## God's Higher Plan in 2022

The theme verse of the year 2022 - Jeremiah 29:11 is not just about assuaging our anxieties about the future, but about pondering over the plan, growth and restoration of our own relationships with God. The context of this verse is very unique. This verse Jeremiah 29:11 is in the midst of a prophetic letter which Jeremiah sent to the people who would be in exile for 70 years in Babylon. God told them to build houses, have children during the exile, and to be faithful to Him and then His promises to bring them back to Israel. It is about God restoring His relationship with His people and they in turn positively reciprocating to His faithful love. It not only calls for trust, but also for prayer, love and worship.

Though this verse is not directly a promise to us, it reveals the heart of God toward those with whom He has graciously bound Himself through a covenant and it demonstrates to us a great deal about how God keeps similar promises to His people of the New Covenant. As people of God who do not belong to this world, we can get discouraged about living in this world. It is not always easy. We have to deal with many of the effects of sin, illness and death and temptation. And we live in a society that is turning against Christ and His believers. In our daily lives, we endure a lot of pressure. There are so many corrupting influences on us and on our children, through media, society and various means. We are to live as aliens and sojourners in this life, suffering rejection and even persecution at times.

But our God, in fact, does have plans for us-plans to restore, heal and prosper our relationships with Him, to bring us back from a land of sin and evil to a land of His bountiful goodness, His blessing and His life. His thoughts toward us are thoughts of peace and working towards "a future and a hope." God's plan has a happy ending. Yes, the thoughts that God has on us are loving, constant, personal, helpful, hopeful and eternal. He is always working towards the good of His people and for the good of our nation. His thoughts are toward our future involvement in His kingdom. God even calls us to pray for the nation in which we dwell, "that we may lead a quiet and peaceful life" (1 Tim 2:2). While we are here, the Lord calls us to use our gifts, and build up His Church so that His Kingdom will be extended.

Within the larger context of the Bible, God still speaks to us today through a promise which He had given to the Jewish people who were under the slavery. Being the new Israelites, once we understand the nature of God's plans for us and the nature of the goodness He promises for us, we can confidently apply this promise in our lives in the New Year 2022.

## Pursuing **HIGHER** Plans...

We have just stepped into a new year, 2022. God has been on our side when we had gone through a tumultuous and turbulent year which we have just crossed. The Corona pandemic shook the whole world and heaped pain and suffering on people. In this context God has given to FMPB Jeremiah 29:11 as the theme verse for 2022, "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future" and "Towards a Higher Plan" as the theme of the year.

### Contexts of Jeremiah 29:11:

When we understand the historical and literary context of Jeremiah 29:11, most Christians will find that it takes on a deeper, more relevant and even more powerful meaning for their lives. Understanding the context of a passage of scripture will help us to avoid the human tendency of reading the scripture with our own desired meaning, and will instead help us draw out of scripture the original meaning intended by God and His prophet.

### Historical context:

In the historical context, Jeremiah spoke these words to Jews who had been living under the domination of the Egyptian and then Babylonian Empires before eventually being carried into exile from Jerusalem to Babylon. We can imagine what it would be like to live under the domination of one's enemies and then to be forced by those enemies to leave their homeland and settle in a foreign country.

### Literary context:

In the literary context, the false prophet Hananiah had told the people that God would break the yoke of Babylon, freeing the people to return home, within two years. While his message sounded appealing to the people, it was a lie and resulted in God removing Hananiah from the face of the Earth (Jeremiah 28:15-17). Instead, Jeremiah tells the people that they would live in Babylon for at least 70 years. Therefore, they should settle down, build houses, marry and even pray for the peace and prosperity of the city in which they had settled in (Jeremiah 29:4-10).

When we understand the context, we discover that the words of Jeremiah 29:11 were spoken to people in the midst of hardship and suffering; people who were likely desiring an immediate rescue like the one Hananiah lied about. But God's response is not to provide immediate escape from the difficult situation. Rather, God promises that He has a plan to prosper them in the midst of their current situation.

### Application of Jeremiah 29:11:

Christians facing difficult situations today can take comfort in Jeremiah 29:11 knowing January 2022

that it is not a promise to immediately rescue us from hardship or suffering, but rather a promise that God has a plan for our lives and regardless of our current situation, He can work through it to prosper us and give us a hope and a future.

This word applies not only in personal context but also in organization's context. God has a plan for every one of us as well as for the organisation. This plan of God to prosper and to give a hope and future is to realize the vision of FMPB to reach the Indians with the gospel of Jesus Christ.

When God's plan is not as per our expectation and in our timing, we have a tendency to set aside the plan of God and sometimes even try to implement our own plans. Whatever may be the timing and plan God has for us, His plan is better than every other plan.

### **God's plan succeeds:**

To achieve the plan of God, we need deep commitment, sacrifice, patience, perseverance and focussed life towards the God given vision. The plan of God sometimes seems irrational and illogical to our human minds. We need to keep our faith to implement the plan of God though the plan may not look logical. When the Israelites were asked by God to walk around the wall of Jericho, the plan looked illogical because no wall would fall by walking around. But in the end the plan of God succeeded.

### **A comparison of human plan and God's plan:**

Genesis 11 describes the human plan of building the tower of Babel in the plains of the land of Shinar and 12th Chapter presents God's plan of making a nation from Abraham. On analysing both plans, the human plan of building the tower seems superior because it had all ingredients for success. But the plan

of God depended on a childless old man of 75 years and on his obedience. Both human plan and God's plan can be analysed in four different areas in detail.

### **1 Purpose of the plans:**

Genesis 11:4 explains the purpose of the project of building the tower, had to make a name for themselves, lest they be scattered abroad over the face of the whole earth. They were very clear in their purpose and what to do to achieve the purpose. In God's plan the purpose is making Abraham a great nation. The history of Israel started from there. There was no flaw in the purpose of the human plan and all people were clear in the purpose and determined to do so.

### **2 Means to achieve the plans:**

The people who planned to build the tower in Genesis chapter 11 had the best technology of that time and had resources and means to achieve that. Genesis 11:3 says "Then they said to one another, "Come, let us make bricks and bake them thoroughly. They had brick for stone, and they had asphalt for mortar". The people knew to bake the bricks and had asphalt to use instead of mortar. Whereas in Genesis 12, God had a simple and very ordinary man to accomplish the purpose of building a great nation.

### **3 Level of commitment:**

Genesis 11:6 God himself certified the level of commitment of the people, "..... now nothing that they propose to do will be withheld from them". The people in Shinar were so motivated and enthusiastic that God said that nothing they propose to do will be withheld. The man God chose to accomplish His plan had partial commitment and ended up half way or obeyed partially twice. First of all when God called him to go to Canaan,

Abraham and his father settled in Haran for five long years until the death of Terah (Gen. 11.31). Again in Genesis 12.1, God called Abraham to go to Canaan leaving his father's house, he took Lot along with him.

#### **4 Source for the plans:**

Though the people in Shinar scored heavily on the first three areas namely, purpose, means and commitment; the important factor is the source for the plans, which made the plan in Genesis 11 to fail and Genesis 12 to be successful. It was human plan to build the tower of Babel and God's plan to bring Abraham to Canaan and start a new nation. Because of this factor of God as a source made the plan to be a success. Our plans may be well thought out one, but still they may fail. But when we accept God's plan and work for it, God will make His plan a long lasting one and a blessed one.

#### **When God's plans are not our plans:**

Proverbs 19:21 says "Many are the plans in a person's heart, but it is the Lord's purpose that prevails." The Bible directly tells us that no matter what our plans are, the Lord's plan is what will come to fruition. This verse exhorts us to commit to God's plan and do everything in order to accomplish it.


#### **What does it mean to commit your plans to the Lord?:**

"Commit" is a word that in Hebrew literally means "to roll." Genesis 29:3 and Psalms 22:8-9 use the idea of "rolling" something over to the Lord. The idea is completely giving something over to God while depending on Him. When we "commit" our works to the Lord and His plan, we are offering everything we do completely to Him.

As partakers of FMPB's vision to reach the nation with the Gospel, let us surrender our everything to accomplish God's plan of reaching India. Always remember God has a plan for you to prosper you and to give you hope and a future. God bless you and use you to the fulfilment of His vision through FMPB.

# Relentless Pursuit of Vision in the Midst of Challenges



The Opening chapters of Genesis portray the greater God as a God of plan and purpose. God's purposes and plans go beyond creation and touch every area of life. This is candid in all the dealings with humankind. Either the election of Israel or the plagues in Egypt. Either the healing of an invalid or the miracle of changing water into wine at Cana. **Every work of God has a purpose. Interestingly, God's purposes are interconnected i.e., His purpose for an individual may be connected to His purpose for a people. The rescue of a child from the Nile is connected with the liberation of His people from their long bondage in Egypt. The man who becomes blind on his way to Damascus is entrusted with the task of opening the eyes of multitudes in Asia Minor.**

The Lord who makes plans is keen to see them fulfilled as He has intended. Therefore, He reveals His plan to His people. The Lord called Moses and revealed His plan for the people who were going through unspeakable suffering in Egypt. When God's plan was unfolded to Moses, with all clarity and action-plan, it became the vision of Moses [Ex: 3 & 4]. God expected Moses to own His plan, obey and pursue it. **Vision always goes with challenges. To pursue the vision while facing the challenges may seem to be difficult and impossible. When the vision is clear, its pursuit becomes easy.**

## 1. Clarity in Vision

As we have seen in the call of Moses, it is God who gives vision. He wants us to see people and their problems through His eyes. He wants us to feel His feelings. He wants us to own the responsibility of bringing a change wherever He directs us. Thus, vision is not our desire or wish. Rather, God gives us the privilege of sharing His vision. **Vision is not a sudden idea that strikes in the mind of God, because of an emergency. Rather, it is rooted in His eternal plan.**

Austin Sparks writes, "God given vision has its roots outside of time and circumstances, eventualities, contingencies or emergencies." Therefore, God given vision has wider implications than our limited understanding of it. When we share the vision of God, we participate in the larger plan of God. When Paul was in Corinth, the Lord spoke to him in a vision encouraging him to continue to speak. Because God had a plan of saving many people in that city, He wanted Paul to continue his mission without fear. This revelation of many people in that city gave him a great motivation to lengthen his ministry there [Act 18:9-11].

Another aspect of vision is its concreteness. God-given vision is not shaky, because it is built on His good promise as we read in Jeremiah 29:10 -

*"When seventy years are completed for Babylon, I will visit you, and I will fulfill to you my promise and bring you back to this place."*

-This verse underlines the significance of time factor in God-given vision. It is ordained by God that the people of God should be in Babylon during this period [Jer. 29:4-7]. No prophecy would alter it. No human force could reduce the days of their captivity in Babylon. False prophets attempted to confuse and derail their hope [Jer. 29:8]. But, the people of Judah were expected to be steadfast in the vision of their 70 year long stay in Babylon.

The rapid change in socio-political and economical trends and unfavourable circumstances may create a strong pessimism in the pursuit of our vision. These challenges may continue to exist and cause delay in our progress. Yet, we need to continue the race without losing hope. As the athletes do, we may have to jump over the hurdles and endure the troubles and distresses.

The confident words of the Psalmist may be a good stimulus as we pursue our vision.

*"For by you I can run against a troop, and by my God I can leap over a wall"*

[Ps.18:29]. We tend to be disheartened when our regular activities are restricted or reduced and our forward movements seems to be blocked or delayed. God's plan does not change or fail. Eastman Curtis helps us to understand and accept the delay in our progress. He draws attention to the towers that control the movements of aeroplanes.

Sometimes, the towers at the airport put the planes in a 'holding pattern in the sky.' During this time, the planes keep flying in a circle until their landing is permitted. He recalls his own experience of being in a holding pattern for two hours once. His words of encouragement read as follows -

*"We feel like we are going in circles instead of moving forward in our destiny. Sometimes we may experience a delay or some sort of obstacle. It doesn't mean we have to give up."*

Time plays a vital role in God's plan. His plan may look simple, but His purposes are wrapped in it. Therefore, God's plan is a process. Moses was called to liberate the Israelites from Egypt. He met Pharaoh as directed and expected immediate deliverance of his people. But there was no sign of their deliverance. Moses was discouraged and upset. He said, "You have not delivered your people at all" [Ex. 5:23]. Moses conceived their deliverance as a simple happening. In God's mind their liberation was a process.

**God-given vision gets fulfilled in His own time. Therefore, we are called to hold on to our vision in spite of adversities and uncertain situations. Apart from clarity in vision, we need to have enthusiasm and energy to reach the point of fulfilment.**

## 2. Energetic Venture

Vision is not a shallow dream, but it drives us to venture. Venture cannot be a venture if it lacks courage, hope and energy. The vision that's cemented with enthusiasm and energy makes a great impact. That's why Paul gives a strong exhortation in Rom.12:11 to keep the spiritual fervour while serving the Lord. In another version,

it reads: Do not be slothful. The New Living Translation makes it more understandable. It reads: Never be lazy but work hard and serve the Lord enthusiastically. The Greek word used for 'fervency' literally means 'boiling in spirit.' It is the Spirit of God who sets us on fire. Therefore, **we cannot afford to become tepid as we pursue a high goal. Maybe, it's high time to examine our spiritual warmth. Mission cannot survive on mediocrity. The changing global environment challenges us to shed our mediocrity and rise above our average performance. We have to add passion and ardour to our missional activities through fervent prayers.**

With the quick availability of global news in the cell phone we are more interested in collecting information than spending time in intercession. Wesley L. Duewel writes, "The greatest work that you will ever do for God is to intercede in accordance with His will."

Intercession is a powerful tool to bring the Kingdom of God. That's why Duewel lays emphasis on enlarging our intercession with wider coverage. Connecting prayer with God's purposes, he writes,

"You can unite yourself more fully with the purpose and plan of God in prayer than you can by any other form of Christian service."

The fall of Jericho walls reminds us of the great energy that was required in the task. The Israelites were told to march once around the city seven days carrying the ark. But on the seventh day, they had to march around the city seven times. It means that they have to work hard on the last day using all their energy. Soon after the completion of the seventh round, the walls would collapse. The armed men would immediately rush in and plundered the city of Jericho.

There must be a willingness to work hard. John C. Maxwell calls it 'stretching ourselves.' He emphatically states that **we should be like a rubber band; it is not useful until it's stretched.** He warns that **we will be losers if we shrink blemish in the face of challenges.** When we stretch in the vision given by God there won't be any room for withdrawal. When Paul was heading for Jerusalem, there were prophecies about the danger ahead [Acts 21:3-5, 8-14]. But he never discontinued his journey. The secret of his energy to pursue God's will lies in his firm commitment i.e., that he was ready to die in the plan of God [Acts 20:24, 21:13]. Pursuit of God-given vision requires great energy in terms of passion, perseverance and willingness to suffer. In the mission of God, the needs go beyond the goal of individuals. It's the united effort that fulfils the larger vision.

### 3. United Endeavour

Someone said that 'united effort' can unleash great energy that makes a difference in creativity, productivity and efficiency.' We find a battle situation in 2 Samuel 10th chapter where the Ammonites rise against David. The Ammonites hire the Syrians and others. Joab and his brother Abishai are supposed to lead their Israelites in the war. It's interesting to read what Joab tells his brothers on the battlefield.

*"If the Syrians are too strong for me, then you shall help me, but if the Ammonites are too strong for you, then I will come and help you."* [2Sam.10:11]

What a classic example of being united in the battlefield! If we have a common goal, we have to work together.

In Numbers 32, we find the Reubenites and Gadites placing a request before Moses not

to make them cross the river Jordan. As they had very large herds and flocks and found the land of Jazer and Gilead suitable for livestock they wanted to possess it and live there. Moses was not happy about their request because they were selfish and had lost sight of the common goal of the conquest of Canaan. After hearing the harsh reply of Moses, they expressed their readiness to join their fellow Israelites in battle leaving back their wives and children. We can draw some lessons and guidelines from this episode for our mission practice today.

1. Selfishness is a hindrance to a joint venture.
2. We must be concerned about co-believers and co-workers.
3. If it is a common goal, we have a collective responsibility.
4. We have to make a vow to fight the battle to the end [Num.32:18].
5. We should not expect any personal advantage or benefit [Num.32:19].

When we fail to join our brothers, in battle they may withdraw from the battlefield due to discouragement. Eventually it may impede the progress of God's plan for us too [Num.32:6-15].

We are engaged in a vision-driven venture. The increasing challenges around us may discourage us and force us to withdraw from the task. If we stand together helping each other we will certainly move forward towards victory. A clear understanding of vision, passion, spiritual fervour and willingness to stretch ourselves to the need will help us to fulfil the vision of God.



## Rev. Dr. Prof. JTK. Daniel, An Ideologue for Church-Mission Relationships! (28.12.1938 - 04.12.2021)

Rev. Dr. Prof. JTK. Daniel was an educationist, missiologist, mentor and one of the great architects of FMPB. He played a vital role in the development right from her inception. Being the son of the CSI Pastor and ordained minister of the Church of South India, he had a heart for missions that led him to create inroads to bring about healthy relationships between Church & Missions. He had written and edited a number of books. His prolific writings and conversations with theological insights, charismatic leadership during the last five decades inspired with wit and humour will forever be etched in our memories.

Dr. Daniel was born on 28th December 1938 in Nazareth, Tuticorin District, Tamil

Nadu as the third child among the two elder sisters, one younger sister and two younger brothers. He accepted Jesus Christ as his personal Lord and Saviour in a meeting, where Mr. P. Samuel was the speaker. He led his siblings to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ. As a result, his brother Arputharaj, being a teacher and preacher, and was involved in the Church and Youth ministry and Julius, being an officer in IRS, was involved in the ministry of UESI and later became its President.

Dr. Daniel actively participated in St. John's College, Palayamkottai 'Reunion Fellowship' along with Mr. Sam Dhanaseelan, Mr. M Patrick Joshua and many others who later became the stalwarts of Missions. He studied theology at Knox College, Dunedin, New Zealand and had earned a doctorate in Philosophy from the University of Madras. Dr. Daniel was a Mathematician and served as Professor in Voorhees College, Vellore and Pope's College, Sawyerpuram.

Dr. Daniel served as a Chaplain and Professor in Madras Christian College from 1965-'90. He initiated and encouraged the Madras Christian College to introduce a Department for Christian Studies. Furthermore, he became the Principal of Serampore College from 1990-'98 and rejuvenated her ministry. He retrieved and restored some of the old

historical documents of William Carey from getting destroyed.

Dr. Daniel had written the “**Manual for Missionaries**” of FMPB and served as the honorary General Secretary in 1966. He became the editor of Araikooval magazine. He was a long-term member of the Executive Committee and served as the Chairman of Higher Studies Committee. He loved the missionaries and always kept his home open for them. He was affectionately called as ‘JTK Annan’ by all.

Dr. Daniel’s role in the Church Mission relation was remarkable. He paved the way for organising meetings between Mission leaders and the Church leaders in order to reach our nation with the Gospel of Christ. He was the ideologue of FMPB for Church Mission relationship policies which helped to promote the work among the mainline Churches in a cordial manner. He played a major role in the Church Integration process of FMPB with the CNI Gujarat Diocese. He encouraged the missionaries and leaders to undergo theological studies to enhance the ministry. He regularly taught in the National Institute of Missions and Bethel Bible Institute, emphasising the importance of training. He nurtured and groomed missionaries to write study materials for believers and lay leaders keeping in mind the cultural and missiological context in which the Churches are planted.

Dr. Daniel played a pivotal role in raising and mentoring the missionaries. His contribution in the mobilisation ministry was invaluable. Annan became a prominent speaker in most of the mission mobilisation meetings. He emphasised the need of forming new prayer

groups to raise leaders and to train them. He introduced ‘Communion Service’ during the Tamil Nadu State Conference.

Dr. Daniel was blessed with a wonderful family, and his wife Mrs. Beulah Daniel stood by him through all the ups and downs. They were blessed with a son and a daughter and both of them are married and blessed with children. Their son, Dr. Sundar Daniel, is working as a Professor in IIT, Roorke. His daughter Mrs. Sheela Lionel is a teacher in Singapore for Technical students. With regard to family and ministry, Dr. Daniel was very conscious not to jeopardise his family over the ministry and gave utmost importance to it as in the words of Saint Paul, “If a man does not know how to manage his own household, how can he care for God’s Church?” (I Tim 3:5).

Dr. Daniel always welcomed his colleagues and faculties of MCC for Bible study and fellowship until his old age. However, he prayed and encouraged people through the phone to all who sought his counsel and exhortations.

He went to be with the Lord on 4th December 2021. On the following day, the funeral service was conducted in the CSI St. Mark’s Church, Chennai and he was buried in Madambakkam Cemetery.

We thank and praise God for his exemplary life. May God bless all those who are inspired by the life of Dr. Daniel and let’s all try to emulate the good model he set forth.

Bara Village is located in Akbarpur Tehsil of Kanpur Dehat district in the state of Uttar Pradesh in India. Total geographical area of Bara village is 21 kms and it is the biggest village by area in the sub-district. ### Beginning of our Ministry:

In January 2004, Mr. Paul Hudson preached the Gospel in Bara village where many received the Gospel with joy. Mr. Ram Babu was one among them. their faith. Here are two incidents, narrated in the prayer report of Rania mission field dated April 2004 and May 2004 respectively.

- At Bara village, Kusma placed her hand on a snake by mistake. Immediately she called on Jesus Name. Soon the snake went away without harming her.
- At Bara village, Saraswathi was unable to walk for 3 years. She had a lot of pain in her leg. After prayer, the pain in her leg reduced and gradually she began to walk."

People from the neighbouring villages like Igra and Miserpur also responded to the Gospel as a result of outreach ministry. Mr. Rampher of Igra village narrates his testimony



*"In 2004, missionary Mr. Paul Hudson and Mr. Maniram of Miserpur village came to our village (Igra) and preached the Gospel. He also gave some tracts to us. He told us to come to the worship on Sunday at Rania. In the worship, there was a woman tormented by evil spirit. Prayers were offered for her and she got well. Seeing the miracle her whole family joined the Church after a month."*

He is the present Church elder of Barajode Church.

### **CHURCH GROWTH:**

Through outreach ministry many more surrounding villages like Ninaya, Niranjanpur, Nabipur, Naahi, Kurari and Kuit Mandir were reached with the Gospel. Our Mighty God did lots of miracles in the lives of the people, some of them are given below which were taken from the Rania prayer report

- Dec 2004 - A young man named Ramesh Pal of Ninaya village became mad. He was taken to magicians but he did not get well. Through the believers of their village, they heard about the Church and came for worship. Within 2 weeks he became perfectly normal. His wife had left him within one day of marriage. She too returned to live with him. Ramesh has started to tell about Jesus to the people of his own caste.

- May 2009 - Neelam was healed from fever and body pain which created an open door at Naahi village.

- Nov 2010 – Kesarani from Niranjanpur was suffering from the torment of the evil spirit. She was very lean - just skin and bones. She came to the worship for prayer. God heard the prayers and delivered her from the evil spirit.

- Mar 2015 – Ranu Devi of Kurari village was delivered from demon possession. In fact at her daughter's wedding in July 2016, she even printed Bible verses in the invitation card.

### **Worship details:**

In 2004, worship was started in a rented room at Rania. In 2010, the worship at Rania was shifted to Jainpur. In Jan 2012, the worship at Jainpur was shifted to the temporary room constructed at the purchased Church land. In Oct 2013, after the Church was dedicated, the worship continued at the Barajode Church.

The Barajode congregation members are from the following villages: Kurari, Jindaura, Naahi, Tilaunchi, Bara, Ninaya, Niranjanpur, Nabipur, Indruk, Kuitmandir and Kripalpur. All of them are from Chamar, Pal, Kushwaha, Kateria, Yadav, Diwakar and Paswan communities.

The Barajode Church land was purchased in 2010. The size of the land is 7 biswa (1 biswa = 1350 square feet). The total cost of the land is Rs. 2,80,000/-

### **Church Construction:**

The Barajode Church foundation work was started in August 2010 but due to opposition the work was interrupted. According to Zac 4:6, by God's power, on 21.8.2012 the foundation work of the Church started again. By God's grace, government officials helped to overcome the opposition and to build the

Church. It is a Pucca Church and was named as St. John's Church. There was opposition during the time of construction from the anti-Christian forces. They beat the Rania missionary, Mr. Clement Packiaraj. Even the neighbouring landlords opposed the Church construction. The Church Size is 40X25 ft.

On 20.10.2013, the Church was dedicated. The Field Secretary (N), Rev. Franklin M Y Patham, Northern Zonal Secretary, Rev. Rajadurai, Kanpur Regional Secretary, Rev. S. Ponnusamy and the sponsor, Mr. Lazar participated in the dedication service.

## Miracles and Important Events:

- Ashmith from Niranjanpur is a small boy. When he was 5 years old, he accidentally fell down on a nail and it cut the nerve of the left eye. Many medical treatments were given but his left eye did not receive eyesight. When he came to the worship, the missionary shut his right eye and showed his fingers but he was unable to see. So the missionaries and the believers earnestly prayed for him. On 26.1.2011 i.e., the missionary prayed for him and shut his right eye and showed his fingers. The boy saw through his left eye and answered correctly. God had restored his eyesight through prayers. Praise God.



- Mr. Ganga Prasad of Nabipur village had 3 sons. Two of his sons wanted to grab all their father's property and so they did witchcraft

against their father's household. So Mr & Mrs. Ganga Prasad, one of his sons, Dilip and daughter Priyanka became mad. Priyanka was the most affected one. Lots of money was spent in vain for black magic and other treatments. One day she got a book called, "Yeshu kahani" and she read it. Suddenly she tore the book into pieces. The next day she took the left out pieces of the book and she started reading it again. She put her faith in the Lord and she started going to the Church along with the believers of her village and was delivered from the evil spirit. She accepted Christ and through her, her whole family accepted Christ and got deliverance. Her brother, Dilip's wife, Rajini had left him because of his mental illness. As per the missionary's advice, he talked with Rajini's family. She saw the changes in him and she was reunited with him after 2 years of separation. She too accepted Christ.

## Church Activities:

The missionaries who served in the Barajore congregation are Paul Hudson, Edward Rajadurai, Clement Bakiaraj and Ebenezer G. Sam along with their families.

Through the outreach ministry of the believers 20 people have accepted Jesus Christ and few small groups have been established. 50 to 60 people attend the Sunday service every week. In the Sunday service, each session is shared between the Church elder, local evangelist and the missionary. The total strength of the Barajode Church is 237. Since it is the only Church in Rania mission field, believers from many other villages also come for worship.

We praise God for the Barajore Church and we continuously pray for the growth of this Church.


