility. When we act in accordance with the Lord's will, God is pleased and glorified. When we go through difficult situations, just like the clay, we might feel immense pain and it might seem unbearable. However, God is shaping us not to break us but to mold us into useful vessels for His purpose. Just as the clay undergoes transformation in the potter's hands, God is creating us to be useful and honourable vessels. Let us continue to accept His molding until we become beautiful and honourable vessels fit for His use. May the Lord Himself break us, shape us and make us useful vessels for many. Amen!

FROM THE GENERAL SECRETARY...

Dear Partners in the mission of reaching the unreached,

Next to June the Periyamalai Day, July is an important month in the history of Friends Missionary Prayer Band, because it is in this month, FMPB set its foot in North India in the year of 1971. It is true that multitudes in large part of North India is still longing to know the Saviour who would save them and provide eternal life. At the same time God blessed the faith of our first North Indian missionaries Rev. Y.Hilkiah and Mrs. Daisy Hilkiah who set their feet in Basti on 23rd of July 1971. Who am I to be blessed by the Lord

he theme selected for the Tamil Nadu Annual State Conference 2024 is "Who am I"? God blessed David saving-"When your days are over and you rest with your ancestors. I will raise up your offspring to succeed you, your own flesh and blood, and I will establish his kingdom. He is the one who will build a house for my Name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever", 2 Samuel 7:12,13. David humbly replied to God saying, "...Who am I, Sovereign LORD, and what is my family, that you have brought me this far?" 2Samuel 7:18. David who was very successful in his life also faced many ups and downs. He who touched great heights also went down to the depths of sins. We read in 2 Samuel 7:1 & 2- that "when the king sat in his house, and the Lord had given him rest from all his enemies; That the king said unto Nathan the prophet, see now. I dwell in a house of cedar, but the ark of God dwelleth within curtains". See where the thoughts of David wander off as he rests in his house. He worries that he, being a mere human, lives in a house decorated with Cedar, whereas the Ark of God dwells between the curtains. He longingly questions himself as of when he will build a temple for the Lord. When God rescues us from our difficulties and meets all our needs, we do not think of God but only of ourselves.

Christians Today, are attracted bv Prosperity Preaching. What is Prosperity Preaching, it is - God, I Praise you because you made me dwell in Peace and I praise you because you blessed me with a house of Cedar, but God this is still not enough for me. I need a gold-plated house, because I am a child of the King and you grant me whatever I ask. And the one who makes me flourish is you. "Why has the ministrial burden and missionary visions decreased in today's churches? Why has the ministrial sacrifices gone down? Why has the number of youngsters committing to the ministry declining?" if we ask questions as such, we find that there could be many other reasons to this. Though there are multiple other reasons, the major reason for this is wrong teachings. It has entered the church and is destroving it like cancer. God does bless us, True!



In Genesis12:2-3, God said to Abraham: "I will make you into a great nation, and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you and whoever curses you I will curse; and all peoples on earth will be blessed through you". Today, we have forgotten that we should be a blessing to the church and the nation; and the burden for ministry has diminished. We expect all the blessings to be ours. When we figure out from where does this wrong mindset originates, we conclude that there may be two reasons - 1. God's blessing is worldly materials 2. God's blessing is meant only for me.

Since people believe that God's blessings are just worldly and physical, they tend to move from church to church and change from one pastor to another. They also look for powerful missionaries and run after them. God's blessings are not just materialistic and physical. Of course, God provides us with worldly blessings, but God's blessings should not be used only for our selfishness.

God blesses us in our spiritual life. He sanctifies us with his spirit. He inspires us with His Words and gives us visions through our prayers. But we do not consider these as blessings because we were not taught in such a way. God's blessing is that "You'll be a blessing to the world". In today's Christian life we either forget or are made to forget about the spiritual blessing.Today scenario as we lack leaders to teach the Bible correctly, So our prayers have become selfish like- "God Bless me, my family and my generation". God's blessing is granted to us so that it could be passed on to other people through us and that we might be a blessing to others. God blessed David, but then David did not think of building an even bigger house for himself instead he was worried that the Ark of God was in a tent and why isn't a temple built for the glory of God. Even at this moment his thoughts were towards God. When God blesses us, we should think of others who are in need.

Christian life must be Jesus centred, less of self and more of others: by doing so we receive great happiness. David 's heart was burdened about building a Tabernacle for God even when God blessed him. Today God still searches for such burdened hearts about the kingdom of God in us. There are still people in our country who have not heard of our Lord even once. Jesus Christ said this as His last command - "Go ve therefore, and teach all nations. baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost". Matthew 28:19. And in verse 18 He says - "All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth". We need to understand that authority. God did not call us to serve an ordinary man. Today the burden for souls and the swiftness for ministry has been decreasing gradually in the churches. Are there any programs that telecast God's work in the Christian TV channels that broadcast programs round the clock? Only programs on personal blessings is being broadcast. Where is Christianity heading towards? We are called by God to bring revival into our churches. We are certainly ordinary people but we are called to shake the nations, spread the Gospel and to serve the King of Kings.

"When I was studying Theology in Kentucky, I was so desperate to know when my studies would get completed and when I would go preach and serve the Lord. I wanted to win souls for the Lord. My favorite animal is Horse. Whenever I see horses in Kentucky, I used to imagine myself as a Black horse wanting to achieve something for the Lord. But felt as thou there was a rope tied to my neck. I wished to cut the rope on my own effort and run. On a Palm Sunday, during the service the Bible passage read was that Jesus said to his disciples, "Untie the colt(donkev)". Then God spoke to me saying, "I will untie you when my time comes. Do not think of yourself as a majestic horse, I just want you to be an ordinary donkey who can carry me".

When that donkey carried Jesus, many people spread their garments on the way; and others cut down branches of the trees, and spread them on the way and cried "Hosanna!!". The Lord said to me, "You are just as this donkey that carries me and whatever is done by the people on the street is not being done for you but for me." Today many preachers are misled because they do not have a clear understanding about this. The donkey will not be valued once Jesus gets down from it. God has given us an opportunity to carry Him and his Gospel into the world. As David surrendered himself in front of God saying , "Who am I ,Lord" ; let us also humble ourselves and say, "I surrender myself as a donkey who will carry you and spread your Gospel throughout the nation". The same God who blessed the nations through Abraham wants to bless this nation through us. Let us commit ourselves into God's hands to live for God and not for our own self. May the Lord bless each one of us

God's children started on May 15 towards Bethel as families and individuals in trains, buses. special vehicles, and their own vehicles. All of them were warmly welcomed by the Chennai Redhills Area Leaders and Volunteers. who were responsible for Registration and accommodation. Bethel Campus was adorned with Bible verses which captured the hearts of everyone. The hand-painted paintings. ethnic details and pictures of people groups, and biographies of the missionaries made by the hard efforts of Missionary Artist Mr. Y. Navaneethar Annan had been placed throughout the main hall challenged all the participants.

On May 16, the inaugural program of the Tamil Nadu Annual State Conference began with prayer. The Madurai Music Group, led by Mr. E. D. A. John Berlin, introduced the Bishop of Gujarat Diocese and the Bishop declared open the conference and brought greetings from the Diocese. Rev. S. Ravikumar beautifully introduced the theme "Who am I" from 2 Samuel 7:18 with "An Earthen Vase Speaks". Bethel Executive Director Mr. L. Ebenezer welcomed the participants with warm greeting. The pen drive containing the songs produced on the theme was introduced by the Secretary Communication Department Mrs. Mercy Selwyn and was dedicated by President C. Reginald and the first copy was received by the Bishop of Guiarat Diocese. The missionaries who had completed their service in FMPB were felicitated and commemorative gifts were



given. Our missionaries who have fought the good fight and have gone to be with the Lord were remembered in prayers. The presence of the Santhal believers from Jharkhand, Sikh believers from Punjab, the young people from Alapally hostel in Maharashtra, our missionary family from Himachal Pradesh, and our jailed missionary family from Uttar Pradesh made the conference a special one. The procession of our field believers and missionaries in their spectacular cultural costumes from different parts of India cheered the 3159 people gathered in the meeting hall.

The first message on the opening day was given by Dr. V. C. T. Prabusingh. He shared David's longing to do something for the Lord when everything was perfect and encouraged the people to decide to do something for the Lord. After lunch, separate meetings were held for youth, teenagers and children, 517 youth and 708 Teens participated in it. The cultural dance and testimony sharing by the Santhal believers thrilled everyone in a gathering of 1.569 adults. During the evening Sandhya meeting, the testimonies of our believers' children from Alapally glorified God. Navaneethar Annan's Light and Sound program captured the challenging work of our missionaries and the commitment of our believers. At the end of each meeting, the counselling team under Mr. A. P. Kanagarai counselled and guided those who accepted the altar call

On May 17, the second day of the camp, was observed as the "Fasting and Prayer Day". All the participants fasted and prayed with tears for the nation and for our ministry. Cultural program and ministry sharing by the Santhal and Sikh believers encouraged for more prayers. The challenges in our Himachal ministry added weight to the prayers. Our jailed missionary's sharing from Uttar Pradesh



moved everyone to tears. Dr. V. C. T. Prabhu Singh's stirring message in the evening led many to commit themselves to the Lord's ministry.

On May 18, the third day of the camp, Rev. D. Paul Solomon's message on call during Action Hour, helped many to commit. The people were then divided into districts, and the planning for the financial year 2024-2025 went on very well with the leaders and supporters from their respective areas.

In the afternoon, the staff and volunteers from various departments in our organization shared their work experiences and the important tasks we still need to accomplish as an organization, which gave everyone much to consider. This year, there was a special gathering for newly married couples. Rev. S. Emmanuel Raniitsingh and Mrs. Vasanthi Emmanuel gave excellent presentation on family life which served as a perfect guide for the participating couples. To all gathered on the beautiful grassy hill at dusk, the General Secretary, Rev. S. John Berlin, delivered the Word of God with deep devotion, accompanied by the Spirit. Many tearfully rededicated themselves to the Lord.

The last day of the camp, May 19, began at 4:30 am with a Holy Communion service. Many were seated in the Lord's presence with great desire. President, Mr. C. Reginald,

delivered a divine message that deeply impressed everyone. After this, SCAN session was held at 9 am, in which Rev. S. Daniel Thomas shared the Word of the Lord. The camp concluded heartily with lunch.

During this camp, teenagers, youth and children set up many prayer stations and prayed earnestly. It was an unforgettable event when 45 children skipped two meals and prayed on the day of fasting and prayer. In the youth meeting, 106 people accepted Jesus Christ as their Savior and 61 youth dedicated themselves to full-time ministry. God also graced the birth of 128 new youth prayer groups. 46 teenagers dedicated themselves to full-time ministry and 93 teen prayer groups were formed, contributing Rs. 7.855/- as donations. In the children's meeting, 93 children accepted Christ as their personal Savior for the first time. Additionally, 124 children committed themselves to pray for the nation and for the missionaries, and six of them dedicated themselves to fulltime ministry. Special counselling hours were provided to parents of the children. This year. 15 children returned the money filled hundies and 18 new hundies were issued.

The Camp Convenor Mr. P. Devaraj, the Coordinator Prof. J. Arulraj Daniel, the Camp Treasurer Mr. M. Prince Muthuraj, the Joint Treasurer Mr. N. Edison Ratnam and Mr. D. Allen & Mr. S. Dhanasingh, along with many volunteers worked together wholeheartedly for the success of this year's state conference. We express our heartfelt gratitude and appreciation to all of them.

Rev. Ram Singh Bhai Vasava (1957 - 2024)

Rev. Ram Singh Bhai Vasava was born on June 16, 1957, in the village of Samarpada, Walia Taluka, Baruch District, Gujarat. His parents passed away when he was just four years old. While attending St. Xavier High School, he learned a little about Jesus Christ. Without the opportunity for college education, he took on the responsibility of managing agriculture in his village.

In 1980, when the Gospel was preached in Samarpada village through the FMPB, Ramsingh, who had been living a restless life, accepted God as his Savior. After completing his twelfth standard, he secured a government job as a writer. However, he declined the job and, in 1981, joined pioneer workers Rev. John Paul Dhanasingh and missionary Rev. Nesamony in village-tovillage evangelistic work as a volunteer. From 1982 to 1989, he worked as a local evangelist in Chakra, Dediapada, Gujarat. On January 28, 1986, he married Urmila Ben and they were blessed with four daughters-Preeti, Pragati, Sara, Ringo-and a son Ashish John. In 1989, he became a full-time missionary and underwent a oneyear ministry training at Yavatmal. He then served from 1993 to 1994 at the Gopalgani field in Bihar and from 1995 to 1999 at the Dhadqaon in Maharashtra, After 1999, he continued his ministry at Selamba, Mosali, Valiva, Karot and Kosamba fields in Gujarat. Rev. Ram Singh was deeply dedicated and formed many worship groups wherever he worked. He tirelessly pursued God's work until his retirement on June 30, 2022. On June 8. 2024, he suffered a heart attack and entered the kingdom of God. Let us pray for the comfort of his wife, children, and family who are grieving his loss.

Testimonies about Rev. Ram Singh: Rev. Nesamony and Vasavi Bible translator Rev. S Rajendran testified to his dedication. Rev. Ram Singh, known for his hard work in ministry, often visited many villages on foot and by bicycle when there was no transport, preaching the gospel and leading many Vasava people to God. Mrs. Jeyaseeli Devadoss

Ms. Javaseeli Israel was a dedicated missionary who devoted her life to the people of the Kukna community in Guiarat State. Jayaseeli was born on June 23, 1957, as one of four children to Mrs. Sundari and Mr. Vedamuthu, a Sub-Inspector from Manarkaadu, a village in Tirunelveli District of South Tamil Nadu, From an early age, she lived a life pleasing to her parents and the Lord. While studying at school, Javaseeli loved to tell her fellow students about Jesus. She accepted Jesus as her personal Savior during a conformation class in her eleventh grade. Inspired by a spiritual gathering about the need for evangelism. Javaseeli dedicated herself to evangelism. After completing her schooling, she learnt typing and, in 1977, ioined FMPB as a full-time missionary. She was sent to Allahabad in Uttar Pradesh for initial training. On May 27, 1977, she married Mr. Israel Devadoss and moved to Pippalwada village to carry out missionary work among the Kukna people living in the Dang district of Gujarat. At that time, the area had colorful bamboo houses scattered in the forest where fierce tigers roamed, and the people lacked electric transport and medical facilities.

Mrs. Jayaseeli began evangelizing with her husband in ancient villages where the villagers were controlled by sorcerers and village leaders. Because of her fervent prayer, the Spirit of God performed miracles, and people began to accept Jesus in great numbers. Today, more than 45 thousand Kukna people accepted God and worship Him in hundreds of congregations because of the foundation laid by Mrs. Jayaseeli and Rev. Israel Devadoss. In 1989, they went to the UBS College of Theology in Pune for further studies in theology and continued their ministry at the leadership training center started at Pippalwada. After being in charge of the National Missionaries Training Center at Jhansi for a while, they completed the work and returned to Pippalwada, Guiarat, It was her custom to accompany her husband on his mission trips and meet the village women alone to hear their problems and pray with them. Mrs. Jayaseeli was known for treating everyone who came to the training center with a warm and welcoming demeanor.

She finally worked at the Field office and retired in 2022, living with her daughter. She suffered from poor health and entered into God's eternal rest on June 11, 2024. God blessed this missionary family with two daughters, Grace and Glory, and two sons, James and Noah. All are married and living as witnesses to God. Let us praise God for Mrs. Jayaseeli's beautifully devoted life and pray for the comfort of her children and grandchildren.

DOLYAMBAR CHURCH HISTORY

South West Region II, Western Zone, Gujarat

General Information: Dolyambar is a medium size village located in The Subir taluka of The Dangs district, Gujarat. The village comes under Malga panchayat. Ahwa is the sub district head quarter and the distance from the village is 50 km. District head quarter of the village is Ahwa which is 50 km away.

The Beginning: On 8-5-1981, L. Masilamani, his wife Mrs. Vanmathi and their first son M. John Kingsly (two years and eight months old) opened the Ahwa field by going and settling in a rented house in Pipaldahad village. While doing ministry they found out that there was a good receptivity in the nearby Junner village and they moved to Junner village on 30-11-1981. Mr. Sampat Bhai was recruited as an evangelist to work in Ahwa field (it was called as Pipaldahad field in the beginning) and he came to Junner on 3-5-1982. Sick people from nearby villages came to Junner and got healed through the prayers of the missionaries and the evangelist.

The first believer from Dolyambar village: Manu Bhai Bhavdu Bhai Umarshala from Dolyambar village was in dire need of healing from his sickness. His witness:



"My name is Manu Bhai Bhavdu Bhai. I am living in Dolyambar village. I was suffering from chest and throat pain and there was always a burning sensation. I was admitted in one hospital in Bardoli city. There was no improvement. Then I was put in a Peer shrine (Muslim holy man's tomb) in Mahuva town, later in Peer shrine in Ambala city for 52 days, did traditional bhakti by offerings to the spirits through the bhagats and my relatives too did the puias to please the spirits by sacrifices of cocks, goats etc. In-spite of doing so many things and spending thousands of rupees I was not healed. Then all the family members began to think and decided to try the Christian faith. One person named Sakkaram from our village told me that the Christians are doing ministry in Junner village and there is a Church. So I went to that Church on one Sunday and participated in the meeting. Evangelist Sampat Bhai and missionary L. Masilamani prayed for me. I got the healing through their prayers. From that day onwards I and all my family members have become Christians. We were added to the fold of Jesus at Junner village on 4-7-1982."

The first meeting in Dolyambar village was conducted on 31-7-1982 in the house of village headman Motiram Bhai. Evangelist Sampat Bhai was conducting regular night meetings in that village. Six families were attending the Junner Church for Sunday services. These first believers helped the missionaries to continue the ministry by bringing them to their village after they were driven out of Junner village.

First Believer Testifving During the Enquiry Due to Opposition: One government primary school teacher named Arjun Bhai Choudhry instigated opposition for the Christian ministry in Junner village as nine children were taken to the Bethel hostel. The village headman mobilized severe opposition to the missionaries, the evangelist and the new Christians were Interrogated, Manu Bhai and his wife boldly testified for Christ in that meeting and told that they would bring the missionary family to their village if they are asked to leave Junner. The enquiry board ordered the missionaries and the evangelist to leave Junner village. So they left Junner on 30-8-1982 to Ahwa. God prepared the Dolyambar village headman to invite the missionaries to his village.

Dolyambar Village Headman Motiram Bhai Sukhirao Bhai Rathod's Testimony:



"My wife's name is Gangu Ben Motiram Rathod. She was suffering from physical and mental illnesses and she used to run away from people. I called religious priests called "bhagats" and offered goats, fowls, coconuts etc. I was trying to get healing for her through the shamans (diviners) for my wife. But she was not healed. My wife's relatives had become Christians in Borinapada village and they called her to the Church in Daher village. there through praver she was healed. Then I and my whole family believed in Jesus Christ, I heard through Manu Bhai of our village that missionaries are driven out from Junner village. So Manu Bhai and I invited missionary L. Masilamani family from Ahwa to our village to do the ministry from here in December 1982. I and my brother in law Bikhu Bhai used to accompany the missionary in going to other villages for ministry to give testimonies and to make known to others that once notorious Dolvambar people have become Christians and they are supporting the missionary ministry."

Missionaries Moving to Dolyambar Village: Missionaries left Junner and went to Dolyambar village on 12-3-1983. The Ahwa CNI Church pastor Rev. T. V. Gaikwad helped them much during the time of opposition. Missionaries got their accommodation in the veranda of the village headman's house in the beginning later in a room with goats on one side and cows and oxen on the other side. Their simple life appealed to the simple tribal people. They also did some medical ministry by attending to the immediate medical needs doing first aids for the Christians and the seekers. God did many miracles and many people believed in Jesus.

Church Growth: Dala Bhai from Varli tribe narrates his experience: "I studied from 8th standard to 10th standard in Pimpri Middle

school. During my 10th standard vacation in my village Dolyambar, I was healed from a swelling in my leg which had pus and gave a terrible pain and cried out of pain throughout the night. I called Vanmathi Masilamani, my sister Saru Ben and Rana Ben to pray for me. In the night missionary L. Masilamani too prayed for me. I was healed and was added to the flock of Jesus on 21-9-1985. I am doing God's ministry as an ordained Pastor with the Church of North India now."

Great harvest: On 24-10-1983, seven from Bombay Bhandup Tamil Methodist Church members came to Dolyambar for visiting the ministry of their sponsored missionary L. Masilamani. Bhajan Mandali went on from 8 p.m-7 a.m. Nearly 250 people attended. On 26-10-1983, under the leadership of Rev. S. Retnamoney and T.V. Gaikwad 75 people were added to the flock of Jesus. Families of Dolyambar village headman Motiram Bhai and his brother in law Bikku Bhai (Kharbari) took baptism. Nav Jeevan Seva Mandal (NSM) started literacy classes under the leadership of Rev. S. Arulraj in Dolyambar village.

Church Construction: Meetings were conducted in the house of Motiram Bhai. As the number of people increased they planned to build a Church in their village. Motiram Bhai donated the land for Church construction. People donated the wood, bamboo for the walls and gave free labour for the kacha Church construction. The local forest officer gave one tree to raise a cross flag on it. Dr. S. Devadoss hoisted the flag, dedicate this first Church on 27-6-19841 and was garlanded by the forester. More than 400 people gathered for the dedication function. CNI evangelist Madhukar M. Pawar (later ordained priest) led the bhajan meeting in the night.

Regional Field Secretary Rev. Johnson Barnabas dedicated the renewed Church. Pucca Church was planned during the time when D. Abraham was the field missionary. Motiram Bhai donated his land in another area and all the people worked freely for the Church construction. The measurement of the Church is 50 feet length and 25 feet wide. This Church was completed on 25-9-2007. The Church was dedicated on 19-10-2007. Rev. S. Arulrai came with a team and dedicated the Church. The believers were from Varli and Bhil People Groups. Mr. Jeyaram Bhai Motiram Bhai is the catechist in this Church. 60 to 90 persons attend the Church. Friday praver meeting in the night and Cottage praver meetings are conducted every Wednesday. There is no opposition. Manu Bhai from the beginning till the present time is the Church Elder. Dala Bhai and Sitaram Bhai who committed to become full time workers from this Church are pastors now. This Church was integrated with Church of

Church Dedication: This first Church

was renewed and dedicated on 22-4-1990.

This Church was integrated with Church of North India in April 2013 through a function held at Bardipada village in Pipalwada field. The process was started from 2004 with an agreement for gradual integration. In April 2013 the integration process was completed. The integrated Churches have come under the direct administration of the CNI diocese. The FMPB evangelists who are ordained by Gujarat CNI are the pastors of these Churches.

Prayer Request: The whole village to come to faith. The backslidden people should return to Christian faith. For the youth to be regular to the Church. Children of believers should have facilities for studies.
