Independence Day, Our Gospel Day!

We, the Indians celebrate our 75th Independence Day on 15th August i.e. independence from the British Raj that once ruled over us. It was the birth of independent India and the beginning of our beloved freedom. It is good to thank God for the blessing of liberty,

remembering all the freedom fighters of India. It is right to be patriotic and celebrate our nation's independence. The Christian community has reasons to legitimately feel proud of its contribution to the nation. Both prior and after independence 2.3% of India's population of Christians have contributed to its development in a significant and unique way. In fact Christians' contribution may be far beyond its statistics both in quality and quantity.

Although it is obvious that political, national and democratic freedoms are good, true freedom is found only in Christ and in His Kingdom. From the General Secretary...



Dear Partners in the fulfilment of the Great Commission,

Greetings to you all in the mighty and matchless Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

Nehemiah - focusing on task in the midst of opposition:

When Nehemiah was building the wall of Jerusalem, he faced different kinds of opposition like ridicule, planted lies, threatening and attack on his reputation, all mentioned in Nehemiah chapters 4 to 6. His main weapon to blunt the weapons of the enemy was prayer (Neh.4:4&5). When Sanballat ridiculed the Jews (4:1) and Tobiah the Ammonite said, "What they are building-even a fox climbing up on it would break down their wall of stones!"(4:3), Nehemiah's response was "Hear us, our God, for we are despised." Instead of responding to the adversaries directly, Nehemiah went to God in prayer and cried before Him. In all these things, he never wavered on his vision of building the wall or lost his focus from the task at hand. As

we are trying to fulfil the vision of reaching this nation with the gospel of Jesus Christ, we too face many hurdles and adversaries. Nehemiah teaches us that we have to take all adversities to God in prayer and keep our focus on the vision of bringing the gospel to every single Indian.

Indigenization:

The initiative of Indigenization in our Churches and congregations is picking up speed. The Zonal and Regional secretaries with the help of the missionaries are drawing plans and strategies to make the Churches self-sufficient in finance, governance and propagation. The Santal Sahibganj region Churches provide all financial support to their evangelists from April 2021. Praise be to God.

Maximizing the utility of collection app:

We introduced a Mobile App to record the details of sacrificial offerings of our donors in September 2020 with a view to shift our accounting to digital mode for easy access and increased accuracy. Also, it was believed that it would reduce the burden of our Prayer Group leaders although there may be some initial difficulty to get accustomed to the new system. The first step in this direction is to enrol all our supporters in the Offering Collection App. By God's grace, 341 PG / SCAN groups in Tamil Nadu have started using this Mobile App so far. We have encouraging reports from

these App users and the members of these Prayer Groups receive their receipt promptly. However, I am a bit concerned about the pace of enrolling our supporters – only little more than 6600 people have been enrolled. I request all the Prayer Group Leaders and their concerned Mobilization Secretaries to hasten the process for the glory of our Lord Jesus. We have also added a facility in the Mobile App for donors who send offerings directly to FMPB to provide details of their donation."

National Institute of Missions programs:

At present our missionary training centre (NIM) in Jhansi, Uttar Pradesh is having 7 missionary candidates undergoing the training and will go to the mission field in September 2021. Another batch of 23 candidates will join NIM for a 10 month training program in August beginning. There was a missionary interview in July also at Chennai. Please pray for all the missionary trainees that they may be equipped to face the challenges in the mission fields and filled with the burden of souls.

Starting prayer meetings in person:

On 13th of July I attended a prayer group leaders meeting in Chennai. I was thrilled to meet the Prayer group leaders with family in person after a long time of corona lockdown and related restrictions. I praise God for our prayer group leaders'

unquenched enthusiasm in serving the Lord by mobilising prayers and financial support for the ministry of FMPB. After conducting meetings in virtual platforms for a long time, now is the time to conduct the meetings in person to strengthen the fellowship and sharpen the vision of our supporters.

Basti day:

Our first missionary to North India Rev. Hilkiah and family set their feet on the soil of the first north Indian mission field Basti in Uttar Pradesh on 23rd July 1971. We have completed 50 years of ministry in North India on 23rd July 2021. This humble beginning has been blessed by the Lord by expanding the ministry from one field in 1971 to 347 fields in 2021. Glory to Him alone.

Pray for the grieving families:

This month I visited some of the families who lost their dear ones in the second wave of Covid'19. Those families need our prayers regularly. All of us may pray continuously before the throne of grace for the surviving members.

Our prayers remain for all of you.

Turn to God and Build New India!

**“O Land, Land, Land,
Hear the word of the Lord”
(Jer. 22.29).**



The birth of the month of August brings to our memory of our nation's Independence Day. A lot of thoughts of our leaders, soldiers and civilians who struggled hard for the independence cloud our mind. 73 long years have rolled by since we received independence. We are proud of our nation and our leaders who made India into a secular state.

Though our nation is celebrating 75th Independence Day, our nation is lagging behind in various things. Poverty could not be eradicated. The democratic values, the freedom of the democratic institutions and the rights of the common man and woman are now at stake. Every day we read in the news papers and hear in the media about corruption, murders, rape, suicide, oppression, hunger, addiction, terrorism, fundamentalism, and attack on minorities. Let us see in the light of the Scriptures what the Lord expects from us and refer to history how the nations have been blessed by God when they turned to him.

Jehoiakim, the king of Judah (II Kings 23.34) neither had regard for justice and righteousness, nor had any concern for the poor and needy and had shed innocent blood. He used forced labour to build his palace and paid the workers nothing. Therefore, he was deposed and taken to Babylon. Jehoiachin, his son succeeded his father [Jer. 22. 24]. God warns him and the people of Jerusalem to turn to him, saying O! Land, Land, Land, Hear the Word of God.” In the same way, God calls today the nation of India to turn to him. When human beings turn to God there is fullness of life and joy, fullness of love and peace. That will give birth to a NEW INDIA.

I. Righteousness exalts a NATION (Pro. 14.34)

God cannot bless the nation which is defiled by various sins and wickedness. But when the people of a nation turn from their evil ways and sins, the Lord blesses the nation. The Lord sent Jonah to preach the judgment of God to the people of Nineveh. Then the people of Nineveh heard the preaching of Jonah, *So they believed God and proclaimed a fast and put on sackcloth from the greatest of them even to the least of them.* [Jon. 3.5]

The king also arose from his throne and was covered with sackcloth and sat on ashes. They repented and turned to God, so God relented from punishing the city. Thus, Nineveh became a NEW Nineveh. When India turns to Lord, then it will become a New India. When a heart is converted, everything turns topsy turvy. That is why God says, “Rend your heart, and not your garments and turn to the Lord” [Joel. 2.13].

The holy life of the early first century Christians attracted the society and the kings. The world could see a new way of life in Christ in them. The kings and rulers were astonished at the way of life filled with purity, love and courage of the first century Christians. Today God calls us to live this new life.

II. The king by judgement establishes the land (Pro. 29.4):

It is an abomination to kings to commit wickedness: for the throne is established by righteousness [Pro. 16.12]. To rule a nation, the leaders of the nation need wisdom. Wisdom comes from God. When the leader rules the nation with wisdom and righteousness, the nation is blessed. Solomon was young when he became the king of Israel. He asked God to give him wisdom to rule the nation of Israel. God granted his request [I Kings. 3. 5 - 14]. The reign of Solomon transformed the nation into a new nation - spiritually, socially, economically, commercially and so on. On the day of dedication of the new temple, he stood on his knees and spread his hand towards heaven and prayed to

God to bless the nation and the temple [I Kings. 8.22 - 54]. God also heard his prayer and promised to be with him and be in the temple to bless the people [I Kings 9. 3]. God established Solomon's throne and blessed the nation of Israel. A new golden era began. His regime was marked by spectacular growth in all spheres.

Abraham Lincoln dreamt of America to be a nation devoid of slavery. The Negroes were treated like animals. He was a president who prayed early every morning. God strengthened him to reform the nation of America. He created a new America devoid of slavery system. He says in his speech at Gettysburg of the abolition of slavery as “**a new birth of freedom**”.

Queen Victoria of England feared God and walked righteous before the Lord. She honoured the Word of God. She walked in the ways of the Lord. Victorian Age was noted for the piety of the Christians. Church attendance on Sundays was very important. History says that in every house the discussion on the Sunday sermon was a common practice. God blessed England. The British ruled the whole world. They gave the principles of democracy to the world. No wonder. A lot of missionaries rose up from England and Scotland and went around the world and built God's kingdom.

III. When praying people multiply in a nation, the nation blooms:

When I heard these words, I sat down and wept, and mourned for certain days

and fasted and prayed before the God of heaven” [Neh. 1. 4]. When praying people multiply in a nation, the nation blooms into a new nation even if the nation may be on the brink of destruction. God changes the destiny of the nation. God punished the Israel nation by sending them into exile to Babylon. The walls of Jerusalem were broken down and the people in captivity were in great affliction. When Nehemiah who was a cupbearer in the palace of Artaxerxes heard of the demolition of the walls and the affliction of the people in captivity, he wept, cried out and prayed with fasting for several days [Neh. 1. 4]. He ventured to rebuild the nation. Nehemiah swung into action. He rebuilt the walls of Jerusalem, reformed the bad systems that crept into the society and temple, resettled the people, reinstated the law and restored the worship in the temple. A NEW Jerusalem came into being to the glory of God.

Philiph Jacob Spencer, (1635 - 1705) a college professor started prayer groups throughout Germany that ignited revival in the Churches in Germany. The people in the prayer groups preached in the Churches about repentance, holiness, and emphasized the need of preaching the Gospel to the people who had never heard before. As a result Ziegenbalg and Plutschau, the two young Germans were sent out as missionaries to India. A new era of mission - The First Protestant Mission - came into existence. Through the efforts of Ziegenbalg the first school for women was started. The first printing press was started. Thus education awakened Indians from superstitions and various enslavement of poverty, bonded

labour, child marriage, sati, illiteracy and so on.

Pandita Ramabai (1858 - 1922) a Brahmin widow received a new life. Christ Jesus became a pioneer in the education and emancipation of women in India and a social reformer. Since she had received the new life of Christ she lit the light of hope and courage in the lives of innumerable widows who were despised by the society and religion and encouraged them for women empowerment.

Yes, by executing righteousness the nations have progressed towards new heights of civilization, science, and technology etc. Moral standards of the people have improved a lot. The righteous national leaders and men and women of God have reformed the societies and nations to turn away from the wrong ways. They have turned the course of the nation towards the newness of life.

The Gospel of Jesus Christ in India has liberated people from social, moral, religious and other evil bondages. People have been set free from sin, sickness, superstition, illiteracy, ignorance, bonded labour, child marriage, exploitation of women, caste system, oppression and other evil practice like untouchability etc. The Gospel of Christ not merely saves people from sin but it enlightens and builds them socially, economically, intellectually, and spiritually by giving them education and their basic needs of life. As builders of NEW India, let us repent from wickedness, have fear of God, pray to see India turn into Nava Bharat.

MIGRANT MINISTRY

- A New
Mile
Stone!

In India, there are approximately 6 crores of inter-state migrant labourers living in despicable conditions. In Tamil Nadu, there are about 15 Lakhs migrants and about 5 Lakhs of them are living in Chennai alone. Despite contributing 10 percent of India's GDP, these workers are socially, politically and spiritually disinherited. Migrant workers are generally employed in the informal sector, doing unskilled jobs in textiles, manufacturing, construction, hotel, transportation etc or in domestic work. Migrants start working at an early age, spending their days at worksites and return to the perilous shelters in the slums where they share small rooms with 5-6 other inmates. Mostly they are exploited by the middlemen who are in contact with them in terms of their work. They are politically invisible to urban planners because they are not enfranchised in the area where they work. They are often denied basic entitlements including access to subsidized food ration, housing, drinking water, public health facilities, education and banking services. They often work in poor conditions lacking social security and legal protection.

When our Union Government imposed national lockdown in March 2020 to contain the spread of COVID-19, millions

of Indian migrants struggled as factories closed down.

They lost jobs and were desperate to return home in that uncertain time. With no food, water or public transportation, they commuted hundreds of kilometres on foot-dying of hunger and exhaustion, suicide, road and rail accidents, police brutality, and denial of timely medical care along the way.

Welcoming a stranger is an important Biblical virtue for Christians. Every human being has inalienable rights, so caring for migrants is a significant mission of the people of God today. Moreover, we, the people of God, should never forget the fact that we are called "as aliens and strangers"(1.Pet. 2:11) in this world. Sojourners could be the best description of our lives on the earth.

Migrants in the Bible

Christianity even draws its foundational doctrines significantly from a history that has a clear thread with migration. It is in Genesis 3 where the original migration of mankind happened as a result of Adam's rebellion against God and was expelled from the Garden of Eden (Gn. 3:1-24). In their expulsion from Eden, Adam and Eve migrated into another land as a result of God's judgement.

However, in reversing the Adamic migration by recreating a new person for Himself, God called Abraham to leave his home in order to inherit the promised land of Canaan (Gn. 12:1-3). This shows us that for God's large Salvific purposes, Abraham migrated to dwell in foreign lands which God wanted to give to him and his descendants (Gn. 12) as a promised blessing. In this way, the notion of Adam and Abraham's migration is juxtaposed. On one hand, Adam's migration was in the form of punishment and destruction, whereas on the other hand, Abraham's migration was particular and universal in nature as a blessing. The speciality of Abraham's migration was a kind of receiving particular blessings for him and his descendants, while the universal aspect of his migration lies in bringing people back to eternal fellowship with God.

The commandments that God gave the Israelites when they entered the Promised Land made reference to the foreigners living in their midst. Having once been foreigners themselves in Egypt, they were to treat the foreigners with nothing less than the greatest love.

"When a foreigner resides among you in your land, do not mistreat them.

The foreigner residing among you must be treated as your native-born. Love them as yourself, for you were foreigners in Egypt. I am the Lord your God."
(Leviticus 19:33-34)

The plight of these foreigners-many of whom were working in Israelite households-reminds us of the migrant workers today. And the call to "love them as yourselves" reminds us of Jesus' second commandment to us: "Love your neighbour as yourself" (Matthew 22:39).

FMPB Ministry among Migrants



God gave the burden of reaching the migrants in South India in the year 2005 to our missionaries Rev. Devadass & his wife Mrs. Asnath Devadoss while sharing the Gospel to the migrants on their travel to Chennai by train. After hearing the Gospel many migrants even asked their address for further contact. They visited them the next day and there were 60 people to whom they were able to share the Gospel. God spoke to them through two verses when they were praying for the North Indian Migrants. They are -

Phil.2:13 - for it is God who works in you to will and to act in order to fulfil his good purpose.

Isa. 49:19,20 - "Though you were ruined and made desolate and your land laid waste, now you will be too small for your people, and those who devoured you will be far away. The children born during your bereavement will yet say in your hearing, 'This place is too small for us; give us more space to live in.'

In response to God's call, our missionaries started the ministry at first among the migrants in Thirumudivakkam, Chennai. Mr. Malik Karmakar was our first believer who accepted Christ during their first evening meeting and confessed his faith in the Lord Jesus Christ on Oct 3, 2011. Through him we got the opening to reach many of his migrant friends and families. As a result three of his friends also

confessed their faith in the Lord in March, 2012. Then we started the first Christmas service for the migrants in their house in which 15 migrants participated.

On 27th August, 2012 we conducted a program for the Hindi speaking community. The guest singer was Mr. Anil Kant, who is a very famous Christian singer. Through this program we were able to reach out approximately 1,200 migrants. That was a breakthrough for their ministry. Similarly in the year 2014, we conducted another program for the Hindi speaking community. The guest singer was Mr. Vijay Benedict. This also helped us reach a lot of Hindi speaking people. We work among the migrants who live in Manali, Redhills, Katrambakkam, Thandalam, Ayanambakkam, Kolathur, Guindy, Athipattu and Korattur of Chennai and conduct worship services for them.

After the Sunday worship in Hindi, the volunteers conduct separate worship in different languages such as Oriya, Assamese, Bengali and Bhojpuri. We conduct seekers' meetings, cottage prayer meetings, teaching and training programs.

Through a training program called TAFTEE, 14 people are ready to become evangelists and have started doing evangelism. More than 23 persons are in training currently. On June 9, 2019 (Periyamalai Day) we had distributed 110,000 Hindi Gospel literatures across Tamil Nadu through volunteers supporting our ministry.

Blessings of Migrant Ministry

Through our ministry among the migrants, many drunkards God delivered from the habit of drinking alcohol, many from the possession of evil spirits. Many migrant families started sending their kids to schools and many youngsters have been able to build their career. First Christian Marriage for our migrant believers were conducted in 2017.

Almost thousand migrants are with us and currently worship is being conducted for them in 10 places. Hundreds of migrants have accepted Jesus Christ as their personal Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ so far 191 persons confessed their faith in the Lord Jesus Christ.

The people who accepted Jesus Christ are sharing the Word of God in their villages after going back to their respective states and they are in constant touch with us. And three of them have even donated their lands to build a Church in Purulia in Bengal, Lakisari in Bihar, and Sirsai in Assam.

Care and Concern

Moreover, we give educational support to the children of migrants through St. John's School, Manali. During the lockdown 2020, we were able to supply 180 packets of groceries to the families in Pallikaranai, 100 packets to families in Thandalam and 150 packets to families in Thiruvotriyur. We also involved in flood relief work during 2015 Chennai floods and respond to similar crises in the consecutive years.

Vision & Goal

God willing, we would like to expand our ministry to 25 locations to conduct services before 2022 March. After April, 2022 we want to send the people who have trained for ministry to other Districts of Tamil Nadu. After this, we want to send people to the four states in South India as well.

Migrant Believers

One more concern and challenge is that a good number of our believers in many mission fields across the nation, become migrants nowadays. As there are no proper earnings in their own places, in order to manage their livelihood they travel to the nearby states. It creates a lot of challenges to their spiritual life, as they may not have a proper spiritual fellowships and spiritual gatherings in their work spots. As a result, there is a possibility of some of our believers give up their personal relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ and may return to their old evil practices. They are vulnerable in their spiritual life in many ways. So, we need to pray for this special concern.

Please join us, in praying...

- That the Holy Spirit to open the hearts and minds to receive His grace and love

and know that Jesus is Christ, who came to seek and save the lost.

- That our migrant friends may experience God's love even in their isolation, and receive His comfort and strength.
- That we may find creative ways to minister to them and share the message of hope in Christ, and that these efforts will be fruitful.
- That the Churches around them to identify these people and to come forward to help them.
- That they may be brought together in a larger level for an Annual Convention that may create a sense of belonging to them.
- That many North Indian language speaking volunteers to join with us in the extension of this ministry.
- That their children to get an opportunities to study to come up in social life.
- That their medical needs to be taken off without any hindrance.
- That the ministry for migrants to spread across Tamil Nadu and our nation also.
- That the migrant believers to keep their faith in the Lord Jesus Christ in their work spot.
- That the migrant believers who go back to their respective places to stand firm in their faith and lead a witnessing life.
- That the migrant believers to find out resources for their livelihood in their own respective state itself.

FAMILY BENEVOLENT FUND (FBF) NEED FOR OUR MISSIONARIES

I have received full payment and have more than enough... They are a fragrant offering, an acceptable sacrifice, pleasing to God. (Phil. 4:18)

With much grateful hearts we thank each of you for your prayers and support in meeting the needs of our missionaries. May God bless you abundantly for meeting the medical needs of our missionaries during the pandemic period. We hereby would like to share with you about one more concern of providing Family Benevolent Fund [FBF] to our missionaries.

We already have a scheme of Family Benevolent Fund in FMPB to which we save Rs.50/- from the salary of each missionary. We return this saved amount to the missionaries when they retire from our organization. Until last year,

we used to grant Rs.1,000,00/- to our missionaries who died due to disease or accident during their service. Keeping the present situation and economical inflammation in mind, in the last Executive Committee, it was decided to grant Rs. 2,000,00/- to a missionary family if a missionary would pass away during their service. This grant would be Rs.1,000,00/- for the retired missionary and Rs.50,000/- for the local evangelist.

As on date, 7 missionaries during their service, 2 missionaries after their retirement, one volunteer and 5 local evangelists have passed away due to Covid'19. As we have already settled the saving amount of the retired missionaries, and due to the present situation there is an enormous need to provide the Benevolent Fund to the missionary families who have lost their family members. Therefore, we encourage you to participate in meeting this need. May our Lord richly bless you and reward you for your sacrificial giving.

Moreover, we continuously seek your prayers for the health of our missionaries, especially those who have lost their spouses and children due to Covid'19, so that God would console them and take care of them in the days to come.

Rajan Andrews was born on 5th October 1944 to Mr. Chinnaiyan & Mrs. Nagammal in a village called Perundalaiyur, Erode Dt where the LMS missionaries from Australia namely Antony Watson Brough, Herbert Arthur Popley and Ellis worked and established schools and hospitals. Mr. Rajan Andrews studied in this Christian School, where he came to know about Jesus Christ. After finishing his schooling, he worked for 18 years in the Sakthi Sugar Mills, at the nearby town as a machine operator. During that time, Mr. Rajan Andrews came into contact with the Cross Bearer Evangelical Team and was involved in the outreach programs.

One day Mr. Rajan Andrews was spending time with God in prayer at the Bhavani riverbed. He was attracted by some dragonflies. One dragonfly fell into the river and it was noticed by another fly and so it tried many times to save the fallen one from the river and finally succeeded. Both

God blessed their married life with a son - Mano Samuel and a daughter - Blessy Ranjitham. After the studies Mano Samuel was employed in a private company in South Korea and Blessy finished her CA.

Rev. Rajan Andrews' family served the Lord based at Periyamalai for two and half years and in 1983 they started a new mission field at Perigai. Hundreds of people accepted the Lord, and many Churches were planted in and around this area. Later, God enabled them to build Churches in Panthikuri, Jodi Kolathur, Thimmachattram, Pillakottai, B.Agragaram, Kalagoundanur, Ariyur, Mantharalli, Pethappampatti, Nambipatti, Sundaikaipatti, Ganapathy Patti, Jadaiyampatti and Thalanattham. Then they did the ministry for 7 years based at Harur and established many congregations. Thus, this couple served the Lord as missionaries for about 30 years in our various mission fields.

Due to old age and prolonged sickness he was promoted to glory on 18th May 2021 at Erode. We thank God for his wonderful life and ministry. Let us uphold the family in our prayers.

Biography



MRS. SUSEELA PATRICK JOSHUA (1940-1994)

Rev. Arthur Margoschis an European Missionary came to India in 1875 and settled down in a village called Sanpathur which was later christened as Nazareth. He proclaimed the Good News in and around Nazareth and established a few educational institutions. Mr. Sagayam, born in Nazareth studied in Margoschis High school and landed in a job with the co-operative Department. He married sister Nallammal of Virudhunagar who was a teacher by profession. The couple was blessed with three children namely, Thomson, Suseela and Wilson.

Daughter Suseela studied in Thangammal Periyasamy Government High School in Virudhunagar. In those days, girls were not allowed to pursue higher studies. But Suseela's parents got their daughter

admitted in Sarah Tucker College, Palayamkottai. After graduation she joined Christopher's training college and successfully completed her B.T degree by God's grace. Suseela was appointed as a Teacher in Sarah Tucker Higher School, Palayamkottai.

Salvation: The teaching faculty of Sarah Tucker College was spiritually deep-rooted in faith and they had guided many students to Jesus Christ. Such guided students led witnessing lives both in Churches and among their families. Though Suseela was a Christian, she had no idea of whether her name was written in the Book of Life nor was she assured of her salvation. She regularly attended college chapel and participated in spiritual meetings. At this juncture, Mrs. Daisy Paul, one of the lecturers of Sarah Tucker College, conducted a Prayer group in which Suseela attended. Her participation in the prayer group gave her assurance as a follower of Jesus Christ and slowly but steadily her faith in Jesus Christ grew deeper and stronger.

Marriage: Bro. Patrick Joshua is the son of Mr. Masilamani and Mrs. Parimalam from Idaiyangudi. He completed his graduation from St. John's College, Palayamkottai and post-graduation from Madras Christians College, Tambaram, Chennai. Since he had accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and Saviour in his youth, he ministered through reunion fellowship among students during his college studies. While studying in St. John's College, the youths in the college used to assemble in groups and pray. It was the time of missionary awakening in

Tamil Nadu and the missionary activities were picking up momentum. Youths got involved in the activities of Friends Missionary Prayer Band. Bro. Patrick Joshua's mother was a prayer warrior and hence, it was no surprise for the son to inculcate the qualities from his mother. After post graduation, Patrick Joshua joined Life Insurance Corporation of India at the managerial level. Patrick Joshua's younger sister Anbu worked as a teacher along with Suseela in Sarah Tucker High School. Anbu suggested to her parents about Susheela as the suitable partner for Patrick. After the formalities, Patrick Joshua and Suseela were united in Holy Matrimony in Virudhunagar church on 18.11.1964.

Ministry with FMPB: Mr. Patrick Joshua was working with LIC in Kadambur as Area Development Officer. After marriage, the couple moved to a house in Kadambur. Joshua worked as a Catechist in a church at Sivalingapuram near Kadambur. Later Joshua was promoted as Manager and transferred to Kovilpatti. Mrs. Suseela, as a homemaker, looked after the family while the couple was residing in Kadambur; God blessed the couple with the first-son on 23.11.1965. He was christened as Shalom Devabalan. The second son Jim Elliot was born on 23.03.1967, third daughter Sabeena Monica on 10.01.1968 and the last son Franco was born on 10.08.1971. The family was committed to prayer and meditated on the Word of God. Mrs. Suseela spent most of the time nurturing the children on Christian faith. From 1966 onwards, Patrick Joshua worked as the Honorary Treasurer of FMPB. Joshua was

transferred to Veerapandianpattinam and hence the family too moved to that place. The office of finance of FMPB functioned from their home. Mr. John Kirubakaran worked as Assistant in that office. Later, Mr. Asirvatham and Mr. Chellappa joined them. Thus, a small office of FMPB became functional in Veerapandianpattinam.

The parents decided that their children should know more about Jesus Christ and so they started a Sunday school in their house and the nearby children were invited to attend Sunday school. Mr. Robert Simon conducted children's classes and the children of Patrick & Suseela accepted the Lordship of Jesus Christ.

Call towards Full Time Ministry:

In 1978, due to the expansion in the Ministry of FMPB, Patrick Joshua was requested to take up the mantle of full time work of General Secretary. Both Patrick and Suseela prayed and as a result, Joshua resigned his job from LIC and was installed as the General Secretary of FMPB on 01.01.1978 risking the future of children and their educational needs and family necessities. The family laid their faith only on Jesus Christ and moved forward. Patrick donated his Provident Fund amount of one lakhs rupees to meet the urgent needs of FMPB. He sold his car. He donated the amount along with his savings to make both ends meet in FMPB. The amount received from FMPB as salary was very little compared with what he had received from LIC. Hence Mrs. Suseela had to reduce the expenses in the family budget under the

financial constraints. They lived happily and imparted the same values to their children. As per the constitution of FMPB, there was no difference in the salary offered to the missionaries, be it the General Secretary or other office staff.

Ministry among Women: In order to encourage the women on missionary activities, Mrs. Suseela invited a group of women for prayer at the residence of Mrs. Lily Reuben in Ayanavaram. Besides the prayers, the group used to visit hospitals and prayed for the patients. Bible studies on second Tuesday, fasting prayers on third Tuesday and house visit on fourth Tuesday were undertaken by the women prayer group. Women missionaries were not paid salaries. They were given a small amount of honorarium as spouses of the missionaries.

Last Days: In September 1993, Suseela was diagnosed with cancer in the stomach. It was a great shock to the family. She was taken to Christian Medical College Hospital, Vellore and treatment was started. Mrs. Suseela with a smile on her face, in spite of severe pain, spoke encouraging words to those who visited her. During the final days, the family moved to Kumaran Nagar, Chennai. Her unquenched thirst was that a Church should be constructed and Kumaran Nagar should become land of KUMAARAN NAGAR (Land of Son-Jesus). On 16.03.1994, Mrs. Suseela received her Final Call from God.

Let us praise and thank God for enabling Mrs. Suseela to complete the Race successfully.

Borewells for the needy people of India




