Integrity: The True Test of Faith

One Sunday, a pastor preached a powerful sermon on integrity. The very next day, while traveling on a bus, the conductor mistakenly gave him more change than he was due. At first, the pastor thought, "Perhaps the Lord has provided the extra money I need for this week." But the Holy Spirit prompted his heart. Before getting off the bus, he returned the extra money and told the conductor about the mistake. The conductor smiled and said, "I heard you speak about integrity in your church yesterday. I wanted to test you. You have passed."

This story reminds us that the world is closely watching our lives. The seventh ethos of our organization is **Integrity** (Being honest in our word and deed with a life of transparency) Psalm 84:11: "The Lord bestows favor and honor; no good thing does He withhold from those whose walk is blameless."

The Bible clearly emphasizes that integrity is a foundational principle of the Christian life. "Now it is required that those who have been given a trust must prove faithful" (1 Cor 4:2).

"Since an overseer manages God's household, he must be blameless-not pursuing dishonest gain" (Titus 1:7). As followers of Christ, we are accountable not only to the people of God but ultimately to our heavenly Master, Jesus Christ. We must give an account of the time, money, ministry, family and opportunities entrusted to us. This calls us to live above reproach in every area, especially in matters of money, reporting, and statistics-whether financial accounts or ministry results. Exaggeration, dishonesty, or manipulation must find no place in the life of a servant of God.

The Scriptures promise great blessings to those who walk in integrity: "Their walk is secured (Pro 10:9), they are guided (Pro 11:3), they will be saved" (Pro 28:18).

"We are careful to do what is right, not only in the eyes of the Lord but also in the eyes of man" (2 Cor 8:21). When we are faithful in small matters, God entrusts us with greater responsibilities. Honesty in the little things leads to safety, guidance, salvation, and blessing.

On the other hand, Scripture warns us about the dangers of being untruthful: (Luke 16:11, Pro 11:3, Pro 12:22). Dishonesty leads to destruction, loss of trust, and ultimately God's disapproval.

If we live with integrity, we will be courageous, respectable, trustworthy and worthy of responsibilities. More importantly, we will be blessed by God. As we continue in the mission of leading India to Christ, let us examine ourselves in the light of God's Word. May we be the same in private as we are in public-living examples of truth, transparency, and faithfulness.

FROM THE GENERAL SECRETARY...

*"Neither before nor after Josiah was there a king like him who turned to the LORD as he did—with all his heart, with all his soul and with all his strength, in accordance with all the Law of Moses."
- 2 Kings 23:25*

Dearly Beloved in Christ,

There are moments in history when God raises a man, a movement, or a generation not just to carry forward what exists, but to reform what has been lost. Josiah's story is one such moment. His reformation was not just political or religious but it was deeply spiritual, national, and missional. It was a turning back to the centrality of God's Word, to the exclusivity of God's worship, and to the urgency of God's covenant mission.

At just eight years old, Josiah began to reign in Judah, and by sixteen, he was seeking the Lord. At twenty, he began purging the land of idolatry, and by twenty-six, he rediscovered the Book of the Law and led a nationwide revival. The Word of God had been lost and neglected in the very house of God! What a tragedy and what a mirror to our times.

We live in an age where mission can easily become management, where strategy can replace surrender, and where the passion of God's call can fade into professional routine. The call of Josiah is not simply to

"do more" but to return to the very heart of God.

1. Reformation Begins with a Tender Heart

*"Because your heart was responsive and you humbled yourself before the LORD when you heard what I have spoken... I have heard you, declares the LORD."
(2 Kings 22:19)*

Josiah tore his robes when he heard the words of the Law. He did not defend the past or justify the status quo. He humbled himself. The greatest need in mission today is tender-hearted leaders and missionaries, those who tremble at God's Word, who mourn over sin, and who are broken for the condition of the Church and the lost. Reformation never begins with strategy; it begins with sackcloth and ashes.

May we examine ourselves: have we lost the fire of early calling? Are we content with numbers without tears, budgets without brokenness, or gatherings without glory? Josiah reminds us: God responds to hearts, not just actions.



2. The Word Must Be Central Again

"Hilkiah the high priest said, 'I have found the Book of the Law in the temple of the LORD.'" (2 Kings 22:8)

The Word of God had been buried in the very temple. What irony! The people of God had built structures, performed rituals, and maintained religious appearances, yet had lost the Word itself.

A missionary movement not rooted in Scripture will eventually run dry. Josiah's revival began not with a campaign, but with a rediscovered Bible. We need a return to biblical preaching, prayerful meditation, and obedience-based discipleship and not as theory, but as lifeblood.

3. Idols Must Be Removed, Not Managed

"Josiah smashed the sacred stones and cut down the Asherah poles... He did to them what is done to dust." (2 Chronicles 34:4)

Josiah didn't just silence the idols but he destroyed them. He didn't accommodate idolatry; he eliminated it. Reform means dealing radically with sin and compromise, both in our personal lives and in our movement.

What idols exist in our mission today?

- The *idol of success* measured in numbers rather than faithfulness
- The *idol of recognition*, where platforms matter more than obedience
- The *idol of comfort*, where sacrifice is sidelined

Idols don't just exist in pagan lands but they can creep into offices, into budgets, into prayerlessness, and into self-promotion. Josiah calls us to radical cleansing, not just minor adjustments.

4. Covenant Renewal Must Be Public and Personal

"Then the king stood by the pillar and renewed the covenant in the presence of the LORD—to follow the LORD and keep His commands..." (2 Kings 23:3)

Josiah gathered all the people from leaders to laymen and led them in a covenant renewal. It was not enough for him to change policies; he wanted hearts changed. Mission begins with personal surrender, but must lead to public covenant.

As mission movements, we must gather to repent, weep, and recommit? Not for programs but for HIS Presence. Not to just talk about mission but to meet the Master of the mission? Our calling is not merely to preach the Gospel, but to live it with undivided hearts. Josiah shows us that revival in the land flows from revival in leadership.

A Call to This Generation

Josiah was only 26 when he led this reformation. God is still looking for Josiahs young men and women who will not settle for inherited tradition or shallow religion, but who will rise with holy fire and holy fear, to lead a generation back to the Word, back to the Cross, and into the harvest.

Dear Partners of the Gospel, the times are urgent, and the call is clear. We must rekindle the vision, re-dig the wells, and renew the covenant. Missions must flow not from trends but from truth, not from momentum but from meeting God afresh.

Just as the Word of God shook a nation in Josiah's time, we believe God is calling us to reignite the missionary movement through spiritual reformation and not just in strategy but in spirit. Josiah's reformation reminds us that:

- Mission without *the fear of the Lord* becomes activism;
- Mission without *the Word of God* becomes directionless;
- Mission without *heart-deep surrender* loses its power.

Let this September be a personal and collective Josiah moment, a consecrated time to tear our robes, open the Book, cleanse the idols, and stand at the altar once again to say:

"As for me and my house, as for me and this mission movement-we will serve the Lord." (cf. Joshua 24:15)

Southern Zone: A Gathering of Courage and Faith

This spirit of renewal was tangible during my visit to the Kolar and Chittoor region, where our missionaries gathered in unity. It was a challenging yet encouraging time as we listened to their struggles and victories. Their perseverance in hard soil, much like Josiah's reforms amidst idolatry, reminded me that revival often begins with a remnant who refuse to give up.

A special highlight was the Missionary Dedication Service held at Immanuel BHEL Church, Ranipet, on 27 July 2025 where 17 missionaries were dedicated by Rev. Benny Michael, alongside a host of CSI pastors. The church overflowed with tears, prayers, and missional joy as these servants committed their lives to the harvest. It was a moment of covenant renewal, much like Josiah's public re-commitment ceremony (2 Kings 23:3).

SPARK 2025: Igniting the Flame Among Professionals

Another remarkable event was **SPARK 2025**, a gathering of Christian IT professionals held at **ISCA, Chennai**. With passion and purpose, they explored how their vocation can serve the Great Commission. Like Josiah who reformed the temple and the palace, these professionals are reclaiming their secular platforms as sacred spaces of witness.

North Eastern Zone: A Vision for the Santhals

Our journey to the North Eastern Zone was marked by God's unique presence. One of the most significant moments was witnessing the dedication of the newly built staff quarters at Snehalya Health Centre. This is more than a building—it is a symbol of God's provision and a shelter for those who serve day and night, bringing healing and hope in Christ's name.

"Blessed are the feet of those who bring good news..." (Isaiah 52:7-and in this case, hands that bring healing too.

Snehalya Health Centre continues to be a beacon of mercy in a region often marked

by medical scarcity and human suffering. Dedicating the staff quarters is an investment into mission sustainability—a reminder that mission work is not only about reaching souls but also caring for the sent ones who live among the people, often far from comforts.

Spending time with missionaries and joining in prayer and planning to reach One Crore Santhals left me deeply moved. Their commitment to unreached people groups echoes Josiah's sweeping reforms that touched every region of Judah. It's a reminder that God's mission must be both deep and wide, transforming hearts and touching forgotten corners.

Eastern Zone: Planting and Building for the Future

In the Eastern Zone, we dedicated the new Buddi RCPS, and also successfully completed the official submission for the St. Thomas School Trust registration with the Sub Registrar. These are more than legal milestones in fact they are prophetic acts of planting long-term mission infrastructure for generations to come. Engaging with missionaries in this region further revealed the courage and creativity that fuels their daily witness.

A Nation in Prayer: Fasting, Weeping, Standing in the Gap

Across the country, the National Fasting Prayers for the nation and mission took place in various locations. Particularly noteworthy was the renaissance of the TN & Pondy mobilization prayers at Thirupattur, where leaders gathered with hunger and hope. The response was overwhelming, and there was a collective

plea to make this an annual event here. As in Josiah's day, the reading of the Word led to weeping, fasting, and re-dedication (2 Chronicles 34:27-31).

Andhra Pradesh: A Conference of Renewal

The **Andhra Pradesh South Regional Mission Conference 2025** held at Beattie Memorial Church, CSI Vellore Diocese, Chittoor, on 15-16 August, was another divine appointment. It culminated with the dedication of six missionaries by Rev. Samuel Arthur. The sessions rekindled vision, fellowship, and intercession for the unreached people of the region. It echoed Josiah's desire to see the entire nation return to God's purposes.

In all these events, one theme stands out: God is calling us to renewal. Not just to do mission, but to be a people shaped by the Word, filled with the Spirit, and committed to the Covenant.

Josiah didn't just restore buildings—he restored hearts to God. This is the need of our hour. Let this September not pass by as just another month, but as a holy moment to tear down idols, rediscover the Word, renew our vows, and rekindle the mission.

Let our prayer be:

"O Lord, renew our days as of old."

INTERGRITY TOWARDS INHERITING THE LAND

A STUDY ON **CALEB'S** INTERGRITY

"Because my servant Caleb has a different spirit and follows me wholeheartedly, (with integrity of heart) I will bring him into the land he went to, and his descendants will inherit it".

(Numbers 14:24)



The Lord has testified that His servant Caleb had a different spirit which was not found in the life of around 20 lakhs people who were led by Moses from Egypt. The integrity of Caleb is seen in the following verses in the Bible.

Numbers 14:24, Joshua 14:8-15, Judges 1:14-15, I Chronicles 4:15

INTEGRITY OF CALEB, who inherited the Land

1 Not following the majority (Numbers 13:26-33)

Caleb was not being carried away by the opinion of majorities. Rev. Dr. Sam Kamaleson said that a believer needs to be vigilant and careful to avoid 3 things as he / she walks in the spiritual life. (i) I (Ego) - self, (ii) Sexual area, (iii) Following the majority not the truth. Although around 20 lakhs people were not in favour to go and possess the land promised by God due to fear, adverse and remarks made by other spies, yet Caleb was not carried away by the majority. God is not expecting a crowd but at least one man who would follow

Him in integrity, trusting the promise of God to inherit the land.

2 Not murmuring (Numbers 14:2; Exodus 15,16, 17)

People murmured ten times against God and Moses. People also murmured against the report of Joshua and Caleb about the land. People had an attitude of murmuring against the breakfast the Lord provided from heaven - the manna, "And the people spoke against God and against Moses: "Why have you brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? For there is no food and no water and our soul loathes this worthless bread" (Numbers 21:5). The heavenly manna became worthless for the people of God and they murmured against Moses. Because of this murmuring attitude many people were dead in wilderness. "Nor complain, as some of them also complained, and were destroyed by the destroyer" (I Cor 10:10). But Caleb did not murmur but followed the Lord in integrity of heart with faith.

3 Spirit of faith (Numbers 14:24)

The Lord testified that Caleb had a different spirit, the spirit of faith. And since we have the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, “I believed and therefore I spoke,” we also believe and therefore speak (2 Cor 4:13). St. Paul had this spirit of faith in him just as Caleb had. About 20 lakhs people did not believe the promise of God nor trusted God’s Word to inherit the land. Only the people who have the spirit of faith and trust in God’s Word can inherit the land.

We have the promise of God. “When you cry out, let your collection of idols deliver you. But the wind will carry them all away, a breath will take them. But he who puts his trust in Me shall possess the land, and shall inherit My holy mountain” (Isaiah 57:13).

Although nations are filled with idols, we need to trust the Lord’s promise in removing all the idols and inherit the land. “The Lord alone will be exalted and the idols will totally disappear” (Isaiah 2:17, 18). Therefore, let us have the spirit of faith that was in the life of Caleb and possess the land, in integrity of heart.

4 Followed wholeheartedly (Numbers 14:24)

Caleb followed the Lord wholeheartedly. Caleb was senior to Joshua. However, the leadership was given to Joshua, the junior. But Caleb did not mind because he followed the Lord not for position, not for promotion, not for profit and not for any worldly recognition. He followed the Lord in integrity trusting God’s promises and His

Word without seeking the earthly blessings. Name, fame, popularity are just a shadow but character is permanent. Caleb was not after any of worldly recognition but he was after God’s recognition. Dr. Sam Kamalesan said in the kingdom of God, Power, Position and Parochialism are non-issues and they are non-Kingdom values. Caleb had Kingdom values in integrity of heart. That is how he could inherit the Land.

5 Waged war even at the old age (Joshua 14:10, 11)

“And now, behold, the Lord has kept me alive, as He said, these forty-five years, ever since the Lord spoke this Word to Moses while Israel wandered in the wilderness; and now, here I am this day, eighty - five years old. As yet I am as strong this day as on the day that Moses sent me; just as my strength was then, so now is my strength for war, both for going out and for coming in”. At the age of 85, he had a strength to war, and was willing to move and climb mountain. He asked Joshua to the give mountain region, the hill country. “Now therefore, give me this mountain of which the Lord spoke in that day; for you heard in that day how the Anakim were there, and that the cities were great and fortified. It may be that the Lord will be with me. And I shall be able to drive them out as the Lord said” (Joshua 14:12). Mr. Patrick Joshua, former FMPB Gen. Sec. said that “growing old is inevitable but growing up is optional.” Those who wait upon the Lord, those who hope and trust in God’s promise in integrity shall renew their strength and inherit the land like Caleb.

6 Walked with a heart of integrity (Joshua 14:8)

Caleb followed the Lord wholeheartedly with integrity of heart. There are four witnesses about his integrity of heart.

1. **Witness of conscience:** Joshua 14:8
“Nevertheless my brethren who went up with me made the heart of the people melt, but I wholly followed the Lord my God”.
2. **Witness of the leader - Moses:**
Joshua 14:9 “So Moses swore on that day, saying, “Surely the land where your foot has trodden shall be your inheritance and your children’s forever, because you have wholly followed the Lord my God”.
3. **Witness of Co-worker - Joshua:**
Joshua 14:13, 14 “And Joshua blessed him, and gave Hebron to Caleb the son of Jephunneh as an inheritance. Hebron therefore became the inheritance of Caleb the son of Jephunneh the Kenizzite to this day, because he wholly followed the Lord God of Israel”.
4. **Witness of the Lord:** Numbers 14:24 “Because my servant Caleb has a different spirit and follows me wholeheartedly, I will bring him into the land he went to, and his descendants will inherit it”. God is expecting us to follow Him faithfully, wholeheartedly with integrity of heart in order to inherit the land. God is looking for good and faithful servants and not great and famous servants. Matt. 25:21.

7 Inherited the land (Numbers 14:24)

Because Caleb followed the Lord trusting God’s promises faithfully, wholeheartedly with integrity of witnesses, the Lord blessed him and his descendants to inherit the land.

Therefore, let us commit our lives to follow the Lord with integrity of heart as Caleb did, so that we can also inherit the land in our time for the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.

TRANSFORMATION OF THE SOCIETY AT KOLAR

VISIT OF THE PRESIDENT TO KOLAR MISSION FIELD



Kolar is known for its gold mines; now, it is also known for the transformation of the people of Kolar through the efforts of FMPB. Started in 1996, Kolar missionary field has brought immense results to the society in people transformation and societal transformation. In a span of 30 years, we are able to witness a joyful, blessed and progressive group of people in 7 mission fields, 10 Churches, 27 congregations and more than 15000 people.

31 July 2025 - It was a blessed day for me as I visited Vemagal Church at the Kolar mission field which was overflowing with people who are thankful for what God has been doing in their lives - ordinary people being changed into God's called

special people, uneducated and unlettered people today studying at colleges and universities, people without much respect today are occupying key roles as advocates, dentists and graduates. A large number of people, young and old, people with a hunger for God's blessings gathered together for worship, fellowship and prayer at the Church premises. I could discern the outpouring of the Holy spirit on the people when I talked about the God of break-through.

I thank God that He has raised many local leaders including Advocate James, who led the worship on that day and providing able spiritual leadership. The local leaders are providing able leadership in the governance of the Church. Mr Thimmesh, Zonal secretary and Regional Secretary Mr Sunil Data Kara along with the missionaries and evangelists working in the field along with their families participated in the meeting. I could see immense joy and

hope in their faces, as they continue to be in the mission. It is these front-line missionaries and evangelists who have been enormous work untirelessly for God. I want to appreciate each one of them.

Kolar is part of the ancient Morasu Nadu, where Kannada, Telugu and Tamil languages and cultures blend. We do not have the Kannada version of Araikooval, even though we have a large congregation in Karnataka. Let us take steps to bring out the Kannada version quickly so that the people of Karnataka can be benefited

Currently we have 5 evangelists in Kolar mission fields. The people have promised that they will take steps to identify 5 more evangelists to enlarge the ministry. Their vision is to establish prayerfully 10 more Churches in the area in the next five years. This is the way we want to enlarge the mission, with the local people owning the ministry. One CDC has been approved recently and it is yet to start. The local congregation desires to have more CDCs in the Kolar mission field. Zonal and Regional Secretaries will study this and will prepare

a roadmap for expansion of the mission. In the Malur Church, I understand that some cracks have appeared and this needs to be looked into quickly by the Property committee for repairs and renovation

As a part of providing livelihood to the people in the mission field, they have initiated TAILORING PROJECT by purchasing a tailoring machine on their own. One of the evangelists has the needed skills to take this initiative forward. What we require is to provide 9 more tailoring machines to the remaining Churches at a cost of Rs 50,000 per machine. Let us pray that the Lord will raise families to support this local initiative of providing tailoring machines at each of the Church premises very soon.

At Kolar mission field, one could see the enormous fruits of the FMPB ministry in a span of 30 years. This is God's doing and this is nothing short of God's miracle. Let's join our hands in praying that the mission will expand manifold in the entire state of Karnataka and be a blessing to the people

Most Rev. Prof. Dr. K. Reuben Mark is the **Bishop of CSI Karimnagar Dioceses**. He became deputy moderator in 2020. Now from 21st July onwards assumed the office of the Moderator of CSI. He pursued advanced studies in homiletics in India and in Denmark, and was professor of homiletics at the ecumenical Protestant Andhra Christian Theological College for around 20 years before his election as Bishop of Karimnagar in 2015.



Rt. Rev. Paul Francis Ravichandran whom God has chosen, used in His service and now consecrated as the **Fourteenth Bishop of the Diocese of Madras** on 3rd August 2025. He served in Christian Union Church (Annamalai Nagar), Christ Church (Walajabad), St. Matthew's Church (East Tambaram), St. Paul's Church (Choolai), St. Mark's Church (Selaiyur), Church of the Risen Redeemer (Kodambakkam), Holy Cross Church (Avadi), and CSI St. Peter's Church (Kattumannarkoil, Cuddalore District) and Victorious Cross (Ashok Nagar) congregations across the Diocese. Rt. Rev. Dr. Vincent Vinod Kumar whom God has chosen, used in His service and now consecrated as the **Fifth Bishop of the CSI Karnataka Central Diocese** on 4th August 2025. A Glimpse

Andhra Pradesh is a southern Indian state on the eastern coast, the 7th largest and 10th most populous, with Amaravati as its capital and Visakhapatnam as its largest city. Telugu is the official language. The state borders Odisha, Chhattisgarh, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, and the Bay of Bengal, and has India's longest coastline.

People & Culture: Telugu people form the majority, alongside tribes like Gonds, Savaras, and Porja, as well as Muslims and Christians. Kapu: A dominant caste, especially in Coastal Andhra, often using the title "Naidu." Reddy: A prominent caste with many sub-groups, involved in agriculture, animal husbandry, business, and government jobs. Madiga: Traditionally engaged in agricultural labor, leatherwork, and now government jobs. Odde: Known for stone breaking. Padmashali: Traditionally involved in weaving, agriculture, laundry services, and business. Cuisine is very spicy with dishes like dal/pappu, gongura, peanut chutney, and ragi mudda. Marriages often occur within extended families, with both arranged and love marriages accepted.



Nallamada Field (Rayalaseema, Anantapur District)

Population: 10,944, literacy rate 55.92%. It is known for temples and a waterfall - Tourist places.

The **Friends Missionary Prayer Band (FMPB)** opened the Nallamada field on 23 August 2021, sending Mr. Dinesh Maraiya's family to minister among Madiga, Boya,

Erukulu, and Padmashali communities, with many believers from the Madiga caste. Initial challenges included language barriers and lack of transport.

Barriers: The caste system restricts fellowship between upper and lower castes. Families worship their Kuladevata. Superstitions persist-neglect of widows, carrying charcoal to ward off evil, and rituals for crying children.

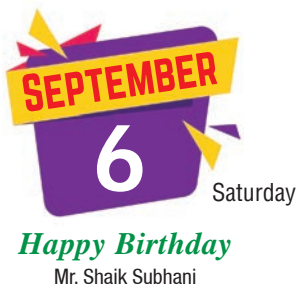
