God Became Man

Throughout this year, we have meditated on the theme "Who am I". In this Christmas season, we are reminded that the Lord became man. Let's reflect on this profound truth together. Understanding another person's feelings by putting ourselves in their place is called empathy. A man of God put it, "Jesus walked in my shoes." To truly experience human needs, it's not enough to just

witness suffering—we must enter into it. This is why God took on human form, walking among us, sharing our experiences. As John 1:14 says, "The Word became flesh and dwelt among us." He became one of us!

The Apostle Paul, in Philippians 2:6-11, describes how God took three forms to redeem us:

1. Divine Form 2. Servant Form 3. Human Form

Divine Form: Christ was the very image of God (v. 6). He did not regard equality with God as something to be grasped or taken by force because it was already His. The full nature and attributes of God were found in Christ. Christ embodied the full nature and character of God, possessing 100% of His divine attributes and virtues."

Servant Form: Although equal with God, Christ humbled Himself, relinquishing His heavenly status. He took on the form of a servant, embracing humility and poverty (2 Corinthians 8:9).

Human Form: Christ became fully human while remaining fully divine. He grew in every way as we do (Luke 2:52). With flesh and blood, He faced the same temptations yet lived without sin (Hebrews 2:14; 4:15). He entered into our condition to redeem us.

Why did He take on human form?

- 1. To conquer death and bring us salvation** (Ephesians 2:14).
- 2. To intercede for us** and empathize with our struggles, experiencing our pains and emotions as a human (Hebrews 2:18).
- 3. To reveal divine qualities like love, mercy, and forgiveness** (John 14:9).

As we celebrate Christ's incarnation this Christmas, let us remember our missionaries, who have traveled to unknown places to proclaim this Good News. May we, too, share this message of love in word and deed, so that everyone around us may come to know this God of love.

WHO AM I,
THAT I SHOULD BECOME
A CHILD OF GOD,

RECEIVING
THE SON OF GOD AS
THE SON OF MAN?

He made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness (Phil.2:7).

Who am I, that I should become a child of God, receiving the Son of God as the Son of Man? This powerful reflection captures the profound mystery of God's grace. On our own, we are unworthy of such an immense gift—the Son of God becoming the Son of Man to reconcile us to God. Yet, through His grace and love, God made this possible. Jesus, fully God and fully man, entered the world so that we might be adopted into God's family, becoming sons and daughters of the Most High. No other human in history could or ever will share in this incomparable glory.

In Bethlehem, we witness “glory and humility” meet in their extremes. What a deep descent—from the heights of glory to the depths of shame, from the wonders of Heaven to the wickedness of earth, from exaltation to humiliation, from the throne to the cross. The God who made, rules, and sustains the world entered it not as the mightiest, but as the smallest and most

vulnerable, wrapped in swaddling clothes, full of divinity in a manger.

The humanity of Jesus is essential, as His role as the God-Man uniquely qualifies Him to be the perfect mediator between God and humanity. If He were only God, He would have no point of contact with us. If He were only man, He would share our need for salvation. But Jesus is both fully God and fully human. Born of a woman, He shares our humanity. Born of God, He remains sinless. When He died on the cross, He did not share in our guilt as a sinner but bore our guilt as our Savior. This is God's plan of salvation.

The Name “Immanuel” is Truly Unique

The word “Immanuel” appears in three places in the Bible (Isaiah 7:14; 8:8; Matthew 1:23). Reflecting on this name reveals profound spiritual truths. A biblical commentator noted that within this one name, all human needs and the entire plan of God are encompassed.

Most people, regardless of faith, acknowledge that God is with us, being omnipresent, omnipotent, and omniscient. But what makes

the title “Immanuel” unique? In the Old Testament, “Immanuel” was a word of hope, victory, and prophecy. In the New Testament, tied to the birth of Jesus, it gains new depth and significance. God created humanity in His image, and when humans fell into sin, He revealed Himself as “Immanuel” to redeem them and dwell among them. As C.S. Lewis said, “The Son of God became a man to enable men to become sons of God.” Jesus became human to restore the image of God in humanity.

Why would God seek to save lost humanity? Genesis 1:27 tells us, “God created mankind in His own image,” and Genesis 2:7 says, “the Lord formed a man from the dust and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life.” Human beings not only bear God’s image but carry His breath. This divine connection creates within all people a natural instinct to seek God, whether they recognize it or not. Even isolated tribes often create gods in their image, as St. Paul observed in Athens with the “unknown God” (Acts 17:23).

Every human has a “general revelation” of God’s existence, but they need the “special revelation” of Jesus Christ to truly know Him. St. John clearly states, “Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life” (1 John 5:12). Immanuel-God with us-is the only one who can restore, fulfill, and give meaning to our lives. Through Jesus Christ, our sins are forgiven, and we are reconciled with our Creator.

The Reign of Immanuel is Truly Unique:

The prophet Micah foretold, “But you, Bethlehem *Ephrathah*, though you are small among the clans of Judah, out of you will come... one who will be ruler over Israel,

whose origins are from of old, from ancient times” (Micah 5:2). Jesus, Immanuel, was born humbly in Bethlehem. Though from King David’s lineage, His family tree includes Ruth, a Moabite. Jesus is the King of a spiritual Israel, not of earthly kingdoms. His reign is eternal, existing before the foundation of the world. Though He was rich, He became poor for our sake (2 Corinthians 8:9), a King unlike any other. Mary’s Magnificat celebrates His kingdom: “He has brought down rulers from their thrones but has lifted up the humble” (Luke 1:51-55). During Christmas, we should reassess His reign in our lives and reflect it in our words and actions.

The Call of Immanuel is Truly Unique:

When God became man, His kingdom began in this world. Jesus’ first message was, “The kingdom of God has come near. Repent and believe the Good News!” (Mark 1:15). Jesus spoke of the Kingdom of God over 120 times, describing it as both present and future. His kingdom has already begun spiritually, but the full realization is yet to come. It is God’s will that none should perish, and that all should come to know Him. We are called to spread His Kingdom on earth. India, with countless seekers of God, needs to know that only Immanuel can fill their emptiness and bring fulfillment. Through Jesus, they can have fellowship with the true Creator.

The Purpose of Immanuel is Truly Unique:

At the heart of Christmas is a mission. Christmas reflects the mission of God. Jesus, the greatest cross-cultural Missionary, came from Heaven’s glory to a woman’s womb. As His Church, we must send missionaries across cultures, bringing worshippers from every tribe, tongue, and nation to Him. As

we celebrate Christmas, we must remember Christ's first coming and prepare for His second by reaching those who have not yet heard about Him.


Am I Unique? Who am I?

Yes, who am I to receive the glory and promise of Immanuel? The Unique Promise of Immanuel is one of the most profound assurances given by Christ, especially when He says, "I am with you always, to the very end of the age" (Matthew 28:20). This promise isn't just for the original disciples but extends to all believers who take up the mission of spreading the Gospel.

Through the birth of Christ, God enters our space, time, and history, and even more

so, each of our personal lives. Christ is Immanuel-God with us. God is with each of us today in a deeply personal way. Jesus Christ is the Way to Glory. The Lord Jesus not only wants us to witness His glory; He wants to share His glory with us. A crown of glory awaits each of us if we follow His footsteps of humility and become witnesses of His glory (2 Corinthians 3:18). As the Christmas season surrounds us with its splendor, may the glory of Jesus' birth over 2,000 years ago and His greatest promise, "I am with you always" (Matthew 28:20), fill our hearts and minds with awe. Let us reflect: Who am I to receive such an indescribable gift from God? (2 Corinthians 9:15).

CHURCH HISTORY

RATIA FIELD,
HARYANA REGION,
NORTH ZONE

GENERAL HISTORY

Ratia town is named after a Hindu sadhu, Rattan Nath. The roughly 6,000-year-old site holds within it a rich legacy and its ties to the past can possibly help trace the history of Haryana, and the country. It is located on the bank of Ghaggar River about 23 km North of Fatehabad. It has an average elevation of 210 metres (688 feet).

BEGINNING

Ratia mission field was opened on 1.7.1994 and Mr. Raja Edwin Moses and Mrs. Vanitha Rani were the pioneer missionaries of Ratia. On 15.7.1994 the missionary family arrived at Ratia field. The missionary couple faced threat from the anti-Christian people in August 1994. They were asked to pronounce the names of other gods but God protected the missionaries through prayers and helped them to win souls for Christ.

Before the Ratia field was officially opened, missionaries Mr. Raja Edwin Moses and Mr. Deva Anbukan visited Ratia every Monday in 1993 to conduct outreach and distribute Gospel materials. During one visit, they faced a violent mob while announcing Gospel books at Bhagat Singh Chowk. They were rescued by an armed Tamil soldier, who warned them about the strong opposition in the area.

Initially, villagers responded positively to the Gospel, with miracles leading to change of heart, particularly after a Muslim family from MP Sotar accepted Christ. One of their

relatives, **Mr. Beerbal**, tormented by an evil spirit, sought help from the missionaries, who prayed for his family, resulting in their deliverance and accepted Christ in 1997. They were baptized by Mr. Raja Edwin Moses and began sharing the Gospel with others.

"On December 24, 1999, Ratia's Church elder, Mr. Beerbal, shared the Gospel with his friend Mr. Magar Singh, whose family was suffering from spiritual bondage. On Christmas Day, both families attended worship, where they were prayed for. That night, Mr. Magar dreamt of Satan crying that he could no longer dwell in their home because Jesus had come. Mrs. Beerbal had a similar dream in which an evil spirit asked her for a new home, and she sent it to hell. By December 26, Mr. Magar's family experienced complete relief and began sharing their testimony.



Hiralal the Church elder of Ratia Church, originally from a village in Faridabad district, Uttar Pradesh, belonged to the Ravidas Chamar community and migrated to Ratia forty years ago. Raised in a family of Hindu priests, he faced severe health issues after his father's death and felt hopeless after being told by a magician that he would die within forty days. In despair, he concluded that no god existed. However, a believer named Mrs. Santhosh introduced him to

the Gospel, encouraging him to attend a satsung led by Pastor Raja Edwin Moses. Inspired by the verse "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened," Hiralal gradually began to believe in Jesus. After a critical night of prayer by his wife, he awoke completely healed and decided to follow Christ wholeheartedly. Hiralal, who had previously struggled with alcoholism, anger, and violence, experienced a transformative change. He, his wife Sunita, and their four children were baptized on March 4, 2001, at Sotar Dani. Hiralal played a significant role in constructing the Ratia Church and actively engaged in ministry, alongside his siblings, who also serve in various capacities. His younger brother, Sam Sunder, even shared the Gospel with a classmate, Kulwinder.

These people were attending the Sunday worship at MP Sotar Church. Sometime later, they requested the missionaries to conduct the worship at Ratia itself. So missionary, Mr. Raja Edwin Moses started the worship at his house at Shakti Nagar, Ratia. Four Christian nursing students and totally 10 people participated in the first worship at Ratia.

CHURCH GROWTH

A fire got ignited among the Ode Rajput community and this fire spread to the villages also. God did astounding miracles in the lives of people that many accepted Christ and joined the Church. Some testimonies of the believers are given below.

Ms. Mona @ Devi Rani (W/O Mr. Jay Beer Singh)

Mrs. Devi Rani Jaybeer from Ratia, Haryana, was raised in a Hindu family and devotedly worshipped God Shiva. Despite her efforts,

including fasting and praying during her 10th-grade exams, she failed two subjects, leading her to lose faith in God. During a challenging time, Rev. Raja Edwin Moses encouraged her to trust in Jesus and memorize James 1:5. After doing so, she successfully passed her exams, which prompted her to fully embrace Christianity and confess her faith on May 25, 2003. Following her baptism, she felt called to serve the Lord and pursued a Theological studies at a Bible College in Faridabad. After completing her studies, she became a local evangelist in Ratia and joined the FMPB as a full-time missionary on June 11, 2008.

Local evangelist, Mr. Gurupreet: Gurupreet from Ratia grew up in a family of idol worshippers, with his father, Mangal Singh, serving as a fortune teller possessed by a spirit. For twenty years, they conducted rituals and gatherings in their home. However, after a significant event, Mangal fell severely ill, suffering from pain that led the family to seek healing through temples and sacrifices, all to no avail. Eventually, Gurupreet's uncle took Mangal to Pastor Om Prakash in Jamalpur, where he found some relief. Although Gurupreet initially resisted accepting Christ due to fears about their deities, he eventually attended church with his father and experienced a change of heart while playing the dholak. Mangal discarded their idols and they began attending MP Sotar Church regularly. In 2009, Gurupreet and his family accepted Christ, with his parents confessing their faith in 2010. He was baptized by Babu Bhaiya and began serving in the church. Despite his desire to enter ministry, financial constraints held him back until he fell ill with typhoid. After

recovery, his father allowed him to work with missionaries, which ultimately changed his father's heart, leading to Gurupreet officially joining the Lord's service in 2012.

Social Transformations

The Gospel brought by the missionaries not only changed their hearts but also brought social transformations in them and they could come over poverty.

Worship Details

The believers from Ratia attended worship at MP Sotar Church but later requested that missionaries conduct services in Ratia. Missionary Raja Edwin Moses began hosting worship at his home in Shakti Nagar, attended by local believers and four Christian nursing students. As attendance grew, they sought a larger venue, initially using a house belonging to believer Kalu's younger brother. Due to inconveniences there, a temporary shed was constructed in 2006 for Rs. 80,000 with local support.

THE CHURCH LAND AND CONSTRUCTION

The land for the Ratia Church, measuring 12 Marla, was purchased from Mr. Pehelwan for Rs. 12,00,000. The congregation, comprising members from Ode Rajput, Rai Sikh, Bajigar, Dhanak, and Balmik communities, faced opposition during construction. Despite challenges, Rev. Raja Edwin Moses and the believers persevered through prayer. The church's foundation was laid on June 21, 2011, and it was dedicated on November 25, 2011, by Rev. Christopher Thomas. Contributions came from various believers, including 100 cement bags from

one donor and Rs. 2,00,000 from another anonymous supporter. Many provided labor and resources for the construction. Mrs. Vanitha Rani notably fasted for five months during this time. Notable attendees at the dedication included former Zonal and Regional secretaries and other missionaries.

History of Opposition at Ratia

The missionaries often faced opposition from Hindu fanatics, leading to threats and pressure from landlords to vacate their homes. One ward member even threatened to harm them, but he later suffered a severe health issue that resulted in the amputation of his leg due to diabetes. Additionally, a local youth leader opposed to Christianity eavesdropped on the missionaries' phone calls, but a Tamil family nearby informed the missionaries about his actions.

CHURCH ACTIVITIES AND INFORMATION

Outreach ministry

Church elders conduct weekly outreach to villages, distributing tracts and preaching the Gospel, which accounts for 90% of the baptisms at Ratia Church. They hold children's classes every Saturday, attended by 50 to 70 children, led by local evangelist Mr. Gurupreet and his family. Monthly youth meetings take place, and women gather for prayer every Tuesday for various causes. Fasting prayers are held on Wednesdays. Weekly Sunday services, led by church elders, the local evangelist, and missionaries, around 70 to 100 people gather to worship. The total membership of Ratia Church is 989.

Full-time workers from Ratia Church

Mrs. Devi Rani Jaybeer Singh is serving the Lord as a full-time missionary with FMPB in one of the mission fields of Rajasthan, her

younger brother Mr. Sam Sunder is serving the Lord as local evangelist in Haryana Region. Mrs. Gurupreet from Ratangarh village is also serving the Lord with FMPB as a full-time missionary at Maharashtra. Also, Mr. Vikas Masih, and Mr. Gurupreet from Ratia are serving the Lord as local evangelist in Haryana Region. Mr. Inderjeet from Ratia works as an independent pastor.

Your prayers are our victories

Evangelist Deepak from Bagli, Madhya Pradesh, was attacked by a mob while traveling to a night meeting. The mob beat him, took his mobile, Bible, and offering money, and then took him to two temples. Believers managed to rescue him after a turmoil. False accusations were made, claiming he had removed god photos and urged people to accept Jesus. On 12th October 2024, Dinesh Mavda, Hari Baba, Jeeban, and Arjun were detained after a prayer meeting. After several bail rejections, Arjun was released on 21st October, and Deepak received anticipatory bail.

Dinesh, Jeeban, and Hari were granted bail on 14th November and released from Bagli Jail on 15th November. Despite challenges, God's grace and prayers from believers nationwide sustained them. We ask for continued prayers for peace, resolution of the cases, and the freedom to continue ministry.

TRAIL BLAZERS

Johann Leonhard Dober was born in March 1706 in Mönchsroth, Swabia, Germany, to Johann Dober and Anna Barbara Link. He learned the pottery trade from his father in his youth. At the age of 17, he accepted the Lord as his personal Savior while attending a Moravian Church service in Herrnhut.

At a meeting held on July 24, 1731, Count Nikolaus Ludwig Zinzendorf shared with the gathered brothers what he had heard from Anthony Ulrich, a former slave from the Danish island of St. Thomas, about the great opportunity for the Gospel among the Caribbean slaves. Dober could not sleep that night. He felt that a West Indian slave was pleading with him to come to his island and bring the message of Christ to those suffering in spiritual darkness. He realized that if he were to minister among the slaves, he would have to be sold as a slave himself. The brutal beatings, the extreme heat, the unsanitary conditions, and the degradation of slavery haunted his mind. The thought of the suffering slaves weighed heavily on his heart day and night. He realized that God was calling him to a life of sacrifice.

When Dober shared his burden with his friend Tobias Leupold, he was surprised to learn that his friend was equally burdened. Together, they knelt in prayer and rededicated

themselves to the work of God, deciding to follow God's call regardless of personal comforts or desires. They made their commitment known to Count Zinzendorf. Though their desire to serve God was deeply encouraging, the Moravian brothers initially took no action for a year because Dober and Leupold were young men. Eventually, they made their desire known to the leaders of the Church in writing. Though they faced ridicule and opposition, they persisted and sought to discern God's will through drawing lots, as advised by Count Zinzendorf. The lot indicated that Dober should go, with the Lord affirming his calling and asking him to wait for his friend. So, a carpenter named David Nitschmann was chosen to accompany Dober, and the two of them set out for the Caribbean.

Ministry in St. Thomas

Count Zinzendorf prayed for and blessed them before sending them on their journey. Dober and Nitschmann boarded a ship bound for the West Indies and traveled to Copenhagen. The officials there were amazed by their courage and asked how they planned to live without financial support. They replied that they would work as slaves among the slaves. The authorities were initially reluctant to allow whites to become slaves, but they understood that without becoming slaves themselves, Dober and Nitschmann would not have the opportunity to preach the Gospel to the enslaved people working in the sugarcane fields. Realizing the missionaries' firm commitment, the officials granted permission for them to set out on their journey on October 8, 1732.

Two months later, they arrived in St. Thomas, where they began preaching the Gospel to the slaves. Contrary to their expectations, slave life was not as harsh as they had feared. They lived in a mud hut and worked together for three months. Though Dober was prepared to become a slave in order to minister to the slaves, by God's providence, he was able to use his skills in pottery and carpentry to support himself. As a result, people began to love and trust Dober, who had willingly accepted the position of a slave in order to make free men in Christ. Over time, darkened hearts were illuminated by the Good News of God's mercy and grace. Through their ministry, more than

13,000 people came to a life transformed by the Gospel. This was the beginning of the Moravian Missionary Movement, which would go on to become the pioneering force that spread the Gospel to the farthest reaches of the world.

Later Years

In 1734, Dober returned to Germany for other ministry purposes. However, the foundation he had laid for the Gospel in the West Indies continued to grow, with Moravian missionaries establishing churches on the islands of St. Thomas, St. John's, Jamaica, Antigua, and Barbados. Other missionary movements later followed, continuing the work in the Caribbean. After more than 30 years of traveling and ministering throughout Europe, Dober passed away in 1766, leaving behind a legacy of sacrificial service for the Gospel.

Reflection

Jesus Christ emptied Himself, took the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men to save us, who were slaves to sin (Philippians 2:7). Are we willing to follow the example of Johann Leonhard Dober, who, in following Christ's example, sacrificed his own comfort and even his freedom to bring the Gospel to the slaves in the West Indies? Are we prepared to put the needs of perishing souls ahead of our own conveniences?

Lord, give me the heart of a servant so that Your name may be glorified through me. Amen!
