







Charles Spurgeon shared a story about his grandfather James, a poor pastor with a large family and a very small income, but he loved the Lord, and he would not have given up his preaching of the Gospel for anything." When their only cow died-cutting off the children's milk supply-James confidently said God could provide even fifty cows if needed. That same day, a group in London, unaware of his situation, raised money for struggling pastors. When they reached the end of the list, there were still five pounds left. One man suggested sending it to James Spurgeon. Another said, "No, let's not send just five pounds. Let me add five more to go with it." Others joined in, and the day after his cow died, the next day, he received the gift-just after the loss of the cow.

This story highlights that God provides for our needs and keeps His promises. Faith in God is demonstrated, not just in our prayers for His provision, but also in our patient belief in His justice. When you are wronged, trust God to take care of you and deal with it rather than taking vengeance yourself. We show belief in a physician, lawyer, or banker by entrusting them with what we cannot handle ourselves. In the same way, we truly believe in Jesus as

From the General Secretary...

Dear Prayer Partners

Greetings to you in the precious name of our Lord Jesus Christ!

In a time marked by conflict, uncertainty and fragile ceasefires, our nation stands at a critical crossroads. Tensions at borders, political instability and the deep scars left by violence have stirred widespread anxiety. While the media echoes with headlines of negotiation and retaliation, we are reminded that for lasting peace to take root, the Church must rise in fervent intercession and bold witness.

As partners in mission and prayer, we are not passive observers of the unfolding drama - we are active participants in God's redemptive work. This is a call to look beyond the headlines and step into our divine responsibility, to pray, to proclaim, and to be agents of peace.

Understanding the Nature of Conflict

The Bible is replete with accounts of war and turmoil. Yet, beyond the physical battles, Scripture reveals a deeper spiritual reality. James 4:1 asks, "What causes fights and quarrels among you?" - pointing to inner conflicts rooted in sin, pride and selfish

ambition. In this sense, the wars we see today are reflections of spiritual unrest, where the kingdom of darkness seeks to disrupt and destroy.

While ceasefire agreements offer momentary relief, they cannot heal the hearts of a broken nation. Peace, in the biblical sense, is not merely the absence of war - it is the presence of justice, restoration, and righteousness. As Jeremiah warned, "They dress the wound of my people as though it were not serious. 'Peace, peace,' they say when there is no peace" (jer6:14).

True peace comes only through reconciliation with God. As believers, we are entrusted with this message of hope - and commissioned to proclaim it in every context, including those marred by conflict.

A Biblical mandate for intercession and Mission

Throughout history, God has sought those who would intercede on behalf of nations. In Ezekiel 22:30, He says "I looked for someone among them who would build up the wall and stand before me in the gap on behalf of the land..." in seasons of unrest, the Church is called not to retreat but to stand in the gap with spiritual authority.

Jesus Himself, approaching Jerusalem, wept over the city and lamented, "If you, even you, had only known on this day what would bring you peace..." (Luke 19:42). His tears reveal the divine yearning for cities and nations to recognize the path to true peace.

Furthermore, in the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus declared, “Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God” (Matt 5:9). The role of a peacemaker is not passive. It involves entering spaces of conflict with compassion, wisdom, and a commitment to values of the Kingdom of God.

Mission in the midst of Crisis

In regions affected by war, the need for the Gospel becomes even more urgent. Physical devastation is accompanied by emotional and spiritual trauma. Fear, displacement, and loss have left many seeking answers and stability.

This is where our mission becomes most relevant. The message of Christ - who reconciles man to God and restores broken relationships - is the foundation for true, lasting peace.

At FMPB, we continue to stand with the unreached and marginalized, even in the most sensitive and volatile regions. Our commitment is unwavering; to be a presence of hope, to preach Christ crucified and risen, and to serve with compassion in communities that need healing.

Divine Protection in the Conflict Zones

We offer heartfelt thanks and praise to God for His hand of protection upon our missionaries, local evangelists and believers serving in Jammu, Kashmir and Punjab. Despite complex and often volatile circumstances, they have remained rooted in their calling - serving the people with courage, grace, and unwavering faith.

Their commitment to remain with local people, to offer prayer, encouragement, and tangible support, is profound testimony to the

love of Christ. In every prayer offered, every Scripture shared and every act of kindness extended, they are embodying the Gospel.

Their lives declare what the psalmist wrote: “He will cover you with his feathers, and under His wings your will find refuge...” (Psalm 91:4)

We invite the entire prayer network to uphold them daily - pleading the promises of God over their lives and ministries and thanking HIM for sustaining them in such strategic mission fields.

A Glimpse of Hope

While the challenges we face are great, our hope is greater. Revelation 21 gives us a vision of what is to come: “He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain...” (Rev 21:4) This is not a fantasy - it is the reality we work toward every day, as ambassadors of Christ and laborers in His field.

As conflict simmers and peace feels fragile, let us rise as watchmen on the walls - faithful in intercession, courageous in witness and unwavering in hope. Now is the time to stand in the gap. Now is the time to proclaim peace through Christ. Now is the time to believe that the light shines brightest in the darkness. Let's us labor together-until every stronghold fall, until every wounded heart is healed, and until every corner of our nation declares: Jesus is Lord.

June Focus: Engaging, Equipping, and Expanding the Mission

This month, FMPB moves forward with key initiatives that reflect both our urgency and hope for the Gospel:

June 6-7 marks the **interview of new missionaries**, a vital process in expanding the harvest force for unreached regions. Please uphold these candidates in prayer - that the Lord would confirm HIS call, provide clarity, and fill each one with passion for the lost.

On June 9, we commemorate **Periyamalai Day**, remembering the heritage and sacrifice of our pioneers who sowed with tears. The humble and historical roots of our mission movement and may it be a reminder that every great move of God begins with obedience, sacrifice and prayer.

Additionally, **Central Zone visits and field programs** will take place 23 - 29 June.

Faith



Christian faith fundamentally revolves around the belief in a single triune God and the acceptance of Bible as God's word that divinely inspired and authoritative.

Faith is the corner stone of our Christian belief. Without faith we could not please God.

1. Faith is the belief and trust in God's existence and character

Whoever draw near to God must believe that he exists and that He rewards those who seek him [Hebrew 11:6]. By faith we understand the authority, power and presence of God. One can understand the living God by experiencing the presence of God through the Word of God, revelations and by personal experiences.

By faith one can understand and grasp God's character. God is having **unlimited power and authority** over all creations. God is **present everywhere** at all times. God's **love is fundamental** aspect of his creation provision and relationship

with humanity. God is **holy** completely sinless. There are many other characters we can experience in God such as justice, goodness etc. Let us experience His presence and character in our life.

2. Faith is complete trust in God and His promises

Once a man was walking on a tightrope holding a long bamboo stick between two hills. He had his son seated on his shoulder while doing this stunt. When the man walked over the rope and reached the other end with his son, the crowd began to clap and whistle seeing his breath-taking performance. The man asked the crowd can I do this again, and the crowd shouted Yes. He asked again "do you have complete confidence in my skill? The crowd replied Yes. Then, one of you send your child so that I can carry it across this rope. But no one was ready for that. The people knew that the man has the ability to take their child across the rope. But when it comes to their personal experience, they did not

have the complete confidence and trust in him. If we do not have such confidence and trust in God, we will be always be worried and stressed. Can we completely trust in God and His promises. (Prov 3:5-6)

3. Salvation is received through faith in Jesus and His grace

Salvation means being saved from eternal doom. It often refers to being saved from sin and its consequences, ultimately from the eternal punishment or separation from God. There are four steps to being saved.

- a) Believing in Jesus Christ the savior and confess it (Rom:10;10)
- b) Recognize the sinful nature
- c) Repenting of sins. If anyone recognize sin and feels sorry (regret) for it and confesses it, it is the crucial step towards repentance. This kind of repentance will lead to salvation (2cor7:10)
- d) Christian Faith is always described as a life style (2cor5:7). Faith is more than words It's a way of life manifested through actions (Jam2:14)

4. Sacrificial service increase Faith

In response to the disciples' request to increase their faith (Luke17:5-10), Jesus taught that even a small faith can accomplish great things, emphasizing the importance of obedience and service over seeking miracles. Jesus illustrated this

point with a parable about a servant. Faith is about full filling one's duty and serving others without expecting recognition or reward this act of service can serve as a witness to others of the power and love of God.

5. The Test of Faith

God may test an individual's faith to reveal the depth of their faith and commitment in their faith. Jesus tested the faith of the Canaanite women to reveal her unwavering belief in Jesus (Mathew15:21-28). Jesus initially ignored her request. Secondly, Jesus denied her request by answering that He was only sent for the Israelites. Thirdly Jesus completely rejected her by using the analogy of the children's bread and dogs by suggesting that blessings of God are reserved for the Jewish people and not gentiles like her.

Inspite of the rejection, this Canaanite woman persisted her plea. Why because she knows only Jesus can solve her problem. This kind of faith help us to overcome all tests. Job was tested by satan, Abraham was tested by God. Disciples were once tested by storm. We might be tested by God, satan or natural calamities etc. But our firm faith in the triune God will help us to overcome all these test(1peter1:6-7). Test and trials make our faith greater than refined Gold.

Periyamalai Day

2025



Periyalamalai is more than just the name of a place - it is a symbol of life, legacy, and purpose for the Friends Missionary Prayer Band (FMPB). It was on June 9, 1967, that God chose this quiet, mountainous village of Periyamalai in Pettamukilalam, Dharmapuri district, to be the sacred ground where the first seed of the FMPB mission was sown. It was not chosen because of its popularity or prominence, but because God delights in using the humble beginnings to accomplish mighty things. Just as a mustard seed grows into a large tree, so did this first act of obedience - the first mission endeavor of FMPB - blossom into a nation-wide movement.

Watered by the prayers, tears, sacrifices, and tireless labor of God's faithful servants, the seed at Periyamalai has grown into a banyan tree - vast, strong, and life-giving. Like the branches of that tree spreading wide, so too has the mission grown, reaching across states and cultures, bearing fruit in every season, and sheltering multitudes under the love of Christ. Periyamalai is not merely our first field - it is our spiritual foundation. It is a testimony that small beginnings, when guided by God's hand, can transform into a great harvest.

Periyamalai, in Pettamukilalam, is the birthplace of our movement - our very first mission field. For the past 58 years, God has faithfully led and nurtured the work that began there. Many faithful individuals have participated in this divine mission in countless ways, each contributing uniquely to the expansion of God's Kingdom. Today, as we look back, our hearts overflow with gratitude, recognizing the abundant fruit borne through their dedication and obedience.


We give thanks to God for His faithful servants, Rev. Harris Hilton and Mrs. Padma, who were the first missionaries in this visionary land. Their step of obedience laid the foundation upon which generations have built. Their love, humility, and sacrifice shaped the spiritual landscape of this region and ignited a fire that still burns bright.

We also remember and honor our senior missionaries and their families, who joyfully surrendered their comforts, finances, education, youthful years, and talents to build God's Kingdom here. Their footsteps have become a legacy of faith for generations to follow.

Equally, we express our heartfelt gratitude to the prayer group leaders and supporters who, with great faith and sacrificial commitment, said, *"Go and do God's work in the field; we will uphold you with our prayers and offerings."* These hidden heroes played a significant role in establishing God's Kingdom in the southern part of our nation through their unwavering intercession and support.

Periyamalai is home to a diverse population - including the Irular, Lingayats, Adi Dravidians, Arundhatiyars, Vanniyars, and Vellalar Gounders. Before 1967, many of them had never even heard the name of Jesus Christ. But in His sovereign grace, God made a way - opening hearts and villages, and preparing a people to receive the Gospel of peace.

The First Fruits of the Mission



Mr. Raman (Stephen)

The very first fruit of this mission. Initially, he was deeply opposed to the missionaries. Along with six others, he planned to set fire to their hut, blaming them for the lack of rain. But that night, heavy rain fell continuously - thwarting their attempt. Convicted by this miracle, Raman returned the next morning and asked, "Was it your God who saved you?" Moved by the Gospel shared by Mrs. Padma - through a simple picture of the crucified Christ - his heart was transformed. He threw away his cigarettes and beedis, and gave his life to Christ. Thus, Raman became Stephen.



Mr. John Allimuthu

A postmaster in Darentahalli, he was a friend of Stephen. After a devastating fire destroyed 50 homes in Pettamukilalam, he came to assess the damage. There, he met Hilton annan and Padma akka. He stayed with the missionary couple, received the Gospel, and was given a New Testament. Two years later, in 1969, during a meeting at Danishpet, he publicly confessed Christ as his Savior and joined the flock.



Mr. Victor Ramalingam

Appointed Headmaster of Ulaganall village in 1967, he was introduced to Allimuthu and accompanied him to see the fire-ravaged at Pettamukilalam. Caught in the rain, the missionaries welcomed them into their humble hut - "Jehova Jireh" - offered them food, clothing, and the message of salvation. Touched by their kindness and the power of the Gospel, Victor became the first in Periyamalai to confess Christ. Eventually, 25 members of his family also came to faith.

The Gospel Advances

From Pettamukilalam, the Gospel journeyed to the plains of Marandahalli through Mr. Eben Azaria, leading Mr. Vijayakumar to Christ. The ministry continued to flourish through Mr. & Mrs. Dharmamani in Iruthukottai, where Mr. Peturu Muniyappa became the first local minister.

Over the years, many missionary families have faithfully served across the Dharmapuri district. Today, the fruit of their ministry can be seen in the lives of fourth-generation believers worshipping the Lord.

From this field

- ◆ 27 individuals have become full-time ministers, serving across India
- ◆ 55 others are serving as local evangelists
- ◆ The Zone has now expanded into three active Regions
- ◆ Local churches have become self-supporting and self-governing
- ◆ The believers actively support the ministry with their prayers and resources

Looking Ahead with Vision and Faith

The mission continues. Let us uphold this field in prayer as the team commits to the following vision by 2030:

- ◆ Evangelize 440,000 people
- ◆ Reach 880 new villages
- ◆ Form 88 worshipping groups
- ◆ Build 44 churches
- ◆ Disciple 4,400 believers and integrate them into the Body of Christ



However, as she moved forward, the water rose to her knees and then to her hips. At this critical moment, Anitha called out to the Lord for help. In His faithfulness, God protected her, fulfilling His promise in Isaiah 43:2, and did not let her drown. Glory to His name!

Gogamukh and Dhakuakhana



Fields

Assam is located in the Northeastern region of India. It is situated at foothills of eastern Himalayas. It borders the countries Bhutan to the north, and Bangladesh to the south. It also borders the states Arunachal Pradesh, Meghalaya, Tripura, Nagaland, Manipur, and Mizoram, which are collectively known as the 'Seven Sisters of India'. Assam has 35 districts with Dispur city being its capital. Geographically, Assam is filled with hills and valleys. The eastern Himalayan range known as Assam Himalayas and the Barail range are present here along with numerous smaller hills. The Brahmaputra River flows through Assam for about 650 to 725 kilometres. The Brahmaputra valley and Barak valley serves as fertile floodplains for agriculture and tea plantations. These geographical features of Assam add to the scenic beauty of the state.

The Gogamukh and Dhakuakhana fields are located in the Dhemaji and Lakhimpur districts of Assam. These regions are located near the Brahmaputra. The main occupation of the people here are agriculture and fishing. The people here live in stilt houses as the region receives abundant rainfall and is hit by heavy floods twice or thrice every year.



The Mishing tribe, the second largest group in the Northeastern India, live in the fields of Gogamukh and Dhakuakhana. They were earlier called as 'Miri', but are now officially referred to as 'Mishing people'. They are known as 'river people' as they live around the regions of Brahmaputra.

The people of this region have various cultural and traditional practices. Mishing people are nature worshippers. Their belief system is centred around Donyi- the sun, and Polo- the

moon. They also worship sprits of ancestors, stars, and other elements occurring in nature like thunder and lightning. For example, Ali-Ai-Ligang is a festival celebrated before sowing the seeds, where they pray to the sun god for good harvest.

The FMPB ministry started here in 2019. However, the seeds were sown much earlier by our Missionaries Kavitha and Ahila when they ministered in the Gopur region. One of the early fruits of Gopur's ministry was a young girl named Ringu Kuttum the daughter of our first believer and local evangelist Millan Kuttum in 2006. Ringu was married to a non-Christian family in Gogamukh. She was forced to follow her in-law's religious customs. She prayed continuously for 10 years for her husband's salvation. In 2019, the Lord answered her prayers and her husband was baptised into Christ. Through this couple's invitation, the FMPB mission work was initiated in the Gogamukh region.

Although the work started off slowly, God worked wonders. A new congregation was established in the nearby village of Kosuthuli. There were multiple miracles in the nearby areas. Mr. Leela Misong was healed from cyst in the stomach, Mrs. Bileshwari was healed from blood cancer, Hemakantho was delivered from alcohol addiction, Manju was healed despite kidney failure. In Hatiyamora village, a fellowship began after God healed Mangalson from stomach ulcers and boils.

In the last six years, the Lord has added around 111 souls to His kingdom. The first five years yielded 60 believers, and in just last year, 51 new souls were added. Currently, there are four congregations in the Gogamukh area. We praise God for these miracles.

In 2022, God helped open the mission field in Dhakuakhana. A man named Mr. Devakantho, who suffered from Müllerian tumours, a type of cancer, was miraculously healed. Through him, a small fellowship has begun. We trust the Lord will do greater things in this field. Our ministry among the Mishing tribe is currently expanding, reaching as far as Lakhimpur. Our vision for the coming year is to win 100 new souls from the Gogamukh and Dhakuakhana fields which have 250 and 162 villages respectively.

One of the major challenges for missionaries in this region is that, the people believe Christianity is a foreign religion. They also associate Christianity to the lower castes. Moreover, the people fear social isolation if they were to move away from their faith. Let us pray the smooth sailing of the ministry in these mission fields and that more people eagerly accept Christ.

To Pray

- Pray for safety from floods caused by rain, storms, the Brahmaputra River, and the NHPC dam. These have severely affected agriculture, causing migration and water-borne diseases. Though the government has built bunds and check dams, pray for their success and for protection from illness.



- ◆ Pray against the stronghold of drug use, rice beer, and alcohol, which are causing mental health issues among the people.
- ◆ Pray for deliverance from diseases like cancer and encephalitis that are prevalent in these regions.
- ◆ Pray against these spiritual intrusions, due to the influence of other communities, bringing in idolatry and addiction.
- ◆ Pray for protection from anti-Christian groups, who promote ancestral worship and stir up youth against Christians and gospel work.

VISIT TO SANTOSHA VIDYALAYA, DOHNAVUR



Recently, I visited Santosha Vidyalaya along with Bro James Dharmabalan. It was a delight to spend half a day with the children of the missionaries studying at the school, along with the Principal and the Chairman of the School Board. More than 300 children of FMPB and NSM missionaries are studying at the school. When I met them, I could see radiance in their eyes and passion in their attitude.

It's our responsibility to invest substantially in the future of the missionary children. We want to invest in their university education, career development, character development and missionary calling. We can take up a few projects in this regard, in consultation with the School. When I spoke at the Auditorium, many students expressed their desire to become missionaries.

I look at them as the future leaders of our nation - missionary doctors, missionary engineers, missionary civil servants, missionary judges, missionary scientists, missionary teachers, full time missionaries, missionary political leaders who will bring a decisive change in the society. International Day



Against Drug Abuse and Trafficking

On December 7th, 1987, June 26 was first observed as the International Day Against Drug Abuse and Trafficking by the United Nations General Assembly. This day was marked in order to tackle the global drug problem, that is to raise awareness and take action towards the goal of a society free of drug abuse and trafficking.

Addiction is a condition where an individual engages with an action or a substance despite its harmful consequence. Drug addiction is one

such disorder, where the individual consumes it in uncontrolled amounts. It puts the person in a state of momentary pleasure but it comes at a cost. The neurological functioning of the brain is affected due to drugs. It results in long-term problems such as: difficulty in learning, decision-making, judgment, memory, and also causes stress and behavioural changes in a person. Unfortunately, a lot of people continue to consume drugs despite being aware of these harmful consequences, as they see it as a form of escapism from their day-to-day struggles.

The World Drug Report of 2024, presented by the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime has reported that as of 2022, there are 292 million drug users globally, out of which 64 million people suffer from drug use disorder. It is a significant increase of 20% over the past decade. In India, there are over 73.25 million drug and alcohol users. And as of 2021, India is the 3rd in line, in the list of countries with the most people with drug use disorder with 6.3 million people.

This prevalence of drugs is due to the increase in drug trafficking businesses over the years. Drug trafficking stands as the third largest business in the world. The UNODC has observed India as one of the major hubs of illicit drug shipments. Reports say that in the year 2024 alone, a total value of 1.07 billion dollar worth of drugs were found in the country. The drug businesses have been ever growing in the country across rural and urban areas. A police survey shows that 1377 drug peddling hotspots have been identified in the state of Kerala alone. It goes to show the dire state our country is in at the moment.

Plenty of youth these days get into drugs due to peer pressure. They often consider taking drugs "cool". Surveys have observed how teens these days prefer drugs over alcohol and

cigarettes. Drugs have become so common that children can obtain it in schools. School-going teenagers are often given these drugs for free and in return, they act as their 'carriers' and distribute it among many others. Youngsters who get involved in this waste way their lives.

Youth between the ages of 18 to 35 are most prone to drug addiction. It affects their development and productivity. Drug abuse, apart from physical complications, they are psychologically affected as well. The addicted persons are often seen to be in a life-or-death state. There are high chances that these youngsters turn out violent and as a result are prone to commit other crimes such as theft, murder, etc. For example, in the month of February, there was case of a 23 years old young man who had killed six people including his family members. This was due to his addiction to drugs which had immersed him in debt. It is evident that breaking free from this addiction is a major struggle. Therefore, it is essential that they are provided with the best treatment and rehabilitation facilities, so that they do not plunge themselves into other crimes.

Prevention is better than cure. This principle applies to drug abuse as well. It is high time that something is done to deter this snowballing issue. The Government is doing its best, through various campaigns and teams of law enforcers to monitor the production and distribution of drugs. However, we as the Children of God, are called to take action as well. It is our duty to pray earnestly that we see a change in our country. 1 Corinthians 6:19 says, "Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own". The body that we are given, belongs to God. We ought to keep it holy and not ruin ourselves. Therefore, this June 26th, let us take it up on us to pray for the Lord to provide a way out of all the drug related issues in our country.

- ◆ For individuals who are currently addicted to drugs in our nation, from young teens to adults and for their families.
- ◆ For individuals who are struggling to get out of the addiction, to break free.
- ◆ For people who are undergoing treatment to not relapse back into the addiction.
- ◆ For youngsters and school-going children who engage in drug abuse and distribution knowingly and unknowingly.
- ◆ For to come up with more rehabilitation facilities and treatment methods that are accessible and affordable.
- ◆ For the Government use its power appropriately in order to stop the widespread availability, production, and trafficking of illegal drugs.
- ◆ For the people who engage in such businesses to repent and seek other legal jobs.
- ◆ For the people of our mission fields who have fallen prey to drugs, to repent and accept Christ.

Mr. Thangchinlian Langel, born in 1984 in Churachandpur District, Manipur, to farmer parents Mr. L. Tualkhanpau and Mrs. Thongzaning, was raised in a

Christian household with two sisters and a brother. He embraced Christianity early, attending Sunday School and experiencing salvation at age ten during a Crusade Meeting through Romans 10:9. Driven by a desire to deepen his understanding of God's Word, he pursued theological education, earning a B.Th. from Faith Baptist Bible College & Seminary, Kerala (2007), and an M.Th. in Manipur (2009). During his studies, he felt a clear calling to serve as a cross-cultural missionary. On 21/05/2010, he was united in marriage to Miss. Vung Thianching.

Mrs. Vung Thianching was born as the eldest daughter to Late. Mr. N. Ginlian and Mrs. Ningzadim at Bungmual village of Churachandpur District, Manipur, on 14/03/1987. She has two brothers and one sister. Both her parents worked as Government employees. They were a good Christian family. Since her childhood, she was nurtured in Christian teachings through Sunday School and other Church activities. In the year 2000, she received salvation at a Youth Camp. Her favourite Bible verse is 1 Peter 2:9. After completing her 12th standard, she was interested in studying the Bible and enrolled for the Bachelor of Theology course in Trivandrum Bible College, Kerala, in 2006 and graduated in 2008. Presently, since March 2025, they have been working in Raghunathpur Boys Hostel, Chhattisgarh.

God has blessed them with two sons. The elder son, Pauthianlal Langel was born in February 18, 2011, and has completed class 8. The younger son, Thang Lianding Langel was born in May 30, 2012, and has finished class 6. Both are currently studying in Easton Hall School, Churachandpur, Manipur.
