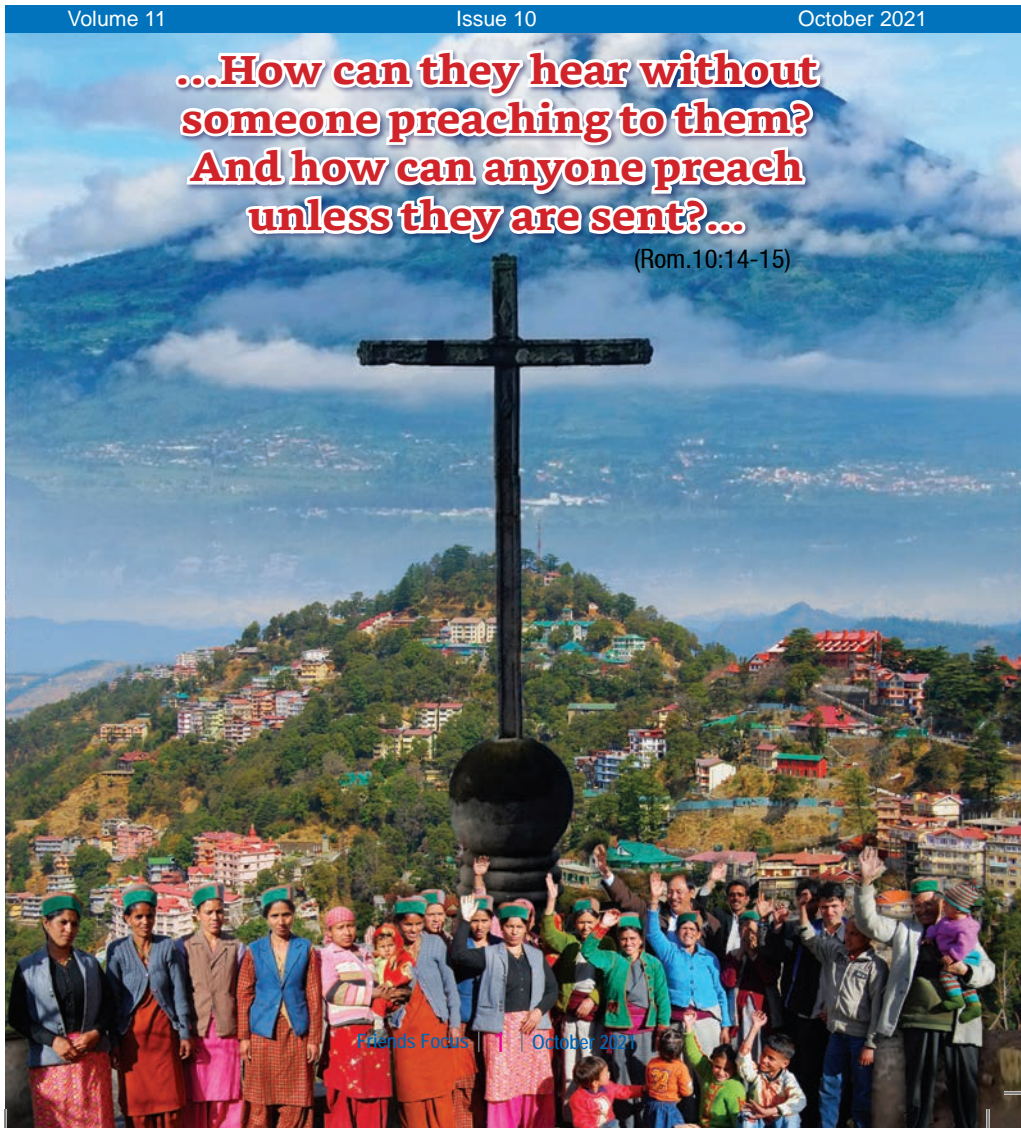

and benefits of heaven to go into another land, the land He had created - earth and live there among those people in order to bring redemption and salvation to a lost and dying world. In FMPB, the month of October is known for Mission Field Trips. Hundreds of our prayer group leaders, sponsors and friends used to travel in small groups to almost all our 264 mission fields in order to pray and encourage our missionaries and to see how God works through them to bring many to His fold. A mission trip can be a powerful, life-changing experience that broadens our perspective, gives us better direction in our thought and practice of our ministry. After visiting the mission field, one's vision and the goals of the individual's ministry will take a sudden change. The individual who travels to visit the missionary will be better equipped with knowledge and experience to be an advocate for the missionary work. Mission Field Trips will help us to pray for the missionary work more intelligently. It is about relationships, encouragement, shepherding, and the encouragement the missionary receives in knowing that their sending Church or prayer group is fully behind-backing them. Moreover, as Paul puts it 'we become co-workers in God's service' (1Cor.3:9). We become 'Mission focussed Christians' and our passion for God and for the unreached people will take a sharp increase. In the end, God will produce a deep level of sanctification in us through our mission involvement that will lead us to a closer likeness of Christ Jesus.

Due to the pandemic situation, the mission field trips have been suspended for the past two years. However, the earth is the mission field of our Lord Jesus Christ, especially our God loves India as it is the most unreached nation and the largest mission field on earth. No wonder, the Spirit of God works in the mission fields of India forever and our prayers, mission endeavours and memories too get entwined with our missionary families, especially who are living in the North on behalf of us and for the sake of the Gospel Indeed!

From the General Secretary...

Dear Partners in the fulfilment of the Great Commission,

Greetings to you all in the mighty and matchless Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

The Book of Jeremiah describes one of the tragic stories of Judah. The Babylonians set fire to Jerusalem. The commander of the imperial guard Nebusaradan carried the people of Jerusalem into exile to Babylon. He left behind some of the poor people, who owned nothing, in the land of Judah (Jer. 39.10). Some people came to Gedaliah at Mizpah, who was kept by Nebusaradan to rule the remnant and killed him. For fear of retribution, they gathered the remnant and wanted to take them to Egypt. Before fleeing to Egypt they approached Jeremiah to know where God wants them to go (Jer. 42:2). When Jeremiah told the will of God for them not to go to Egypt but stay in Jerusalem (Jer. 42.19), they said, "you are lying" (Jer.43.2). The people disobeyed thinking Egypt will be safer than staying in Jerusalem as the Lord said.

When the will of God and our interest is in conflict, we make decisions that suit us and give good returns or benefits. The Lord says in Isaiah 55: 8, 9 My ways are not your ways, My ways are higher than your ways, and My thoughts are higher than your thoughts. Abiding

in the will of God is the foremost priority of Christian living. We are called to walk with the Master not on our will and reasoning.

Vision Casting Seminar for Mobilization Secretaries:

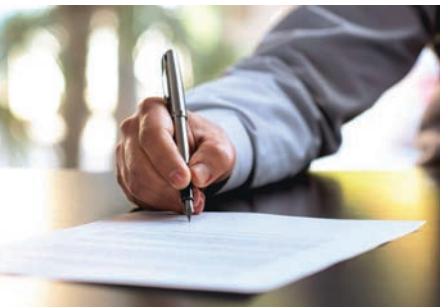

Worshipping the Lord with Loharbacho Village Believers:

On 5th September, I had an opportunity to worship the Lord with Malto believers of Loharbacho village. One elderly believer said that long back the missionaries said that "God would bless you people with everything needed for life. Then we accepted Christ and today God has given us roads, electricity, education and above all salvation".

What a testimony from a community transformed by the Gospel of Jesus!

Hostel Children:

Most of our hostel children studying in 9th to 12th stds are back in the hostel. We have to thank God for bringing the children back to the hostel after a long stay at home due to the pandemic situation. Lower class children, especially children from the Child Day-Care Centres are given tuition in the centre or in their villages as the schools for them are not opened yet.

Paul's Missionary Journey & Our Mission Field Trips

Saul travelled to Damascus to persecute Christians. On the way his life was transformed when he had an encounter with Jesus. He received a new great vision because of this encounter. 'Damascus' travel changed him upside down. 'The persecutor had become persecuted.' With great zeal in heart, Paul started his journey. All the journeys of Paul are very important. As per Isaiah 45:22, "Turn to me and be saved, all you ends of the earth; for I am God, and there is no other". Paul evangelized all the people of the earth. His vision which he received from Jesus and God's guidance encouraged him. His life-time goal was to preach the gospel from Jerusalem to Illyricum that is from one end of the earth to the other end.

Challenges are unavoidable, when we try to accomplish a vision in our life. During those days, sea voyage and travel by road, both were dangerous and full of challenges. In the parable of Good Samaritan, even the travel from Jerusalem to Jericho was described as dangerous. If local travel was intimidated one, how would it not be dangerous to travel to other countries? Here I would like to bring out the salient features of Paul's journey under three headings.

1 I was not disobedient to the heavenly vision:

That heavenly vision did not allow Paul to sit idle. In Acts 20:18-24, he says that his only aim is to finish the race and complete the task the Lord Jesus had given him. His theological knowledge and travel experience enabled him to write thirteen epistles to the Christians around the world. We were able to get only a few epistles from other Apostles. Lack of exposure could be the possible reason. If they too had travelled extensively like Paul, we would have received more epistles from them also. Paul explains his travel sufferings in 2 Corinthians 13: 23 - 27. Paul obeyed the vision which was revealed to him by Jesus and travelled to many places. That travel and his experiences are great a challenge to us.

2 I am a debtor:

Romans 1:14. I am a debtor both to the Greeks, and to the Barbarians; both to the wise, and to the unwise. A work which cannot be ignored, a duty which cannot be pushed away, a position which cannot be excused and a responsibility that should not be forgotten. The vision that did not allow St. Paul to sleep. We could say that the vision did not guide him rather it dragged him to fulfil the task.

Flogging, pelting, beating, humiliation, suffering, starving, thirst, nakedness, cold and ship wreck - all these difficulties could not make him to take a step back, because of his deep affection towards Jesus and the vision he had received from Him. Romans 8:38, 39 got fulfilled in his life. So in all the places where he placed his feet had congregations. He had sown with tears

and harvested with joy. [Psalm 126:5.] He preached with great zeal and won souls in great numbers, because the Apostle Paul knew that his labour in the Lord would not go in vain. [1 Corinthians 15:58].

3 I have fought the good fight: (2 Timothy 4:6)

Paul, in his first missionary journey, travelled to Cyprus, Lycia and Galatia provinces to evangelize the people. In his second missionary journey, he travelled to Galatia, Macedonia and Achaia provinces to preach the Good News. And in his third missionary journey, he travelled to Galatia, Asia, Macedonia, and Achaia and up to Jerusalem to do ministry. In his final missionary journey, he travelled to Crete, Asia, Macedonia and Achaia provinces to tell the Gospel. It is surprising how it was possible for Paul to make such journeys with limited transportation facilities and facing dangers. But the Acts of the Apostles and the epistles he wrote to the churches are the strong evidence for his journeys and his tremendous ministry.

So he was able to say with confidence that, "I have fought a good fight and finished the race."

Friends Missionary Prayer Band is delighted to welcome its prayer partners for field visits. From 1971, Friends Missionary Prayer Band started sending missionaries to North India. The leaders of FMPB visited the Mission Fields, met the missionaries, and stayed with them in their houses which had no basic facilities. Their affection encouraged the missionaries. Until 2019, these visits were continued in all the states of our nation.

The ministry has flourished, due to the visits of the leaders, the supporters and the Promotional Secretaries. So Field Visit is not a Pleasure Travel. The supporters of FMPB, who pray with tears and give sacrificially, visit mission fields to see the fruits with their own eyes. This is called Field Visit. In 1988, we were doing ministry at Borio Field, Jharkhand and we lived in a small hut with our two year old son Livingston. Mr. Jeevaraj, who was the Executive Committee Member of FMPB visited us, and prayed for us with a broken heart. Now that mission field has hundreds of congregations and thousands of believers of Maltos and Santals. Bihar, which was called 'the graveyard of missionaries,' is allotted to Trichy prayer group leaders for prayer support. The prayer group leaders visited Bihar every year and prayed with burden for souls in fasting. As a result, Maltos came into the fold of Christ in great numbers. It had been called the fastest people movement in the world in the 90s. Jharkhand (once it was part of Bihar) which was called, 'the graveyard of missionaries' has become Lord's Vineyard at present.

When we visit mission fields and pray with the missionaries, they become our prayer partners who pray for us. The impact of mission field visits in our hearts, make us pray for them fervently. Then the missionaries' ministry would yield fruits and there will be plenty of congregations wherever they step in. So in one way your mission field visit is a missionary journey too. We would like to invite you to take part in the mission field visit with that kind of the spirit.

FMPB - Mobilization Ministry, Chengalpattu

Rev. J. Winfred, the Initiator of Mission Field Trips!

Rev. Winfred, our superannuated missionary of FMPB, served in various capacities like mobilization ministry, HQ- Administration, lay leaders' training program etc. In fact, he is the pioneer and implementer of field visit when there were no computer booking facilities available in Indian Railways, phone or no mobile facilities and no enough information available to travel across the nation. He explored the possibility of taking the prayer group leaders to the mission fields of North India every year in the month of October which is considered as the best season for visiting North India. He was a typical guide who showed

the way and meticulously planned the field trips and as a result, now hundreds of prayer groups' leaders and friends visit the mission fields every year.

Let us hear Rev. Winfred citing his experiences concerning the vision of field visit as follows -

"Patrick Joshua Annan requested me to take our Prayer Group Leaders to visit our FMPB mission fields of North India in 1978 in order to have fasting prayers with our missionaries for the great harvest of souls for His Kingdom. So I accompanied our prayer group leaders by Train to North India and we were in three days of fasting and prayer in our first North India mission field, Basti and then in Gonda of Uttar Pradesh. Rev. Hilkiah Annan, our missionary of Basti had made all the arrangements for the meaningful prayer. And also we had a prayer in and around the places of Uttar Pradesh which required peace and protection during the time due to the Ayodhya issue.



In order to reduce the expenses of the travel by train, we used to avail the facility of circular journey tickets. Our missionaries Rev. Devavaram Samraj and Lt. Israel Devadoss helped us in making all the arrangements to see the mission fields, for our stay inspite of all limitations. Even during the earthquake in Gandhidham, Gujarat on 26th Jan 2001 we were on field visit at Gujarat and God protected our team, missionaries and our Churches. In January 2002, Bro. Mohan C Lazarus "Jesus Redeems" Nalumavadi and Fr. S.J. Berchmans visited our mission fields in Gujarat and participated in our 'Mela' arranged for our young believers and they were surprised to see the mass movement that had taken place in Pipalwada mission field of Gujarat.

I remember the words of Zachariah "who has despised the day of small things" [4:10] and I am glad that many of our prayer group leaders and friends are now practising it with utmost sincerity for the welfare of FMPB. All glory to God!"



Senders' Sharing

about their Mission Field Trips!

The role of both the 'goers' and 'senders' are very important for successful missionary work.

Regarding the Christian's options for missions' involvement, John Piper, a missiologist once famously offered these three: "Go, Send Or Disobey." In missionary work, we should recognize that there are some that God calls for cross-cultural ministry and there are those who co-labour behind them. Paul explains this relationship to the Church in Rome:

"And how are they to preach unless they are sent?" (Rom. 10:15).

This thought echoes throughout Paul's epistles. Paul in his epistle to Philippians says that God had entrusted the very same assignment to both the missionary and the senders as 'partakers of grace' [Phil: 1:7].

In FMPB, the 'Senders' i.e., our prayer group leaders and supporters used to visit the mission fields once in a year. There are two purposes for the mission field trips -

1. To encourage the missionary and to know about his ministry in person.
2. To get inspiration from the missionary work in order to do mobilization ministry effectively and to get involved in missions meaningfully.

Below are some of the feedbacks given by the Field Trips Team who visited our mission fields in the past few years in order to praise God and to draw inspiration and meaningful participation -

We, from Chennai - Tambaram mobilization area during our trip to Chiriyi & Khargone fields in Madhya Pradesh met the believers who had been healed from various illnesses through the prayers of our missionaries. We were astonished by the fact that the illiterate evangelists and believers were able to read the Bible and teach others too.

From Nazareth we went to Andhra on a field visit. We had faced opposition while distributing tracts to the people in the villages. So, we specially prayed for the opponents of the Gospel and returned back with the decision of building a Church in Islapuram, where we had faced opposition.

From Virudhunagar we had gone with a view to see the ministries among the Santals and we were really challenged by the spiritual growth of the poor believers in Jharkhand State, their interest in bringing the needed things as offerings to the Church.

While on our visit to Telangana mission field, from Santhome, we were able to meet the people who were healed through prayer, who had risen from the dead and the naxalites who were transformed by the Gospel and realized the power of Jesus Name.

Field visit became a great blessing to our mobilization ministry in Kerala. Moreover, among the members of the team who visited fields, 4 of them committed for the missionary work and 2 of them had already joined FMPB.

Our team members from Chennai – Thiruvanniyur visited the mission fields of Madhya Pradesh. To reach the village Makerkeda which was high on a mountain, we had to travel by a boat and then by walking, viewing the hilly terrains, valleys and rivers and also wild animals and dangerous people. We were able to understand the hard labour put forth by the missionaries to reach out to the people living in interior villages. It was really a challenge to sleep in Dungra Bhil people's houses, under the same roof where the cattle too were tied on the other side.

Our team members from Ambai & Kadayam of Tamil Nadu came with a commitment to raise funds to build a Church in Padagamba village in a hilly terrain of Himachal Pradesh in the mission field Rampur, where in a night meeting a believer donated his land to construct a worship place.

We, from Chennai-Anna Nagar mobilization area, had been to Alwar field in Rajasthan and appreciated the missionaries who were taking efforts to bring up all the 47 boys in Christian discipline and motivating them to excel in studies. Our hearts overflowed with joy to see the believers singing heartily, worshipping our Lord in the worship service, in the village Nahoma of Ramnagar in Punjab.

The heart stirring testimonies of the Majuli believers and the way they withstand the opposition both from their families and the village folks, just because they accepted Christ, stirred the thinking of members who had travelled right from down South Kanyakumari, to Assam on a mission field trip. On our return, we had to cross the river in a boat for 3 hours only, but due to the dangerous flood situation we had to cross for 9 hours which motivated us to work for the Lord with renewed vigour.

It was a real challenge for our spiritual life when we, the team from Pondicherry in Cuddalore district, joined worship along with the young believers who were worshipping with zeal and vigour in the mission fields of Rajasthan. On our way back we had a good fellowship with the missionary trainees in Jhansi and we realised the importance of praying for their future ministries.

We, the prayer group members and leaders from Coimbatore returned back with a burden to pray, for the ministries in Budhlada & Faridkot mission fields of Punjab and to share about the missionaries' testimonies and about the needs we saw and heard.

Missionary Biography

Bro. JOHN DHARMAMONY

(1953 - 2009)

Early Period

Mr. John Dharmamony was born in Elamchirai, a small village in Kanyakumari district, on 4th August 1953 in a Christian family. His father Mr. Chellappan was a farmer and mother Mrs. Thai Chellappan was a home maker. God blessed Mr. Dharmamony with one elder sister Ms. Leelabai and four younger brothers namely Johnson, Sundaramani, Manonmani and Nesamony. All were farmers except Mr. Nesamony, who became a full time Christian worker. Their father died while children were still young and the whole responsibility of taking care of the family fell on their mother.

God saved John Dharmamony from many dangerous accidents in his early days. On an occasion he fell into the burning

fire wood stove and God miraculously saved him. On another occasion he was carried away by the swirling water in a canal near his home but survived.

Born again experience

After finishing his school final, Mr. John Dharmamony joined polytechnic college. He was very active in the sports and other activities. One day when he jumped from a high place he injured one of his heels. Unaware of the injury he continued to play, run, and participated in the long jump event too. Within a few days he got severe pain in the heel, consulted a physician and had a minor surgery. After some time, one of his knees gave trouble with unbearable pain. He was unable to walk or fold his leg. So he consulted a few more local physicians and got relieved off the pain but only for some time. Hence he was sent to an Ayurvedic hospital at Trivandrum in Kerala. He received treatment there for a month but there was no improvement. So, he went to the Government hospital and the orthopedic surgeon recommended him to remove his leg lest it may affect other parts of his body. His mother and brothers were not willing to remove his leg. They prayed to God earnestly. They were not in a financially sound position for considering further treatment. John Dharmamony needed blood infusion as he was so anemic. One of his brothers gave him the needed blood.

The family of Mr. John Dharmamony had undergone severe financial crisis

as the family was confronted with many difficulties one after the other. The illness, plight of his family's problems sapped off his energy and Dharmamony grew restless. He thought that his life would soon come to an end. In the meantime, Dharmamony cried unto God. He felt that the sin of his youth was root cause of all his sufferings. Then, Dharmamony confessed that only because of the grace of God he was still alive. After a month he was taken to the house but still pus was oozing out from the wound. His wound caused further damage to his leg. Due to severe pain and stench the family decided to take him to the hospital again. Dharmamony was so discouraged and lost his hope. He turned his eyes upon Jesus. Suddenly he recollected the verse of the popular Tamil hymnal 'Devapita enthen meippanallo' (The Lord is my Shepherd). He opened the Bible and turned the pages to read Psalms 34. Tears trickled down on his cheeks. The verse 20 'He protects all his bones, not one of them will be broken' got his attention and he whole heartedly believed that verse was written just for him and prayed to God. He was totally broken and began to confess all his sins to the Lord Jesus Christ and pleaded him to wash his sins with His precious blood. And he accepted Jesus Christ as his personal Saviour on that day. He was taken to the hospital again for a checkup. The doctor who examined was astonished to observe that the wound was miraculously healed. The pus oozed out from his wound was completely stopped and he was relieved off his

pain. This experience transformed the life of John Dharmamony. He personally experienced that Jesus is alive. Once again he committed his life to be a witness for Christ thereafter.

Call to the ministry

After his miraculous healing, he had an opportunity to attend a missionary challenging meeting in Elamchirai Church, conducted by FMPB. In that meeting he heard about the challenge of reaching out the souls of various peoples in India perishing without an opportunity to hear the Gospel. The preacher gave a challenge to young people to go as cross cultural missionary to reach the unreached Indians. A few missionaries working in North India shared about their experience in the field ministries. Their sharing kindled the passion for souls in the heart of John Dharmamony. He started praying with his friends for the missionaries. He led this prayer group. Due to the poor financial condition of the family he was compelled to seek a job to take care of the family. Hence he came to Trichy in search of a job. He got employed within two days, and for a one full year he worked in Trichy. During his weekend he joined along with the FMPB prayer group in BHEL, for prayer fellowship and outreach ministry.

In 1977, Mr. John Dharmamony had an opportunity to attend the Tamilnadu State conference of FMPB, at Danishpet, Salem. During the meeting he felt that God has called him for the ministry. He was in a dilemma when thoughts about

the needs of his family. He was unable to take a decision. He returned from the camp but he was still struggling to take a decision. While he was working in the factory he miraculously escaped unhurt from an accident occurred when a running blade of the factory fan fell off. God again saved him. This incident gave him an assurance that God is able to save and protect him wherever he could go for the ministry. Putting an end to his dilemma he decided to go as a missionary. He attended the FMPB interview and joined the mission on 14th July 1977.

Training and Mission work

In 1977 he was sent to Bethel Bible Institute for one year missionary training. After his training he was temporarily posted in the Dindugul FMPB office. He was sent to the first mission field of FMPB in Periamalai. He preached the Gospel in and around Iruthukottai and Anchetty villages.

Marriage

Family arranged the wedding of John Dharmamony to Ms. Alice who was already serving the Lord through FMPB as a missionary in Uttar Pradesh. Their holy matrimony was held on 24th May, 1982. God blessed their married life with one boy and a girl namely Theodore Kirubakaran and Jenita Princes. These children went to Santhosha Vidhyalaya in Dohnavur for Schooling. After their Higher Studies in the professional colleges, they got married. God has blessed them with good life and children.

Church Planting Ministry

Mrs. and Mr. Dharmamony did the ministry in Anchety and Chengam mission fields. Latter, they were sent to Mosabani field in Orissa. In 1994, they had an opportunity to serve the Lord in the state of Jharkhand, based at Dalbhumgarh. In a short while they were called back to Southern Region. Based at Chengam, they started reaching out and then from Thriuvannamalai field. God blessed their 9 years of ministry in and around Thriuvannamalai. They planted many Churches and hundreds of people were brought into the fold of Christ and began to worship the Lord in various congregations. He also raised many Church elders and trained them to manage and lead these newly formed congregations.

His Home call

In 2008, due to his sickness Rev. John Dharmamony came to Chennai for the treatment. He lost his memory. After the treatment he gradually regained his memory. In 2009 he fell ill again and admitted in the hospital for further treatment. His wife and children suffered a lot due to his illness. He entered into the glory on 19th January 2009. John Dharmamony was very zealous for the Lord and led hundreds of people to Christ. After his home call his wife Mrs. Alice Dharmamony is ministering through the mobilization wing of FMPB, based at Adambakkam, Chennai. Please remember this family in your prayers.

**KEONJHAR FIELD, UTKAL REGION,
SOUTH EASTERN ZONE
Beginning to February 2014**

South Balanda is a small Village/hamlet in Talcher Tehsil in Angul District of Odisha State, India. This village is on the border of the Angul District and Dhenkanal District.

Beginning of Ministry:

The Keonjhar mission field was opened in February 1986. Mr. Fredrick Satya Samuel and Mr. Ruban Samuel were the first missionaries of Keonjhar field. The South Balanda village was reached with the gospel when Mr. Ashok Nayak was the field missionary. Mrs. Champa Munda, a resident of Balanda village was sick for a year because of an evil spirit. She was unable to eat or sleep. She became very weak and her condition became pathetic. Her husband Mr. Ramesh was a colleague

of Mr. Vijay Munda. Vijay Munda was a believer from Oriya congregation. Mr. Ramesh told about the pathetic condition of his wife to Mr. Vijay Munda. With much frustration, he told him about the amount of money he had spent for performing puja and for treatment. As Mr. Vijay Munda was a believer, Mr. Ramesh asked him to come to his house and pray for his wife. Mr. Vijay consented and prayed for Mr. Ramesh's wife. God heard the prayer and healed Mrs. Champa Munda on her deathbed. So she along with her whole family accepted Christ.

Meanwhile, another woman, Mrs. Randai Bodhra's mouth got twisted suddenly because of witchcraft. Her husband called Mr. Vijay Munda from Orissa to pray for his wife. God touched her and her mouth was restored. This miracle made Mrs. Randai Bodhra's entire family to accept Christ.

Mr. Kisku Marandi, a believer of an independent mission, called the believers to his house and started a worship service. The first worship service was conducted on 10.3.1998 in which 5 people participated. Later, the worship was shifted to the house of Mrs. Risha Munda. 8 people accepted Jesus Christ and joined the worship. Mrs. Risha Munda was one of the first believers

Church Growth:

The first believers had the gift of healing, so whenever they prayed for someone, they were healed and the demons fled. Because of this, people accepted Christ.

From 2001 onwards, gospel spread to the nearby slums. People from Banda Hating and Sarma Hating listened to the gospel with much interest. Here are some incidents of miraculous healing from the Keonjhar prayer Report and field history

“In Banda Hating, Mrs. Nagi Munda’s right leg became completely bent due to witchcraft. She became like a crippled woman. On 22.10.2003, some believers and the local evangelist went and prayed for her. After prayer she felt better and at night her leg was completely restored. Now she can walk freely. Praise God.



As Mrs. Risha Munda donated her 3 decimal land for constructing a Church, a temporary shed was constructed on that site. So the worship was shifted from Mrs. Risha Munda’s house to the temporary shed and it continued till 2008. The worship was then shifted to the semi pucca Church that was constructed by the believers in another site.

The Church Land:

Woship service was being conducted in the land donated by Mrs. Risha Munda where a temporary shed was constructed. Later, the Church elder, Mr. Vikas Goipai donated his land to build a Church, as the temporary shed was too small to accommodate the believers. He motivated the believers to construct a Church. The land donor is Mr. Vikas Goipai was the Church elder.

The Congregation & Community:

The South Balanda congregation members are from 6 villages: Balanda Hating, Sarma Hating, Thermal Hating, Central Colony, Remu Hating, Bagadhora. Most of the believers of this congregation belong to the HO community. Also migrants from Jharkhand and from various districts of Odisha are members of this congregation. The migrants are settled here as they are employed in thermal power plants and coal fields nearby.

Church Construction:

The Balanda Church foundation stone was laid on: 4.4.2008. It is a semi – pucca Church. Church Size: 21X12. There was no opposition during construction. The Church was constructed through the local contribution of believers. Rs. 10,000 was received from FMPB headquarters toward Balanda Church construction. On 4.4.2010 the Balanda Church was dedicated by Rev. Haramohan. It was a Easter Sunday. The believers built the Church all by themselves.

Mr. Krishna narrates his testimony in his own words. This incident occurred in Sep2012.



“I am Krishna Hembrom from Bam village. I work as a driver in Angul district. While doing my job I got in touch with 3 girls and soon I fell in love with all the three of them. As days went by, one among the three girls

realized that I was not willing to marry her. So she did witchcraft against me. My legs became weak and I was unable to walk. My family took me to a magician in Mayurbhanj district. The magician did all the possible magic tricks he knew and he asked us to sacrifice hen and goat. We spent Rs. 8000 there but my physical weakness remained as such.

Again my parents took me to a reputed hospital in Dhenkanal district. I was admitted there for a month. They took many tests but they were unable to diagnose my illness. The doctor referred me to Dhenkanal district hospital, where the doctor bandaged my hip so that I would get strength in my legs. But after bandaging, my health deteriorated further. With much difficulty I was brought back to my village.

When I worked as a driver at Angul, I remembered someone saying that if anybody would put their faith in Jesus before dying he would get eternal life. So I made a phone call to a believer, Mr. Dhulan Bhai who also had accepted Christ because of his physical healing. He advised me to go to the Church. So my brother carried me to Balanda Church for prayer. After one and a half months of constant prayers and applying prayer oil, I became perfectly normal. Praise God! Hallelujah!"

Mr. Ashok Nayak, Mr. Haramohan and Mr. Samarendra Singh were the missionaries who served in the Balanda Congregation.

Sunday school:

The Sunday school is conducted every Sunday from 8 am to 10 am at the

Anganwadi School. 10 children attend Sunday school. Lakshmi Purthy is the Sunday school teacher. There are 3 small groups functioning under Balanda Church.

Offerings:

The monthly offering totals upto Rs. 1500/-. People bring thanksgiving offering, tithe, rice offering (handful rice) and pledge offering (vow) voluntarily.

Holy Communion:

Once in 2 months the Holy Communion service is conducted by the local evangelist or the missionary. Around 50 people partake in it.

Outreach:

The Balanda Church elders, Mr. Vikas Goipai, Mr. Marthom, Mr. Dumburu Hembrom and Mrs. Risha go for outreach ministry to the nearby slums every Wednesday evening. They gather the people in a particular place and proclaim the gospel. Through the outreach ministry, 20 people accept Christ every year.

Church attendance:

60 to 70 people attend the Sunday service. The Church elder, Mr. Vikas Goipai leads the Sunday service at Balanda Church. The Balanda congregation has 120 believers (25 families).

Prayer Points:

1. There are more than 20 Slums in this area. Pray that people from all the slums to accept Christ.
2. As the present Church is small, the believers are in need of a bigger Church to worship the Lord.
