

[2 Chro.7:14]



During the pandemic, the most oft-quoted verse in Christian circle has been 2 Chronicles 7:14 - *"if My people, who are called by My name, will humble themselves and pray and seek My face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land."* As India crosses the threshold of 2.97 Crores COVID'19 cases and 3.83 Lakhs Corona virus-related deaths by late June 2021, Christians across the country

are praying for healing. But the Lord's healing is not just physical, but spiritual and also it is conditional. The emphasis on "if/then" statement in that verse makes a clear connection between our spiritual and moral "healing" as a precursor to physical "healing."

It should be noted, to whom the verse is addressed: *"My people, called by My Name!"* God is speaking to people that we would call saved. God is speaking to people who have identified themselves with Him and His work. God's people alone can play a part in this healing right now. *"I will heal the land!"* - That is a promise from God to His people, who are willing to fulfil all the 'four conditions' - humble themselves under God's authority, pray, seek God's face and turn from evil. In the absence of the initiative and leverage to lead our nation to meet those 'four conditions,' we cannot own a personal responsibility for the Great Commission to the people of our nation, which may block both physical and spiritual healing.

Therefore, the healing of our nation must start with those that have trusted Christ as their Saviour. Either way it is our responsibility to share the Gospel to the world with true repentance, our eyes fixed on Jesus. We do not have power to change minds and opinions, but God can. The power of the Gospel is greater than any force on earth. Often when people are fearful for their lives, they are more willing to have conversations about eternity. Let us look for opportunities for ministry in this pandemic situation!

The ministry done by the prayer group leaders who went to be with the Lord must be carried forward with dedication and zeal by new leaders. The importance of the prayer groups and prayer group leaders are proved once again during this pandemic time. They worked tirelessly in spite of the pandemic and lockdown to ensure that the needs of the missionaries were met. I praise God for every one of you for your commitment and sacrificial service to the Lord through FMPB.

Mobilization Meetings:

The Tamil Nadu Mobilization, Prayer Wing and Youth Wing together organized meetings to connect with our supporters in the lockdown period and to pray for the nation, from 25th May until now. The youth team is conducting training and seminars in the evening. The feedback we received for these meetings is very encouraging.

Periyamalai Day:

Periyamalai day was observed as the prayer day on 9th June 2021. On that day, 54 years before, our first missionaries set their feet in the first mission field.

The Tamil Nadu Mobilization, Prayer and Youth Wings had organized a 12-hour prayer to celebrate the faithfulness of God in the life of our organization, out of which 5 hours was in zoom. A maximum of 470 participants joined on zoom and around 200 people attended on YouTube. The North India Mobilization arranged the same meeting from 8am in the morning. The Field Department also observed the day in prayer. Headquarters had organized a 12-hour chain of prayer.

Tamil Nadu Virtual Annual Camp:

The Tamil Nadu Annual Camp will be conducted as a virtual conference from on 3rd and 4th of July 2021. It will be conducted in zoom with 1000 connections and will be streamed through our official YouTube channel and in the FMPB official Facebook page in a controlled way. Encourage your near and dear ones to attend these important meetings.

Meeting with CMC Team:

The Member Care team missionaries of FMPB and myself had a consultation with the CMC, Vellore distant education department to explore ways to help our missionaries. Based on that, a zoom session was conducted by the CMC team to our field missionaries.

OUR NATION!



Dear brothers and sisters,

My loving greetings to you in the name of Jesus Christ, the Saviour of the world.

We are living in the days of the nations of the world wilting under pressure. We are living in unfavourable situations and we do not know what will follow next.

Many of our Indian missionaries, prayer group leaders, sponsors and others representing various missions have gone to be with the Lord due to Covid'19. Even FMPB has lost a few of our missionaries, Hon-mobilization secretaries, senior prayer group leaders, sponsors and members. We never forget to uphold the members of the deceased families through our prayer. God has protected our lives not because of our righteousness, good works and sacrificial deeds in comparison with others. Instead, we need to thank God with gratitude for keeping us alive purely by His grace alone. Moreover, a few of us in our organization have gone up to the verge of death and got deliverance in their lives.

“Because of the Lord’s great love we are not consumed, for His compassions never fail” [Lam.3:22]. Let all glory, honour and praise be to our Lord Jesus

Christ alone. It is heartbreaking to know from the India Missions Association that more than 70 missionaries have passed away and 1000 missionaries are directly affected by Covid'19. It may not be an exaggeration that these are the ‘days of stunning.’ The Corona virus has affected people irrespective of anything- poor or rich, educated or uneducated, powerful or ordinary, people who do ministry or not doing ministry and so on. As America was affected severely in the 1st wave, India was affected in the 2nd wave of Covid'19. It is painful to all of us when we read the newspapers and watch the TV about what is happening in and around the people of our nation. When this situation would change?- is the question nagging our minds.

In the history of the world, we come to know that almost for three years from 1918 to 1920, there was a pandemic situation and more than 20 crores of people had been affected and 5 crores people died due to that. American scientists assuredly state that this Covid'19 in the year 2020 had made more people succumbed to death than what the 2nd World War has claimed.

During Biblical times, we came to know that this type of pandemic situation was prevailing in the nation. The people of Israel in their 40 years of wilderness died as they were sinful and disobedient to God [Ex.17

& Ps.106:7-36]. Moreover, due to the decision of David taken in contrary to the Biblical guidelines, 70,000 of the people of Israel died due to plague. All these incidents show that God judges when the chosen people have gone astray or when a society becomes sinful. The same thing is happening in India and around the world. As a result, we see devastation day after day.

There is no other way to escape from this destruction than confessing our sins with true repentance of our hearts, and as Moses stood in the breach to turn away the wrath of God, we too should pray and plead for the healing of our nation. At this juncture, it is very common among the preachers using the Bible verse- 2 Chron.7:14 –“if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land.”

Reading 2Chronicles 2-6 chapters would throw some light on the context and the background. We come to know from these above chapters that God gave an opportunity of building the temple of Jerusalem to Solomon, the son of David. As we know, God did not permit David to build the temple although he wished to do so. But David collected all the logistic requirements for the building of this temple. The temple was built elegantly and dedicated for the glory of God. On the day of dedication, Solomon prayed to God raising his hands before Him [2Chron.6:13-42]. At night God appeared to Solomon in a dream [2Chron.7:12] and told Him He would give answer his prayers in the following particular situations [V.13].

- 1. When there is no rain**
- 2. When locust devour the land**
- 3. When there is a plague among my people**

When the people who are called by His name have to do 4 things, God will do 3 things for their sake. If so, who are all the people who are called by His name? The people who are called by His name are – all who have accepted Jesus Christ as their personal Lord and Saviour and who keep their faith in Him and grow in Him. In Rev. 7:13-14 it is mentioned that they are the people who have ‘washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.’ In Rom.13:12, it is mentioned as they ‘put on the armour of light.’

What is required by the people who are called by His name?

- 1. Humble themselves**
- 2. Pray**
- 3. Seek God's face**
- 4. Turn from wicked ways**

1. Humble themselves: The antonym for humility is proud, arrogance, self-righteous, haughtiness etc. The God whom we worship is a God of humility. “And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to death - even death on a cross!” [Phil.2: 8]. “God opposes the proud but shows favour to the humble” [1Pet.5:5]. Yes, Humility is a unique Christian virtue that has to be practiced in personal, family, social and ministerial life. The world may stamp ourselves as ‘mad’ when we are really humble enough. But when we humble ourselves, God lifts us to the higher plane beyond what we could imagine.

2. Prayer: Humility and prayer are interlinked. The one who is faithful in prayer will be humble in all the circumstances. Similarly, the one who is humble enough will pray in all the situations. Jesus is a great model concerning this. “Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where He prayed.” [Mk.1:35]

I personally experienced the dawn prayer along with Mr. PaulduraiSamy annan, one of our pioneer prayer group leaders in 1973. During the earlier stage of my salvation experience, I was just a bachelor. PaulduraiSamy annan used to knock at my door exactly at 5am everyday and take me on his bicycle to the nearby bank of a pond for prayer. That dawn prayer made a great impact in my life. It played a vital role for the formation of prayer cells and for the raising of many prayer group leaders in the areas of west Tirunelveli. As a result, many came forward to go as missionaries. I praise God and am grateful to PaulduraiSamy annan who was God's instrument to trigger this revival in our areas.

The Bible teaches two important aspects of prayer. They are - ‘Prayer for the Blessings’ [Gen.32:26] and the other one is- ‘Praying with concern for the Saving of Souls’ as St. Paul did [Rom.15:32]. God is expecting us to do offensive prayer against the schemes of the devil. Our former General Secretary Mr. Patrick Joshua also used to talk about three types of prayer as follows -

- 1. General Prayer**
- 2. Defensive Prayer**
- 3. Offensive Prayer**

These types of prayers are needed these days. We cannot simply win the devil in the battle with blunt weapon of nominal

prayerful life. And our weapon against satan should be sharpened enough. We need to analyze our prayer life in order to make it consistent enough to move forward. Let the power of the Holy Spirit bring back the deep experience of prayer life as it was in the earlier days of our organization.

3. Seek God's face: In the Book of Jeremiah, it has been very clearly mentioned about how to seek God's face [Jer.29: 10 -13]. God has promised in this verse that He will fulfil the desires of our hearts while we seek His face. There is no way rather than seeking His face in order to escape from the fearful destruction of these days. In the 14th verse, He gives the promise that He will bring back from captivity [here i.e., Covid'19]. Our God expects us to seek His face in all the circumstances till the last breath of our life.

4. Turn from wicked ways: “If a wicked person turns away from the wickedness they have committed and does what is just and right, they will save their life” [Ezek.18:27]. For example, God says to Jonah, “Go to the great city of Nineveh and preach against it, because its wickedness has come up before Me” [Jonah1:2]. But later “when God saw what they did and how they turned from their evil ways, He relented and did not bring on them the destruction He had threatened” [Jonah 3:10]. As the city of Nineveh was protected from destruction, when we too humble ourselves, pray, seek His face and turn from our wicked ways, God will certainly heal our country India.

May our Lord Jesus Christ use us as the people who bring healing to our nation! Amen.

Heart to Heart!

(Reflections on my ordeal with Covid'19)



I greet all the members of Friends Missionary Prayer Band who live for the redemption of our nation with love and humility.

I have been hospitalized only three times in the journey of my life of 68 years-

- I came to know through my mother that when I was a small child I had a fall, while playing on the banks of a stream in Thengamputhur and got a fracture and was treated in the Puliyaditha Master [tiger killer] hospital at Putheri, KK Dt.
- Secondly, I went through gallbladder surgery in Chennai.
- Thirdly, I went through treatment for 17 days as I was infected with Covid'19 that has killed a large number of people.

I would like to share with you the feelings and thoughts which made lasting impact during the ordeal.

When I was hospitalized, I came to know that a few of our missionaries, local evangelists, volunteers, prayer group leaders, Hon. Mobilization secretaries,

mission sponsors and members of our organization went to be with the Lord due to Covid'19. And many are still waiting for the healing from the hands of God from this terrible disease. As Friends Missionary Prayer Band, we are earnestly praying to God for His comfort and consolation to the families who are going through such pain and loss.

The afflictions of our beloved friends affected me to a great extent that did not allow me to have a peaceful sleep and to cease my cry with tears. I was not able to comprehend about the unfavourable situations. Instead of questioning God, I pleaded with God to teach me what I can learn out of this. I hereby try to highlight whatever I have learned at this juncture.

1 | It was good for me to be afflicted (Ps.119:71)

How can affliction be good to a man? The writer of Psalms 119 affirms that it was good for me to be afflicted. The Psalmist reasoned it in the previous verses, "Before I was afflicted I went astray, but now I obey Your Word" [119:67]. Lord, You have enabled me to keep up Your Word, contrary to the life of moving apart according to my mind...Yes, the affliction that You permitted was good for me.

As our God who tests us in the furnace of affliction [Isa.48:10], let us give our affliction to God in order to preserve our lives according to His Word [Ps.119:107]. Let us glorify in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; perseverance, character; and character, hope [Rom.5:3-4].

It is very easy to say or write like this. But it is an unbearable pain to the people who have lost their loved ones. Moreover, it is the loss of livelihood when someone loses a husband, wife, father, mother and children in the family. Many of our missionaries have lost their beloved parents. The only consolation that we have in our faith in Christ Jesus is that the departed beloved ones are safe in the hands of God and we would certainly see them face to face one day. The comforting words of our Lord Jesus Christ is, "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid" [Jn.14:27].

2 | God does not give a life without afflictions (Jn.16:33)

Although we are living in the days of the preachers of prosperity Gospel who claim that believing in Christ Jesus would lead to problem-free life and blessed life, our Lord Jesus Christ says, "In this world you will have trouble" [Jn.16:33]. Our Lord who won the world is with us that gives a great consolation to us. So let us be strengthened to live. Our God

is the one who permitted satan to sift off Simon as wheat [Lk.22:31]. He is the one who permitted Paul to suffer in ministry far beyond his ability to endure, so that he despaired of life itself [2Cor.1:8]. It is a great blessing that Jesus Christ prays for us in our suffering so that our faith may not fail [Lk.22:32]. The Apostles also emphatically taught Church after Church that we must go through many hardships to enter the Kingdom of God [Acts 14:22]. What a wonder it is! Let us keep in our mind the ministry of St. Paul, who although knew very clearly that there is imprisonment and hardship waiting for him in his task of testifying to the Good News of God's grace in the cities, he did not consider his life worth [Acts 20:23,24]..

3 | Our afflictions will comfort those in any trouble (2Cor.1:4, 6)

The testimony about afflictions and comfort that Paul and his fellow ministers share with us would make us worthy when we ourselves would experience the same in order to share with others in their afflictions. I lost my second daughter before my salvation experience. However, this loss enabled me to give comfort to those who went through the same affliction. As our God permitted me to be infected with Corona virus, I myself experienced the suffering and its deeper pain that enabled me to share with others the consolation that I have received from God. **When few of our missionaries and friends of our ministry went to be with the Lord, I was not able to identify with them and physically**

share their sorrows during that time, but I was able to pray to God with tears all through the night for their consolation and deliverance from their afflictions from the hospital bed.

4 | We are not His offspring without His chastisement (Heb.12: 6-7)

For the welfare of our lives, we get punishment from our parents in our lives. There cannot be any parents without punishing their children. Too often we are ready to accept the chastening of our parents, but we are not ready to accept the discipline of our Eternal Father; if so, we are not legitimate, not true sons and daughters at all [Heb.12:8]. No discipline seems pleasant at the time and it is painful; but later on, however, it produces a harvest of righteousness and peace for those who have been trained by it [Heb.12:11]. Joseph had gone through so many afflictions, but later on, he became the prime minister of the nation. Job went through greater afflictions, but the Lord blessed the latter part of Job's life more than the former part. So let us not take it easy or become weary during our afflictions, instead with a poised mind accept it for our goodness.

5 | We are called to follow His footsteps of suffering (1Pet.2:21)

Our eternal call is to suffer like Christ Jesus and to follow His footsteps. Jesus Christ has left His model as a legacy in this regard. The people of this world used

to follow the footsteps of many. But we the people of God have only one model i.e. Jesus Christ. His characters and values have to be reflected through our lives. There is no use of patiently enduring the punishment for the offence we have done. But if we suffer for doing good and we endure it, this is commendable before God [1Pet.2:20]. Even if we should suffer for what is right, we are blessed [1Pet.3:14]. For it is better, if it is God's will, to suffer for doing right than for doing evil [1Pet.3:17]. If we are insulted because of the name of Christ, we are blessed [1Pet 4:14]. Therefore, let us not bother about the present sufferings but run with perseverance the race marked out for us.

6 | To win the Crown of Life, trials are necessary (James 1:12)

James in his epistle exhorts us to consider it pure joy whenever we face trials of many kinds [James.1:2-3]. Then in the 12th verse he adds, blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life that the Lord has promised to those who love him. There is no Crown without Cross. Jesus too endured the suffering. He cried loudly, My God, My God, why have you forsaken Me? Why are You so far from saving Me, so far from My cries of anguish? [Ps.22:1]. If Jesus Himself suffered to that extent... What about us? We have a great comfort that no temptation has overtaken us except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; He will not let us be tempted beyond what we can

bear. But when we are tempted, He will also provide a way out so that we can endure it [1Cor. 10:13]. God only permits the suffering that all mankind faces in general. We are not given suffering that is specially created for us. God never permits suffering beyond what we can bear.

God is good. Let us seek His presence. Let us plead to our God in His presence daily for the family members of Friends Missionary Prayer Band. Let us give our petitions to God for the friends who are in grief and loss. Let us not be weary as our task is to inherit our nation for Christ. As children, let us shoulder the noble task that our parents have left here. Hence, the name of God will certainly be glorified by us.

In conclusion, I would like to share some concerns with you. The tenure of our office bearers of the organization will come to an end in the month of August 2021. The President and Vice-President are completing their 1st three years term. The treasure completes his 2nd term of six years. Our Lord has to enable our Executive Committee to find out the suitable persons who can take forward our organization further. I request you to pray for this important need in your unceasing prayer every day.

Today our organization moves forward without lacking anything only because of your unceasing prayers, unrelenting endeavours and untiring support with concern. We appreciate you and praise God for you. Amen!

Melakulam in Tirunelveli district. She was brought up in the fear of God by her godly parents and accepted the Lord as her personal saviour in her childhood. Through the listening of mission challenging songs, she got the burden to win souls for Christ. Then she started involving in Sunday school and led many to Christ.

On May 11, 1987, she got married to Rev. P. Rajadurai who was working in Jobat mission field in Madhya Pradesh as a missionary among the Bhils. On May 12, 1988 while they were ministering among the Rathwa Bhil people at Chaktala village in UP, their first son Joshua Perinbadurai was born. The family shifted their base to Kawant in Gujarat in October 1988. While focusing on Rathwa and Bilala people groups, the door was opened among the Dungra Bhils since Oct 1990. As the children of the Dungra Bhil community living in the Narmada river banks were very poor and illiterate, in June 1999, they opened a hostel for 38 boys and 12 girls at Kawant

Sis. Bathsheba was the 4th daughter of the five daughters and two sons born on the 8th of December 1963 to Mr. Duraisamy and Mrs. Thangapalam who were primary school teachers in a small village called

in a rented house. Mrs. Bathsheba and Rev. P. Rajadurai continued their ministry among the Dungra Bhil people until June 2008. There were approximately 9000 believers from the Dungra Bhil community, 35 congregations and 7 churches. She is fondly remembered as a mother by the Dungra Bhil believers for her love and hospitality.

In June 2008, Rev P. Rajadurai was appointed as the Regional Secretary of Aravalli region they moved to Godhra. The ministry was expanded to Mathwad in Madhya Pradesh. Other mission fields such as Tanakla, Naswadi and Bodeli in Gujarat were also opened to take care of the believers. Mrs Bathsheba regularly accompanied her husband on his field visits and was an encouragement to the women missionaries. They were placed in mobilization ministry in Baroda from 2019 and raised many prayer supporters and sponsors.

Mrs. Glory Sugnathi
(1949 - 2021)

Sis. Glory Suganthi was born on 18th June 1949 in Koilvilai village of Kanyakumari district. Her father Rev. Gunamudaiyan was ordained presbyter of CSI Kanyakumari Diocese and her mother Mrs. Thangam was a homemaker. As her parents were ministers of God, they were very much keen to rearing their children in the fear of the Lord.

In 1974 while attending a spiritual meeting and prayer, the Lord spoke to her through the Bible, Ms. Glory was convicted of her sins. She confessed her sins and accepted Jesus Christ as her personal Saviour. There was a great change in her life that delighted her parents. She had a passion for prayer and reading the Bible. Thus, she grew in the Lord. Then she got a chance to attend a FMPB challenging meeting and committed to full time missionary work.

On 10th May 1976, Ms. Glory got married to Mr. Francis Jaya Balasingh who was a

missionary of FMPB, serving in Siwan, Bihar for Church planting ministry during that time. God blessed their married life with three children, two daughters namely, Joan Evangeline and Amy Magdalene and a son Hudson Timothy. At present, both the girls got married and settled after their studies. Hudson after his post graduate degree is employed in the private sector.

After the marriage, Mr. Francis J Singh and Mrs. Glory were placed in North India Church Planting ministry. They served as missionaries in Gaya (Bihar), Datia (M.P) and Vyara (Gujarat). Then she worked with her husband Mr. Francis who was the Secretary for Northern Zone, coordinating the ministry based at Delhi. Later they were transferred to Chennai and Mr. Francis J. Singh was serving the Child Care Ministry, HQ Administration, Public Relationship Department etc and Mrs. Glory was doing mobilization ministry in and around Ambattur area. She used to conduct women prayer meetings and mobilize them for the mission.

Mrs. Glory Suganthi retired from the service with FMPB on 18th June 2014. She was helping her husband in all possible ways in his ministry. She was suffering with some of the ailments due to her old age. Still, she was attending the regular prayer meeting in and around her house. Mrs. Glory was infected with Covid'19 and was admitted in a private hospital at Ashok Nagar, Chennai along with her husband who was also affected with Covid'19. As she was suffering from other co-morbidities, this Covid'19 infection aggravated it and led her to very bad condition. In the early morning of 17th May 2021, she lost her breath and entered into God's glory. She did what she could do for the extension of His kingdom. Please uphold Mr. Francis and the family members through our prayers.



Dolyambar Church History

Rev. L. Masilamani

Dolyambar Village is in the Dangs district of Gujarat. The Dolyambar village has a population of 352. Dolyambar village has lower literacy rate. In 2011, literacy rate of Dolyambar village was 69.53 % compared to 78.03 % of Gujarat.

The Beginning

On 8-5-1981, L. Masilamani, his wife Mrs. Vanmathi and their first son M. John Kingsly (two years and eight months old then) opened the Ahwa field by going and settling in a rented house in Pipaldahad village. While doing ministry they found out that there was a good receptivity in the nearby Junner village and they moved to Junner village on 30-11-1981. Evangelist Sanpatbhai was recruited as an evangelist to work in Ahwa field (it was called as Pipaldahad field in the beginning) and he came to Junner on 3-5-1982. Sick people from nearby villages came to Junner and got healed through the prayers of the missionaries and the evangelist.

The first believer from Dolyambar village:

Manubhai Bhavdubhai Umarshala from Dolyambar village was in search of healing for his sickness. In his own words, Manubhai narrates,

"My name is Manubhai Bhavdubhai. I am living in Dolyambar village. I was suffering from pain in my chest and throat and there was always a burning sensation. I was admitted in a hospital in Bardoli city. There was no improvement. I tried traditional bhakti to heal me by spending on many kinds of offerings to the spirits through the bhagats. I had to sell one of my oxen to meet these expenses. As I didn't see any progress I came to my village. My relatives started to do the puja to please the spirits by sacrificing cocks, goats etc. I spent more than one thousand and five hundred rupees, but I did not receive healing. Then all the family members began to think and decided to try the Christian faith. One person named Sakkaram in

our village told me that the Christians are doing ministry in Junner village and there was a Church. So I went to that Church on one Sunday and participated in the meeting. Evangelist Sanpatbhai and missionary L. Masilamani prayed for me. I got healed through their prayers. From that day onwards I and all my family members have become Christians."

The first meeting in Dolyambar village was conducted on 31-7-1982 in the house of village headman Motiramhbhai. Evangelist Sanpatbhai was conducting regular night meetings in that village from Junner village. Six families were attending the Junner Church for Sunday services. These first believers helped the missionaries to continue the ministry by bringing them to their village after they were driven out of Junner village. How they brought the missionary family to their home is explained below.

First Believer testifying before the village panchayat due to opposition and their declaration to take the missionaries to their village Dolyambar.



One government primary school teacher named Arjunbhai Choudhry raised opposition against the Christian ministry in Junner village as nine children were

taken to the Bethel hostel. The village headman mobilized the people to oppose to the missionaries and the evangelist. They were to stand before the panchayat in Pipaldahad village with the new Christians and a local man conducted the inquiry. Dolyambar's first believers Manubhai and his wife boldly testified for Christ in that meeting and told that they would bring the missionary family to their village if they are asked to leave Junner. The enquiring officers ordered the missionaries and the evangelist to leave Junner village. So they left Junner on 30-8-1982 and moved to Ahwa. God prepared the Dolyambar village headman to invite the missionaries to his village.

Dolyambar Village Headman Motiramhbhai Sukhiraobhai Rathod's Testimony:



"My wife's name is Gangu Ben Motiram Rathod. She was suffering from physical and mental illnesses and she used to run away from people. I called religious priests called "bhagats" and offered goats, fowls, coconuts etc. I was trying to get healing for her through the shamans (diviners) for my wife. But she was not healed. My wife's relatives became Christians in Borinapada village and they called her to the Church in Daher village. So I took my wife to this Church and

through prayer she was healed. Then I and my whole family believed in Jesus Christ. I heard through Manubhai of our village that missionaries are driven out from Junner village. So Manubhai and I invited missionary L. Masilamani family from Ahwa to our village and to do the ministry from here in December 1982. Missionaries came to our village on 12-3-1983. I and my brother in law Bikhubhai used to accompany the missionary while visiting other villages for ministry to give testimonies and to make known to others that once notorious Dolyambar people have become Christians and they are supporting the mission.”

Missionaries Moving to Dolyambar Village:

Missionaries left Junner and went to Ahwa for stay. The Ahwa CNI Church pastor Rev. T. V. Gaikwad helped them much during this opposition. As the Dolyambar village headman and Manubhai invited the missionaries to their village, missionaries went to live in Dolyambar village on 12-3-1983. Missionaries got their accommodation in the veranda of the village headman's house in the beginning. They also did some medical ministry by attending to the immediate medical needs doing first aids for the Christians and the seekers. Many people from Dolyambar and the nearby villages came to Dolyambar sought healing from Christ. God performed many miracles and many people believed in Jesus.

Church Growth:

Many people from Dolyambar village started believing in Christ. In 1983, Dalabhai who had finished his tenth

standard came to his home in Dolyambar in the vacation. He had abscess on his legs and he was healed by the prayers and medical help of the missionaries and the believers. He now works as the CNI pastor in this area. He narrates his experience:

“I studied from 8th standard to 10th standard in Pimpri Middle school. Then I wrote my new SSLC examinations and came to my village Dolyambar. I stayed for 15 days and then there was a swelling in my foot. It became a boil and from inside it was paining so much. My leg became so heavy and I could not walk. Due to this suffering I was weeping throughout the night and day and I spent my days like this. My brother was trying our traditional religious practices of “bhakti” to spirits. Medicines prepared from the Dangs medicinal plants were applied on my leg. But I didn't get any improvement by all these efforts. Missionary L. Masilamani was living in the house of my sister in my village. So I called his wife Mrs. Vanmathi Masilamani, my sister Saruben and Ranaben to my house and they prayed for me. In the night L. Masilamani came and prayed for me. Through these prayers I got healing and I got peace in my life. I accepted Jesus Christ as my saviour on 15-4-1983. I experienced much happiness in my life. I am doing God's ministry as an ordained priest with the Church of North India now.”

Dolyambar village has three parts. One is called “Patel Falia” the area where the village headman and his close relatives reside. The other is “Nichle falia”, the area south of the patel falia. Another

is the Narayandevpada which is in the north-western side of the Patel falia. The village headman Motirambhai is a big land owner. He has three sisters living near to his house in his land. Among the three sisters, one elder sister family and one younger sister family became Christians as they experienced healing. Manubhai family also lives in the Patel falia. Manubhai family became a prayer warrior praying for the sick people. Village headman's elder sister's husband was Bikhubhai. His testimony is given below.

Bikhubhai Manjibhai Baria from Varli tribe (1983)

"I was a follower of our traditional tribal religion. Once my granddaughter Malti was suffering from high fever and she became unconscious and she could not talk. Missionary L. Masilamani family was living in our village. We sought the prayer of missionary's wife Vanmathiben for the healing of Malti. My son in law Manubhai and Vanmathiben visited and prayed for Malti. Malti got healed through the prayers and she became normal. So I and my whole family members believed in Jesus Christ."

Mrs. Vanmathi Masilamani narrates this incident:

"I was called by the Kharbari family (Bikhubhai was the Kharbari [secretary] of Dolyambar village) Ranaben and Manubhai to pray for a small girl named Malti who was seriously sick. I went and saw that small girl was lying down running high fever. Her hands and legs were stretched out straight and was having stiffness in her various muscles, in neck and jaw. I applied vicks ointment

on her body and prayed for her in faith. Very soon she became alright and was completely healed. I praised God for her recovery. Because of this her father Lakhubhai Bikhubhai and his father Bikhubhai family members believed in Jesus Christ."

Nainaben Mahdubhai was the younger sister of village headman Motirambhai. Her husband was from Jamnya Mahal. He settled in her wife's village. This family also believed in Jesus.

Great harvest

On 24-10-1983, seven Bombay Bhandup Tamil Methodist Church members came to Dolyambar for visiting the ministry of their sponsored missionary L. Masilamani. On 25-10-1983, Rev. T.V. Gaikwad, Bros. Johnson family, Israel family, Johnson's father in law came to Dolyambar in the evening. 'Bhajan Mandali' started at 8 p.m. and it continued till 7 a.m. Nearly 250 people attended. On 26-10-1983, 75 people joined the Church in Dolyambar. Rev. S. Retnamoney and Rev. T.V. Gaikwad conducted the service. Families of Dolyambar village headman Motirambhai and his brother in law Bikkubhai (Kharbari) join the Church within one year after the Junner opposition. The field missionary L. Masilamani with his family felt happy in the Lord for this abundant harvest.

The pioneer missionary L. Masilamani family's identification with the Dolyambar Church believers by living in their village in order to cater to the needs of their spiritual and medical needs is one of the main reasons for the Church

growth. They moved to Dolyambar village on 12-3-1983 with their first son John Kingsly who was five years old at that time. They stayed in the veranda of the village headman's house and later in a room along side the goats on one side and cows and oxen on the other side. This simple life appealed to the common people. Later this couple were blessed with twin sons, George Wesly and Golden Frankly, exactly one year after their moving to Dolyambar village on 12-3-1984. Their living among the Dolyambar people with the twins is not forgotten by many even in the year 2016 when the coverage was done for writing Church history of that village.

Nav Jeevan Seva Mandal (NSM) started literacy classes under the leadership of Rev. S. Arulraj in Dolyambar village. Many believers learnt to read and write in Gujarati language through Kukna literacy materials. It helped them in reading the Bible and to grow strong in their Christian faith. The NSM clinic run by Mr. And Mrs. Henry in Dolyambar village from 30-9-1989 to may 1991 helped the Dolyambar village people and other people from other villages very much. One bore well was dug in the patel falia for getting drinking water by NSM. There was a steady Church growth in Dolyambar village.

Church Construction

Meetings were conducted in the house of Dolyambar village headman Motirambhai. As the number of people increased they planned to build a Church in their village. Motirambhai donated land for Church construction. People donated the wood, bamboo for walls and

gave free labour for the kacha Church construction.

Dr. S. Devadoss dedicated this first Church on 27-6-1984. More than 400 people gathered for the dedication service. The local forest officer gave one tree to raise a flag imprinted with Cross on it. Dr. S. Devadoss hoisted the flag. The forester garlanded and honoured Dr. Devadasan. Bro. John Paul Dhanasingh also attended this function. This Church is the biggest Church when compared with Karadiamba, Javatala, and Sadadvihir Church buildings. 1200 tiles were put on the roof. CNI evangelist Madhukar M. Pawar (later became an ordained priest) led the bhajan meeting in the night.

This first Church was renewed and dedicated on 22-4-1990 and Rev. Johnson dedicated the renewed Church. Pucca Church was planned during the time when D. Abraham was the field missionary. Motirambhai donated his land in another area and all the people worked freely for the Church construction. The measurement of the Church is 50 feet in length and 25 feet wide. The Church construction began on 15-2-2006. This Church was completed on 25-9-2007. The Church was dedicated on 19-10-2007. This Church is named as St. Mark Church which is now part of the CNI, Gujarat Diocese after 211 Churches planted by FMPB were integrated with the CNI, Gujarat Diocese.

Out of 100 households 40 households are in Christian faith. We are concerned to see the rest of the households also to embrace faith in Christ.





God Broke the Line of Hereditary Nerves Problem!


