## Immutable God!



**M**ankind is constantly changing. Like the seasons, our mood changes, our character changes, our appearance changes, and so on. Everything that has been created is constantly changing. But God, who is the Creator, does not change (Mal. 3:6).

God is immutable is to say that He never differs from Himself. The concept of a growing or developing

God is not found in the Scriptures. God is unchanging in His being, perfection, purposes, and promises. God can never get better or never get worse. He never learns or forgets, and He cannot be anything other than perfectly holy. God was the same when He created the earth as He is today. In fact, Paul tells Timothy in 2 Timothy 2:13 that "if we are faithless, He remains faithful, for He cannot deny Himself." God's faithfulness is not dependent upon our faithfulness. What a blessing!

We belong to God and He is unchanging no matter what our situation and circumstance appear to be. No global pandemic, economic downturn or schemes of the demonic forces catch our sovereign Lord off guard. Even in the changing storms of life, the immutability of God brings great hope, joy and peace to believers in Christ. 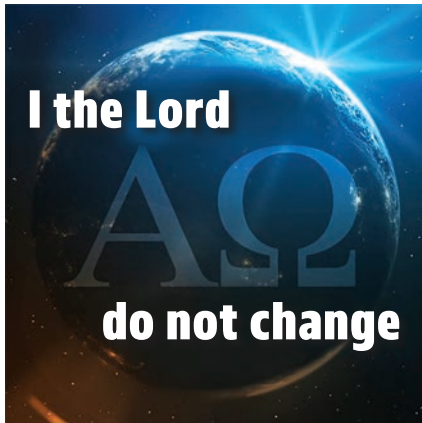
We remember you in our prayers. Together we will reach this nation with the gospel.

### Introduction:

“I am the Lord; I do not change” is a profound and robust statement of God with deep meaning. This honest statement of God the Lord ‘Unchanging God’ discloses the distinctive personality of God.

The Lord God is manifesting Himself as an Unchanging God. In the midst of changing scenario of the nature, uncertain human life, unpredictable future, degrading human values, changing world environments, volatile economic conditions of the nation / world and the policies which can change human dignity and the development of the nation -

The Scripture assures that the Lord is an Unchanging God. In the light of the Scripture the three unique truths genuinely substantiates this truth.

1. Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever [Hebrews 13:8]

2. “...by two unchangeable things in which it is impossible for God to lie...”[Hebrews 6:18]

3. “...for God’s gift and his call are irrevocable...” [Romans 11:29]

### 1. Unchanging Christ [Hebrews 13:8]

Fundamentally, Jesus Christ is the King of the Unchanging Kingdom [of God] - [Hebrews 12:28]. His authority over nature will never change [Mark 4:39]. Indeed, Jesus Christ has the absolute control and supremacy over the ocean and roaring waves of the sea. [Psalm 65:7; 89:9; and 104:6-7]

The Lord God [Jesus Christ] is Light. There is no darkness in Him [I John 1:5] shows that Jesus Christ has dominant authority over the Darkness [Colossians 1:13]. Indeed, Jesus Christ has victory over the power of sin. He has paid the penalty for sin and has taken all the curses on himself on the cross of Calvary. Through his death at the cross he has earned freedom to the whole humankind. He has power to give freedom to all from the bondage of sin [Romans 6:23; John 3:16; 1:12 and I John 1:9].

In addition, Jesus Christ has absolute power and command over sickness. He bore our sin as well as sickness and paid the price of his life at the cross. Our Lord Jesus Christ who is the Healer is an unchanging God to all [Isaiah 53:5; Matthew 8:16-17; I Peter 2:24; Acts

10:38 and Romans 8:11] irrespective of persons.

Moreover, Jesus Christ has authority and absolute victory over fear. He has power over fear. He is faithful to deliver anyone who believes in him, because he is an unchanging God [Philippians 4:6-7; John 14:27; Matthew 6:34; I Peter 5:6-7 and Luke 12:22-26].

## **2. The two Unchanging Things [Hebrews 6:18]:**

Jesus Christ is the anchor for these two unchangeable things. According to the Scriptures, these two things are God's Promise and God's Oath respectively [Hebrews 6:14, 17]. Jesus Christ is the hope of these two irrevocable things. He presents himself as the High Priest before the Throne of God in the Kingdom and advocates for all humankind because of these two unchanging things, .

These historical events helps us to understand that God's Promise [Genesis 12:1,2] and God's Oath [Genesis 17:2] in the life of Abraham.

FMPB had received God's promises and oath to reach out to different ethnic groups and people of numerous cultures to become kingdom citizens and representatives. God's promises have unlocked innovative doors for the gospel of Christ to penetrate into numerous people groups. This good news has transformed people to become God's children to enjoy a new life in Christ. The results of the preaching of the Gospel have instituted worship groups

to magnify the Lord and worship centres for the Spirit of God to dwell among His people.

The aroma of prayer which is ascending into heaven through the integrated network between personal relationship of the human community with the Living God and praying community of the people of God. This relationship inspired the sending group to walk through the horizon to realize the vision. In addition it has become a gentle community which could help to see another perception of invisible territory with great vision through the covenant which is unchangeable.

The God of our forefathers is unchanging in His word and promises. Not only the Jews but the plan of God was reaching gentiles too through the good news of Jesus Christ was God's unchanging strategy. God called Abraham, Jacob, Moses and Joshua to lead. The same unchanging God also called and raised Nehemiah, Esther and Ezra to build. Above all, prophets like Elijah, Elisha, Isaiah, Ezekiel and Daniel were

instrumental to reveal God's glory and to edify through their life and ministry.

These grace and call which is recorded in the Old Testament are unchanging things. In the New Testament, keeping Jesus Christ as the focal point, God called Peter, John, Jacob, Paul and Timothy and disclosed the secret of God's Plan.

In the past centuries, many missionaries' foundational messages and sacrificial lives have penetrated into different parts of the world with gospel of Jesus Christ. FMPB's visions entwined with the grace of God and the call to all the cross cultural workers confirms that the Lord Jesus Christ is an Unchanging God.

More than 50 missionaries have entered into the glory of God and their lives are still communicating though they have fallen into the ground as a corn of wheat. On the other side, the partakers of the gospel from the prayer groups also have set a model dying as a corn of wheat. The Lord is so faithful and unchanging in the life event of us through miracles, significant things, incredible events, hostilities, damages and gains.

He will never change. He will not change forever and ever. His word will never change for He cannot go back on His Word. His covenant with the humankind will never change. His grace will never change. His call to His people will never change.

### **Rev. IMMANUEL IRAIPITCHAI**

**(A life bloomed for Christ over the Sitara hills of Maharashtra)**

Rev. Immanuel Iraipitchai had a historical mission background. He hails from Tiruvannamalai of Tamil Nadu where our early missionaries toiled a lot to bring many to the fold of Jesus Christ. In 1706 the Danish King Frederick IV, sent the first protestant missionaries Bartholomew Ziegenbalg & Heinrich Plutcho from Halle University, to India. They ignited the light of the Gospel based at Tharangambadi of Tamilnadu. God used them to establish many congregations, and the Tamil Bible was translated. One of their successors Mr. Ochs was doing the evangelistic work in Thiruvannamalai which was then in South Arcot district, established the Danish Missionary Churches. In 1863 a Church was built in Melpattampakkam. The missionaries also started Schools. One such famous school was Danish

Mission School, in Thiruvannamalai and in 1914 the Carmel Lutheran Church. In 1951 a new constitution was introduced and that paved the way for indigenous leadership and the Churches were named "The Arcot Lutheran Churches."

Mr. G. George Athisayaseelan one of the believers of the Danish Mission, got educated and became a teacher in Danish Mission School and ultimately was appointed as the Headmaster of the Danish Middle School of Nakkambadi village. He married Ms. Vasantha who also became a teacher.

### **Early Life:**

Bro. Immanuel Iraipitchai was born on 11th December 1968 as the eldest son in the family of Mrs. Vasantha and George. His three sisters Annal Arumai Selvi, Sara Jeba Selvi, Elizabeth Ezhil Selvi are married and settled. His younger brother Ebenazer Erai Amirtham is currently serving as the Pastor of ALC Church. His parents nurtured all their children to rely on God and to walk in the way of the Lord. Emmanuel finished his schooling in the Danish Mission School. During his school final, Immanuel Iraipitchai had an opportunity to attend the Tamil Nadu Annual Conference of Friends Missionary Prayer Band, at Bethel, Danishpet.

### **New Life in Christ:**

In 1986, during this State Conference, he was touched by God through the message of Rev. Dr. Sam Kamaleson and he accepted Jesus Christ as his personal

Lord and Saviour. He attended the camp every year. He also actively participated in the Church youth meetings and began to grow in the Lord. He read the Bible regularly and mediated it carefully.

## **Call to the Missionary Work:**

He pursued his higher education in a nearby college. During his college days, he enthusiastically attended the Evangelical Union prayer cell and Bible study groups. Later he led the Bible study encouraging the college students to participate. Thus, he became a witness for the Lord Jesus in his college. After finishing his B.Sc., in Mathematics in the year 1989, he continued his postgraduate studies in Mathematics M.Sc., and finished his studies successfully in 1991 from Sacred Heart College, Tirupattur.

He never missed the TN Annual Conference of Friends Missionary Prayer Band. His father Mr. G. George became the prayer group leader and led the prayer group to pray for the missionaries and raised financial support for the missionaries. In fact he served as Hon. Mobilization Secretary of FMPB. God laid the burden of the perishing souls of North India in the heart of Immanuel Iraipitchai. He began to pray earnestly for the missionaries. He attended the youth training meet which was held for 5 days at Puthupatti - Palar Dam, Vellore Dt, in which Bro. Stanley Prince was the guest speaker. Rev. Ananda Sekar, Richard Sampathkumar and the late Mr.

Nelson arranged this camp. This camp inspired him to commit himself for the full time ministry.

## **Bible Translation Ministry:**

Mr. Immanuel Iraipitchai had an opportunity to attend a seminar on Bible Translation in UESI-TN's triennial conference in 1990. From that time he cultivated a keen interest for the Bible Translation ministry. One day during the family prayer, his father, George Athisayaseelan asked him, "What will you do after your studies?" He answered that he would go as a missionary with FMPB. His father said, "Why don't you consider Bible Translation...." This confirmed his desire to become a Bible translator. His parents and the siblings permitted him wholeheartedly with much prayerful tears to become a missionary. He joined FMPB on 18th November 1991 when he was 24 years old and underwent missionary training in BBI, Danishpet, Salem.



## **Mission work in North India & family life:**

After finishing his missionary training, Immanuel Iraipitchai was sent to Jharkhand to preach the Gospel among the tribes of Maltos and Santals and he worked there for more than six years. Then he was ordained as the Presbyter by NELC.

Bro. Emmanuel married Sis. Jane Amutha Kirubai on 17th June 1997 and both went to work among the Pawra people of Maharashtra and Madhya Pradesh as missionaries. He expressed his willingness to do the Bible Translation in a needy language. Immanuel and Jane continued to pray that the leadership of FMPB should send them for Bible Translation ministry. For that they stayed in a remote village called Sahane Poidi and learned Pawra language. They were also well trained in translation ministry by the linguists across the world. So, FMPB opened the avenue for the Bible Translation ministry among Pawra Community. When FMPB decided to form Sitara as a separate region carved out of Khandesh region, he was whole heartedly proposed and accepted by all the missionaries and evangelists as its Regional Secretary. He held the responsibility of Regional Secretary for more than six years in the Sitara Region to work among Pawra people. Since 1998, he had been involved in the Bible translation ministry in Pawra language which does not even have a script. God enabled them to complete the New Testament in Pawra language and have brought out 3 publication drafts. It was published in May 2019 during the Tamil Nadu State Conference to the glory of God.

God blessed Immanuel and Jane with 3 daughters. The elder daughter Ms. Evangeline Ratchanya Malar [aged 24] has completed Bachelor of Occupational Therapy; the second daughter Ms. Naladam Narcheithi Malar [21] is doing



Optometry studies in SRM Medical College and the youngest daughter Ms. Gladys Kirubai Malar [16] is studying in 12th Std at Ebenezer Mat. Hr. Sec. School, Chennai.

By nature, like his parents, Bro. Immanuel was certainly a very calm gentleman and deep thinker with a beautiful smile. He led a simple lifestyle. He was a role model to his colleagues and evangelists. He moved with the people without any discrimination and proved that we could win anyone through love. He was considered as uncle, father and big father by the believers as he showed his love towards them in such a way. He even sacrificially supported the evangelists with finance when they were badly in need of it. His personal touch and confidentiality led many to share their personal and ministerial problems with him without any fear. He never compromised on Biblical values. As a mentor and counselor he always quoted scripture, the legacy left behind by the mission leaders while dealing with issues. He was known for his friendliness, unity and generosity even to the non-believers. He had introduced the system of sharing Gospel through 'story telling' to the new believers as

they were illiterates. He toiled hard to lift up the Pawra community and even sent some of our believers' children to study in SRM University, Chennai.

## Home Call:

In the last week of March, Emmanuel had fever and cold. On 4th April 2021, he went to Nandurbar for treatment. His treatment was done in NIMS hospital as daycare treatment for three days. There he was diagnosed of Covid'19 positive. Since Covid'19 was rampant, there was a heavy demand to get Remdesivir injection in Nandurbar. So, the injection was purchased from Indore and a dose was given on 6th April 2021. Day by day the oxygen level in his body was going down. Our missionaries tried to admit him in the private hospitals. So, our missionaries went to NIMS, Tulsi, Smith, Inglo, Seva, Shirpur hospitals for bed and treatment. All these hospitals were full and no bed was available. Finally he was admitted to EHA Hospital in Chinchpada, Maharashtra. But his oxygen level was unstable. On 8th April Chinchpada doctors told that he needs to be admitted in a hospital where a ventilator facility is available. So he was moved to Best Multi Speciality Hospital in Nandurbar. Even when he was under the support of the ventilator, his oxygen level was unstable and he was in a very serious condition. The doctor who was treating him took much effort to save his life from Covid'19. But there was no improvement and his condition deteriorated. On 9th April at 3.45pm he lost his breath leaving his beloved family and the Pawra community.

Dr. Rajesh Vasava who treated Mr. Immanuel said that "Lost one of my dearest, most respectable friends, a gentle man full of life and hopes for a great future. It hurts me a lot. Every death hurts-this hurts me worst because he had complete faith and trust in us, still we could not save him-Covid took him away."

Dr. Rajesh approached the SA Mission Church Pastor and arranged a graveyard for burial. SA mission members also helped in this regard. The hospital handed over the body to the Municipality. By 9.30 pm on 9th April 2021 with a good number of missionaries from Sitara and Khandesh Region, believers, evangelists and family members, he was buried with a hope of Resurrection.

We, as FMPB, are shattered at the news about the sad demise of our beloved missionary and we pray that our Lord of consolation would console his beloved wife, three daughters and the family members. Immanuel has fallen as a kernel of wheat. Let us continue to uphold the family and the larger family of Pawras for whom he has left a very rich legacy, the "New Testament" in Pawra language.

## **Rev. JOHN BERLIN**

**the new General Secretary for  
Friends Missionary Prayer Band**

**G**od has enabled the leadership of FMPB to select Rev. John Berlin as the new General Secretary for Friends Missionary Prayer Band.

### **His early days:**

Born on 4th March 1965, in a Christian family, Rev. S. John Berlin hails from Orumavilai, Seynamvilai, Kanyakumari Dist. His parents Mr. A. Selvamony and Mrs. Chellammal were blessed with 6 children out of which 5 were boys and 1 was a girl.

### **The Turning Point:**

He considered himself as a good Christian due to his involvement in Church activities and absence of wrong doings in him until he got saved in 1986. A book about Jesus' second coming written by Robert D. Manley was handed to him by his primary school teacher. His love for reading helped him to accept Lord Jesus Christ as his Abba and Father.

### **His preparation & Call:**

He graduated with a B.Com degree from Scott Christian College, Nagercoil. His dream to become a Chartered Accountant was not pursued because of God's call to go as a missionary.

Many hurdles were before him not to go as a missionary by providing other options like to be a Pastor, to be a donor etc. But, God in His mercy helped him to be obedient to God's call and he joined FMPB in 1987.



### **His family:**

He got married to Leela Bai in 1991 who was born in Karungal of Kanyakumari District in the Christian family of Mr. Christudass and Mrs. Ponnesam. She accepted the Lord as her Saviour in 1976 and started

serving the Lord full time from 1980. She joined FMPB in 1987 and worked as a missionary in Gujarat prior to her marriage.

God blessed this couple with two daughters, Nixia Sancy who is married to Paul Kingsley and living in Luxembourg and both of them did their post graduate studies from Indian Institute of Managements and Nissix Sancy who has completed her B.Sc Nursing from CMC Vellore.

### **As a pioneer Church Planter:**

Soon after his training in Bethel Bible Institute, he was placed in Siwaith for his Hindi training and then in the Field Office, Nagpur. In 1989 he joined ministry in Jharkhand among the Malto Tribe. For 16 years he toiled as a missionary in Bhagaiya field and LTI, in Barharwa and in Tinpahad fields. John Berlin was ordained as a Presbyterian by the Moderator of Northern Evangelical Lutheran Church on 10.10.2004.

### **His Mettle as an administrator:**

He was looking after the Field Administration for 4 years in Nagpur, Maharashtra as Secretary-Administration while late Israel Devadas was appointed as the Field Secretary prior to his functioning as Eastern Zonal Secretary. He was called to take up the responsibility of Secretary Finance in the Head Quarters from 2007 - 2011. Meanwhile, he completed the Master's Degree in Business Administration with Finance specialization (MBA Finance) in Pondicherry University as part of in service training programme organized by the leaders of FMPB when they spotted his talents in finance and administration.

He has rendered his service as a resource person for "Cross Cultural Communication" and "Sharpening Your Interpersonal Skills" workshops.

He was placed in-charge of Strategic support in Head Quarters where he left his imprints in shaping up the policies and practices of the organization. He also made good beginning in the Information Technology department of the organization in co operation with volunteer techies. He functioned both as the Communication Secretary and Finance Secretary before he moved to Nagpur to take up the responsibility as Secretary - Field for all India from 2017 till 2021. He also played a crucial role as part of the transition team of Officiating General Secretaries in 2015 -16 for about four months before the installation of Rev. Sutharsan Thomas as General Secretary.

## ORIYA CHURCH HISTORY KEONJHAR FIELD, UTKAL REGION, SOUTH EASTERN ZONE

From the  
beginning up  
to February  
2014

**O**riya is a medium size village located in Telkoi Block of Keonjhar district, Orissa with total 222 families residing.

The Keonjhar mission field was opened in February 1986. Mr. Fredrick Satya Samuel and Mr. Ruban Samuel were the first missionaries of Keonjhar field. In the year, 1982 the BYM missionaries Mr. Philip Bishoyi and Mr. Chellian were staying at Kanjipani and were doing ministry at Telkoi, Keonjhar. Both the missionaries went door to door proclaiming gospel and distributing tracts at Oriya village. A man

named, Naru Munda from Oriya village met them and told about Mr. Beersingh who had a shriveled hand. He took him to Beersingh's house. The missionaries told him about Jesus and his miracles. Mr. Beersingh told them that he would accept Christ if his hand would be restored. Through the prayer of BYM missionaries his hand got restored. So he accepted Christ and worship center was started at Mr. Beersingh's house. In 1985 the BYM missionaries had to vacate the area due to severe opposition.

After the BYM missionaries left, the first believers started attending the Baptist Church at Keonjhar. A believer, Mr. Mangalu Munda from Simlipahad (not a FMPB believer) started visiting Oriya and was giving pastoral care. He introduced the organization, "Amar Jyothi"

and its missionary, Mr. Shabnam Singh. The worship at Mr. Beersingh's house was continued by the latter organization. Even at that time there was severe opposition. But the people of Amar Jyothi rendered help to the believers. Later they too left the area.

In the first week of November 1989, a believer named Soma Munda came to the FMPB missionaries, Mr. K Francis and Mr. Ashok Nayak and invited them stating, "The Lord has clearly spoken to Mrs. Beersingh to call the Madras brothers working in Keonjhar to teach us." Five times the missionaries evaded him from telling this. Finally Mrs. Beersingh's daughter fell sick, so her husband came and told the missionaries about her sickness. The missionaries prayed for her and God healed her. From then on FMPB missionaries started visiting them.



Fifteen persons joined the Church on 20.1.1990. Rev. Edwin Balasingh and Mr. M J Sugumaran and the field missionaries were present. Soon after the service, nearly 100 people came with sticks to beat the missionaries. They dragged the believer, Mr. Soma Munda like a dog. They forced them to go to the Katarapali police station. They took the Bibles and bags of the missionaries. They tried to beat the missionaries and burn their Bibles and bags. But by His grace a policeman took them to the police station at Telkoi and the station head sent two policemen as escort them till Jagmohanpur.

## CHURCH GROWTH

People from the neighboring villages started coming to the Oriya believers for prayers and experienced miracle. From Keonjhar field history dated May 1990, "In May 1990, Mrs. Subuni Gagarai was suffering from dysentery. They went to many witch doctors for healing but she did not recover. Finally, Mrs. Subuni Gagarai and her husband went to Oriya village and asked the believers to pray for her. Through the prayers of the Oriya believers, she got well. Her family accepted Christ. 5 people joined the Church at Badajamda field on 8.6.1990."

## Great Miracles

A Oriya believer, Mr. Pradhan Munda's wife Mrs. Hawnri Munda was admitted in the Telkoi hospital due to a tumour in her stomach. The medicine that was administered to her did not heal her. On the 4th day she passed away and the doctor declared her dead and asked her family to take back her body. As they were bringing her body home, the villagers of Katarapalli (3 km from Oriya) mocked them because they were Christians. They told the believers

to throw her body in the jungle and go away. The Oriya believers decided to pray for her to rise again. For three continuous days and nights they prayed for her. On the 4th day morning she rose up and asked for food. During the 3 days, her body neither decomposed nor stank. Because of this miracle 60 to 70 people started coming to the Church.

## Worship Details

From November 1989 FMPB continued the worship at Mr. Beersingh's house. Due to lack of space at Beersingh's house, a believer, Mr. Mohan Munda donated his land in 1993 and a Katcha Church was constructed on that land. So the worship continued at the Katcha Church till 2009. Meanwhile, in 2001 Mr. Pradhan Munda and his son, Mr. Maheshwar Munda donated their 20 decimal land because God rose up Mr. Pradhan Munda's wife, Mrs. Hawnri Munda from the dead. As the number of believers increased to 70, again there was lack of space at the Katcha Church. So they decided to build a Church in the land donated by Mr. Pradhan Munda and his son, Mr. Maheshwar Munda (the land donated by Mr. Mohan Munda was smaller). In 2011, a semi pucca Church was built and dedicated. So the worship was shifted from the Katcha Church to the semi – pucca Church. In Oriya village, believer, Late. Mr. Pradhan Munda and his son, Mr. Maheshwar Munda donated their 20 decimal lands towards Church construction.

## THE CONGREGATION AND THE COMMUNITY

The Oriya congregation members are from the following villages: Oriya, Balisahi, Purunapani, Kaliapani, Pitanali, Katarapalli, Demiria and Jata villages. All of them are from HO people group.

## CHURCH CONSTRUCTION

The Oriya Church foundation stone was laid on: 25.4.2010. It is a semi – Pucca Church. There was no opposition at the time of construction. The Oriya Church was constructed entirely by locals' contribution. Some donated wood, some donated tiles and still others gave Rs. 1000/- or Rs. 2000/- each. All the believers worked hard and built the Church. They brought wood from the jungle for erecting the beam. Mr. Ramo and Mr. Bhimo were the main masons. On 5.12.2010 one of the beams broke, so again three more beams were brought. The missionary's wife, Mrs. Susama gave Rs. 3000/- for doors and windows expenses. The Oriya Church was dedicated for the glory of God by the field missionary, Rev. Haramohan at 12.30 pm.

## MIRACLES AND IMPORTANT EVENTS FROM ORIYA CONGREGATION

In 1986, the first believer Mr. Beer Singh's 20 years old daughter passed away because of a tumour in her stomach. None of the villagers helped them in burial. Frustrated Beersingh, decided to go back to his old faith. Even his son, Somnath supported him. But his wife, Mrs. Sunai Munda refused to accept his decision. So she was chased out of their house. So she made a small hut and started living there.

### The first believer, Mrs. Sunai Beersingh Munda

Anamu Munda was from Jhili village. His wife was suffering from dysentery because of the witchcraft done by a sorcerer who was their relative. Anamu Munda sought the help of a magician for his wife's healing. As his wife did not get well, they remembered Soma Munda and the believers from Oriya

village. On 16.12.1991, the Oriya believers prayed for her and God healed her.

## CHURCH ACTIVITIES AND INFORMATION

The missionaries who served in Oriya congregation: Mr. Fredrick Satya Samuel, Mr. Ruban Samuel, Mr. K. Francis, Mr. Karunakaran, Mr. Ashok Nayak, Mr. Harmohan and Mr. Samarendra Singh. The Local evangelists who served in Oriya Congregation is Mr. Soma Munda and Church Elder was Mr. Maheshwar Munda.

### Church Committee

The Church committee members are Mr. Maheshwar Munda, Ramu Munda (Secretary), Somnath Munda (Treasurer) and Bhima Munda. The committee meets once in 3 months. The tenure of each committee is 3 years. The believers selected the members by raising their hands when the names are read. The committee discusses about the outreach, spiritual growth of the believers and Church related issues. Mr. Soma Munda from Oriya village worked with FMPB as local evangelist.

### Outreach

The Oriya Church elder, Mr. Maheshwar and the first believer and Mrs. Sunai Munda goes for outreach ministry once in a month. They had been to Demiria, Jata, Tenteinali and Baradavtha villages for outreach ministry. They pray for the sick and share the gospel to those who are upset with problems. Through outreach ministries, a congregation is established at Baradavtha village. The believers share the gospel to their relatives and 18 worshipping groups have been started so far because of the belief of the relatives. Glory to God.

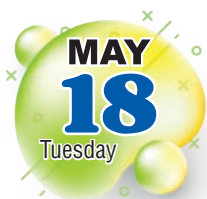

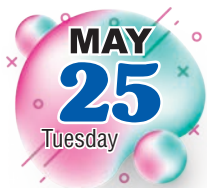
