Be led by the Holy spirit!

Have you ever wondered, "What is God's plan for me? Why are there so many obstacles as I strive to fulfill His purpose in my life? Won't anyone help me complete the mission God has given me?"

These are thoughts that many of us have at some point in our spiritual journey.

From the time of the Old Testament, we see that the Holy Spirit chose individuals-leaders, prophets, and judges-upon whom He descended to carry out His plan and perform His works (Numbers 11:17, 25; 27:18; Judges 15:14; 1 Samuel 10:6, 10; 16:13-14). In the New Testament, we also read that Mary, Stephen, Paul, and Peter were filled with the Holy Spirit. It is only when the Holy Spirit rests on someone that they can do mighty things. As Jesus Christ promised in Luke 24:49, He sent the Holy Spirit to stay with us-to encourage us, to make us bold, to guide us into all truth, and to convict us about sin, righteousness, and judgment (John 16:7-8). Yet, we also see that Satan has used many people to try to prevent God's plan from being fulfilled. However, God's children, empowered by the Holy Spirit, have always carried on and completed His plan.

God protected Moses from Pharaoh, who wanted to kill him, and made him the leader of the people of Israel. God's Salvation for All Mankind

"Therefore, if God gave them the same gift He gave us who believed in the Lord Jesus Christ, who was I to think that I could stand in God's way?"
- Acts 11:17

When Jewish Christians and apostles in Jerusalem heard that the Gospel was preached to the uncircumcised gentiles who had gathered at the house of Cornelius in Caesarea through Peter, they were initially angered (Acts 11: 1-3). However, when Peter described his experience of his vision and how the Holy Spirit manifested in those Gentiles who had gathered and their baptism, those who listened could no longer resist the truth and began to glorify God (Acts 11:18). They then embraced God's plan of salvation for the gentiles, and committed their life to fulfil God's plan, as a result, the Gospel spread rapidly to many nations, as recorded in the Acts of the Apostles.

Breaking Down Obstacles to Fulfill God's Plan

During the days when our pioneer missionaries were working among the Maltos in Jharkhand, the Santals



witnessed a transformation in the lives of the Maltos. Initially, these missionaries hesitated to baptize the Santhals who desired baptism, as their primary goal was to evangelize the Malto people. However, upon obeying the guidance of the Holy Spirit and understanding God's broader plan, our missionaries began preaching the Gospel to the Santhals and baptized them. Today, over 120,000 Santhals have turned to God, a testament to the great work God has done among them.

The vision of clean and unclean animals had deep significance for Peter. In a time when there was a great divide between Jews and Gentiles, this barrier was removed through the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on all people. Who are we to hinder the fulfillment of the Holy Spirit's great plan? No one could prevent the Christian unity that arose when those gathered in Cornelius' house were filled with the Holy Spirit and baptized. Recognizing this as the leading of the Spirit, some individuals embarked on missionary journeys to

preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the Gentiles. Their willingness to abandon old perspectives paved the way for the Gospel to reach the entire world.

Obedience in Fulfilling God's Plan

Years of servitude and oppression by religious leaders had profoundly impacted the Jewish mindset. The Jews who had forsaken Gentile worship after returning to their land strictly adhered to God's laws, following the traditions and cultural practices as prescribed in the Book of the Law of Moses.

When Peter, a circumcised Jewish believer, ate with uncircumcised people in the house of the centurion Cornelius, he justified his actions by appealing to God's mercy. While Peter spoke the Word of God to them, the Holy Spirit came upon all who were listening, and they spoke in many tongues. Peter emphasized that this was the direct work of the Holy Spirit, not of his own doing. If God burdens us to preach the Gospel to certain people, He will also prepare their hearts to receive it. The Holy Spirit will work in them.

In many of our mission fields, we have witnessed even those who initially resisted the ministry eventually being converted. Our duty, like Peter's, is to obey the Spirit in doing His work, and the results will be great. As Ecclesiastes 11:1 says, "Cast your bread upon the waters, for you will find it after many days."

Sharing God's Burden to Fulfill His Will

God shows no partiality toward any individual, group, or nation. As Peter declared in Acts 10:34-35, "God does not show favoritism but accepts from every nation the one who fears him and does what is right." Jewish believers were compelled to realize that God had a plan to save the Gentiles as well. Today, the Gospel is being preached among approximately 266 ethnic groups through the Friends Missionary Prayer Band, ensuring that God's plan is fulfilled in our country.

As 1 Peter 4:10 instructs, we must use our gifts to serve others, faithfully administering God's grace. Whatever our calling, we are committed to sharing the good news of the Gospel with those in need. If there are people we encounter daily who do not know God, they are our mission field. Our task is to introduce them to Jesus Christ. As Paul exhorts in 2 Timothy 4:2, "Preach the word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage—with great patience and careful instruction." 1 Corinthians 9:16 For when I preach the Gospel, I cannot boast, since I am compelled to preach. Woe to me if I do not preach the Gospel. These verses prompts us to share the Gospel with the others.

Am I an Obstacle to the Gospel?

Stumbling blocks are inevitable, but woe to those through whom they come (Luke 17:1). Is our language, color, caste,

or culture a hindrance to proclaiming God's Gospel to others? Do we treat others as God treats us? We who receive and enjoy God's love, mercy, grace, and forgiveness daily, share them generously with others. As Christians, we must move beyond personal pride that hinders the spiritual growth of others. Without the indwelling power of the Holy Spirit, we cannot successfully accomplish anything for God. God is never harsh with us. Therefore, we must accept one another as Christ accepted us, to the glory of God (Romans 15:7).

If our personal preferences, habits, status, or self-righteousness become obstacles, the Holy Spirit cannot work through us. We

should measure every aspect of our lives against Christ's example and ensure that our speech, behavior, and attitudes do not become stumbling blocks for others.

Beloved children of God, we must be effective instruments in God's hands to proclaim the Gospel and help new believers and those weak in faith grow in God. Let us devote ourselves fully to fulfilling God's plan of salvation, so that every knee will bow and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

CHILLI CHURCH HISTORY

(GHATAMPUR FIELD, KANPUR REGION,
NORTHERN ZONE, FIELD NORTH)



Chilli is a medium size village located in Ghatampur Tehsil of Kanpur Nagar district, Uttar Pradesh. Chilli village has higher literacy rate compared to Uttar Pradesh. As per the constitution of India and Panchayati Raaj Act, Chilli village is administrated by Sarpanch (Head of Village) who is the elected representative of the village. Chilli village of Kanpur Nagar has a substantial population of Schedule Caste. The village Chilli currently doesn't have any Schedule Tribe (ST) population.

BEGINNING

The Ghatampur mission field was opened in March 1991. The pioneer missionaries of Ghatampur mission field were Rev. Azariah Raj Kumar and Rev. Raja Edwin Moses. The seeds of the gospel were sown at Chilli

village during the period of missionary, Rev. Peter Hariram in April 1993. But the seeds sprouted and produced fruits during the tenure of missionary, Rev. C R George in 1999. Rev. C R George and the local evangelist, Mr. Surender Kumar went to Chilli village for outreach ministry. They stopped at the house of Mr. Ram Sahi who was taking tuition for some children. They told him about Christ and gave him some tracts to read. As he started reading the tracts he came to know about the saving knowledge of Christ. That day many onlookers from Chilli village heard the gospel through them.

Mr. Ram Sahi - The First Believer:

Ram Sahi was tormented by an evil spirit from his childhood. He desperately needed deliverance from it. He continued to read the gospel packets and he decided to take baptism. On 29.1.2000 he and his wife were baptized at Sukhapur village by missionary, Rev. C R George. He started attending the katcha church at Ghatampur. Though not immediately, he got deliverance from the evil spirit. This deliverance led him to share about Christ to his fellow villagers.

After accepting Christ God did many more miracles in his life.

Another woman named, Sharadha was delivered from demon possession in Sept. 2000. On 29.9.2000, Sharadha, Bal Govind and his mother along with 6 more people from Chilli village were baptized by Mr. C R George at Ghatampur. The believers went to Ghatampur church for Sunday worship. From Sept. 2000, every Sunday evening the believers gathered at the house of the first believer for night meeting. The believers conducted the night meeting by themselves. At the very first meeting 15 people participated. In the year 2000, a total of 26 people from Chilli village accepted Christ and took baptism.

CHURCH GROWTH



Church Elder, Mr. Rajesh: "After the demise of my mother, I was constantly suffering from fever. I took a lot of medicines and treatments. I concluded that nobody in this world can ever heal me. One of my fellow villagers and a believer, Mrs. Rani gave me a Bible to read and guided me to the church at Ghatampur. On the first day of receiving the Bible, I read 3 pages. That same day, I got relief from fever. I realized that since it was "Holy Bible", it really had power to heal me. But later the fever gripped

me again. My wife advised me to read the Bible again as it has power. I read 40 pages and got to know more about Christ. I started going to the katcha church at Ghatampur as there was no satsang at Chilli village. In 2007 I took baptism. Rev. Paul Daya Singh baptized me and my wife."

The believers of Rampur village, Mrs. Vijaykanthi and her husband Rajjan did not have children for 12 years. Through prayers, Mrs. Vijaykanthi conceived and gave birth to a baby girl. Through this incident many people started to put their faith in the Lord. Later, a Sunday worship was started at Chilli village and local evangelist, Mr. Anil Kumar led the service. After the church was constructed in 2010, many old congregations came under the jurisdiction of Chilly pastorate.

THE CHURCH LAND AND CHURCH CONSTRUCTION

On 1.7.2009, a land was purchased at Chilli village for church construction from Mr. Kamlesh Kumar Gupta in the presence of the Central Regional Secretary, Rev. N Rajadurai. The Church Name is Prabhu Yesu Masih Satsang Bhavan. The foundation was laid on 4.3.2010. The believers helped in the construction work. On 5.10.2010, the Chilli church was dedicated by Rev. Israel, PREM Secretary (Tirunelveli). The God's word was shared by Rev. Selvaraj, Honorary Mobilization Secretary - Nellai. Special guests: Rev. S Christopher & team (Yesu Katha), and the Central Regional Secretary- Rev. N Rajadurai & family were also present. Rev. Paul Daya Singh was the field missionary during the time of church dedication.



THE CONGREGATION AND THE COMMUNITY

The Chilli congregation members are from the following villages: Miranpur, Laukaha, Husangapur, Shrinagar, Kamandalpur, Usmanpur, Madha, Benda, Qutbuddinpur, Beheta, Ayodhyapur, Rampur- Navedi, Bamburaha, Mugalpur, Choubepur, Shividari, Doulatpur and Chilli. All of them are from Paswan, Sankhwar, Chamar, Kori, Dhobi and Pal communities.

MIRACLES AND IMPORTANT EVENTS FROM CHILLI CONGREGATION

- ♦ Jan 1992 - On 20.1.1992, follow up ministry was done at Choubepur village. 30 people participated. After the meeting got over, Mr. Parmeshwar and his relative came to the missionaries and gave their cigarette box and said that they will not use it again.
- ♦ Jan 1996 - At Baburaha village, a young man Mr. Dharam Raj was affected by fits. Because of fits, he lost his speech. Believer, Mr. Baburam brought the young man to the missionaries for prayer. When they prayed for him, God made him to speak at that very moment.
- ♦ Aug 2001 - the local evangelists, Mr. Gyanender and Mahender went for outreach ministry to Mugalpur village. A lady named, Radha was under paralytic attack for 5 years. The local evangelists prayed for her and miraculously she started to walk. Praise God.


♦ Buffalo of Mr. Ram Sahi from Chilli village's fell sick. It was frothing at the mouth. The vet was unable to come immediately. So Ram Sahi and his son prayed for the buffalo till 12am. God heard their prayers and healed the buffalo.

♦ Mar 2003 - Believer Pappu's daughter was unable to walk for 4 years. One day she asked her father whether she could walk or not. He saw her and said, "Walk in the name of Jesus". Immediately the girl started walking. Praise God.

♦ Feb 2013 - Vijaypal of Miranpur village had bent fingers and toes. Because of fits he was unable to walk properly. Also, he was dumb by birth. Two years before, he accepted Christ as his personal Saviour and he regularly attended the church at Chilli. He used to sweep the church and spread mats and kept the church campus clean and tidy. He spent most of the time in the church campus. His bent fingers and toes have become normal and also he is able to talk in a better way. His mother testified that from the day he accepted Christ, he did not get fits. Through him 3 families including a doctor's family has accepted Christ. Praise God.

Monthly once Wednesday fasting prayer is being conducted at the Chilli church. The local evangelist leads the fasting prayer. Some believers, accompany the local evangelist for outreach ministry. Holy Communion service is being conducted in the first Sunday of every month by the local evangelist or the missionary. The local evangelist leads the Sunday service. The total strength of the Chilli church is 319. Lets uphold this Church and all its activites in our prayer. Also the Church to overflow with souls.

TRAIL BLAZERS



Robert Sinclair

Robert Sinclair was born on 15 November 1883 in Glasgow, Scotland. His father, Mr. John Sinclair, was a mason. After losing his father at a young age, Robert suffered greatly and took up his father's trade. He studied at Glasgow Theological College for two years and was ordained as a Pastor on March 3, 1909. In the same year, he travelled to Nagercoil, Tamil Nadu, India. In 1910, Robert married Bessy Graham Smith at the Home Church, Nagercoil. He was subsequently transferred to Mathikode and later to Marthandam, where he served from 1919 to 1939. During his time in Marthandam, Robert undertook significant church-related construction projects. He was responsible for the completion of parts of the LMS Boys' School and the entire Girls' School. As the number of schools grew, so did the need for teachers, prompting him to establish a teacher training school in May 1932.

Due to his wife's failing health, Robert returned to Scotland in June 1937. Unfortunately, World War II prevented him from returning to India. An accomplished architect and builder, Robert designed and oversaw the construction of the grand "Stone Church" in Marthandam, which was completed and consecrated on 13th May 1933. Robert was known for his piety and godliness. In one instance, he forgave a person who had assaulted him and provided the individual with a job, demonstrating his compassion and commitment to his faith. He worked tirelessly for the church and the betterment of the community in and around Marthandam.

Robert initiated the Evangelist Band and the Revival Band to stimulate evangelism. He purchased a small bus for outreach ministry and organized a team to visit nearby villages such as Pulianvilagam, Kalachanthi, Airandengu, Sennithotam, and Kerala. He also provided the group with a violin and a magic lantern. Additionally, he started a Sunday School, teaching young children Bible verses and social morals, and formed a choir. A library was established for both Christians and non-Christians.

Bessy, Robert's wife, taught women lace-making for self-employment. The garments produced were exported and displayed in exhibitions and won many prizes. After returning to Scotland, Robert served as a Pastor in a church there. He passed away on 12th September 1946 in his homeland.

Missionary Biography

Early life

Paul Gopalan hailed from a small town called Neyyattinkara near Trivandrum, Kerala. He was born to Hindu parents on the 20th of April 1961. He studied in a school nearer to his home. He attended the Sunday School run by the Church regularly. He learned more about Jesus in Sunday School. After his high school studies, he joined a Polytechnic college and finished his two year course there. Then, he migrated to Chennai seeking employment. He stayed in his own brother's house, who was employed in a private firm in Padi, Chennai.

Born again Experience

Paul Gopalan too got a job in Chennai and started his life in Chennai city. He also earned more young friends, who led him to sinful habits. As there was no direct control of his parents, he began to lead a life as per the wishes of his own heart; eventually he lost his peace and real joy. Meanwhile, one of his friends introduced him to a group of young people who used to gather in the Padi Church and pray. Paul Gopalan was attracted by this Christian fellowship and began to attend the fellowship meetings regularly. And he joined them

in the Sunday Worship Service in the CSI Church at Padi, Chennai. In a meeting held on 29th July 1984 at Chennai, he accepted Jesus as his personal Savior and Lord. Mr Simon and Mr Yogaraj helped him to grow in the Lord and soon he became a Sunday School teacher.

Called to be a missionary

In 1985, Paul Gopalan attended a mission challenging meeting conducted by Friends Missionary Prayer Band, at Chennai. In this meeting, he came to know about the millions of people who did not have an opportunity to hear about Jesus and the Gospel. The speaker of this meeting gave an altar call, challenging the young people to commit their lives to go as missionaries to proclaim the Gospel and lead them to eternal life. Many young people committed their lives to go as missionaries; Paul Gopalan was one among them. This was a turning point in his life.

North India Ministry

Paul Gopalan immediately applied to FMPB to go as a missionary. In the interview held on the 3rd of November 1987, he was selected as a cross-cultural missionary candidate. FMPB sent him to the missionary training centre at Siwaith, Near Allahabad, Uttar Pradesh. After his training, he was sent to the State of Himachal Pradesh to proclaim the Gospel to the people who did not even hear once. Along with Mr Edward Gnanamuthu, his co-worker, he started the ministry, based at Hamidpur. They did the ministry for two years in that place, among the needy people and preached the Gospel. Paul Gopalan was suffering from problem of indigestion for too long and the pain in his stomach persisted. Day by day this pain increased and the treatment given in the hospital did not lessen his pain. His health started deteriorating and he became very weak. So, he returned to Chennai for better treatment.

Married Life

He took treatment in a good hospital and God healed him. Considering his health, the FMPB transferred him to Trivandrum, Kerala. He became the Promotional Secretary and his job was to find new members, to establish new prayer cells, and to motivate the Christians with the vision of Mission. He did this mission mobilizing ministry among the Christian Churches in the Trivandrum region. His parents with the help of FMPB found a suitable bride for him Ms Rebeccamma,

who was serving the Lord as a cross-cultural missionary in Gujarat. The marriage was held in Chennai on the 19th of July 1993. God blessed them with a girl child and the parents named her Phoebe (Lavanya).

Last days

After their marriage, they were asked to be involved in the Kottayam mission mobilization ministry. They conducted mission challenging meetings and encouraged the Christians to involve in the mission with their prayers, donations and sponsorships. Again Paul Gopalan relapsed into severe stomach pain. And he continued to take treatment for this. In the year 2004, he was admitted to CMC, Vellore, for treatment as the pain became unbearable. The doctors diagnosed that his kidneys were the worst affected and not functioning well. A team of doctors tried their best to give him good treatment. But his condition worsened. On the 4th of June 2004, he entered into glory leaving behind his wife and daughter. Then his body was taken to his native place in Kerala and buried with the hope of resurrection.

Though he lived for a short period of time in this world, he served the Lord with utmost sincerity through the ministry that God gave him. His wife continued the mobilization ministry in Chennai and their daughter **Phoebe** finished her degree and is married Let's remember this family in your prayers.

The Holy Spirit



The Holy Spirit is considered the third person of the Holy Trinity, along with God the Father and God the Son (Jesus Christ). The Holy Trinity is the Christian understanding of the nature of God as three distinct persons in one divine essence. "And Peter said to them, "Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit." (Acts 2:38)

Through the power of the Holy Spirit, believers are saved, filled, sealed, and sanctified. The Holy Spirit reveals God's thoughts, teaches, and guides believers into all truth, including knowledge of what is to come. The Holy Spirit also helps Christians in their weakness and intercedes for them.

The Holy Spirit: The Holy Spirit, or Holy Ghost, is God, the third Person of the Holy Trinity, who eternally "proceeds" from the Father (John 15:26). The Holy Spirit is co-equal with the Father and the Son. The word "Spirit" commonly translates the Greek New Testament word *pneuma*.

The work of the Holy Spirit: The Spirit dwells inside every true Christian. The body of faithful Christians becomes His temple (1 Corinthians 3:16). He is described as a 'Counsellor' or 'Helper' (paraclete in Greek, guiding them in the way of the truth.) The 'Fruit of the Spirit' (the result of His work) is "love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control" (Galatians 5:22). The Spirit is also believed to give gifts (natural and supernatural) to Christians as is found in the life of Christ and His disciples healing the sick, raising the dead, and more.

The Holy Spirit is often described as the active presence of God in the world and in the lives of believers. The Holy Spirit is associated with various roles and functions, including:

Comforter/Advocate/Helper: The Holy Spirit is seen as a source of comfort and assistance to believers (John 14:26). In times of trouble or need, the Holy Spirit is believed to come alongside believers to provide guidance, strength, and support.

Teacher/Guide: The Holy Spirit is a teach and guide believers in understanding and living out the teachings of Jesus Christ. This includes helping believers interpret and apply the Scriptures to their lives.

Conviction of Sin: The Holy Spirit is often seen as convicting individuals of their sinfulness, leading them to repentance and a turning towards God.

Empowerer: The Holy Spirit is considered to empower believers for Christian living, equipping them with spiritual gifts for service and enabling them to live according to God's will.

The Holy Spirit and Jesus Christ: In Christian theology, the relationship between Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit is a central aspect of the doctrine of the Trinity. The Trinity is the understanding

that God exists as three distinct persons—the Father, the Son (Jesus Christ), and the Holy Spirit—yet these three persons are one God. The Bible is the primary source for understanding this relationship, and while the term "Trinity" is not explicitly mentioned in the Bible, the concept is derived from various passages.

Jesus and the Holy Spirit at Jesus' Baptism: One significant event highlighting the relationship between Jesus and the Holy Spirit is the baptism of Jesus. All three persons of the Trinity are present at this event. Matthew 3:16-17: "As soon as Jesus was baptized, he went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting on him. And a voice from heaven said, 'This is my Son, whom I love; with him, I am well pleased.'"

The Promise of the Holy Spirit: Before His crucifixion, Jesus promised the coming of the Holy Spirit to his disciples. John 14:16-17: "And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever—the Spirit of truth."

The Work of the Holy Spirit: Jesus explained that the Holy Spirit would come to guide and empower believers after his departure. John 16:7: "But very truly I tell you, it is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Advocate will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you."

The Great Commission: In the Great Commission, Jesus instructs His disciples to baptize in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, emphasizing the unity of the three persons. Matthew 28:19: "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit."

Pentecost: The Holy Spirit descended upon the disciples in a powerful way on the day of Pentecost, fulfilling Jesus' promise. Acts 2:1-4: "When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them."

1. The Holy Spirit is a Helper Who Teaches and Reminds (John 14:26)
2. He Convicts the World of Sin (John 16:7-8)
3. The Holy Spirit Dwells in Believers and Fills Us (1 Corinthians 3:16, ESV)
4. He is a Source of Revelation, Wisdom, and Power (1 Corinthians 2:10-11, Acts 1:8, Ephesians 1:17-20)
5. He Guides to All Truth and Knowledge of What Is to Come (John 16:13-15, John 16:13)
6. The Holy Spirit Gives Spiritual Gifts to Believers (1 Corinthians 12:7-11)
7. He is a Seal in the Lives of Believers (Ephesians 1:13)
8. He Helps in Our Weakness and Intercedes for Us (Romans 8:26-27)
9. He Makes Believers New and Grants Us Eternal Life (Romans 8:10-11)
10. The Holy Spirit Sanctifies and Enables Good Fruit in Our Lives (Galatians 5:16-21)


