

Our God is a God of systems, predictability and order, and God honours planning. The plan of "God the Father" was given to "God the Son" for the purpose of executing that plan = the responsibility of God the Holy Spirit who teaches us and reveals to us. Yes, the Father plans, the Son executes and the Holy Spirit reveals it to us. In all planning, God has a part and we have a part. Planning with the help of the Holy Spirit and Jesus Christ we need to execute this plan. When God is executing His plan in our lives and ministry, He also designs and arranges events which continue to unfold until His purpose is revealed.

Many of God's plans are detailed throughout the Bible. He has plans for nations, for people groups, and for individuals. We know that God's plan for those who know Him includes reaching others with the Good News of salvation (Mat. 28:19; 2 Cor. 5:20). Beyond salvation, God also knows the gifts, talents and skills He gave us, and He knows how we could best use them to make an eternal impact. God's plan unfolds in our lives as we use all we have for His glory (1 Cor. 10:31).

The Apostle Paul's plans serve as a model for our plans. The spiritual children of Paul were inspired by and consistent with God's plan for Paul and for his ministry, as well as for the world (Acts 9:15-16; Rom. 1:1-15). Because God's plan included the salvation of all nations, Paul moved towards those places which were unevangelized (Rom. 15:18-21). He drew tentative conclusions concerning God's plan for his life, and then set himself to carrying out God's purpose (Phil. 1:19-26; 2:19-24). Paul's plans were often modified by divine intervention. Paul and others were alert to God's leading (Acts 13:1-4; 16:4-10; Rom. 15:22). Sometimes human and/or satanic opposition played a part in the changes in Paul's plans, but all of this was in the providence of God with determination (1 Thes. 2:14-18).

Our plans should also be governed and guided by what we know of God's overall plan for His creation. Especially, in this Covid'19 pandemic situation, our plans should be executed with determination and intensity along with flexibility, knowing that God often accomplishes His will in ways which we would never have imagined and for which we would never have planned. All of our plans must be subordinate to God's plan and must take into account God's rearranging of our plans.

Planning and execution are critical due to the present inconsistent situations. At this juncture, planning for our ministry needs to be given more attention with determination and intensity. "Good planning and hard work lead to prosperity, but hasty shortcuts lead to poverty" [Prov.21:5]. God's Plan is centred more and more for eternal cost and to be understood and experienced in tangible ways that demonstrate more of God's will done on earth as it is in heaven. Let God's Plan lead us way amidst so many challenges while we execute it in our ministry today!

FROM THE GENERAL SECRETARY...

Dear Partners in pursuing higher plans,

Our theme word for this year is 'Pursuing Higher Plans' which reminds us that we have to pursue God's higher plans rather than running behind man made plans which have no long-lasting impact in our lives as well as of others. Colossians 3rd Chapter verses 1 to 3 says, 'Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things. For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God.'

These verses exhort God's children to set their hearts on things above and explain further the whereabouts of the 'above' by saying where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. It detailed further that we have to set our minds on things related to God and His mission, not on things on the earth. How much this is needed in the lives of today's Christians, who are running behind the things related to this world. For them, God is only for this earthly life, not remembering about eternity and things related to that. The vast majority of Christians are pursuing things of the earth rather than pursuing God's higher plans. The Bible also gives two reasons for setting our hearts on things above, that is vs.1 says since



you have been raised with Christ vs. 3 says for you died and your life is hidden with Christ in God. Setting our hearts on things above and pursuing God's higher plan is the parameter to know whether we have been raised with Christ and died to this world.

Christmas Programs:

Few thousand young believers of our mission fields celebrated their first Christmas this year. Though there were many threats and opposition, the God of heaven helped our missionaries and believers to celebrate the first advent in spirit and truth. In some places permission to conduct Christmas programs in the open were denied at the last moment, but God's grace was sufficient that all the believers have celebrated Christmas.

I preached in a few Churches in Kanyakumari during the Christmas week. I thank all the pastors and mobilization secretaries who organized the programs in the Churches. The autobiography of Ms. Mary Stella our retired missionary of Gujarat was released on 26th December, 2021 at Nagercoil. I praise God for the life

and ministry of Ms. Mary Stella who impacted more than one generation of believers and non-believers alike in Dangs district of Gujarat.

Home call of Mr. Hemachandran:

The man with contagious laughter had his last laugh on 5th January 2022. Mr. Hemachandran, the retired missionary of FMPB is the author of many firsts in FMPB. He was the first prayer group leader of the first sponsoring group in BHEL Trichy. He initiated the FMPB mobilization ministry in Andhra and Northeast India. Even after his retirement from FMPB for more than 2 decades before, he is still freshly remembered by many missionaries. His life will be remembered with his contagious laughing, and his legacy will be followed for a long time to come.

Meetings with other organizations:

I met the leaders of Friends Medical Mission International, Scripture Union, MUT training and BBI board. The meetings were blessed by the Lord for His kingdom expansion.

New missionaries recruited:

The Interview Committee of FMPB met on 8th January 2022 and God helped us to select 6 Brothers and Sisters who have committed their lives to do full time ministry in FMPB. All the six missionary recruits will go for field exposure in a few days. Kindly pray for their formation time

in the mission fields will be a time of learning and understanding the ministry.

Corona third wave:

The third wave of the corona is surging, though it is not as severe as the second wave, it is spreading very quickly and infects a large number of people. Many of our missionaries and their families were affected by the third wave, but almost all of them came out of it without any harm. Please do not lower your guard against Corona, but strengthen the fight against Corona through prayers and following the protocols.

National Planning Conference:

God willing, we may have the National Planning Conference 2022 on 12th and 13th of February 2022. We are making all arrangements to conduct the conference, but the final decision will be taken based on the guidance of the government at that time. Following the NPC, there will be meetings of the Executive Committee and Ministry Council in the next week. Kindly pray for the above meetings.

Planning with Kingdom Perspective

It is a worthy saying that “Failing to Plan is planning to fail.” Planning is very important part of the Christian life and very much essential for an organization. A ‘Plan’ is a vision and it is the process of seeking God’s will and clear ways to fulfil it. Strategic planning is not just a biblical concept alone, but a biblical mandate too. It is the chosen method of working to establish the Great Commission [Mt.28:18-20].

FMPB has always been goal oriented and has given priority for planning even from its inception. Our pioneers are architects and planners. Even in the 1980's, we had strategic plans such as – reaching 220 districts of 11 states, with 440 missionaries, within 10 years. It seemed to be a gigantic ambition of 400% growth from the actual status of the organization. But God honoured the plan and helped us to accomplish it. Following this, God gave us so many plans to take the Gospel to every nook and corner of our nation. As the Scripture promises, “Ask me, and I will make the nations your inheritance, the ends of the earth your possession” [Ps.2:8] we need to look to God and His scripture to motivate, encourage and guide us in this venture.

Our God is the Ultimate Long Range Planner:

God has given us proverbs (16:1-4) and examples through many biblical heroes like

Moses, Joshua, Nehemiah, David, Paul & Others. A foundational scripture on planning says, “Where there is no vision, the people perish (Proverbs 29:18).” Planning without God in the picture turns futile. **Goals that are within the will of God and that are designed for the glory of God are pleasing to Him.** Strategic planning clears the uncertainty and helps missions to make decisions based on the Gospel (Prov. 16:19).

Biblical Basis for Strategic Planning:

God’s ability to foresee the future is demonstrated in Genesis 3:15. After the sin of Adam and Eve, God looked far into the years ahead as He spoke to the serpent and told, “I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; he will crush your head, and you will strike his heel.” Satan would strike Christ’s heel, referring to the painful death of Christ on the Cross, but that was not the end of the story. Christ would crush the head of the serpent. While Satan would appear to have won when Jesus died on the cross, Satan would be the ultimate loser in this great spiritual battle. God’s purposes encompass the whole range from eternity to eternity and extend to every part of His dominion. From a short-range perspective, things may appear to be out of control, but God orders all things in such a way that they will reach a glorious consummation.

We can point to Jesus as the greatest example of one who planned strategically. He began by recruiting disciples, developing them into leaders, then sending them “to the ends of the earth” (Acts 1:8). His strategy included some public teaching and miracle working. Ultimately, His strategy took Him all the way to the cross, the grave, and the resurrection. Jesus Christ knew the plan, to provide redemption for mankind long before leaving heaven to carry it through.

Strategic Planning in Scripture:

The Scripture is filled with examples of leaders who established strategic plans and carried them through.

Moses: We see clearly in Scripture that Moses was a strategic thinker. Moses was struggling as a leader soon after he led the nation of Israel out of Egypt. His father-in-law, Jethro, came to see him after hearing the incredible things God had been doing. Jethro observed that Moses was overloaded with the burdens of leadership and he shared with him a God-given plan-a strategy-for dealing with the issue. He taught Moses how to set up a strategic plan by delegating the work so that the load would be distributed among many. As a result, the manpower resources were used more effectively and the ministry was accomplished. Moses was also thinking strategically when he sent spies to the land of Canaan.

Joshua: Joshua, the protégé of Moses, also demonstrated strategic leadership. In Joshua 6, God gave Joshua a little lesson on strategic thinking. As Joshua was to lead the Israelites into the Promised land, they were facing the first enemy in the land, the strong city of Jericho. God gave Joshua a strategy. He could have simply reached down from Heaven and zapped the city, but God chose to work through a strategy that involved His people.

Nehemiah: Nehemiah was a God appointed leader who used strategy. When God laid it on his heart to rebuild the walls of Jerusalem, Nehemiah began to establish and then work through a well-planned strategy to accomplish the vision which God had given. He assessed the damage. He secured the resources. He established leaders and distributed the assignments among them. Here we see Nehemiah's well drawn-out plan for the reconstruction of the walls.


David: David was a strategic thinker from boyhood. He did not defeat Goliath with his might or strong armor. He defeated Goliath using a God-given strategy that pinpointed the weak-spot of his enemy. Later, as a leader of soldiers, David needed men who could think and plan strategically, and God gave him the men of Issachar (1Chron.12:32).

Paul: The Apostle Paul, a key player in establishing the early Churches, had a strategy. It is obvious in reading the accounts of his missionary journeys that Paul chose key cities in which to establish as heads men for ministry. He chose cities where he might have the greatest influence on the largest number of people.

‘Proverbs’ Speaks:

The book of Proverbs has a number of clear practical principles regarding strategy and planning.

1. Proverbs 15:22 - Plan fails for lack of counsel, but with many advisers they succeed.
2. Proverbs 16:3 - Commit to the Lord whatever you do, and your plans will succeed.
3. Proverbs 16:9 - In his heart a man plans his course, but the Lord determines his steps.

4. Proverbs 20:18 - Make plans by seeking advice; if you wage war, obtain guidance.

The Role of Holy Spirit in Our Planning and Goals:

1. Seek First the Kingdom of God:

Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously and he will give you everything you need. [Matthew 6:33]. So what does this mean when we are in a planning process?

First of all, acknowledge the sovereignty of God. As we plan, we agree that God is Lord over everything we're talking about, and that our planning effort is really just a way of discovering His will.

Secondly, seeking first the kingdom of God means that we surrender our own agendas, to God and to each other we say: I would really like to see this happen, but I'm giving this over to God. Of course it might well be that this comes under God's plans. But we won't know whether or not this is true if we force our own agenda into a planning process.

Thirdly, seeking first the kingdom of God comes from a passion for God and His glory. As human beings, we are easily prone to seek our glory, or that of the institution we serve. But as we grow in our faith, we desire God's glory more and more. Thus we seek His kingdom, not only so that His will might be done, but also that He might be lauded as King of Kings and Lord of Lords.

So, when we gather together for planning, we need to surrender our agendas and ambitions, and seek God's kingdom. This commitment, perhaps as much as anything else, will help us discover God's plans for the future.

2. Listen for the “Bass Note” of Scripture:

The “bass notes” of Scripture must echo throughout the process if it is to be guided by the Holy Spirit. For Example, One of the deepest and loudest bass notes of the Bible is the mission of God to redeem his creation, including humanity. The strategic planning of a Christian organization, therefore, must have a missional ring to it. Therefore, participants in a planning process must look at their work from a Biblical perspective. They should let the Scripture fill their hearts and minds as they plan. In the end, they should be able to show how their goals are consistent with Biblical values and priorities.

3. Respect the Ways God has Led in the Past:

It is a fact that ‘Planning,’ by definition, is a future-directed enterprise. But ‘Planning’ that makes room for the Spirit will take seriously what God has said and done in the past. We need to acknowledge or respect the ways that God had led our pioneers in the past.

4. Recognize that God's New Wine Requires New Wineskins:

Most of us lean either toward hanging on to the old wineskins or rushing forward too quickly to the new. Perhaps it's more accurate to say that we want the old in some ways (where we are comfortable) and the new in some other ways (where we want change). It is hard to live between respecting the old and openness to the new, but there is no way for Christian leaders to avoid this tension. It is an essential aspect of our leadership. It is risky to be open to change. It can make one feel scary and uncertain. But it's also risky for an organization to resist change.

Different Christian traditions tend to emphasize different ways that the Spirit

guides us. This is fine, though sometimes people emphasize their own modes. For the first and foremost, strategic planning involves our thinking. But, as we reason individually and together, we should also be open to the move of the Holy Spirit.

5. Be open to the Supernatural Gifts of the Spirit:

Scripture teaches us that the Spirit of God dwells in each believer and also in the midst of God's people as they gather. Though we usually associate the gifts of the Spirit with gatherings for worship and or ministry, we mustn't limit the Spirit's power to these settings alone. The Holy Spirit is surely able and willing to gift God's people in the midst of strategic planning processes, since wisdom, knowledge, prophecy and teaching are also spiritual gifts, they can provide special insight to guide us to make right choices. They will give specific, supernatural help in a planning process if we are open and available.

6. Recognize Each Person's Participation:

Practically speaking, the communal contest for the Spirit's guidance means that if a planning process is going to be successful in the effort to clarify God's will, then each person who involves needs to be willing to participate, both in giving and receiving. Then the community discerns what is authentically from the Spirit. Ideally, each individual will own the possibility of being a channel of the Spirit's guidance. And, each individual will be open to hear and discern what the Spirit says through others. When Christians gather in unity, seeking most of all to build up the body of Christ above everything else, then the planning process can be an effective vehicle of the Spirit's guidance.

7. Pay Close Attention to the Basics:

If we're to be attentive to the Holy Spirit in our planning, we must pay close attention to the basics. Paying close attention to the basics means listening carefully, both to what the Spirit is "saying" to us, and to what the Spirit is saying through others. We must listen, not only to the words, but to what lies beneath them. They are the mustard seeds of a plan, the portholes into God's future. Here we might very well find God's will in mustard seed form.

God obviously expects us to plan. He has given us a number of clear principles along with some great examples. He makes it clear that we are not to trust our own plans and strategies and ignore the guidance of the Holy Spirit. It is only after we seek the heart of God and His direction that we can establish plans that are pleasing to Him and plans that will succeed. We live in a world that is real and we must take it into account the Kingdom Values that introduces another reality that is greater than the world we see. Our Strategic Plan, sometimes seems to be a big challenge of growing to the level from the actual current status of the organization. But we must approach our work in this world with the 'Kingdom perspective,' such as Elisha's servant experienced when Elisha said to him: "Do not fear, for those who are with us are more than those who are with them." Then Elisha prayed and said, "Lord, I pray to open his eyes that he may see." And the Lord opened the servant's eyes and he saw; and behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha. [2 Kings 6:16-17]. We pray to God to open our eyes to have the 'Kingdom Perspective' in order to accomplish great things for Him through our Planning Conference.

Bro. P. Hemachandran

A Zealous Leader with National Perspective!

(06.12.1935 - 05.01.2022)

Bro. P. Hemachandran [Age 86], the former Associate General Secretary of Friends Missionary Prayer Band, who served in FMPB from 1980 to 2000, received his home call on 5th January 2022 at his residence, Trichy, Tamil Nadu.

Bro. Hemachandran hailed from a Brahmin family, Andhra Pradesh and his grandfather accepted Jesus Christ. His father was a lawyer and his father's involvement in outreach ministry made an impact in his life in many ways. He studied Intermediate in Madras Christian College and B.Sc Chemistry in Nellore. He was employed in Neyveli Lignite Corporation when he was 26 years old. He accepted Jesus Christ as his personal Lord and Saviour in a spiritual meeting, Trichy.



On 4th January 1960, he got married to Ms. Lalitha and God blessed them with two sons - Dr. Paul Gunachander [Medical Doctor by profession] and Mr. George Stephen are leading a witnessing life along with the family members for the glory of God. Then Mr. Hemachandran got employment in the BHEL, settled in Trichy. During this period he came to know about the ministry of FMPB and he became a staunch supporter and prayer warrior of FMPB. He became the Hon. District Leader of FMPB and mobilized new members and leaders. He attended FMPB meeting at Murungapatti, Trichy where he committed himself for the full time ministry. Obeying to God's call he resigned from his Deputy Manager post in BHEL and joined FMPB on 1st August 1980. He was given the responsibility of promoting the mission in Andhra Pradesh where he started the FMPB office in a car shed, belonging to Mr. Sam Purushotham. Someone gave him an old lambretta scooter and he within a short period made many prayer groups and impacted the lives of people. Whenever he visited places like Machilipatnam and Guntur the local leaders would rent a cycle and he visited hundreds of people by cycling hundreds of kilometres. Even for small amounts of donations and subscriptions he would go, collect and pray for the members. He was never embarrassed by any situation.

He was the pioneer mobilization Secretary for North and North East India. He was the pioneer to bring the magazine in Telugu and promotional material like Audio and video CDs in Telugu and other languages. Due to his frequent visits to the Churches in North and North East India, many prayer groups were established and many Churches from North and North East India supported our ministry. He played a vital role in giving national identity to our organization. Moreover, he initiated the ministry of extending the missionary vision among the NRIs who live across the world.

Then Mr. Hemachandran became the Secretary for the FMPB - HQ administration and later he was elevated to be the Associate General Secretary of FMPB. He was one of the key persons in implementing the planning conference in FMPB, which was proposed by Rev. Dr. Samuel Kamalesan. He was the key person for the formation of the Navodaya Team.

In December 2000 he was retired from FMPB and settled in Trichy. He was a good preacher, writer and zealous for missionary work. He translated many songs of FMPB into English and Telugu. Some of these

songs have become very popular in the Telugu Churches.

In fact, he was a regular writer of articles and messages in FMPB magazine. He did what he could do for the extension of God's Kingdom. He used to crack lots of jokes and stayed calm with an ever smiling demeanour. He was at ease both with the rich and poor Christians. He mingled with all kinds of people irrespective of their status. He was a man with cool temperament, always cheerful, never discouraged or hurts by any situation. He was highly intelligent, deeply rooted in the Word of God. He never spoke a word which was not edifying, encouraging. He is the man who is loved by all of his colleagues and affectionately called as 'Hema Annan.'

Mr. Hemachandran received his Home Call from the Lord on 5th January 2022 and was buried with the hope of resurrection in All Saints' Cemetery, Woraiyur, Trichy. We praise God for the beautiful life of Mr. Hemachandran and thank God for his wonderful well-lived life. Let us uphold his beloved wife Mrs. Lalitha Hemachandran and his sons' families in our prayers.

Missionary Biography



Rev. Gurubatham Ponraj (1956 - 2009)

Rev Gurubatham Ponraj who hailed from the Pearl City Tuticorin was born in a Christian family of Mr. Moses and Mrs. Daisy who were committed Christians on 1st December 1956. Gurubatham was blessed with one elder brother Mr. Santhosh Raj, one young brother Selwyn Jebaraj and a younger sister Miss. Mary Pon Rajathi. Mrs and Mr. Moses paid much attention to educate their children and also to rear them in a God fearing way. This family was noted for their Church attendance and Church activities. Gurubatham excelled in his studies. His brilliance was always noted and appreciated by the teachers. God gave him admission in the local college and he finished his Bachelor degree.

Salvation Experience:

In 1972, while in college, he had an opportunity to attend a Youth meeting

where he accepted Christ as his personal Saviour at the age of 16, he aspired to become a teacher like his mother, so after finishing his B.Sc degree, he joined the B.Ed course and completed it successfully. He was involved in the ministry of Evangelical Union among the students. He grew in the Lord with this fellowship through Bible study. Later, he took over the leadership of conducting the Bible study for other students of his college. Through his witness he led many students to Christ.

Call to the Mission:

Prof. Ivan Balasingh, Mr. Gurubatham Ponraj's mentor, helped him to reach the other students with the Gospel of Christ. In 1977 Gurubatham attended a Camp conducted by the Evangelical Union in which the spiritual need of the nation was shared in detail. Some missionaries from North India also shared about their ministry. The Spirit of God moved in the heart of Gurubatham, in such a way that he ultimately surrendered his life for missionary work. God also confirmed His calling through the Word of God and the counsel of the believers.

Gurubatham had a plan to become a teacher to relieve his family's financial constraints. But God had a different plan for Mr. Gurubatham. He was in a dilemma in making the right decision. God in the course of time ministered to his heart and prepared him for His ministry. His parents and family members were not willing to spare him for God's work. They encouraged him to do the ministry side by side along with his teaching job. His mentor and praying friends guided him to give priority to God's calling and encouraged him to

obey God and prepare himself for the ministry through a theological training.

Mr. Gurubatham Ponraj joined the Bethel Bible Institute and finished a one year course. At that time he met Dr. Samuel Devadason, who encouraged him to do the B.D course in a Theological college and came forward to sponsor his studies. So, Mr. Gurubatham joined the Union Biblical Seminary at Yavatmal. Apart from his sponsors' help, he took up a part time job in the college to meet all his financial needs. He was very clear in his calling and vision to be a missionary and not a Pastor. So, he searched for a mission agency to join as a missionary and applied to FMPB. He joined FMPB on 17th May 1982.

Married Life:

Friends Missionary Prayer Band sent him to the state of Gujarat. He learned Gujarati and continued his ministry till 1986. He married Ms. Vijayamalar who was also a missionary with FMPB. God blessed their married life and blessed them with a lovely boy child whom they christened as Sam Johnny.

Church Planting Ministry:

They continued their ministry in Gujarat. In 1990 Gurubatham was given the responsibility of Regional Secretary. Based in Pipalvada he continued the Church Planting ministry among the Kukna tribe. In 1992 considering the need of the organization, they were transferred to Odisha state as Regional Secretary of that region, based at Rourkela, Odisha. From 1997 onwards he was asked to take up the responsibility of Western Zonal ministry. Then, he was sent to USA for his higher

studies. He finished his M.Th., and on his return to India he was asked to assist the then Field Director based at Nagpur. In the year 2000, he was transferred to Western Zone to lead the ministries spread across Gujarat and Maharashtra.. At the completion of seven years in Zonal level ministry he was promoted as the Field Director of FMPB.

Last Days:

In 2009 he was conducting a Training for all the Regional Secretaries at Nagpur Field office campus. On 18th September, he went to purchase some necessary things for the training programme. While trying to cross the road, a drunken driver dashed against him. This happened around 8 pm., and immediately he was rushed to the Nagpur hospital. The inner parts of his body were highly damaged by the impact of the car accident. There was no improvement in his health. So, FMPB leaders decided to bring him to CMC, Vellore. He was airlifted from Mumbai to Chennai and in an ambulance he was taken to CMC, Vellore. He was admitted in CMC on 24th September with multiple fractures in his hip and right hand. His urinary bladder was damaged. He was given the best treatment in the CMC, Vellore. On 25th September around 6 pm he had breathing difficulty. Within few minutes he went to be with the Lord leaving his family and all missionaries, in grief. Rev. Gurubatham did his best with his leadership ability and was truly a role model. May the Lord our God continue to comfort his wife Mrs. Vijayamalar who is in the Head Quarters and son Sam Johny who is in USA.

Song - Nearer My God to Thee

Nineteenth century hymnody was characterized by an extraordinary number of women hymn-writers. It is significant that this development came with the great spiritual revivals which aroused Britain and America during the 18th and 19th century. Such women as Charlotte Elliott, Sarah Adams, Cecil Alexander and Frances Havergal in England and Mary Lathbury, Anna Warner, Catherine Esling, Harriet Beecher Stowe, Phoebe Gary, Elizabeth Prentiss and Fanny Crosby in America have contributed some of the most precious gems to the treasure-core of Christian hymns. Indeed, the hymnody of the Church would have been immeasurably poorer had these

consecrated women not been given to us by God with their heaven-bestowed talent.

Sarah Flower Adams was born on February 22, 1805. When she was only five, her mother died. Consequently, she looked to her sister Eliza, two years older, for comfort and encouragement. The two remained best friends for life. Their father, Benjamin Flower, was a radical journalist who, as a young man, had been jailed for his writing. When he died in 1825, the sisters moved into the household of their pastor William Johnson Fox. All this made her draw "Nearer to God." Sometimes God has a way of allowing us to enter into circumstances that ought to make us want to draw nearer to Him.

Adams worked closely with her sister at this time to produce a number of hymns that were used for William Johnson Fox's Collection of Hymns and Verses. In 1841, deeply inspired by the story in Genesis of Jacob's vision at Bethel of the ladder to heaven with angels ascending and descending thereon, she wrote her hymn "Nearer my God, to Thee," that has since become so universally popular and helpful.

Many people consider the hymn "Nearer My God, To Thee" to be the best ever hymn to be written about trust and aspiration for the nearness of God. "Nearer My God, to Thee", is based on the story of Jacob, as told in Genesis 28:11-17. Jacob, fleeing from Esau's wrath, went to sleep on a lonely hillside, with only a stone for a pillow, and dreamed that he saw a ladder reaching up to heaven, with angels ascending and descending on it. In the morning he arose refreshed and named the place of his dream, "Bethel, the House of God."

The name “Bethel” means “house of God.” It should be every person’s desire to have God be nearer to them in life, not just in their final hours! Being nearer to God includes being with the Lord’s people, the household of God (Eph. 2:19.) The Preacher warned us to remember God since “the years draw near when you say, ‘I have no pleasure in them.’” (Ecc. 12:1) As we get older, we should want to draw even nearer to God. Some may have failed to become Christians when they were younger, but they should never doubt that God seeks to have them come to Him (cf. 2 Peter 3:9).

Stanzas two, three and four carry the bulk of the narrative in this five-stanza hymn. Adams’ unifying theme is to be nearer to God. If one sings all five stanzas, the singer will voice the phrase “Nearer, My God, to Thee” or “nearer to thee” 16 times! The hymn reflects a personal faith and relationship with God that was common to true Christianity in all ages. Singing this hymn, we identify with troubled Jacob wandering through a hostile landscape. Angels appear from the darkness and beckon us to rise from our “stony grief.” We are eager for the morning to break. Then, we will sing praise and turn our stone pillows into markers commemorating the place where we’ve awakened to God’s merciful presence.

In her hymn Adams was not afraid to evoke the darkness and terror of Jacob’s situation: Jacob was the child of promise, though he was an imperfect man. He was on the run from a brother who wanted to kill him for what he had done to him; it was pitch dark in the middle of the night in the middle of nowhere; and he had the worst pillow in the world. Still, he recognized

the importance of being near to God even if under dire circumstances. Adams sketches all this, and then affirms: “Yet in my dreams I’d be nearer, my God, to thee.” For that night God came through a dream in which Jacob saw a ladder to heaven with angels coming down and going up. Adams captures the two-way traffic with “all that thou sendest me” and “angels to beckon me.” When she awakes from the dream, she will build an altar and name the place “house of God,” turning her “stony grief” (bad pillow!) into a memorial of intimacy with God. Or, in the final stanza, she might die before she wakes. If so, then she’s nearer to her God. The hymn is a tiny tour of life’s journey to heaven.

When she died in 1848, Sarah had no idea that her hymn text, “Nearer, My God, to Thee” was destined for greatness. The hymn “Nearer, my God, to Thee” went on to achieve international recognition. It was a favourite of Queen Victoria, King Edward VII, and American president William McKinley. It was also played at the funeral of Baptist minister John Harper, who had asked the band to play it aboard the Titanic. Over the years her hymn Nearer, My God, To Thee has been played in various places and for some momentous occasions. It was highly popular among Christians all around even to this day.

[It is not just a funeral song but a reminder to all those who live in dire circumstances to face the challenges of life with hope. What else could be more comforting than singing the song during this Covid'19 break out and thus bringing hope for the living and for those who battle against the invisible enemy?]



Naktia Hanwat Church History

Ahwa Mission Field, Gujarat



(Rev. L. Masilamani)

Naktia Hanwat is a medium size village located in Dangs Taluk of Dangs district, Gujarat state. In 2011, the literacy rate of Naktia Hanwat village was 55.96 % compared to 78.03 % of Gujarat. As per the Constitution of India and Panchayat Raj Act, Naktia Hanwat village is administrated by Sarpanch (Head of Village) who is the elected representative of the village. In Naktia Hanwat village, Schedule Tribe (ST) constitutes 99.11 % of the total population. There is no population of Schedule Caste (SC) in this village. Of the 477 workers engaged in various works, 449 were cultivators (owner or co-owner) while 3 were Agricultural labourers.

The Beginning:

On 8-5-1981, L. Masilamani, his wife Mrs. Vanmathi and their first son M. John Kingsly (two years and eight months old) opened the Ahwa field and settled in a rented house in Pipaldahad village. Soon they found out that people were receptive in the nearby Junnar village and they moved to Junnar village on

30-11-1981. Very soon opposition brewing in Junnar village, made the missionary family move to Ahwa on 30-8-1982. The Ahwa CNI Church Pastor Rev. T. V. Gaikwad helped them much during this opposition time. As the Dolyambar village headman and Manu Bhai invited the missionaries to their village, Missionaries went to live in the Dolyambar village on 12-3-1983. This village became a strategic place to spread the Gospel to the nearby villages. The believers sought the help of FMPB missionaries to develop the ministry in their nearby villages.

Naktia Hanwat village comes under the hills of Sahyadri in the eastern border of Dangs district. Next to this village after crossing the hills through a hilly road comes Dhule district of Maharashtra. Damu Bhai Ramtu Bhai was the first Christian from this village who worked for the founding of the Church in this village. He narrates his story of how he became a Christian:

“I was smoking, drinking liquor and worshipping the idols, which led me to a life

of poverty. I did not have peace in my soul and there was no peace in my family. My wife was suffering from chest pain and she used to have shivering due to cold in her legs and hands. I tried many ways for her to be healed. I called the shamans (bhagats) and gave him fowls and goat for the sacrifice. But she did not get any cure from this. Then I tried to heal her through medicines by consulting doctors and also gave her herbal medicines. But she was not getting better by all these efforts. There was one Christian named Punya Bhai in Bilbari village. He told me to believe in Jesus Christ for my wife's healing. I asked Punya Bhai to pray for my wife. Punya Bhai prayed for my wife and she became well. I heard about missionary L. Masilamani ministering in Dolyambar village. I went and met him in Dolyambar. I joined the Church. I have been serving as a Church elder from the beginning of the Church in Naktihanwat village."

After getting healing, Damu Bhai was attending the Sunday services in Jhari village. FMPB evangelist Bharat Bhai started conducting night meetings in Damu Bhai's home every Friday. There were five families in the first meeting. Slowly the village people heard about the healing power of Jesus Christ through this meeting. Nathu Bhai Gangajiya Bhai was one such man who was searching for a cure for his wife's sickness. He narrates his story:



"My name is Nathu Bhai Gangaji Bhai. My wife had bleeding problem and asthma. We tried the bhagats and spent much on them. But there was no improvement. Doctors prescribed her tablets. These tablets caused much vomiting for her. So she stopped taking the tablets. There was one religious sect doing satsang (bhajan). One of our relatives was doing this. We went there. He said that this disease is a big one. You have to try something else to get healing for her."

At this point Nathu Bhai's wife tells how she got delivered from all her sicknesses.

"My son Balya was a small boy. I could not walk. I told that I will be with my children. There was one Christian in our village named Dhamu Bhai. Evangelist Bharat Bhai used to come to his house. I told my husband that I would like to go to the Christian meeting. Village people told me that in Christian religion people will not weep when one dies. They discouraged me. But I had the confidence of getting cured in that meeting. So I attended that meeting. Believers, elders and evangelists prayed for me. Their prayers healed me. Then we believed in Jesus Christ and joined the Church at Karkhadi. Every Friday night meeting was going on in Dhamu Bhai's house. For Sunday service we went to Jhari village."

Thus people started attending the Friday night meetings conducted by FMPB evangelists in Damu Bhai's home from 1987. For one and a half years the meetings were going on in Dhamu Bhai's house. Bharat Bhai and Sampath Bhai were coming to conduct those meetings. Many people were brought to faith by these evangelists and Church elders Dhamu Bhai and Nathu Bhai. For Sunday services, believers were going to Jhari Church.

Church Growth in the midst of opposition:

Nathu Bhai tells about an opposition caused by his village people with the support of a local politician.

“Our village people went to Dhedu Bhai, a leader in the political party and a leader in the Wood Cutters Co-operative society and told him to stop the Christian meetings in the village. He called us and I went with Dhamu Bhai with a missionary in Ahwa. He told us not to create division in that village. He told us to contribute money for the celebration for the festivals. We told him that we will not be able to do that. We will support any other social concerns of the village.”

Rev. L. Masilamani wrote in the Field history about this meeting of Dhedu Bhai:

In connection with the Naktia Hanwat opposition by one man called Maharya Bhai, L. Masilamani met Dhedu Bhai with Damu Bhai and another believer in his jungle mandali's office in Ahwa. He talked with the missionary very harshly and tried to convince the believers to follow their traditional faith.”

After one and a half years, Bhatya Bhai built a new house near the present Church. As the room in Dhamu Bhai's home was small, the meeting place was shifted to Bhatya Bhai's house in 1988. Bhatya Bhai sought healing for his sick daughter. But after hearing the Gospel in the meetings he decided to continue in faith even if his daughter would die. He also faced opposition in his village for the Christian faith. He narrates his experiences:



“I myself was making liquor and I drank a lot of liquor and smoked tobacco. My life became very poor and broken. There was no peace in our house. My daughter was suffering from a sickness. Her legs and hands became straight and her eyes also looked differently. We tried to get healing through our ancestral faith methods like offering sacrifices of cocks, goats to our gods and goddesses through the bhagats. In spite of spending much on medicines and other things my daughter did not get well. I saw many people following Christian faith in my village for the sake of getting well from illnesses and we decided that we too would become Christians. We told the Church elder Damu Bhai that we are ready to accept Jesus Christ. Then the elder prayed for my daughter. God heard that prayer and my daughter became very well. Seeing this miracle we started believing in Jesus Christ. Then we joined the Church. We were attending the Friday meetings in the village and the Sunday services in Jhari. Within three weeks she became fully well. After ten years my daughter got sick again. She was taken to many hospitals in big cities like Dhule, Ahwa, Chinchpada, Bardoli etc. She was not cured. I decided to continue in faith even if my daughter dies. My daughter died. But I decided to continue the Christian meeting in my house and I thought that I would go to heaven to meet my daughter and I did not give up my faith. One day opponents started conducting a meeting very

close to our meeting place. The Panchayat President was leading that meeting. I told him to stop the meeting. They stopped that meeting. After one year the village people came against us. A meeting was convened in the house of the village head man. They threatened us. I asked them to point out any mistakes in the lives of Christians. I told them that I was working in the houses of village people. I asked them to find any fault with us. They repeatedly told us that Christianity was not needed in this village. Then they planned to beat me as I did not agree with them. I told them to beat me if they found fault in my activities. They accused me of rowdyism. I declared that we would not leave faith even if we were beaten. I challenged them to beat me if they found fault in me. They stopped opposing us for three years. Again after three years they asked us to contribute money for their festivals. I told them that we would give a contribution to their festivals on the condition that they should give a contribution to our festivals. Then they stopped opposing us."

For two years the night meeting was going on in Bhatya Bhai's home. After one year, one kacha Church was constructed with a pucca stone foundation in Nathu Bhai's land.

Church Construction:

Rs. 20,000 was received for Church construction in Naktia Hanwat village in February 1992. A semi-pucca Church was built in 1992 in the land of Nathu Bhai Gangajiya Bhai. Believers gave their free labour with one time food for this Church construction. This Church was dedicated by Rev. Thangasamy from Coimbatore on 21-10-1992 and the sponsor of this first Church was Mr.Gnanapragasam of Tindivanam. This Church was dedicated at midnight. About

this Church dedication the field history register reads:

"On 21-10-1992, Coimbatore sponsors Rev. Thangasamy, Mr. Devadurai and Mr. Dominic went with L. Masilamani by a jeep to Naktia Hanwat without any prior notice. Believers were brought to the Church at around 10 pm. Suvarthik Gopichand Bhai was brought from Amsarpada village (where he conducted night meetings). At 11 pm the Naktia Hanwat Church was dedicated by Rev. Thangasamy. All of them returned to Ahwa at 2.30 am in the mid night"

Church Demolished in 1998 Opposition:

There was an organized opposition during Christmas time of 1998 under the leadership of a sadhu who was heading a fanatic group and instigating the natives to oppose Christians. As a result of this, opposition thirty three Churches were demolished in Dangs district. This Church was also demolished on 29-12-1998 in the 1998 opposition.

Nathu Bhai recollects this incident:

"In the year 1998 during Christmas time anti-Christian forces demolished our Church in our village. They threatened us and told us not to follow the Christian religion. We made a complaint to the police and the Collector. Missionary D. Abraham guided us in these matters. The District Collector came to our village and told the village people not to give trouble to the Christians and everyone should be allowed to practice their own religion in the village. From that time onwards there has been no opposition in our village."

After the demolition of the Church the congregation gathered in the veranda of Nathu Bhai's son Ratan Bhai's house. A new

Church is built in the same place. Money was received for a new Church construction in 2000. Government gave Rs.16,000 as a subsidy to construct the Church due to the demolition in 1998. It was finished in 2001. This new pucca Church was dedicated in 2003. The Church was dedicated by leaders from Mumbai. The Panchayat President told us not to build the Church in the village. But believers insisted on constructing the Church in the same place where the old Church was. The length of the Church is 38 feet and width 27 feet.

Information about Ministry and Church:

Total members of the Church are 190. During persecution 50% of believers were backslidden. Now 110 people from 32 families are in faith. Believers from three families from Khel village attend the Naktia Hanwat Church. 80 to 85 people attend the Sunday service.

Naktia Hanwat is a Pastorate Centre. Vahutia, Dumriya and Haripada congregations come under this pastorate. In September 2016, Rev. Dhansukh was the pastor of this pastorate. Weekly night meetings were conducted in Khel village. Believers from Naktia Hanwat attend this meeting. One or two families join the Church because of these meetings. Three families joined the Church in 2016. Prayer meetings are being conducted from 8 pm to 9.30 pm. every Friday night. 20 to 25 people participate in this prayer meeting which is conducted by Church elders. Pastor comes occasionally.

Missionaries who worked in this field are Rev. L. Masilamani, Rev. Bethuel Bardhan and Rev. D. Abraham families. CNI Pastors who worked in this Church are Rev. Balya Bhai,

Rev. Chiman Bhai and Rev. Dhansukh Bhai. The Church received offerings of Rs. 1500 to 2000 per month through thanksgiving offering, cottage prayer meeting (yearly conducted in each house), Sunday services, tithes, harvest festival, first fruits etc. Due to migration of Christians for around 8 months in a year in the sugarcane fields, offering would be less.

Prayer Concerns:

- ◆ Jugar play (playing cards) with money among the youth is a problem.
- ◆ Backslidden believers should return to the Church.
- ◆ New people should taste the love of Jesus.
- ◆ Migration of believers happen due to unemployment in the village to distant places. 75% believers leave the village to eight months for work elsewhere. Only 25% believers remain in the village.

First believer's marriage awe-struck by the many follow Christ Jesus

In Madhya Pradesh, at Udaipur mission field, our believers Suresh and Pooja were united in holy matrimony. As this is the first Christian wedding in this field, many unbelievers also participated just as spectators. The spirit of God filled the wedding ceremony and the harmony and glory of God attracted many unbelievers and they started showing interest in the Gospel. Praise the Lord.
