BRING YOUR

e was a soldier who left the army due to ill health. Faced with a lack of education, addiction to alcohol, and poverty, he not only acted as a broker for his own sister to engage in wrongful activities but also went to jail multiple times for stealing. One day, perhaps drawn by an advertisement for free food at a church, he entered seeking sustenance. It was there that God intervened through Rev. Hammond's message. That day, he surrendered his life to Jesus. At one point, John G. Ridley, a minister, spoke from Isaiah 57:15, making the concept of "Eternity" clear to him. The word 'eternity' resonated deeply within him, and he felt compelled to share it with others. Despite being illiterate, he learned to draw the word "Eternity" and began painting it on shop doors, sidewalks, and parks when no one was around. The sight of the word sparked fear, conversation, and contemplation about eternity among those who saw it, preparing many for its significance. He painted the word "Eternity" throughout Australia to the extent that almost everyone became familiar with it. The message spread across the country, pointing to the truth that eternity can be reached through Jesus Christ. By the age of 35, he had painted the word over half a million times, later adding phrases like "Obey God" to further raise awareness. In honor of Arthur Malcolm Stace, the word "Eternity" was illuminated at the 2000 Olympics in Sydney, Australia. Additionally, a sample of his handwriting and a statue of him were erected, and the Australian people remember him gratefully.

God used Arthur and his small talent for painting, despite his many shortcomings, to bless many. In the scriptures, we see that a little food blessed thousands (the little boy with the loaves and fishes), a little strength (Gideon), a little flour (the widow of Zarephath), a little courage (David), and a little dedication (Samuel) all achieved impossible things. Today, whatever little we have-our time, talent, and treasure-God can use it mightily if we surrender it to Him. Many of us hesitate due to our perceived shortcomings, but when we place ourselves in His hands, He who is perfect will use us abundantly. Let us offer ourselves and all that we have to God, trusting that He will use it for His glory.

The Lord Who Fullfills the Needs

In many situations in our lives, we focus solely on our shortcomings. By dwelling on these inadequacy, it's natural to overlook the blessings we have. As Christians, we must remember that the Perfect One is with us. The Holy Scriptures frequently illustrates how God fulfills all our needs.

The Perfect One in Our Needs

"Here is a boy with five small barley loaves and two small fish, but how far will they go among so many?" (John 6:9). The disciples saw only the small quantity of food. The miracle of Jesus feeding 5,000 people with five loaves and two fish, mentioned in John 6:1-13, is recounted in all four Gospels. It's suggested that around 20,000 people might have been fed. Jesus Christ looked to the Father, who provides abundantly in times of need.

The God we worship created the entire world out of nothing. He is the same yesterday, today, and forever. He fulfills all the needs of His creation. Are five loaves and two fish enough for a family's dinner? Yet, when blessed, five thousand people ate to their satisfaction, and twelve baskets were left over. What seems small to human eyes becomes abundant in God's hands. We should never underestimate God's power and love.

A Hope in Our Needs

This miracle illustrates God's concern for our personal needs and the necessity of our faith in Him. God meets not only our physical needs but also our emotional and spiritual needs. Because His name is Jehovah Jireh, we must trust Him to provide. This miracle reassured the people and the disciples that God is in control and will provide for our needs.

According to John 6:9, our lives are in the hands of Jesus Christ. God can use us more than we can imagine. When we offer the little we have to God and wait with faith, He will multiply it abundantly, glorifying His name.

A Submission in Our Needs

In Mark 6:38, when Jesus told His disciples to see how much food was available, Andrew brought a boy to Jesus. No one knew about that boy until Jesus told His disciples to feed the people. The multitudes were filled when Jesus blessed the food brought by the boy and distributed it. When we surrender our lives, skills, talents, education, materials and ourselves to God, He can use us to establish His kingdom on earth.

A Miracle in the Midst of Needs

Moses said, "Here I am among six hundred thousand men on foot, and you say, 'I will give them meat to eat for a whole month!' Would they have enough if flocks and herds were slaughtered for them? Would they have enough if all the fish in the sea were caught for them?" The Lord answered Moses. "Is the Lord's arm too short? Now you will see whether or not what I say will come true for you." (Numbers 11:21-23). The Lord fed the people as He promised. Just as God performed many miracles in the Old Testament, Jesus Christ performed many in the New Testament. When there was inadequate wine at the wedding, Jesus provided much better wine than what had been served earlier (John 2:1-11).

A Prayer in the Midst of Needs

In 1999, while ministering in Ranipur, Chhattisgarh, a believer named Nirmalpada invited our family for lunch. After the ministry, ten people, including evangelists and church elders, joined us. The family hadn't expected such a large crowd. The wife prayed, recalling the miracle of Jesus feeding 5,000 people, which was mentioned in the previous week's church service. She prayed, believing God would satisfy everyone with what they had. God answered her prayer, and after everyone ate to their satisfaction, there were leftovers. She joyfully shared this miracle at the following Sunday service.

God has blessed us with physical and spiritual sustenance, forgiveness of sins, and eternal salvation. We must trust Him with all our hearts. Like the boy who gave his loaves and fish and the disciples who obeyed Jesus, we must submit ourselves to God and live in obedience to His Word. Often, we expect immediate solutions from the Lord. We must trust that God will make all things beautiful in His time. "The lions may grow weak and hungry, but those who seek the Lord lack no good thing." (Psalm 34:10).

Our Role Among the Shortcomings

Today, many around us suffer from physical and spiritual hunger. While many are ready to address physical hunger, few can satisfy spiritual hunger. We need individuals who will quide those lost in sin to salvation and save them from God's wrath. Like the disciples who recognized the people's physical hunger and tried to feed them, we must see the needs of those around us through God's eyes. May God use us to share Jesus Christ, the Author of Life, with those in need. Let us strive to live for others rather than for ourselves. May the Lord help us see blessings even in our shortcomings. "My God will meet all your needs according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 4:19).

Missionary Biography

God in His own wisdom called some as zealots for Him, to fulfil His task on this earth. They live only for the extension of God's Kingdom. Sister Esther Mangai was one such zealot for the Lord, chosen by God as a cross-cultural missionary to plant Churches. She hailed from a Tamil Bhramin family. She was born on the 31st of January 1948. She had four brothers and two sisters. As the family was large, they found themselves often in financial dire straits. Miss. Esther Mangai grew up in this family which never knew Christ personally.

Miss. Esther Mangai finished her school and wished to go for higher studies, but the economy of this family did not allow it. In the meantime, one of her sisters became very sick. The family tried treatment in many hospitals and met many doctors, yet nothing gave her the healing. They took her to all the temples too and their efforts were not fruitful. This grim situation affected and shook the whole family.

One of the school friends of Miss. Esther Mangai took her to a Church. That was the first time she heard the Gospel. She did not understand the preaching of the Pastor and the Christian workers. She wanted to pray to her friend's God. Her heart was beating for her sickly sister's healing and the belongings which she lost some time ago. She met the pastor and he shared the Gospel in a simple way and encouraged her to continue to pray to Jesus. God answered her prayers and her sister regained her health. Thereafter her sister got married too. Esther got back all her belongings, which were lost some time ago.

These two events touched Esther's heart, and she longed to know the Lord more and more. So, she got a copy of the Bible and began to read sincerely. As she understood the truth, she accepted Christ as her personal Saviour and took baptism in the year 1974.

Salvation and Opposition:

When the family came to know that Esther Mangai had this new found interest in Christianity and that she had started attending the Church, they were furious and tortured her to leave the new faith. They also tore the bible and burnt it. But. Esther Mangai remained steadfast in her faith and continued to seek the Lord Jesus secretly and attended the Church without the knowledge of her family. After threatening her variously, they told her to leave the house permanently. In this difficult time, God opened a door for Esther Mangai; she got a job in a small school as teacher. So. she moved out of her home and started living in a separate house. During these six months of her new career as a teacher, she grew up in the Lord and began to read and meditate upon the Word of God. The Word of God gave her joy indescribable as well as guided her to a witnessing life for the Lord Jesus.

Call of God to the Ministry:

The six months that she had spent away from her family also helped her to strengthen the relationship with the living God. God called her for His ministry. She experienced the love of God, which forgave her sins and made her the child of God who created the heaven and Earth. She committed her life to proclaim this Good News to all. She was seeking an opportunity to serve the Lord on a full-time basis. And she knew that it was very difficult for women to do the ministry in India. OM India did ministry in Tamilnadu using young men and women. It gave an opportunity to Esther Mangai to do the ministry through the OM women team. So, she began to do the ministry for the glory of God.

Church Planting Ministry:

Miss. Esther Mangai had a passion for the mission, especially to preach the Gospel to the people who never heard the Gospel. In the meantime, she heard about the Friends Missionary Prayer Band. She wanted to do cross-cultural ministry very much. So, she joined FMPB on the 1st of July 1982. Then she underwent one year missionary training. After the training period got over, she was sent to the state of Gujarat. God opened the door for her to do ministry among the Vasave people of Gujarat. She joined other missionary sisters cheerfully to do the Lord's command.

From 1983 onwards, Miss. Esther Mangai started learning the dialect of the Vasave people and started working among the children and women. The Vasave women were uneducated and socially very backward people. Also, they were economically very poor when compared to others. They would toil for long hours as farm labourers and cattle rearers.

Even though there were no basic facilities like good house, water, toilet, electricity, road and transport, our women missionaries worked without any complaint. As they lived adjacent to a forest area, the other threat came in the form of wild animals, especially tigers. They committed their lives with great dedication for the upliftment of these Vasave people. Day by day God blessed their ministry and hundreds of people accepted the Lord and many congregations emerged. Mrs and Mr. Christopher Thomas, one of our missionary families, committed themselves for the translation of the Bible in this dialect. Soon, the New Testament was translated and given to these people to grow in the Lord. Along with other sisters Miss. Esther Mangai worked in the following places - Bajipura, Vyara, Selamba, Ucchal and Kevadi, Hundreds of children and women accepted the Lord and came into the fold because of her hard work.

Last Days:

Sis. Esther Mangai lived as a zealot for the Lord and chose not to get married. She worked tirelessly for the transformation of the Vasave people until her last breath. In 1997, while she was climbing a ladder in her rented house in Kevadi, she fell down and had a fracture in her backbone. She was admitted in the hospital. Later, she was shifted to CMC Vellore on 20th January 1998 for a better treatment. Even after receiving very good medical attention in CMC, her health condition continued to deteriorate. The efforts of the doctors became futile and she entered into God's kingdom on the 22nd of January 1998. She worked very hard for more than fifteen years. Always she was found busy sharing the Gospel. People appreciate her and remember her fondly for her humble and simple life noted for hospitality too. She gave her best for the l ord.

Saved for a Purpose:

Born to second-generation missionaries to China, John Dudley Woodberry's grandparents left their mother land to serve as a chaplain for Chinese POWs (Prisoners of War) during the Korean War. Having first become a Christian "in a childlike way" when he was three years old, Dudley says that the freezing waters of the Yantai Harbor catalyzed his faith in the winter of 1939. Five-year-old Dudley fell through the ice, which led to pneumonia. Barely surviving the illness, Dudley became convinced that divine intervention saved his life. Even at the age of five, "I had a sense," he says, "that I had been saved for a purpose."

God's grace continued to flow through their lives and two years later, when the Japanese bombed Pearl Harbor and declared war on the United States, Dudley and his family were made prisoners of war by the occupying Japanese army in China. Parents and children were separated; Dudley and his siblings became POWs in a different part of the country from their parents. Months later, a civilian prisoner exchange was negotiated between the United States and Japan. Once reunited with their parents, they exchanged ships and finally reached the shores of New York encountering many perils in their journey.

LEARNING TO GO:

Dudley discovered that "something" at age 13, when he heard the pioneer missionary Samuel Zwemer say, "If you want the most difficult but most rewarding work in the world, minister among Muslims."

In 1955 Dudley enrolled in the Bachelor of Divinity program at Fuller, which gave the opportunity for two students from each school to travel to a mission field and complete studies in indigenous cultures. Dudley was selected to study at the American University of Beirut.

He met his wife and partner in ministry, Roberta in Lebanon, where she was studying at Beirut College for Women. Westerners often saw Muslims as an unsophisticated people, completely ignoring their highly varied and developed cultures rich with art, tradition, and theological reflection. Dudley still had the heart of a missionary, but his time in Lebanon convinced him that rigorous intellectual preparation would lead to more effective witnessing.

Building Bridges:

When he graduated from Fuller, Harvard accepted him to study under the preeminent Western scholar of Islam Sir Hamilton Gibb. Dudley did well in his studies, writing his dissertation on the theology of Hasan al-Banna, His commitment to missions was sometimes frowned upon as he was expected to appreciate Arab culture, not convert it. Dudley learned to love and appreciate the indigenous culture of the Islamic nations for what they were, while still yearning to bring the redeeming love and light of Christ to them.

After years of training and discernment along with his two children, Dudley and Roberta became full-time missionaries to Pakistan, funded by the Presbyterian Church. Dudley worked at the Christian Study Centre in Rawalpindi and made great progress in building bridges between Christianity and Islam which led to developing mutual respect but also bringing Muslims to the Christian faith.

SCHOLAR, PASTOR, ADVOCATE:

Dudley's scholastic endeavors also unexpectedly proved crucial for his own safety and the safety of others. During his first tour in Afghanistan, two missionaries were arrested for distributing copies of the Gospel of Luke. Though he never appeared in court, Dudley hired a defense lawyer and developed the defense himself, based on Qur'anic verses that allowed Christians and Muslims to coexist peacefully. The missionaries were released.

A similar situation presented itself in Saudi Arabia, where Dudley was called to serve as the first sanctioned resident pastor in the Arabian interior since shortly after the Islamic conquests of the seventh century. The Church in the capital of Rivadh and elsewhere grew at an astounding rate, to an extent that made the government uncomfortable. To help ease tensions, Dudley showed them letters ascribed to Muhammad that gave Christians the right to worship in their own Churches as long as they were loval and met certain financial and other obligations. The Christians were then allowed to continue a lower-profile worship. When Dudley and his family returned to the United States because of Roberta's health and their children's educational needs-after 11 years of ministry in Pakistan, Afghanistan, and Saudi Arabia-King Khalid thanked him for his work.

Though he oversaw key initiatives in the School of World Mission (SWM) as its dean from 1992 to 1999, Dudley's impact was perhaps greatest in the study of Muslims and their contexts. He further oversaw research in South Asia and West and East Africa demonstrating that Muslims were coming to faith in Christ not only in an "attraction model"-being attracted to a Church or to Christians-but also in a "transformation model": studying the Bible stories of people mentioned in the Qur'an within trusted groups of fellow Muslims, and thus gradually coming to faith in Christ as Savior.

After Dudley retired from the deanship of SWM, Roberta accepted a request to teach their grandson and other expatriate children during the academic year at a school in Pakistan. During this time Fuller became very involved in peace building with Muslims both in the United States and overseas. Because Dudley is quick to tell a story and slow to take credit, it bears telling that he influenced movements in missions, academia, and diplomacy that affect the discussion of how Christians and the West interact with Muslims.

STILL ON THE JOURNEY:

The tale of Dudley's incredible life is exceeded only by the extraordinary depth of his work. It's been suggested that he write a memoir: three arrests in three countries, hitchhiking from New York to Ecuador and through Iran, Pakistan, and India, working as a deckhand for passage from Panama to the United States, negotiating on behalf of hostages, weaving through civil wars and revolutions: all this surely warrants some sort of literary commemoration.

"Oh, no," says Dudley, shaking his head. "I don't think I'll have time. I have too much work to do."

General Information

Chikhli is a medium size village located in The Dangs Taluka of The Dangs district, Gujarat with total 91 families residing. The Chikhli village has population of 395 of which 183 are males while 212 are females as per Population Census 2011.

Chikhli village has lower literacy rate compared to Gujarat. In 2011, literacy rate of Chikhli village was 56.31~%

compared to 78.03 % of Gujarat. In Chikhli Male literacy stands at 66.43 % while female literacy rate was 47.93 %.

As per constitution of India and Panchyati Raaj Act, Chikhli village is administrated by Sarpanch (Head of Village) who is elected representative of village.

Caste Factor

In Chikhli village, most of the village population is from Schedule Tribe (ST). Schedule Tribe (ST) constitutes 100.00 % of total population in Chikhli village. There is no population of Schedule Caste (SC) in Chikhli village of The Dangs.

Work Profile

In Chikhli village out of total population, 211 are engaged in work activities. 86.73 % of workers describe their work as Main Work (Employment or Earning more than 6 Months) while 13.27 % were involved in marginal activity providing livelihood for less than 6 months.

Growth of population

Population of the village has decreased by -27.3% in last 10 years. In 2001 census total population here was 543.

The Beginning

On 8-5-1981, L. Masilamani, his wife Mrs. Vanmathi and their first son M. John Kingsly (two years and eight months old) opened the Ahwa field by going and settling in a rented house in Pipaldahad village. While doing ministry they found out that there was a good receptivity in the nearby Junner village and they moved to Junner village on 30-11-1981. Due to opposition in Junner village, the missionary family left Junner on 30-8-1982 and went to Ahwa for staving. The Ahwa CNI church pastor Rev. T. V. Gaikwad helped them much in this opposition time. As the Dolyambar village headman and Manu Bhai invited the missionaries to their village. Missionaries went to live in Dolyambar village on 12-3-1983.

Many people from Dolyambar and the nearby villages came to Dolyambar seeking healing from Christ. God did many miracles and many people believed in Jesus. Chikhli village is located nearly ten kms from Dolyambar. Dolyambar village congregation became a channel of blessing for many people living in the nearby villages. Chikhli people experienced Jesus Christ through the ministry of Dolyambar church.

The first believer in the Chikhli village is Jatarya Bhai Janya Bhai Pawar (Baptised in 1985).

He describes his conversion experience below:



"I was following my ancestors' religion. Whenever we get sicknesses, we used to go to the bhagats (shamans or magicians) and give promises to fulfill certain offerings for the healing of the sicknesses. Once I got severe pain in my stomach and all my body. I went to the bhagats and offered cocks and coconuts for puja. However, I did not get any improvement. I went to the hospital and stayed there for one month. However, my sickness did not go away. I had more pain in my chest and stomach. One-day one woman told me that Christians are living in Dolvambar village and if I go to their meeting. I would get healing. I thought that I had spent much for my sickness and my sickness did not go away and how it would go away by just a prayer. I was tired of my sickness. Therefore, I went to Dolvambar Christian meeting on one Sunday. The church elder told me that I should attend the meeting every Sunday and follow the disciplines of the Christian faith without fail. then only the disease will leave. After saving this he prayed for me. I had one magical cord on my hand bound by a magician for the healing of my sickness. I was asked to throw it away. I threw it and I got peace immediately in my heart. I got healing completely and I started going to the Dolyambar church meetings every Sunday, I used to take my wife also with me for the meeting. Evangelist Sampat Bhai and Missionary L. Masilamani used to explain the Christian faith to us. We understood it and we were following all what they taught us. By walking ten kms we were attending the Dolvambar church from our village Chikhli. I got full healing from my sickness. Seeing this in my village, Soma Bhai, Mangu Bhai also came to the Dolvambar church meetings seeking healing for the sicknesses of their family members. Later Devram Bhai and four other families started believing in Jesus Christ and we were all going to the Dolvambar village for the church meetings. Then we asked the evangelist and the missionary to convene meetings in our village. So meetings were started in our village from 1985. Evangelist used to come to our village and conducted meetings and slowly the number of believers started growing from five to twenty families. I praise God for this growth. In 1986, one baptism meeting was also conducted in our village. Now all my three sons and their family members are in Christian faith and I thank God for it."

Soma Bhai Jatarya Bhai Pawarson of the first believer Jatarya Bhai Jania Bhai Pawar's testimony.

Jatarya Bhai family took baptism in 1985. In 1985, Jatarya Bhai Bhai approached evangelist Sampat Bhai and missionary Rev. L. Masilamani and requested them to start a weekly night meeting in his village. Rev. L. Masilamani went to Chikhli on 31-12-1985 and conducted a meeting in that village. So night meetings were started in Chikhli in the house of the first believer Jatarya Bhai from 1985 onwards.

Church Growth in Chikhli Village:

Due to the witnessing life of the first believer Jatarva Bhai, many sick people in Chikhli village sought the healing power of Jesus Christ. So the seekers attended the night meetings conducted first in the house of Jatarva Bhai and later in the kacha church. A special meeting was conducted and a baptism service was conducted in Chikhli village on 30-1-1987. Rev. Israel Devadas, office staff Raiendran and L. Masilamani went to Chikhli and conducted a special night meeting. They stayed there. People came from Dolyambar, Damadvihir and Jharan. On 31-1-1987, Mrs. Masilamani and Mrs. Israel came to Chikhli. 25 people were baptised by Rev. Israel Devadoss on that day in Chikhli.

Two believers give their witnesses describing how they found out Jesus Christ.

Jamsu Bhai Kalu Bhai (Baptised in 1986)

"I was a worshipper of idols from my childhood. I studied up to eighth standard in Pimpri school. Due to my poverty I could not study further. My father died. So I had to go to work to earn money for the support of my family. My mother also died. I became very poor. I did not have money to spend when sickness came. Once I got sickness and my wife also had sickness. I had some tumour like hard substance in my stomach. We did not have money to spend on our sicknesses. Nobody was ready to give money to us to spend on our sicknesses. My uncle Jatarya Bhai told us to come to Christian faith and God would heal them freely. So we attended the Christian meetings in our village. My uncle prayed for us. God healed both of us. I understood the Christian faith through the teachings of the evangelists and by myself reading the Bible. We took baptism in 1986 in our village."

Sonya Bhai Ravju Bhai Kotwa and Saru Ben. (Land donor for the kacha church building)



"I was sick. I had pain in my hands and legs. I could not do any work. My uncle Jatarya Bhai told me to come to Christian faith to get well. He prayed for me. Jatarya Bhai took me to Waghai mission hospital. I took medicines and I became well within two months. I became a Christian. I have two sons and they are married and have many children. I felt good and I donated land for kacha church construction. God has blessed me. I was like a mad man earlier. Now God has made me a good man."

Church Construction

In 1986, night meetings were started in the corridor (veranda) of the first believer Jatarya Bhai's house. After three years of the starting of the meeting, a kacha church was built in this village. On 9-7-1987, Dr. Paul and his staff (NSM) came in the morning to Ahwa. With them L. Masilamani family, Rev. Israel family and Bro. Thangavel went to Chikhli by bus. Dr. Paul dedicated the new kacha church.

On 28-11-1991, Rev. T. V. Gaikwad dedicated the renewed Chikhli church in the night. Bro. Rakesh and L. Masilamani went with him. The Chikhli church was in a non-Christian' land. In June 1998, it was shifted to a believer's land. The church was dedicated along with a mela.

Pucca church construction: By 20-3-2010 the church construction was finished. Actual construction work was finished within five days. People gave their labour for church construction. It was a free service. Mrs. and Mr. Dharmadurai dedicated this church on 25-9-2011. Ten people came from outside for dedication.

Testimonies of Believers:

1. Shalu Ben Govinda Bhai

"I was following my ancestral religion with my husband. I was affected by paralysis disease. We tried to heal my sickness through magicians by sacrificing many cocks and goats. But I did not get well. More money was spent on my sickness. But I was not healed. Lastly I became lame and I could not walk. I was disappointed very much. Finally my husband told me to try either peer religion or any religion to get well. Christian meeting was going on in my village. I started going to that meeting. Slowly I became well and I started walking. Then I believed in Jesus and I accepted Him as my personal saviour.

2. Devram Bhai Pandu Bhai

"I was following our ancestral religion. Once I was suffering from headache and I got faintness and used to fall down. Satan was following me. He was frightening me much and he was coming to eat me. Then I started to shout loudly and used to run away. I had more pain in my body. So I was taken to the bhagats (shamans) and many cocks and goats were offered in the pujas. But I did not get cure. Satan was appearing to me and was coming behind me. During this time village church elder Jatarva Bhai told me to come to Christian faith and all my sicknesses would leave me and satan would leave me. So I went to the Christian meetings in our village and the elder and others prayed for me. My sickness was healed and satan was not appearing to me from that time onwards. My wife and I believed in Jesus Christ and we took baptism in 1987."

Details of the Congregation/ Church

1. This church was handed over to the Church of North India, Gujarat Diocese in April, 2013 by FMPB. This church comes under the Piplaidevi pastorate.

2. Strength of the Congregation

Total Baptised people including the backslidden; approximately, there may be 150 people. Out of them 50 people got backslidden. 27 families are continuing in faith totalling 100. No believers from other villages come to this church. Church attendance is 35 people. come to the church. **3. People Group** in this church: Bhil is the majority. Few people are from Kukna.

4. Catechist: Lasya Bhai Laxman Bhai of Guhadia village is the catechist of this church. Church meetings are conducted by the catechist without receiving any money for it.

Pastors come once in two months or once in one month.

5. Church Activities: Sunday Service, Cottage prayer meetings and Friday prayer meetings.

6. Offering: Rs.350 to Rs.400 is collected every month.

Kinds of Offerings: Sunday service offerings, Thanksgiving offerings, First Fuirt offerings etc.

7. Outreach Ministry:

Total population: 500 people are living. Prayer is conducted in the church and in the forest with fasting once in a month for the salvation of the people. Seven to eight people participate in this prayer.

When people are sick they go voluntarily and ask them to pray for them

8. Migration: 75% people go to work in the sugarcane fields. At that time ten to twelve people attend the church services.

9. Prayer Points:

Two divisions should be made into one church

People are perishing in the evil ways. They should come to God.

Church meetings should go on well.

Christians are to be strengthened in faith.
