## Let us Abide in His Word

**I**n his 1974 book *God in My Corner*, boxer George Foreman shared a story about a friend who gave him a Bible before his trip to Africa to fight Muhammad Ali. The friend encouraged him to take it for good luck. At the time, George only knew one verse—"The Lord is my shepherd"—and he treated the Bible as a shepherd's manual, carrying it with him alongside other personal items, believing it would bring him good fortune. Later, in a time of personal hardship, he came to accept Jesus as his Savior and eventually became a pastor.

Today, do we view the Bible in the same way, thinking it will protect us or bring us good luck if we carry it in our vehicle, keep it at our place of business, or take it with us wherever we go? Is it merely a shepherd's handbook, or is it a powerful sword we wield against the enemy? The first ethos of the FMPB is to "Abide in the Word of God." We can only abide in Him if we read, love, memorize, meditate on the Scriptures, and apply them to our lives, and in doing so, He will abide in us (1 John 3:24).

In an age where false teachings abound and confusion and distractions threaten us, we risk being deceived if we don't devote time to seeking God's truth. Like the Bereans in Acts 17:10-15, we must diligently search the Scriptures and learn. To abide in His Word makes us true disciples, helping us grow in spiritual maturity, turn away from sin, and live fruitful lives.

The Bible is the only book that is relevant for all ages, times, and situations. We are not only meant to carry it in our hands but also in our hearts. Many have sacrificed their lives so that we could have it in our mother tongue. It is written that we should grow in the knowledge of God, and for that, we must read and study the Scriptures with understanding. Hebrews 4:12 reminds us, "For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart." The Bible comforts, guides, and transforms us.

May God help us to love His Word more deeply this year than ever before. Amen.

# *From the General Secretary...*

**D**ear Partners in the mission of reaching the unreached,

Abiding in the Word of God is first of our nine God given ethos and is the title for the February 2025 magazines. Paul writes to Timothy in his second letter verses 8 and 9 that "Remember Jesus Christ, raised from the dead, descended from David. This is my gospel, for which I am suffering even to the point of being chained like a criminal. But God's word is not chained". We are not only called to be obedient to the Word of God but also to suffer for the sake of the gospel. And he mentioned the important truth that God's word is not chained. # God's Word

how I am living according to God's commandments. Each individual Christian's actions matter deeply.

Abiding in God's Word is not a temporary commitment-it is meant to last throughout our lives. God expects this in our lives. God's commandments should dwell in us continually. It's not enough to merely acknowledge His Word; we are called to practice it daily. In contrast, even the religious figures and politicians try to keep up their words, but as Christians, we are expected to abide in God's commandments with a deep and unwavering commitment.

Abiding is Action-Oriented. We may read the Bible daily, listen to God's Word, or hear sermons, but it is crucial that His commandments truly drive our lives. In 1 John 3:24, we are reminded: "The one who keeps God's commands lives in him, and he in them. And this is how we know that he lives in us..." This verse clearly tells us the kind of life we are expected to live.

When we abide in God's Word, we live in Christ, and He lives in us. Commandments, precepts and laws are the Word of God. This is the essence of what it means to abide in

**G**od has been blessing the ever-growing missionary organization of Friends Missionary Prayer Band (FMPB). This ministry has grown and expanded to this level primarily because of the power of prayer and also because our senior leaders have established the nine Ethos to guide the expansion of our organization. By the grace of God, we have been able to follow this ethos. In 2025, we have chosen to reflect upon these Ethos, and the first of these is **"Abiding in God's Word"** (1 John 3:24).

This month we are called to reflect on the first Ethos **"Abiding in God's Word"** (1 John 3:24) and to evaluate how faithfully we are living by this principle in our lives. As followers of Christ, we are called to not only understand but also live out God's Word. It's easy to point out the faults in others, but it is much more important to examine

Him: we must first believe in the Word, accept it as our own, and live by it. This Word is not just a collection of teachings—it is **God Himself**. As John writes in 1:1, "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." John 1:14 says "The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth." When we truly abide in Him, there is transformation in our lives.

### **A Life That Bears Much Fruit**

Jesus says in John 15:5, "I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing." When God's Word abides in us, we bear much fruit, and our lives become useful for the Kingdom of God. John 15: 8 says "This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples." Let us also be His disciples as a result of truly abiding in Him—a life that is fruitful, impacting others, and bringing glory to God. Let us live a fruitful life for Him.

### **A Life of Receiving**

In John 15:7, Jesus promises, "If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you." When we remain in God's Word, our prayers are aligned with His will, and our requests are granted. However, this promise is conditional: we must abide

in His Word. Proverbs 28:9 reminds us that "If anyone turns a deaf ear to my instruction, even their prayers are detestable." Abiding in God's Word is directly linked to the effectiveness of our prayers. Let us receive according to His will and live for Him.

### **A Built Life**

Jesus also tells us in Matthew 7:24, "Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock." Hearing God's Word is not enough; we must put it into practice. Jesus is clear in His expectations for our spiritual lives. In this world full of sin, injustice, and darkness, we must build our lives on the solid foundation of God's Word. Only then can our lives be strong, stable, and enduring. Let us be built on Him and live for Him.

### **A Call to Abide in God's Word**

Dear people of God, whether you are a member, supporter, prayer partner, or leader in the Friends Missionary Prayer Band, I encourage you to reflect deeply on this Ethos in the new year. Let us commit to abiding in God's Word and living it out in our daily lives. May we become role models for others, showcasing the transformative power of God's Word through our actions. Let us not be mere hearers, but doers—abiding in God's Word and sharing His love with the world around us.

# Go or Send

## The History of FMPB's Emblem



The emblem/logo is a powerful representation of the vision and purpose of a movement. The emblem of the Friends Missionary Prayer Band is designed as a star-shaped symbol that encompasses a multitude of significant ideas. We have compiled and shared its explanation after consulting with our senior missionary brother and the artist behind its design, Mr. Navaneetha Annan. It is crucial for all members of the Friends Missionary Prayer Band to understand the meaning behind this emblem.

This emblem was created in 1966 by an artist Mr. Duraisamy at the inception of our organization during the time when Dr. Theodore Williams served as the editor of our monthly magazine, *Araikooval*. Later

in 1974 Dr. Emil Jebasing, the then General Secretary of our organization, encouraged the newly joined artist, Mr. Navaneetha Annan, to design a new emblem inspired by the verse from Mark 16:15, *“Go into all the world and preach the Gospel to all nations.”* Emil annan gave the following explanation for the Emblem:

- 1. The Cross at the center of the emblem:** The cross represents Jesus Christ, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world. It signifies that Jesus Christ is the core and leader of our movement.
- 2. The Bible beneath the Cross:** The central message of the Bible is the cross, and His word is the Gospel. The Holy Bible serves as the foundation of our faith. All our ministries and plans are rooted in the Word of God.
- 3. The World beneath the Bible:** The world map symbolizes the mission to spread the Gospel across the globe.
- 4. The Trumpet surrounding the world:** This signifies that every Christian is called to proclaim the Gospel with urgency.
- 5. The Eight Arrow Marks around the symbol:** These arrows represent the call to spread the Gospel in all eight directions-north, south, east, west, and the four intercardinal directions. The words “Go” or “Send” are inscribed on each mark, further emphasizing the mission. These arrows are inspired by the verse in Mark 16:15. Later Mr. Kingsley Arunothayakumar newer appearance to the Emblem.

The cross represents the Gospel to the world, while the trumpet symbolizes the call to proclaim it, and the eight arrows depict the direction and urgency of spreading the Gospel. This is the vision that Brother Navaneetha Annan captured in his design.

With this understanding, we are reminded to make the Bible the center of our lives, to strive for Christ, and to be willing to go in any direction, no matter the obstacles, to proclaim the cross and the Gospel. This symbol emphasizes the duty and responsibility of every member of this organisation. For those who are not called for fulltime, there is still the vital role of supporting this mission through prayer.

Jesus Christ calls us to serve the cross without faltering, until the love of Calvary is known to every person. Let us, with a deep understanding of the significance of this emblem, commit ourselves to serving God with dedication and zeal.

# WAYANAD LANDSLIDE SURVIVORS

**T**he landslide in Wayanad was a great tragedy. On July 30, 2024, two consecutive landslides occurred in the early morning hours, causing widespread devastation. Thousands of people tragically lost their lives while they were asleep. The disaster left the Kerala state, Wayanad district, Meppadi panchayat, and the villages of Mundakai and Suralmalai in ruins.

By God's grace, we were able to immediately visit the area and assist the affected people with their urgent needs. On December 16, Rev. Thomas Mathew, Rev. Abraham Thomas, Rev. Babu, and Rev. Golden Joe Inbaraj formed a team to visit the area again and personally meet some of the affected families. We plan to allocate up to four lakh rupees to support 30 affected families by addressing their basic needs.

Please pray that these needs will be met, and that the affected people will find comfort and hope in the love of Jesus Christ.

# Khunjan Church History

**HANUMANGARH FIELD,  
RAJASTHAN REGION**  
Beginning to August 2019

**H**anumangarh mission field was opened on 24.10.1974, the pioneer missionaries of this mission field being Mr. I Gershome, Mr. Jimson and Mr. Durairaj families. The pioneer missionaries had a few contacts at Khunjan village through their ministry. But they did not accept Christ. After Mrs. Leela Christopher (expired on 13.4.1980) and Mr. Edward Gnanamuthu (Expired on 7.6.1990) fell as grains of wheat in Hanumangarh soil, God opened the doors for gospel at Khunjan village in 1994 during the tenure of Mr. Robert William and Mr. Johnson Tamilselvan families. God touched the hearts of people through the Jesus film that was screened at Khunjan.

The missionaries write in the Hanumangarh prayer report dated March 1994 as follows: *"At Khunjan village we were doing preparatory work for the screening of Jesus film. Suddenly a man came and asked us not to screen the film and after*

*a few minutes he left the place. Without any more hindrances we screened Jesus' film."*

In the beginning some Rai Sikhs were receptive to the gospel. The missionaries met a woman named, Mrs. Akkobai of Khunjan village who introduced Mr. Kashmir Singh's family. Mr. Kashmir Singh of Khunjan had accepted Christ in Punjab. He introduced some of his relatives. Jesus' film was screened at his house in May 1994. In Apr 1994, Mr. Robert William family was transferred and Mr. Bright Jeyakumar family joined the Hanumangarh ministry on 3.6.1994 along with Mr. Johnson Tamilselvan family.

At Khunjan village, Mrs. Akkobai's son, Mr. Mahender Singh was addicted to alcohol. Every month he spent Rs. 2000 for drinking. After prayer, whenever he drank liquor, he vomited. So he stopped drinking liquor and he accepted Christ. Night meetings were often conducted at the houses of Mr.

Kashmir Singh and Mrs. Akkobai. Another resident of Khunjan village, Mr. Prem Singh and his family members also saw the Jesus film and accepted Christ. His son, Mr. Jangeer Singh conveys how his family accepted Christ in his own words -



*"My father, Mr. Prem Singh went to my uncle's place in Punjab. My uncle was a believer. One day a boy named Aman was bitten by a snake. My uncle, Chaand Singh prayed for the boy and he became alright. My father was surprised to see the power of Jesus. And my father started believing in Jesus. He came home and told all of us about this incident. My younger sister, Paramjeet was affected by some or the other illnesses often. My father took her to many magicians and to any place where people suggested. But she was not healed from her sickness. A missionary, Mr. Johnson (Johnson Tamilselvan) came to our village and he screened Jesus' film twice or thrice. We saw the film and to whichever village he screened the film we went there to see the film. Through the film we got to know more about the Lord. Pr. Johnson told us about Christ but my father told us that we would accept Christ if my sister would get well. He prayed for us and he prayed over a bottle of oil and water and he asked us to apply it on my sister. Gradually my sister got well and God helped us in every area where we were struggling. So all of us accepted Christ. My father and mother joined the Church on 12.7.1994."*

Later on 11.8.1995 all the three children of Mr. Prem Singh also joined the Church. On 12.7.1994, twenty Rai Sikhs from Khunjan village accepted Christ. The twenty people include the family of Mrs. Akkobai and her children, Mr. Kashmir Singh's family, Mr. Gopal Singh family and Mr. Prem Singh family. A worship meeting was started at Khunjan village in July 1994 by Mr. Bright Jeyakumar and Mr. Johnson Tamilselvan at a rented house in the neighbourhood of Mr. Prem Singh. At the very first worship 20 people participated.

## CHURCH GROWTH

Slowly and steadily the strength of the Khunjan congregation increased as people started experiencing miracles and deliverance. Missionary, Mr. Bright Jeyakumar writes in the Hanumangarh prayer report dated Jan 1995 as follows: *"Mrs. Shanti from Khunjan village was tormented by an evil spirit. In spite of the believers praying for her, she was not delivered. So at 12.30 am of Dec 29th the believers came to our house and called us for prayer. Immediately we went with them and prayed for Mrs. Shanthi and the Lord delivered her."*

From Feb 1995 prayer report, *"At Suresia, believer Mr. Kala Singh and family did not have children. Mrs. Dhanobai Kala Singh had 8 abortions previously. They accepted Christ on 12.7.1994 and they prayed for the same. The Lord blessed them with a baby boy on 24.1.1995. The baby boy was christened as Samuel Jesuveer."*

For two years worship was conducted at the rented house. Then in Nov 1996, a small plot (35X50) was bought and a katcha prayer hall was built by the believers. So the worship was shifted to the prayer hall. Believers from Khunjan, Tibbi and Suresia participated in the Sunday worship.



**Church elder,  
Mrs. Neelam narrates her testimony**



*"I am Neelam of Ghandhi Nagar, Hanumangarh Junction. We were running a shop in our locality. We did not get any profit from our shop. We struggled a lot financially. Our tenant, Mr. Babu told us about a Christian radio programme which gave him inner peace. So I started listening to the radio programme and started experiencing peace. My brother-in-law's family accepted Christ before itself and my brother-in-law's son, Girish, told us about Christ and about this Khunjan Church. My husband was worried about our eldest son. His ways were not good. My husband and my eldest son joined the Church first. Two months later, I joined the Church. I was suffering from gall bladder stones then. Through prayers of Ps. Jeyakumar (Rev. Bright Jeyakumar), I got healed from gall bladder stone. I did not undergo any operation. God has helped our family in every crisis and is faithfully leading us. Four years back my husband passed away but God is sustaining us still. People in our locality come to our house for prayer and two families have accepted Christ through us. Praise God."*

**Rajendra Kaur (W/O Mr. Krishan Singh) from Bawri community narrates her testimony.**



*"I am Rajendra Kaur from Khunjan village. In my childhood I was tortured by my stepmother and I underwent so many problems. My father was working with Rajasthan roadways. After my father's death, I got my father's job. After my second confinement I developed skin disease all over my body. There were big boils over my skin. My neighbour Mrs. Kalavathy who was also a believer told me about Christ and I started coming to the Church. Through prayers I got healed from skin disease. So I accepted Christ and was baptized on 23.6.2013 by Pastor. Arulraj (Mr. Arulraj Ebenezer). My eldest son was severely affected by asthma. Through prayer God healed him also graciously. Praise God."*

**Mrs. Chinder Kaur from Khunjan village who lives in the neighbourhood of Khunjan shares her testimony.**



*"Our son, Gurubachan was addicted to liquor. He used to beat and torture my daughter-in-law, my husband and me. He was in the company of bad friends and squandered the money by gambling. Every penny that he earned was spent for liquor and gambling. There was no peace in our family. Since the Church was close to our house I came to the Church and prayed for my family. I put my faith in the Lord. My daughter-in-law also started coming to the Church and we accepted Christ along with*



*my grandchildren on 30.9.2015. Through prayers, God changed the life of my son, Gurubachan. His alcoholic addiction reduced and he stopped beating us. Also God cut his bad friendship and he stopped playing gambling. In 2016 Gurubachan also accepted Christ on 1.1.2016. God answered all our prayers and He has filled our family with heavenly peace. Earlier we were living in a mud house but now God has helped us to build a pucca house and He has blessed us with cattle also. Praise God."*

## **THE CONGREGATION AND THE COMMUNITY**

The Khunjan congregation members are from the following villages: Jandawali, Kheruwala, Gandhinagar, Sureshia, Makkasar, Town, Kola, Kishanpura, Amarapura, Tibbi, Masani, Manaksar, Nawan, Housing board colony and Khunjan. The members of this Church are from Rai Sikh, Majbi Sikh, Jat Sikh, Bawri and Bania communities.

## **THE CHURCH LAND**

In Nov 1996, a small plot was purchased for Rs. 15,600 with an area of 35X50 and a katcha Church was constructed. As the plot was too small, it was sold and a new plot was purchased on 23.2.1998 for Rs. 39,000 from Mr. Kashmir Singh and Mrs. Akkobai. A pucca Church was constructed in the latter one. The breadth of the land in the front is 54 feet and breadth at the back is 56 feet. The length of the plot is 87 feet.

## **KATCHA CHURCH**

With prayer, the foundation of the katcha Church was laid on 31.10.1996. A katcha prayer hall was constructed by the believers of Khunjan for conducting worship. On 24.12.1996 thanksgiving

prayer was conducted and the Katcha prayer hall was dedicated by Rev. Bright Jeyakumar. Sunday services were conducted at this prayer hall every week.

## **PUCCA CHURCH CONSTRUCTION**

The name of the Church is St. John Satsang Bhavan. On 8.3.1998 foundation stone was laid for Khunjan Church by Rev. Bright Jeyakumar. A prayer meeting was also arranged in which believers from Khunjan, Tibbi and Suresia also participated. After the foundation stone was laid, sweets were distributed. And the Church size is 44X22. On 23.5.1999 the Khunjan Church was dedicated to the glory of God. Also, the silver jubilee of Hanumangarh ministry (1974 -1999) was also celebrated.

## **CHURCH ACTIVITIES AND INFORMATION**

The Church committee has 8 members. Mr. Jangeer Singh is the Church Secretary and Mrs. Rajender is the treasurer. The Committee members are chosen by the believers. People brought offerings to the Church as tithe, first fruit offering, vow offering, worship offering and thanksgiving offering. The monthly offering of Khunjan Church is approximately Rs. 2800.

### **Prayer Points**

1. There are many independent pastors at Hanumangarh who preach false doctrines and they try to steal our believers.
2. Wrong impressions about Christianity which are prevalent to be wiped off.
3. Marriage problems
4. Opposition to the believers from family and community.

# Trail Blazers

American missionary **Alice Brauer**, who dedicated over 60 years of her life to eradicating leprosy, tuberculosis, and polio in Ambur, was laid to rest on the premises of Bethesda Hospital on Thursday. Brauer passed away on September 30, 2024, at the age of 87, in her bungalow on the now-defunct hospital campus, due to age-related causes.

Born in 1938 in Nagercoil, Brauer was the fourth child of Richard Henry Brauer, who arrived in India from the United States in 1925. He settled in Nagercoil, teaching at the **Concordia Theological Seminary (CTSN)** and engaging in missionary work. Alice completed her schooling in Coonoor and Ooty before returning to the U.S. to study medicine.

When she returned to India to serve at Bethesda Hospital in Ambur under the **Indian Evangelical Lutheran Church (IELC)**, she was deeply moved by the poverty and poor health conditions in the region. She chose to work as a gynecological doctor, commissioned by the U.S.-based **Missouri Synod Missionary Society**. In 1968, she began reaching out to the sick, poor, and needy, providing medical care and sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ. Since then, she lived on the hospital premises until her death.

Throughout her career spanning six decades, Alice's work touched over 60 villages and transformed the lives of many in the local communities. She became a beacon of hope for the people of Ambur, offering care during outbreaks of diseases such as chickenpox, whooping cough (pertussis), cholera, and polio. At a time when immunization programs were in their infancy, she was a trailblazer, advocating for preventive care and child healthcare in Ambur and Vaniyambadi.

Fondly referred to as **"Ambur's Mother Teresa," "Brauer Amma,"** and **"Missiyamma,"** she was known for her kindness and compassion. The locals believed that just seeing her driving her jeep to their villages would ward off evil spirits causing illness.

Alice focused on promoting institutional deliveries to combat the dangers posed by untrained midwives and quacks. She also encouraged neonatal and postnatal care and spread awareness about the importance of immunization. Though initially met with distrust and reluctance from the community, her persistent

efforts broke taboos, and within five years, the hospital saw a significant increase in patient visits. A small but dedicated team of workers supported her mission.

Her compassion extended beyond people. Once, a nomad brought her a peahen's egg for sale. She bought and hatched it among her hens, naming the bird **Indumathi**. She also cared for a pack of dogs, naming each one and treating them with love.

Emlin Chandra, who worked with Alice from 1972 to 1974, described her in a condolence message as someone who "lived a beautiful, godly life, serving the poor and needy, children, the sick, and the dying. She left her own family and adopted every soul in Ambur."

Alice retired as a **Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod (LCMS)** career missionary in 2003 at the age of 75 but continued to serve part-time at Bethesda Hospital. Even after a fall in 2017 left her wheelchair-bound, she remained dedicated to helping new mothers and their babies.

Her life and legacy of love, faith, and service will be remembered by all who knew her.
