Faithful Obedience



Arabian horses undergo rigorous training in the deserts of the Middle East. Their obedience is tested by depriving them of water for days and then releasing them near a water source. Just before they drink, the trainer blows a whistle. If the horses have truly learned to obey, they will turn back to their trainer, who will then provide them with water. The trainer knows their needs and will not allow them to die of thirst. In the vast, trackless desert of Arabia, a horse's obedience could mean the difference between life and death. This

kind of obedience, though severe, is essential when your life depends on the trustworthiness of your steed.

In a similar way, one of the 9 Ethos of FMPB is "Obedience," rooted in John 15:10. God teaches us about obedience through many biblical figures such as Noah and Abraham. In Scripture, God emphasizes the necessity of obedience to His commands, to the leaders He appoints, and to the laws of the land. The consequences of disobedience are severe, as seen in Deuteronomy 28.

One biblical story that illustrates the power of obedience is when Peter, tired from a fruitless night of fishing, obeyed Jesus' command to cast his net into the deep waters. Despite his weariness and scepticism, Peter's obedience led to a miraculous catch (Luke 5:5). God calls us to obey even in the most impossible and incomprehensible circumstances, as shown in the story of Hosea's marriage (Hosea 1:2-3). Delayed or half-hearted obedience is not truly obedience.

Obedience is our duty (Ecclesiastes 12:13; Luke 17:7-10); it is an expression of our love for God (John 14:15) and a sign of our humility (Proverbs 22:4). Through obedience, God is glorified (Leviticus 9:22-23), peace is achieved (2 Chronicles 14:1-6), and miracles happen (1 Kings 14:13-16). Our lives will prosper (Joshua 1:6-9), and we will experience a life full of blessings (Exodus 15:26).

The goal of obedience is to obey immediately with a full heart, even in the most difficult and illogical circumstances, just as the horses must obey their trainer's whistle despite their overwhelming thirst. The consequences of disobedience are grave—just as we saw with Adam and Eve, the confusion that befell Israel, the regret of Samson, the loss of Jonah, the sorrow of David, and the slavery of Israel.

When we choose to obey, we may face ridicule or be seen as foolish. But we are reminded that obedience is better than sacrifice. And when we obey, we can trust that our God will continue to lead and bless us.

Let us pray for God's continued guidance, that we may walk with greater obedience to His will.

Obedience is better than sacrifice

The meaning of **OBEEDIENCE** is an act or instance of obeying as given in Merriam Webster Dictionary.

Obedience is a behavior that's respectful and mindful of the rules and laws in the society at large.

Obedience is a virtue which is not that easy to put into practice until it becomes part & parcel of human behaviour whether it is home, society, community or work spot. Obedience helps a family to live in harmony and thrive as a cohesive whole as an institutions like army, police, civil society etc., to achieve its objectives for better living. It is also one of the many spiritual disciplines. A father expects his wife and children to obey (Ephesians 5). A leader expects his subordinates to obey. Biblically, God has decreed his creation, the mankind to obey to his commands for wholesome living. Arthur Wallis, a second world veteran who later became a missionary says that "the first duty of a soldier is obedience, second is obedience and third too is obedience".

FMPB also has obedience as its Ethos. This movement expects all its members both full time and volunteers to obey our Lord and Master, Jesus Christ and His commands. Jesus was the best example of obedience; one cannot ignore it.

In His Childhood

Jesus was obedient throughout his life time. Once he stayed back in Jerusalem temple and was found deep in discussion with the Sanhedrin members, unknown to their parents. When the parents came back in search of him, and was admonished, -And he went down with them, and came to Nazareth, and was subject unto them: Luke 2:51

In His Career

Jesus was obedient in his career both as a carpenter and as a son of God to carry out the will of His heavenly Father. Wilful submission will earn accolades from our Saviour Jesus Christ and we too will have a satisfaction in remembering the verse," All things happen for good to them that love God" Romans 8:28

In His personal life

When Jesus was considered as a potential threat, he was busy doing good to the people unmindful of the comments passed by others. His eyes were always focussed on God the Father. He always followed the instruction from His father. Very truly I tell you, the Son can do nothing by himself; he can do only what he sees his Father doing, because whatever the Father does the Son also does. - John 5:19

In His profession

He never looked or craved for popularity. He was obedient and did not hide anything from his disciples. His teaching was unadulterated. He never had a hidden agenda. His life was filled with transparency. Jesus answered and said unto him, if a man loves me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him. John 14:23

In His Passion

Jesus' prayer in the Garden of Gethsemane is a pattern for us, I learned", says Catherine Marshall. Christ could have avoided the cross. He did not have to go to Jerusalem that last time. He could have compromised with the priests, bargained with Caiaphas. He could have capitalized on his following and appeased Judas by setting up the beginning of an earthly kingdom. Pilate wanted to release him, all but begged him to say the right words so that he might. In the Garden, Christ had plenty of time to flee, but he used his free will to leave the decision up to his Father.

That is obedience. Letting oneself to do God's will even during times of difficulty, drawing strength from above.

In His Suffering - (Handling persecution)

He never tried to retaliate. He was silent. Suffered silently at the hands of his tormenters (created beings) He had the magnanimity to forgive their sins. Never tried to use His father's authority like leaders in power sometimes act. When standing before the authorities, rulers, he did not show his power. He never tried to threaten others like men who had a powerful backing.

When reviled kept silent, in his daily life. It is all because He enjoyed a very close relationship with His father in prayer very early in the morning hours.

-For as by the one man's disobedience the many were made sinners, so by the one man's obedience the many will be made righteous. Romans 5:19

A transfer from a flourishing field to a dry area is an injustice, the full-time workers may think. Yet when we look above to our Creator God, He helps us submit to the authority of our leaders. Many times, your colleague is preferred for promotion may be due to an ethnic background or partiality. Whatever may be the situation, we always should learn to refer to the Word of God by obeying His Great Commission in proclaiming the Good News irrespective of our counting the perks and benefits, considering the challenges, and counting the cost.

During this time of Lenten season, let us look to the Son of God, and meditate on the sufferings our Lord Jesus endured on the Cross of Calvary and try to imitate Him in all the walks of our lives. To Him be all glory, laud and honour.

Rev Vijay Prasanna Isaac was born to Mr. D Victor Isaac & Mrs. Thangam Isaac at Bengaluru, Karnataka. He lost his father at very young age and was raised by his mother who led him to accept the Lord Jesus Christ as his personal savior and dedicated his life for God's service during Stanely Prince Annan's meeting in Bengaluru. His mother was a Prayer warrior, Prayer Group leader and adherent supporter of FMPB who prayed and contributed generously for missionary work. She prayerfully nurtured and groomed him in the fear of God with biblical values and a strong commitment for missions. As a spiritual son he was mentored by Rev D Harris Hilton, our first missionary who discipled and infused in him the passion, vision and obligation to

fulfill Great Commission in our motherland India. He was actively involved with the local mobilization ministry along with PG leaders like Mr. Jothinathan and others. He served with Operation Mobilization in North India which deepened his calling and widened his vision for missions. He joined the South India Biblical Seminary, affiliated to the Serampore University, and graduated with the Degree of Bachelor in Theology in 1991. He cultivated the resourceful skills in preaching, training, mentoring and deep passion for missions. Rev G Subburam Robert the then Mobilization Secretary motivated him to join as missionary in FMPB. And in obedience to God's calling, he joined as a Cross-cultural missionary in 1991. His missionary journey began with a brief stint

in Gujarat and was later due to organizational need was placed in Church – Mission mobilization ministry in Karnataka. He was ordained as minister of Church of North India in 2004.

THANK GOD FOR THE NATIONAL PLANNING CONFERENCE 2025!

The National Planning Conference 2025 of the Friends Missionary Prayer Band (FMPB) was held at the Gurukul Theological Seminary Auditorium in Chennai from February 7th to 9th. The theme of the conference was "Raising 1,000 Missionaries, Multiplying Prayer Groups & Enlarging Mission Fields." Approximately 312 invitees, including full-time missionaries, honorary staff, prayer group members, and leaders from across the nation, participated in the event.

Pre-Conference Fasting Prayer

Before the Planning Conference, an eleven-hour fasting prayer session was held on February 7th, 2025, from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Nearly 150 people gathered to pray for various concerns related to the ministry, the nation, and God's blessings on the conference. Rev. Jeyapaul Sither, a retired missionary from IEM, shared the Word of God.

During the conference, the General Secretary presented his ministerial report, highlighting God's faithfulness throughout his four-year ministerial journey. The Treasurer presented the approved budget for the fiscal year 2025–2026, emphasizing a growth rate increase from 5.88% to 7.5%. Additionally, Divisional and Zonal Secretaries of FMPB shared prayer concerns, testifying to God's wonderful deeds in mission fields despite numerous challenges and opposition.

Day 1: February 8th, 2025

The conference began with an opening session led by our youth team and missionary kids, under the leadership of Mr. Emmanuel, Honorary Mobilization Regional Secretary of Chennai.

They lifted the gathering in praise with lively songs in English, Hindi, and Tamil.

Mr. John Samuel, President of FMPB, presided over the conference and delivered the keynote address. Dr. Jayakumar Christian, a missiologist and former Director of World Vision International, shared the Word of God, focusing on the themes "Sharing God's Pain" and "Nurturing a Restless Intimacy with God."





The session included video documentaries featuring the Malto, Santhal, and Dungra Bhil people groups, along with mission updates.

The guests of honor included:

- Mr. Siju Thomas, National Director of ADF
- Mr. Wilfred Davidar

They encouraged and exhorted the missionaries based on their respective areas of expertise.

Following this, Divisional Heads presented their reports, prompting attendees to glorify God for His marvelous works. The participants were then divided into ten groups for a brainstorming session,

discussing ten specific questions related to mission strategy and growth.

Day 2: February 9th, 2025

The second day of the conference began with a Holy Communion Service, led by Rev. Isaac Raja.

A powerful testimony was shared by Mr. Krishankumar, a missionary who endured 32 days of imprisonment for the sake of the Gospel.

Later, leaders from all ten groups presented their insights and expectations, based on their group discussions. The question-and-answer session demonstrated the deep commitment and concern of each participant for the ministry of FMPB.

The General Secretary, Rev. John Berlin, shared the thrust of the year, encouraging participants to refine their vision and align their efforts with the conference theme.

A Prayer of Commitment was led by Mr. Sam Ponniah, Vice President of FMPB. The conference concluded with a final address from Mr. John Samuel, President of FMPB, titled "FMPB: God's Movement," reminding all of the unique calling and purpose of the mission.

The event closed with a vote of thanks, prayer, and benediction by Rev. John Berlin, General Secretary of FMPB.

Embracing God's Design for Women

International Women's Day is a global celebration of the achievements and victories of women, observed every year on March 8th. On this day, the programs that are broadcasted honor the accomplishments of women and inspire the next generation to strive for success. However, while women continue to break barriers, many still face self-degradation and humiliation from others.

The Bible offers a remarkable perspective, highlighting ordinary women as models for us to emulate in the modern world. As St. Peter speaks of the "unfading beauty" of these women, he reminds us that this beauty is found in the way the holy women of the past—who put their hope in God—adorned themselves. They did so by submitting to their husbands, as described in 1 Peter 3:4-5.

For those women who focus on external adornment for the sake of self-esteem, the Bible offers a timeless beauty tip: **Obedience**. The beauty that God values cannot be bought with money, worldly

possessions, or human efforts. It is through our time spent with God that He grants us this inner adornment. In the Epistles, **obedience** and **submission** are often used interchangeably in reference to human relationships. Obedience is an act we perform before men, while submission is a quality displayed through our emotional relationship with God. Our relationship with God, and the transformations that His Word brings, are what reveal our obedience and submission.

The Lord sent His only Son, Jesus Christ, into the world to restore the relationship humanity lost in the Garden of Eden. As Philippians 2:7-8 says, "He humbled Himself and became obedient to death—even death on a cross." If Jesus was obedient to His Father, how much more should we strive to be obedient and humble?

Throughout the Gospels, we see that Jesus did only what the Father told Him to do and speak. His close relationship with God in His daily life enabled Him to be obedient

even unto death. Jesus is, therefore, our ultimate model for learning obedience and submission. In Ephesians 5:22, Paul instructs wives to be submissive to their husbands, recognizing the family as an institution established by God. In this structure, the Bible identifies the husband as the head of the family. While there are various opinions on the equality of husbands and wives, the Bible teaches us to live in unity with and submission to our husbands, as we submit to Christ in this divinely ordained institution.

Both husbands and wives are made righteous through the blood of Jesus and are called to live holy lives, establishing Christian homes. This environment also nurtures the growth of children in love

and a relationship with God. When we emphasize submission to God and strive for harmony in our personal and family lives, we can reflect Christ in our public lives. By acting in obedience to God, we demonstrate His love to those around us and help save others from destruction. God uses us to meet the needs of people in various communities and cultures.

Because we play the role as wife, mother, leader, sender, supporters etc, beloved, let us adorn our lives with the beauty of obedience and submission, so that we could reflect the love of God in all that we do.

PIPLAIDEVI CHURCH HISTORY



Ahwa Field, Sahyadri Region

Rev. L. Masilamani

General:

Pipalaidevi is a medium size village located in the Subir taluka of the Dangs district, Gujarat. In Pipalaidevi village, most of the village population is from Schedule Tribe (ST). Schedule Tribe (ST) constitutes 98.79 % of total population in Pipalaidevi village. There is no population of Schedule Caste (SC) in Pipalaidevi village of The Dangs. The people of Pipalaidevi are engaged as Marginal activity cultivators (owner or co-owner) and Agricultural laborers.

The Beginning:

On 8-5-1981, L. Masilamani, his wife Mrs. Vanmathi and their first son M. John

Kingsly (two years and eight months old) opened the Ahwa field by going and settling in a rented house in Pipaldahad village. Brothers G. Samuel and S. Arulraj joined them on 27-9-1981. But they moved to other mission fields and ministries soon. While doing ministry they found out that there was a good receptivity in the nearby Junner village and they moved to Junner village on 30-11-1981. Due to opposition in Junner village, the missionary family left Junner on 30-8-1982 and went to Ahwa for staying. The Ahwa CNI church pastor Rev. T. V. Gaikwad helped them much in this opposition time. As the Dolyambar village headman and Manu Bhai invited the missionaries to their village, Missionaries went to live in Dolyambar village on 12-3-1983. Dolyambar village became a strategic place to tell the gospel to the nearby villages and for those who came to know Christ through God's chosen vessels to contact the FMPB missionary to develop the ministry in their villages.

Missionary family had to go to this village by walking a distance of nearly eight kms carrying their infant twin boys in 1984 to go to Ahwa for purchasing or for any other works. From 1983 to 1987 there were no contacts for the missionaries in this village. But in 1987 God brought some families to Dolyambar village after getting healings in unique ways. Really it was God's time for Pipalaidevi to establish His kingdom from 1987 onwards.

Opposition:

In July 1988 there was much opposition in Piplaidevi and ministry could not be carried out. In 1990 the village headman Ramu Bhai came to follow Christian faith to get healing from his stomach pain and to get victory over his alcoholic addiction. It was a breakthrough for the Christian congregation to get relieved of opposition in the village. It also gave a recognition for the Christian faith and many people came to faith in 1990. 30 people took baptism in 1990. The weekly meeting was shifted to the house of the village headman till a kacha (temporary) church was built in front of the house of the village headman.

Miracles in Piplaidevi Church History

Daulat Bhai Jhunjar Bhai and Shukri Ben Daulat Bhai:

I was drinking alcohol and was involved in fighting. Suddenly a great calamity came on our life. My wife got chest pain became so weak that she could not do any work. I did many pujas through the shamans and spent much on offering many things for the pujas. But no difference was seen in the health of my wife. So, we went to the Kamat church for prayer there the missionaries prayed for my wife. Immediately my wife was healed, we then started following Jesus Christ. Then we attend the Dolyambar church as there is no church in our village.

Shentu Bhai Reshma Bhai and Naiji Ben Shentu:

My wife was tormented by evil spirits and suffered from many illnesses, while

I was addicted to alcohol. We spent a lot of money on bhagat worships and offerings, and my wife tried herbal medicines, but her condition worsened. With no more money to spend, we decided to visit Dolyambar church for healing. After my wife was prayed for, her sicknesses left her within eight days, and she was completely healed. We have been attending the Dolyambar church ever since.

Shukria Bhai's wife Kengu Ben narrates:



After the delivery of her first child in 1989, she became very weak and could not walk, crawling on the floor. Her husband took her to Garkhadi by bullock cart, where there was a church. They had tried pujas with shamans, but she didn't find any relief. Some people advised her to visit the Garkhadi church for healing. Gopichand Bhai prayed for her, and she stayed in her husband's sister's home while being prayed for over the course of a month. After receiving healing, they began attending the Taklipada church.

Goma Bhai Gondya Bhai Jadhav:



I suffered from a skin disease and tried witch doctors and herbal medicines, but nothing worked. The village headman, a Christian, encouraged me to go to church. Evangelist Dhansukh Bhai prayed for me and also blessed the medicines from the government hospital. Gradually, my health improved, and the white patches from leprosy disappeared. I was healed and took baptism in 1990.

Amriya Bhai Raju Bhai Vadhya:



I struggled with alcohol, mental issues, and even considered suicide. I lived a troubled life, once even setting my house on fire and wandering in a saree. My younger brother, Sonu, invited me to church for healing. I went to Taklipada church, where Evangelist Jivalya Bhai prayed for me, and I heard God's word. Over time, I stopped drinking and was healed from my physical and mental struggles, including my sight problems. It took a year, but I fully recovered. I've been living in faith for the last 22 years.

Again in 1988 and 1989 God stirred many people in Piplaidevi village to go to the nearby churches to get healings. FMPB evangelists and missionaries prayed for these seekers in these churches and helped them find Christ. Following few testimonies testified, the congregation had its beginning in Piplaidevi village.

Church Growth

Village headman coming to the faith and the believers sharing their faith to the sick relatives were the main reasons for the church growth. Nav Jeevan Seva Mandal shifted its medical clinic from Dolyambar to Piplaidevi in 1990. The CNI dean Rev. Jivalya Bhai family was working in this clinic. They also shared the gospel to many people who came to the clinic and prayed for the sick people. By 1996 nearly 90 families came to faith in Piplaidevi village.

Church construction and Dedication

In 1990, the village headman Ramu Bhai came forward to put up a kacha church in front of his home. Sonu Bhai Raju Bhai describes about the construction of the kacha church: Then number of believers increased. All decided to put up a kacha church. Every believer contributed one wood from their homes. We all brought karvi (one kind of thick grass used for wall) for the church. Then we built that church. On 26-9-1990, Rev. T.V. Gaikwad, Ahwa CNI pastor, dedicated the kacha church in Piplaidevi village. In December, 2000 the **second church** was constructed and Rev. D. Abraham was the field missionary. It was a semi-pucca church. Pastor Dudley Thangiah of Madurai dedicated that church. This church was constructed in the land donated by the school teacher Mr. Sitaram Bhai Chamar Bhai. On 5-1-2008, beginning of the construction of the **third church** (the present church) was started. On 12-10-2010, this new church was dedicated. The RFS Rev. S. Arulraj came for the church dedication. Some prayer group members came with him.

The land was donated by Sitaram Bhai. There was no opposition during the church construction. Total labour was given by the believers freely.

Church Activities and Important Information

Four families used to come from Pokudmal villages. Bhil and Kukna are the people groups in this Church. Majority people are from Bhil tribe. 250 people are attending the worship services. 60 per cent people go to work in sugarcane fields. Sitaram Bhai conducts the worship services. Mothiram Bhai also helps in conducting prayers. Sitaram Bhai or his son Manoj Bhai helps in conducting the meetings. Worship services, Cottage Prayer meetings, Friday prayer meetings and Wednesday night meetings are conducted regularly. Youth camps are conducted in

a year once or twice. Women gatherings are done occasionally. Revival and special meetings are conducted four times a year. Non- Christians demanded contribution to their religious festivals, but Christians do not contribute. Fasting Prayer is conducted once in two months. Sick people are met and prayed for.

Prayer Concerns

- Total village people should be won for Christ
- Believers should grow strong in faith and continue in faith without backsliding.
- Sunday school to be continued.
- Migration of people for work from September to April every year.
- For them to stay strong when they fall sick and not fall back in faith.

A Meeting With The General Secretary of CNI

Let's say a prayer for our Women!

Women are a wonderful creation of God, deserving celebration, yet face numerous challenges in our nation. These include unequal pay (earning 40 rupees for every 100 rupees earned by men), racial injustice, gender-based violence, inadequate healthcare, and limited education (65.46% for females vs. 80.88% for males). Other issues include human trafficking (at least 3 women per day), online harassment, domestic violence (38%), selective abortion, female infanticide, dowry, child marriages, and low family status.
