I Gave Gold for Iron 1813



During his reign, King Frederick William III of Prussia faced financial troubles due to costly wars. To support the nation, he asked the women of Prussia to donate their gold and silver jewellery, offering in return iron or bronze decorations inscribed with “I gave gold for iron, 1813.” The response was overwhelming. Even more important, these women prized their gifts from the king more highly than their former jewellery. Later this practice gave rise to the Order of the Iron Cross to honour bravery in Germany. The next Ethos of FMPB is “**Sacrifice**” (Keeping God first in our lives and being ready to forgo everything else to reach the Nation for God) Matthew 16:24. The organization has grown this far because of one of the pillars which is sacrifice.

Sacrificing money, education, or even life itself for God's work is a common theme in various religious and spiritual contexts. It signifies a devotion to a higher calling and a willingness to prioritize spiritual values over worldly pursuits. The word sacrifice is not new to FMPB. Right from our first missionary, Mrs. Padma Hilton, who offered her wedding chain when there was no money to pay the missionaries, to prayer group members who have sacrificially given their time, talents, and treasure and the spirit of giving has continued. Today, believers like Dhoniram-a volunteer from the Jobo congregation in Amarapada, Jharkhand-follow this example. After praying for a government job and being selected for the police department, he fulfilled his vow by using his first meagre salary to buy a bike for the evangelist serving among his own people, so they too may hear the Gospel.

Many have given up education, jobs, family, home, and even life for the sake of the cross. Yet, as Amy Carmichael said, “When I consider the cross of Christ, how can anything that I do be called sacrifice?” Just as those Prussian women valued their king's gift more than their own, we too cannot compare what we give up with the salvation, eternal life, forgiveness, and the privilege of being called His children through the cross. Songs like Dr. Emil Jebasingh's remind us: “Those who gave up everything for Christ's sake have never become paupers; those who suffered for His kingdom have never been at a loss.” With Paul, we too can say, “I consider everything a loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord... I consider them garbage, that I may gain Christ.” “From start to finish, my life is for Jesus. All I am, all I have-for Christ and the gospel.”

"Those who sow in tears shall reap with shouts of joy." - Psalm 126:5

Devotional Introduction: When the Altar Becomes the Gateway to the Nations

There are moments in the life of the Church when God beckons His people to pause, reflect, and realign with His mission. July is one such divine invitation. It is more than a mid-year checkpoint-it is a spiritual gateway for the Church to recommit to the heartbeat of God: missions.

From Genesis to Revelation, the story of God has always been a missional story. The Garden was the beginning, but the nations were always the goal. When God called

Abraham, He said, "Through you, all nations will be blessed" (Gen. 12:3). When Jesus stood before His disciples in His resurrected glory, His command was clear: "Go and make disciples of all nations" (Matt. 28:19). The altar of surrender has always been the doorway to the harvest.

Missions are not reserved for the few-they are the responsibility of the faithful. God doesn't call the qualified; He qualifies the called. The essence of our faith is not just in believing, but in going, sending, praying, and giving. Every believer has a role in the Great Commission.

July, therefore, is not a month to merely observe-it is a month to obey. It is a sacred opportunity to rekindle our commitment to God's redemptive purpose. Whether from our pulpits or prayer closets, living rooms or leadership tables, God is calling us to lift our eyes and see the harvest (John 4:35). He is not asking for our convenience; He is asking for our consecration.

We stand at a holy intersection-between the memory of those who went before us and the mission that lies ahead. The mountain of remembrance (like Periyamalai) and the conference of vision (like Tri-Cities) are not isolated events. They are divine alignments reminding us that the gospel must move forward, through us and beyond us.

Let us, therefore, present our hearts anew on the altar this month. Let July become more

than 31 days-it must become a lifetime of resolve to make Jesus known where He is least known.

Periyamalai Day: Honouring the Legacy, Continuing the Journey

On June 9, we commemorated Periyamalai Day, standing on the sacred soil where faith met fire, where the early missionaries poured out their lives like drink offerings. Their sacrifice was not in vain. Their footsteps formed the foundations upon which today's mission stands strong.

This year's celebration was not just a remembrance-it was a recommitment. A recommitment to carry forward the torch lit by those who toiled in the wilderness, cried in the night, and prayed through the storm. As we reflect on their faith, we are challenged to ask: What will our generation be remembered for?

May the mountain remind us: Faith climbs, prays, bleeds, and never gives up. May the tears of the past water the seeds of the future.

DO YOU LOVE ME MORE THAN THESE?

John 21:15

To truly understand this question, we must read John 21 in its entirety. The Bible is full of divine questions that invite reflection and transformation. In Genesis 3:9, God asks, **"Adam, where are you?"** In 1 Kings 19:9, He asks Elijah, **"What are you doing here?"** And in Jonah 1:8, the sailors question Jonah, asking about his identity and mission. John 21 is a significant chapter. If we were to give it a title, it could be **"A Chapter of Restoration."** In verses 1-14, the Lord has a meal with His disciples. Some interpret this chapter by suggesting that the disciples went fishing because they had backslidden, even after hearing of the Lord's resurrection. But I believe they were simply obeying His instructions. Jesus had told them, **"Go to Galilee, and there you will see Me."** So, they obeyed and went. As professional fishermen, it was natural for them to fish-but despite their skill, they caught nothing.

Then Jesus appeared and asked, **"Children, do you have any food?"** When they answered "No," He told them to cast the net on the right side-and they experienced a miraculous catch.

Let's reflect on this passage under three key points:

1.He Reminded Peter of His Call: This scene echoed Peter's original call in Luke 5, when after a night of failure, they caught a

miraculous number of fish at Jesus' word. In John 21, the instruction to cast the net on the right side brought a similar miracle. In both instances, **the nets could barely hold the catch.** The Lord was reminding Peter of his mission.

Dear friend, has the Lord called you? Perhaps you've neglected that call. God's purpose doesn't change, though His methods might. The Holy Spirit is reminding you today: **Return to your calling.**

2.The Reason for Peter's Fall: Peter denied the Lord-not once, but three times, with oaths and curses. Jesus asked him this question three times to remind him of his threefold denial: **"Simon, son of Jonah, do you love Me?"**

Why did Peter fall?

He didn't believe the written Word (Matt. 26:31-35): Jesus had warned, **"It is written: 'I will strike the Shepherd, and the sheep will be scattered.'"** But Peter boldly declared, **"Even if I have to die with You, I will never disown You."** Many today still fail to believe the written Word. But the Bible is **the pure milk of wisdom** (1 Peter 2:2-3). **If you want to grow spiritually and**

love the Lord more, you must diligently study the Scriptures. I testify from personal experience-my love for the Lord deepened as I read multiple chapters daily, drawing strength and wisdom from His Word.

He didn't believe the prophetic Word (Matt. 26:34): Jesus clearly prophesied, **"This very night, before the rooster crows, you will disown Me three times."** Some today reject the prophetic, while others give it undue importance over the written Word. **But we must remember-Jesus is the true Prophet. Whatever He says will surely come to pass.**

He was overconfident: There are three types of confidence: **self-confidence, overconfidence, and Christ-centered confidence.** Peter's words- "Even if all fall away on account of You, I never will"-revealed his overconfidence in himself, rather than trust in the Lord.

He compared himself with others (Matt. 26:33): Peter implied that others might fall, but he wouldn't. Often, our judgments about others are wrong. Even Paul once misjudged Mark, refusing to take him on a missionary journey (Acts 15:38-39). But later, Paul recognized Mark's worth (Col. 4:10; 2 Tim. 4:11).

Likewise, our own downfalls often come from neglecting God's Word, ignoring His warnings, or spiritual pride. True spiritual growth requires deep commitment to the study of Scripture, not just reading a verse of the day.

3. He Reassures Peter: In Luke 22:31-32, Jesus said, **"Simon, Simon, Satan has asked to sift you as wheat. But I have prayed for you, that your faith may not fail. And when you have turned back, strengthen your brothers."** Jesus knew of Peter's fall beforehand and prayed for his restoration.

Temptations may come from Satan, but **nothing happens without God's permission.** Just like in the lives of Job and Paul, whether it's pain, temptation, or trials-they are often allowed by God to fulfill His purposes.

Here's the assurance:

Jesus predicted Peter's fall.

Jesus prayed for Peter before it happened.

Jesus promised his restoration-to strengthen others.

Even if you've fallen, the **Lord will restore you** and use you to strengthen others.

Dear brothers and sisters, God often warns us before a fall-through Scripture, elders, servants of God, parents, friends, or circumstances. Ignoring these warnings leads to disaster. Sin is conceived when our sinful desires join with external temptations (James 1:14-15).

What did the Lord assure Peter? **"And when you have turned back, strengthen your brothers"** (Luke 22:32). Even if we fall, **the Lord restores, heals, and uses us to build others up.** Jesus had already promised, **"After I have risen, I will go ahead of you into Galilee"** (Mark 14:28).

Conclusion: The Lord's question still stands: **"Do you love Me more than these?"**

Let's remember:

God reminds us of our calling.

He teaches us the reasons for our fall.

He assures us of restoration and usefulness.

May this Word remain in our hearts.

For years, the FMPB Conference in Bethel, Danishpet has always been a landmark in touching and transforming thousands of people. This is a milestone where countless young people, teens, young couples and families gather in large numbers and boldly take the decision to dedicate their lives for God and to support FMPB movement. ‘Sandhya’ sessions and the devotions were always historic and strategic.

We want to thank God for the remarkable things He has done during the FMPB ‘Tamil Nadu Maanila Muhaam’ held from 15 to 18 May 2025 at Bethel, Danishpet. 2875 people attended the conference (Adult 1675, Youth 352, Teens 546 and Children 301) and it was an overflowing blessing. The spirit of God moved amidst us. The Lord showered His blessings upon the people through abundant rains during the nights. The President, Vice President, Treasurer and General Secretary were present at the conference.

Bethel is a Hebrew noun couplet, which means “House of God”. Bethel campus lies pretty close to the foothills of the beautiful Servarayan hills in outlying range of the Eastern Ghats. Boasting of magnificent views of lush green meadows, towering trees, dense woods and mighty hills, the Servarayan Hills present the nature’s abundant beauty. We thank God for this beautiful place. In Bethel, my wife and I were mesmerised by watching the Peacocks, one of

the most magnificent birds. Their striking colors, unique patterns, and extravagant feathers are a symbol of beauty, grace, and royalty. I would always encourage the FMPB families to come to Bethel to enjoy Peacocks, the beauty of God's creation and to enjoy God's presence.

More than 400 people committed their lives to the Lord during the Conference and this is the Lord's doing. 'Isn't it wonderful to see such things happen? The highlight of the conference was the huge response from the Teens, both in terms of participation and in terms of their commitment. Many Youths and Teens committed their lives to be 'missionaries' and this will be followed up. I want to appreciate Mr Devaraj, the Conference Convenor, who arranged the Conference meticulously and other team leaders including Rev Daniel Thomas, Mr Daniel Arulmani, Mr Andrew and Mr Solomon Gnanasekar.



- We have decided that we will focus on the youth ministry, teens ministry and the young couple's ministry in the days to come. Only then, FMPB can be very vibrant and raise many missionaries who will dare to go to the mission fields in North India.
- We are looking at the option of having a large Youth conference during the Pongal holidays or any other convenient time. This will be necessary to build the movement. We need many youth volunteers in various cities and a few Youth Directors in the Four Regions in Tamil Nadu.
- We require some physical improvements required in the area of accommodation at Bethel. In association with Bethel, we will try to improve this in the next 12 months.
- The database of all the 2875 participants of the conference will be analysed to understand the participation from each districts and centres. This will give us the basic information and give us the direction as to how we can get more leaders from each centre.
- We will take up steps to follow -up each person and each family who attended the program.
- We thank Bethel Agricultural Fellowship, especially its Director Mr L Ebenezer and Mr Samuel Nirmal for their generosity in giving the venue to FMPB for organising the Conference. We will partner with the Bethel leadership team to take this initiative forward.

➤ Along with me Mr Susi Prabhakaran, Mr Navaneethar, Rev Vijay P Isaac, Rev John Berlin and Rev Emmanuel Ranjitsingh were speakers at the conference. We thank them all. Many volunteers came forward and helped us in counselling and in all the arrangements. They did an excellent job. FMPB is lucky to have such committed volunteers. They are the biggest assets of FMPB movement and I want to sincerely thank each one of them.

➤ God willing, in 2026, we will have the FMPB Executive committee meeting along with the conference in Danishpet so that the EC members can feel the pace and the direction in which the movement is moving forward.

➤ In the coming years, we will also invite the FMPB prayer partners from FMPB-US and Indian diaspora. Together, let us celebrate God's faithfulness.

This is God's movement and this is God's mission. The Annual conference at Danishpet is a remarkable initiative that builds the movement. Let us continue to get involved in this in a big way.

Tamil Nadu Annual State Conference

"More Than These"

John 21:15



"Nesipaaya, Nesipaaya?" (Do You Love Me? Love Me?) - this beautiful song echoed through Bethel, located at the foot of the Servarayan Hills, as God's chosen people began gathering from May 14th onward. As in previous years, Mr. R. Ranjith Pandian, Honorary Mobilization Secretary of Redhills, along with the leaders and volunteers from that area, warmly welcomed the attendees, completed registrations, and arranged accommodations.

On the opening day of the State Camp, May 15th, the entire hall was filled with eager participants. At 9:30 a.m., senior leader Mr. Selvaraj from Tirunelveli opened the camp with prayer. Senior missionary Mr. A. Israel led the singing session, accompanied by Mr. Xavier, Mr. Prem, and Mr. Simpson, with melodious music by Mr. Sam Thomas. Our Vice President, Mr. J. Sam Ponnaiah, gave a warm welcome to the special guests of the camp.

Our President, Mr. G. John Samuel, delivered the special address, and this year's theme was powerfully introduced by Rev. S. Ravikumar. Bethel Managing Director, Mr. L. Ebenezer, also extended his special greetings and welcome.

The pen drive containing this year's camp songs was introduced by Communication Secretary- Mrs. Mercy Selwyn and prayerfully dedicated by the President. The Tamil and English books (Mirror of God) written by senior missionary Rev. P. Stephen Joyson were also introduced and released with prayer. Additionally, the *Seyal Veerar Geethangal* (Men of Action) small songbook was dedicated in prayer by Treasurer Mr. L. Nelson.



The Youth Wing volunteers presented a choreography to a newly released camp song. A moving tribute was paid to the missionaries who entered God's eternal rest, followed by a prayer led by General Secretary

Rev. Vijay Prasanna Isaac. Retired missionaries were honored with mementos. This year, missionary families and believers from Gujarat, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, and Haryana paraded in their vibrant cultural attire.

The first day's message was brought by Evangelist Susi Prabhakaradas. After lunch, onwards special sessions were conducted for Youth, Teens, and Children. This year's camp saw the participation of 2,874 people - 1,675 adults, 352 youth, 546 young youth, and 301 children. The evening meeting took place at the Sandhya Lawn, where the children of believers from Taloda Children's Home glorified God through cultural dances and testimonies. The President delivered the evening message, leading many to rededicate their lives to God. The team led by Mr. A. P. Kanagaraj, Honorary Mobilization Secretary from Annanagar, Chennai, provided spiritual counselling to support and strengthen those decisions.



May 16 - The Day of Fasting and Prayer: The second day was observed as a day of fasting and prayer, with continuous prayer sessions from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Our General Secretary, Rev. Vijay P. Isaac, delivered the Word of God that morning. Everyone, from children to adults, fasted and prayed earnestly for the nation and the ministry. The cultural dances of the Warli, Kukna, Madhwat, Od Rajput, and Barela communities, along with testimonies shared by our missionaries, deeply moved the congregation. The testimony of our missionary Rev. Samarendra Singh, who was released after 20 days of imprisonment in Uttar Pradesh, inspired fervent prayers. That evening, senior missionary Mr. Y. Navneethar presented a powerful Light and Sound program.

May 17 - The Day of Commitment: On the third day, during morning meditation, former General Secretary Rev. S. John Berlin shared the Word of God. During the *Action Hour*, Rev. S. Emmanuel Ranjit Singh's message on God's Call led many to commit their lives to God's service. This financial year, pledges amounting to ₹28,04,250/- were made towards the project of evangelizing millions through 12,554 'Jesus Film' screenings in mission fields. Additionally, offerings of ₹2,43,020/- and one gold ring were received. Leaders, supporters, and members then gathered district-wise to plan the next phase of ministry. Many also wrote testimonies about the blessings they received and the decisions they made during the meetings.



In the evening, Evangelist Susi Prabhakaradas once again shared God's Word in depth, marking a spiritual turning point in the lives of many participants.

May 18 - The Conclusion: On the final day of the camp, at 4:30 a.m., a Holy Communion service was held. Many gathered well before the appointed time, quietly waiting in God's presence.



Evangelist Susi Prabhakaradas delivered a clear and convicting message. The offering collected during the Communion service amounted to ₹78,801/-. Participants then shared their love with one another in fellowship, and the camp concluded joyfully with breakfast.

- 58 renewed their commitment to salvation.
- 83 committed to starting new prayer groups.
- 30 dedicated their lives to missionary work.

- 31 new prayer groups to be started.
- 33 committed to full-time ministry.
- 55 received resolution cards for the missionary medical fund.
- ₹14,762/- donated.

- 30 children committed to praying for missionaries.
- 48 dedicated themselves to future missionary service.
- 71 received new Children's Hundies (little offering boxes).
- 48 fasted and prayed.
- ₹10,056/- donated.

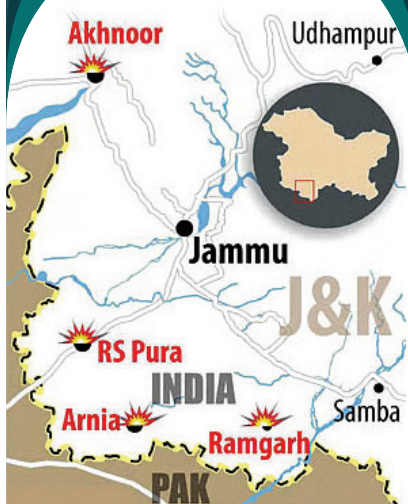

RAMGARH FIELD



Jammu, located in Indian-administered Jammu and Kashmir, is a city of natural beauty and historical significance, bordered by the Shivalik Hills and the Trikuta Range. Known as the "City of Temples," it draws millions of pilgrims to sites like the Vaishno Devi Temple. Dogri is the dominant language, with Hindi, Urdu, Kashmiri, and English also spoken. The climate is humid subtropical, with extremes of heat in summer and cold in winter. Jammu's economy includes basmati rice production (RS Pura) and industries like carpets and electronics (Bari Brahmana).



About Ramgarh

Ramgarh is a town in Samba District near the Indo-Pak border, culturally rich with Dogras (47%) including Brahmins, Rajputs, Jats, Khatris, Meghs, and Chamars. A notable landmark is the Babu Chak (Bamuchak) Temple, built during Maharaja Pratap Singh's reign, famous for murals depicting stories from the Ramayana, Mahabharata, and Puranas.

FMPB Ministry in Ramgarh

The Friends Missionary Prayer Band (FMPB) began its work in Ramgarh on 1st September 2020, focusing on the Bhagat people group.

Bhagat People Group -Derived from bhakta (devotee), the Bhagats are of progressive Punjabi Brahmin heritage, often called "Chota Pandit." Post-1947, many migrated to Punjab and Uttar Pradesh, identifying as SC/BC (e.g., Julaha, Kabirpanthi) to access reservation benefits. Their livelihoods include: **1. Agriculture & Horticulture 2. Handicrafts & Handloom 3. Livestock, Tourism 4. Government & Private Jobs 5. Education & Healthcare**

Despite 70% literacy, the community remains resistant to the Gospel due to: Fear of community backlash, Marriage-

related pressures, Economic insecurity, Deep-rooted superstitions (e.g., belief in black magic, spirits of deceased relatives causing illness) Each village forms micro-teams to monitor Christian activities, often chasing away missionaries. Yet, by God's grace, our missionaries remain safe, supported by three dedicated volunteers. Only a few individuals have come to faith so far.

1. Open doors for the Gospel in every village 2. Removal of spiritual blindness and superstitions 3. Challenges to become

Basti Day



Rev. Hilkiah's family dedicated themselves to reaching the unreached in North India with the Gospel. Their visit to Basti, Uttar Pradesh, on 23rd July 1971, marked the beginning of FMPB's North Indian Ministry and it is celebrated as the Basti day by the organisation. Initially partnering with OM and Ceylon India General Mission, they pioneered outreach through tract distribution, village evangelism, and

Jeep Team Ministry. Basti also became an 'on-the-job' training center for missionaries. From 1986 to 1993, Rev. Victor Packiyaraj's family strengthened the work, especially in Bangarh, starting VBS ministries and mentoring future missionaries like Mrs. Saritha and Dr. Ramsurat. They built the Bangarh Church and extended ministry to Bhubath Joth. Subsequent missionaries such as Rev. John Stephen, Mr. Omprakash, and Mr. Pumsonchin further expanded the work beyond Basti.

Since November 2023, the focus has been on developing second-level leadership. Selected elders and youth are undergoing TAFTEE training. Youth lead worship, VBS teams have been formed, and Bible Quiz Competitions encourage scriptural growth. Special prayers are held for national issues and those struggling with addictions.

Believers actively evangelize, bringing family members to Christ. Retired evangelist Mr. Bhulairam and the family of Rev. Peter Hariram continue to support the ministry.

The congregation practices mutual care, contributing to church renovations. Persistent prayer, including regular WhatsApp prayers, is the backbone of the ministry's progress.

Pawan Kumar And Prabhashini Devi Family

Pawan Kumar was born on April 7, 1988, to Mr. Genda Lal and Mrs. Shivpyari in Ghatampur, Kanpur Nagar District, Uttar Pradesh. He comes from a large family with five brothers and three sisters and is the youngest among them.

From childhood, Pawan was raised in the FMPB hostel, Abraham Bal Bhavan, in Jhansi. The hostel maintained a strong spiritual atmosphere with daily morning and evening prayers. There, he was consistently taught about the love and salvation of the Lord Jesus Christ. Through daily exposure to God's Word, he gradually came to know Christ, believe in Him, and grow in faith. Although he cannot pinpoint the exact moment of his salvation, his journey of faith began at a very young age.

One evening during a prayer meeting, a servant of God preached from Isaiah 6:8- "Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?" The message emphasized the spiritual need of those perishing without Christ and the responsibility of believers to reach them. That evening, Pawan felt a deep conviction in his heart and surrendered his life to God's service.

After completing his BSc, Pawan pursued theological studies and completed his CTh at Chennai Bible College. In 2012, he also completed a one-year ministry training program at NIM Jhansi, which further equipped him for ministry. Following his training, he began serving the Lord in Bihar with great dedication.

Prabhashini Devi hails from the Unnao district in Uttar Pradesh and is a member of the Assemblies of God (AG) Church. She is the daughter of Mr. Shivpratap and Mrs. Sarla Devi and was born on July 8, 1990. She holds a Bachelor's degree in Arts and is the eldest among her siblings, with two younger brothers.

After completing her 10th grade, Prabhashini battled severe health issues. She depended on daily medication and at times even felt that death was preferable to living with the pain. In the midst of this suffering, she came to know the Lord Jesus Christ. With a heartfelt prayer for healing and a promise to serve Him, she placed her faith in Him. Gradually, Jesus healed her completely. Her healing journey, marked by earnest prayers and tears, deepened her commitment to serve the Lord.
