





Love Covers a Multitude of Sins

A husband and wife often quarrelled, so they decided to write down their grievances about each other on separate sheets of paper. As the husband began writing, he frequently looked at his wife's face. Each time he did, his expression hardened, and he would quickly add something new to his list. Seeing this, the wife became even more upset and wrote with greater frustration.

When they finished, they exchanged their papers. The wife had listed every wrong her husband had done against her. But when the husband's list reached her hands, she was surprised. Instead of finding complaints or accusations, she read words filled with love:

"I love you. I am angry with you, but I love you. I am hurt by you, but I still love you." As she read those simple yet powerful words, her tears of pain turned into tears of joy. Truly, how wonderfully 1 Peter 4:8 declares: "Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers a multitude of sins."

The **ninth Etho of our organisation is love** (Matthew 22:39). Our organisation was founded upon and continues to operate on such time-honoured biblical principles. For years, we have been showing our fellow countrymen the love that Jesus showed-transcending barriers of language, race, colour, and culture.

Loving our fellow brothers is the **second great commandment** that Jesus gave us. Without love, carrying the burdens about soul-winning becomes impossible. To nurture and strengthen this love, we call one another brother and sister in our organisation, regardless of age. We inquire about each other's wellbeing, pray for one another, and offer help whenever possible.

Therefore, if we extend unconditional love to our neighbours-whether at home, at work, or in ministry-without expecting anything in return, our nation will be more easily touched by the good news of love, the Gospel itself.

From the General Secretary...

LOVE is the Heartbeat of God's Mission

"By this everyone will know that you are My disciples, if you love one another." John 13:35

The Pulse of God's Heart

If there is one word that sums up the nature, motivation, and mission of God it is LOVE. Love is not something God does; it is who He is (1 John 4:8). Before creation, within the fellowship of the Trinity, love was already flowing, it was the Father loving the Son, the Son loving the Father, and the Spirit binding them in perfect unity.

Out of that eternal love, God created humanity. Out of that same love, He sent His Son to redeem the world. Every divine act right from creation to redemption, from the Cross to the Great Commission all begins in love and ends in love.

"Mission is love in action this love that cannot sit still while the world perishes without Christ." (Rev Dr Samuel T Kamaleson). When love fades, mission becomes a burden. When love burns, mission becomes a blessing.

1. Love: The Source and Motivation of Mission

The story of the Gospel begins not with human effort, but with divine affection. "For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son." (John 3:16) The Father's love sent the Son. The Son's love led Him to the Cross. The Spirit's love empowers the Church to go into the world.

Love is the *motivation* behind every missionary movement, every act of compassion, and every call to obedience John Stott wrote: "*The cross is the blazing fire at which the flame of our love is kindled; but we must get near enough for its sparks to fall on us.*" Without love, mission becomes a project; with love, it becomes a partnership with God's heart.

This is why Paul wrote in 1 Corinthians 13:1-3,

"If I speak in the tongues of men or of angels but do not have love, I am only a resounding gong... If I have faith that can move mountains but do not



have love, I am nothing." So all our eloquence, our achievements, even our faith will mean nothing if they are not fuelled by love.

2. Love: The Language of Discipleship

(John 21:15-17)

After Peter's failure and denial, Jesus met him by the Sea of Galilee not with condemnation, but with compassion.

"Simon, son of John, do you love Me more than these?" (John 21:15)

The question was deeply personal. "More than these" could mean

- More than your nets and boats (your livelihood / Profession / Career)?
- More than your companions (your relationships / Priority)?
- More than your pride and past (your self-image)?

Jesus was probing Peter's heart by not his knowledge, not his ability, but his affection. Before restoring his ministry, Jesus restored his love. And each time Peter confessed, "Lord, You know that I love You," Jesus replied, "Feed My lambs... Tend My sheep... Feed My sheep." The order is vital: *Love first, then service.* Ministry without love becomes manipulation. But love that serves becomes transformation.

"It is not how much we do, but how much love we put into the doing that matters." (Mother Teresa) / True discipleship begins and matures through love. That's why Paul in 1 Corinthians 13:4-7 describes love as: "patient, kind, not envious, not

boastful, not proud... it bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things." This is the kind of love that sustains a disciple, transforms a leader, and compels a missionary.

3. Love: The Power That Endures

Mission is not a sprint; it is a Marathon, a lifelong journey that often passes through valleys of suffering, misunderstanding, and weariness. What keeps the missionary steadfast is not strategy but **love**. "The love of Christ compels us." - 2

Corinthians 5:14 The word compels (Greek sunecho) means "to press on all sides." Love surrounds, sustains, and strengthens us when the way is hard. "*Love, to be real, must cost, it must hurt, it must empty us of self.*"

Indeed, this love endures when applause fades, when fruit seems unseen, when tears outnumber triumphs. It bears all things because it is rooted in the One whose love never fails (*1 Corinthians 13:8*). When the world sees that kind of love that is persevering, forgiving, sacrificial then it sees Jesus Christ Himself.

4. Love: The Goal of Mission

The Great Commission finds its soul in the Great Commandment:

"Love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul, and mind... and love your neighbour as yourself." (*Matthew 22:37-39*). Mission is not merely about spreading information; it is about sharing transformation through love. When we proclaim Christ in love, the Gospel becomes credible. "*We are sent into the world like Jesus - to serve, not to dominate; to love, not to condemn.*" (*John Stott*) The end of all ministry, the fulfilment of every mission, is to bring humanity back into the embrace of divine love. Faith will one day become sight, hope will find its fulfilment - but, as Paul declares, "Love never fails." (*1 Corinthians 13:8*)

5. Love: The Call to Renewal

The risen Lord's question still echoes in our hearts: "Do you love Me more than these?" It is a question for every believer, every leader, every missionary. Do we love Him more than success, comfort, applause, or position? Do we love Him enough to go where He sends, give what He asks, and serve without recognition?

As often Dr. Kamaleson said "*When love motivates, no sacrifice is too great; when love is absent, even small tasks become heavy.*" We are called to return to the simplicity and sincerity of first love so the love that Jesus praised in Mary's devotion, restored in Peter's heart, and demanded of His Church in *Revelation 2:4*, "*You have forsaken your first love.*"

A Challenge to the Heart

Let us pause and marvel at His love:

His love is amazing and constant; it never changes with circumstances or time. His love is deep and endless, reaching the darkest corners of our hearts and embracing us with eternal grace. His love is forgiving and gracious, lifting us up when we fail and restoring us when we fall. His love is holy and immeasurable, pure in its essence and vast beyond comprehension. His love is jealous for our devotion, yet kind and patient toward our weakness. His love is lasting and marvelous, never failing through the storms of life. His love is powerful to redeem, sacrificial in giving, and true in every promise. His love is unconditional and valuable, wonderful and exciting, zealous and alive with passion for His people. Indeed, His love is beyond description and the greatest mystery and the most beautiful reality of our faith.

This is the love that calls us, changes us, and compels us to carry His light to the ends of the earth. As *Paul concludes in 1 Corinthians 13:13*, "Now these three remain: faith, hope, and love. But the greatest of these is love." Let us, then, make love our highest aim and our deepest motivation in mission.

6. Love that Welcomes Little Ones

This month as we celebrate *Children's Day*, our eyes turn to the tender moment when Jesus said: "Let the little children come to Me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these." (*Mark 10:14*). In a culture that often overlooks the small, Jesus lifted them to the center. He blessed them, embraced them, and declared them models of true faith. Every child is a reflection of God's creative love and a trust placed in our hands. To love children is to love the future of the Church and the Kingdom. "*The Church that fails to love its children fails to see*

its future." On this Children's Day, let us reaffirm our calling to nurture children with love, truth, and the joy of Christ. Let our homes, churches, and mission fields become places where little hearts learn early that Jesus loves them deeply and unconditionally.

Dear brothers and sisters, In a world fractured by hatred, greed, and indifference, our greatest apologetic remains love. **Love** is our identity. Love is our calling. Love is our witness. Love is our mission.

May the Holy Spirit renew in us first love that sent Jesus to the Cross, restored Peter on the shore, inspired Paul to preach, and ignited generations of missionaries to go to the ends of the earth. "Let all that you do be done in love." - *1 Corinthians 16:14*

On October 4th, we joyfully celebrated the faithful service of our retiring missionary Rev Prasanth Kumar Kaki, first missionary from Andhra Pradesh who laboured tirelessly for the Kingdom. The decades of dedication, sacrifices, and unwavering faith stand as a testimony to God's grace and faithfulness. Let us continue to uphold him in prayer for a new season of fruitful rest and continued witness.

On October 5th Leaders' Family Get-together at Keelkattalai, Chennai was held for our leaders and their families. It was a refreshing occasion to strengthen relationships, share burdens, and rejoice together in God's goodness. Moments of prayer, sharing, and mutual encouragement reminded us that *the family behind the leader is also part of the mission. Three missionaries were dedicated by Rev J S Shantara*.

By God's immense grace, the Golden Jubilee of the Punjab Ministry was celebrated with great joy and thanksgiving in Budhlada. Over 1,500 people gathered to praise God for 50 years of His faithfulness. The presence of the Bishop of Chandigarh Diocese, the local MLA, and the General Secretary of the Minority Commission added honour to the event. Churches and missionaries were challenged to move toward greater vision and harvest in the coming years. Many prayer groups leaders and members participated from Chennai and Coimbatore.

On October 14th, I had the privilege of meeting with a few of these missionaries and spending time with them in fellowship and prayer. Listening to their experiences and seeing their steadfast courage amidst difficulties was a great blessing. Their unwavering faith, quiet strength, and unshakable hope in Christ deeply moved and encouraged me. It was a reminder that God's work continues very often quietly, but powerfully and even in the hardest places.

Several of our mission stations continue to face stiff resistance. Pray that the Lord will grant our teams courage, wisdom, and grace to remain steadfast in witness. May they stand firm in faith, fearless in love, and fruitful in service. Your prayers are their strength. They lift weary hearts, sustain faithful witness, and keep the mission of God moving forward even in hostile lands. Let us stand together, united in love and intercession, until the whole land is filled with the knowledge of His glory.

Please pray for the upcoming Management Committee and Executive Committee meetings scheduled for later this month. Pray for divine wisdom, unity of heart, and clear guidance as key decisions are made for the advancement of the mission and the strengthening of our ministries across the nation.

In these challenging times, may we return to the Cross, where love was both revealed and released. Let love be the motive of our mission, the strength of our service, and the measure of our success. Because when love leads, God's Kingdom advances.

May our mission be marked by such holy love - love that prays, gives, forgives, and goes. Love that embraces the world because it has first been embraced by Christ.

LOVE THAT MOVES THE MISSION

"You can give without loving, but you cannot love without giving." - Amy Carmichael

"God had only one Son, and He made Him a missionary." - David Livingstone

These powerful words reflect the depth of divine love poured out for humanity - a love that moves us to mission.

The Great Commandment: Jesus summarized the entire Law and the Prophets in two commandments: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: Love your neighbour as yourself." - Matthew 22:37-39

The Acronym of LOVE

- L** - Listen to God and to others with empathy
- O** - Obey God in every sphere of life
- V** - Value people as image-bearers of God
- E** - Engage in acts of kindness and justice

Loving God with all our heart means aligning our entire life with His mission.

Understanding the Commandment: In Matthew 22:37, Jesus commands us to love God with our heart, soul, and mind. In Mark 12:30, He adds **strength** to this list. Both passages are drawn from Deuteronomy 6:4-5, the foundation of the Shema ("Hear, O Israel") - the daily prayer of every devout Jew.

The use of multiple terms - heart, soul, mind, strength - is not meant to divide human faculties but to emphasize the completeness of the love we owe to God. It calls for a love that involves every part of our being.

LOVING GOD: This is the first and greatest commandment - a call to wholehearted devotion. It means prioritizing God above all else and expressing that love through worship, obedience, and faithful service. "Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind." Deuteronomy 6:5; Romans 13:10. Jesus emphasizes the word "all" - reminding us that loving God is not a partial commitment.

- **Heart:** The seat of our emotions and will - love God passionately.
- **Soul:** Our inner being - love God spiritually and eternally.
- **Mind:** Our intellect - love God thoughtfully and intentionally.
- **Strength:** Our physical energy - love God actively and tirelessly.

This is a call to wholehearted, undivided devotion. Nothing must rival God - not idols, not self, not worldly distractions. Loving God supremely is the foundation for everything else in life.

LOVING OUR NEIGHBOUR

Jesus connects love for God with love for people: "Love your neighbour as yourself" (Leviticus 19:18). This is not selfishness but a call to love others as we desire for ourselves - the essence of the Golden Rule. True love for God naturally overflows into love for all - family, friends, strangers, enemies, and the marginalized. Such love reflects God's heart and transforms communities through acts of kindness, respect, honesty, and care.

INTERCONNECTION OF THE TWO COMMANDMENTS

Jesus intentionally linked love for God and neighbour - genuine love for God is shown through compassion, service, and justice. True discipleship is practical, expressed through action, forgiveness, and obedience. Love becomes the foundation for ethical decisions and righteous living, bringing heaven's reality to earth.

Living It Out

1. In Service: When our hearts overflow with love for Christ, we willingly deny ourselves and serve others. Throughout history, we see powerful examples:

- Mother Teresa - served the poor and neglected on the streets of Kolkata.
- Mary Reed - an American missionary to India, who, dedicated her life to serving leprosy patients later was diagnosed with leprosy in 1891,
- St. Damien of Molokai - a Belgian priest who served lepers in Hawaii, contracting and dying from the disease himself.
- Our FMPB missionaries - continue in this legacy, embodying the same spirit of sacrifice and service.

Their love moved them to mission

2. In Forgiving: Loving God leads us to love others - shown through forgiveness and acceptance. "Be kind and compassionate to one

another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you." - Ephesians 4:32 (Also see 1 John 4:20-21; Matthew 6:14-15)

3. In Obedience: Jesus taught that real love for God is revealed through obedience: "If you love Me, keep My commandments." - John 14:15 "This is love for God: to obey His commands." - 1 John 5:3. Obedience is not about rule-following but reflecting God's very nature. When we love and obey, we mirror heaven on earth.

Conclusion: Love is the heartbeat of our faith - the force that moves the mission.

It begins with loving God wholeheartedly and overflows into loving others selflessly.

Such love transforms hearts, heals communities, and fulfills the divine mission of Christ through us.

Let our prayer be

"Lord, fill me with Your love - that I may love You with all my heart, soul, mind, and strength, and love my neighbour as myself. Let Your love move me to mission."

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT ON FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

To
The Members of
M/S. FRIENDS MISSIONARY PRAYER BAND

Report on the Financial Statements:

We have audited the Financial Statements of **M/S. FRIENDS MISSIONARY PRAYER BAND**, 29, High School Road, Ambattur, Chennai – 600 053 ("the Society"), which comprise of Balance Sheet as at 31st March 2025, the Income & Expenditure account and the Receipts and Payments account for the year ended 31st March 2025 and the notes to the financial statements consisting of summary of significant accounting policies.

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us,

Subject to our "Observations on Financial Systems and Statements" attached to this Report, these Financial Statements of accounts of **M/S. FRIENDS MISSIONARY PRAYER BAND** give a true and fair view of the financial position of the Society as at 31st March 2025 and of its financial performance for the year then ended in accordance with the Accounting Standards issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI).

Basis for Opinion:

We have conducted our audit in accordance with Standards on Auditing (SAs) issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the *Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statement* section of our report. We are independent of the "M/s. Friends Missionary Prayer Band, Chennai" in accordance with the Code of Ethics issued by the ICAI, and have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with the Code of Ethics. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

Responsibilities of Management and those charged with Governance for the Financial Statement:

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these financial statements that give a true and fair view of the state of affairs and results of operations in accordance with the accounting principles generally accepted in India. This responsibility includes the design, implementation and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and presentation of these Financial Statements that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.



In preparing the financial statements, management is responsible for assessing the entity's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless management either intends to liquidate the entity or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

Those charged with governance are responsible for overseeing the Organization's financial reporting process.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statement:

Our objectives are to;

1. Obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing (SAs) will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these financial statements.

As part of an audit in accordance with SAs, we exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of these Financial Statements, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.

2. Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control.
3. Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates, if any, and related disclosures made by management.
4. Evaluate the overall presentation, structure and content of these Financial Statements, including the disclosures, and whether these Financial



Statements represent the underlying transactions and events in a manner that achieves fair presentation.

5. We have communicated with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identified during our audit.

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these Financial Statements based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards of Auditing (SA) as prescribed by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI). These Standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether these financial statements are free from material misstatements.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in these Financial Statements.
