

Fitting into God's Higher Plan!

Our God is not a fortune-teller, a soothsayer and a mere predictor. As He is God of All Ages, He knows what's coming because He plans what's coming, and He performs what He plans. We could go on giving example after example from the pages of God's

Word about God's Higher Plan and this truth is fleshed out really well in the Book of Judges also [7:1-23]. When Gideon and his army went into the battle, they must have had a plan, but even before the battle commenced and the victory was won. they found out that God had the best plan.

To Fit into God's Higher Plan, Three Steps Are Necessary -

God's Plan Requires Surrender - Gideon was a man with 32,000 followers! But, by following God's plan, he saw his army reduced, his rank lowered and his pride crushed. What Gideon learned was that this fight was not of Gideon, his army, or even the enemy. This battle was of the Lord! Gideon had to come to the place where he was willing to lay down his ego, his plans, his goals, his dreams and his will so that he might surrender himself to the will of God!

God's Plan Requires Submission - Gideon had to watch when the first 22,000 men and then 9,700 men turned and went home along with their weapons with them. Gideon and the 300 who remained had to walk in obedience to God's plan for the battle or else none of them had a chance of survival!

God's Plan Requires Steadfastness - It took great faith for the 300 to go out against the thousands! It took great faith for them to go without weapons! It took great faith for them to blow their trumpets, break those pitchers and reveal the shining torches. God answered their faith by giving them a resounding victory!

When Peter and the others had fished all night in vain without catching a fish, Jesus told them to cast the net into the deep water and they would catch fish [Luke 5:4-8]. Peter's plan was to leave fishing for that day and go home. But, when he obeyed the Lord, he found out that God had the best plan of making them 'fishers of men!'

When Jesus told His disciples that He was going to die, Peter rebuked the Lord, Matt. 16:21-23. Peter thought he had a good plan, but when Jesus went to the cross and paid for sins forever, Peter found out that God had the best plan.

In God's kingdom, God has made the ultimate objective clear, i.e., the redemption of all mankind [1Tim.2:4]. Jesus prayed, "Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven" (Matt. 6:10). In God's "higher plan," everything happens for a reason and will be woven into the fabric of God's higher plan for those who love Him (Rom. 8:28). So to attain victory let us fit into God's higher plan!



ECHO OF * JEREMIAH THEN & NOW!

e automatically remember the Tamil We automatically remonstrate Whadu Annual Camp when the month of May approaches. Due to the Corona pandemic outbreak and in obedience to the rules of the government, we were unable to conduct the Annual Camp physically. Yet, Last year God in His immense mercy helped us to conduct the Camp virtually. God helped us to plan to have the Annual camp this year. Due to the examinations to be held in the month of May for the students, we have postponed the camp to the month of June.

The theme of the conference is "Towards Higher Goals". This is the main content drawn from the verse Jeremiah 29:11. Our General Secretary had mentioned in the January issue of this year's magazine -Friends Focus. God helped us to think on those lines even in the Planning conference held in the month of February. However, it is good to think in a wider perspective.

Jeremiah was used as a mighty instrument in the hands of God. Even in his young age. -when he was just 20 years old - he obeved to the very tough Call of the Lord during hard times. He delivered the tough words very clearly what God had told him to the people during the reign of the Kings Josiah, Jehoash, Jehochim, Jehoachin and Zedekkiah for 40 long years. Some Bible



scholars are of the opinion that Jeremiah would have prophesied at least for nearly 50 years. All the 4 Kings except Josiah were very wicked. The people under these reigns lived as they pleased. They refused to heed to the Word of God and turned to idolatry and listened to the false prophets.

Jeremiah lived as a prophet who warned them of their sins during these times. His words were very clear and strict. He never spoke gentle words for pleasing the people. Instead spoke hard and strict words. We read about this throughout the book of Jeremiah that is, he never ventured to convey the Lord's message in smooth words but he was very outspoken and straight in his speech. We can read that Jeremiah was hated for his outspoken. and plain but strict words and was not popular among the people as well as the ruling hierarchy.

During our days too, most of our Christian workers have the habit of speaking pleasing words without venturing to admonish the people who are wallowing in sin. We encounter such people who

deliberately speak in order to appease the people refraining themselves from speaking harsh and admonishing words. Many are very particular in trying their best to do their service in order to get good remarks from the people and also desire to become popular among them to gain fame. Jeremiah is a good model for the preachers of this age.

IN UNFAVOURABLE CONDITIONS

THEN: The Jews were under the wrath of God for refusing to follow the methods God had already instructed. God delivered them umpteen times whenever they fell in sin. Now it appears as if His patience has come to an end. The Jews, who ignored the warnings of the Lord deliberately, were delivered into the hands of the Babylonians. God used Nebuchadnezzar, to take the Jews into captivity and to destroy the city of Jerusalem.

NOW: God has allowed many anti-Christian forces to oppress us deliberately just because we Christians refused to live a life pleasing to the Lord as well as heeding to His last commandment of reaching out to the Indians with the Gospel. Nowadays, the political climate is not in favour of preaching the Gospel. So many oppositions and hurdles are propping up to do the ministry. Threatening the Christian workers, imprisoning them and falsely accusing cases are rampant. Churches are being destroyed, worship is being stalled, permission to conduct prayer meetings are not being granted, anti-conversion Bill is introduced in many States, permission to worship their Gods whom they desire is being checked etc.. Some religious activist organizations are creating situations where the peaceful co-existence of people of different faith is not possible.

GOD'S HIGHER PLANS TO POSITIVELY HANDLE THE SITUATIONS THAT ARE NOT FAVOURABLE

The Jews who had gone into captivity in Babylon and also the Jews who staved back in Jerusalem were in great difficulty. They believed the prophecies uttered by the false prophets and were in great hope that they would return back to their land in two years. Jeremiah is writing a letter to the persons in captivity. That letter was not written to an individual but to a group. This letter found in Chapter 29 was written to the people especially those who had lost their nation, houses and even their basic facilities and their freedom and were living as strangers in a foreign land. In this, he has beautifully depicted the problems the remnant were facing and that the captivity would continue for a longer time and has given some tips as to how they need to live when under captivity.

In Jeremiah 29:11, Jeremiah tells the people that God has kept a unique plan for His children and that the plans God has for them are plans to prosper them and not to harm them, plans to give them hope and a future. This verse is the favourite verse for those preachers who are immersed in prosperity doctrines. At the very outset this appears to be a great plan, a dream to fulfill, a plan for safety and prosperity. But this is not the true meaning of this verse. These plans and thoughts will not come to pass immediately. There is no possibility of last minute miracles. He instructs that they should do certain things.

a. To live a Life of Contentment:

THEN: In Jeremiah 29:4-5 He tells people to live a life of contentment in the place which is not favourable: to build houses and live in it; to plant gardens and to enjoy its fruits: to get married their children and to increase: not to decrease but increase in the places where they live. He tells that God will fulfill His unique plan at the right time.

NOW: In this great democratic country. the atrocities against Christians are on the increase. Opposition against the minority Christians and introducing the anti conversion bills are prevailing. We just cannot stop living our lives. We need to live a life of making certain tolerance and keep moving. We are called to reap greater blessings by attending sincerely to the jobs, business, responsibilities, ministries that have been entrusted into our hands. We must have a hope that God will fulfill His plans in all these areas and in our ministerial responsibilities at the appropriate time.

b. God is asking us to pray for the Nation:

THEN: In Jeremiah 29:7 God savs. "Also, seek the peace and prosperity of the city to which I have carried you into exile. Pray to the Lord for it, because if it prospers, you too will prosper". When there is peace in the nation, there will also be peace to you". The people who are in captivity and have become slaves need to pray for the nation in which they reside as captives. God's people should pray for peace to prevail in Babylon.

NOW: This is the same advice given to us during these days. We must pray for the peace and prosperity of our nation. I Timothy 2:1,2 "I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness." The main reason to pray for our leaders does not mean that we may live peaceful and quiet lives but to live in all godliness and holiness.

e. Do not heed to false prophets:

THEN: Jeremiah tells them not to heed to false voices and false prophecies. 8 Yes. this is what the Lord Almighty, the God of Israel, says: "Do not let the prophets and diviners among you deceive you. Do not listen to the dreams they encourage you to have. They are prophesying lies to you in my name. I have not sent them," declares the Lord in Jeremiah 29:8.9. In those days, there were a few false prophets living among them. They were cheating people by telling false prophecies. The people had accepted them, because their prophecies were very soothing to hear. God is instructing the people through prophet Jeremiah, not to accept those false prophets as He did not send them.

NOW: Even today there are prophets living among us who utter false prophecies. People trust them. If the prophecies they utter do not happen, why do people hesitate to keep them away. It is just because they are not pushed aside, they continue uttering prophecies from their mind and are trying to cheat the Christian community. All the prophecies we ought to know are written in the Bible. So let us be careful.

f. He promises to fulfil his thoughts and plans:

THEN: In Jeremiah 29:11, "For I know the plans I have for you." declares the Lord. "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." This promise was given to people in many generations who lived wrongly and to those who believed in false prophecies. God is promising them to fulfill their expected promises in just 70 years. Finally God savs. in Jeremiah 29: 12-14 verses "when you call on me and pray to me. I will listen to you and when you seek me with all your heart. I will be found by you" and will bring you back from captivity. I will gather you from all the nations and places where I have banished you," declares the Lord, "and will bring you back to the place from which I carried you into exile."

NOW: Even if we are not able to fulfill some plans even after many years in Friends Missionary Prayer band, God will fulfill our plans if we continue to pray to Him. and search Him wholeheartedly. He will listen to us. Right from inception. we, in this organization, have the habit of sitting at His feet, praying and planning. We also have the habit of shaping our endeavours according to His Plan. We set goals in all the corners of our ministerial boundaries and are moving forward. Even if we fail to reach the target God has set for us, both in Finance, and in Fields, yet God is helping us to make a marked difference vear after vear.

In the year 2020, we had set our theme "House to House" and worked towards achieving the goal. Unable to conduct worship services, due to Pandemic, God helped us to switch over to worship the Lord in every house and to conduct Bible Studies. Every house became a worship centre. In the year 2021, we set our theme as "Unchanging God." Even though restrictions mounted up, our believers toiled hard and brought a good number of believers into His fold and God thus proved that He is an unchanging God. This is how God is with us helping us to march towards the goals He has set for us.

If God's unique plan has to happen in our lives, we need to do the following things.

We have to live a life of contentment in all circumstances.

We need to pray for our Nation's welfare.

We should avoid false prophets.

With a strong belief that God would keep up His promise, we need to search Him wholeheartedly, and bring our requests to God.

God will definitely fulfill His plan and our vision of reaching the unreached Indians with the Gospel in our generation.

Multitudes to taste His love, Living to dispel the darkness By dwelling in Christ's gracefulness Journeying in the Biblical light.

God. Help us to move forward Truthfully towards Your Unique Plan.

May this be our prayer Lord.

lirasi people group is a diverse group With their own unique identity. Among the Mirasis of Northern India there are Hindus, Sikhs, and Muslims, Also called the Pakhwaii, they are a people known for singing and playing the timbrel, a tambourine-like instrument, All over Puniab there are about 1.12.000 people living. They speak Magadhi. Urdu. Raiasthani. Puniabi and Hindi. The word mirasi is derived from the Arabic word miras, which means inheritance. The Mirasi clan is sub-divided into the following subdivisions, the Rai-Mirasis, who were the genealogists of the Jats: the Mir-Mirasis who participates in Ashura activities: the Dhadhi. the Kalawant, the Khariala and the Kamachi. who are the traditional genealogists of the Brahmins: the Mutrib. Naggal. Qawwal. singers of devotional singers of Sufi poetry, and the Rababis, who play the musical instrument the rabab. Unlike the other Mirasi communities, the Rababis are Sikhs, and trace their descent from Bhai Mardana, a Mirasi who used to play the Rabab before Guru Nanak, the founder of Sikhism.

Generally. Mirasi Puniabi people uneducated. Basically they are very poor and they don't own land and house. They are not generally respected by others, but they themselves think that they are great

and they have lots of responsibilities in their society. Women don't have any power to speak in the public place and they are too often treated like slaves. They have their own people group leaders, and people follow their auidelines.

Cultural Aspects:

Normally Mirasi people live together. They can be easily identified by their dress code. Their food system is different from others and they eat together. They marry from their own sub community only. The parents decide about their children's wedding and they themselves arrange it for them.

Many Mirasi people are labourers, farming tenants, and also vegetables sellers. They have their unique way of creating jokes, folk stories, proverbs etc. to prove their cultural history. Mirasis are known for their laziness. They were covered with the guilt even in the hot seasons. Whenever the question comes on the laziness of a person, their quote 'is it Mirasis Razai' [quilt]. They were blessed with folk music. Mirasi people entertain at fairs and sing at weddings. The well-educated Mirasis work in government, serve in the military and do research for genealogies. They have a caste council to judge in disputes and make sure that the people behave as they should. Mirasi people do not marry outside their group.

Belief System:

Mirasi people can be Muslim, Hindu or Sikh. The Hindus among them are having a wide variety of beliefs. They can worship no gods or thousands of them, for example.

- ✓ All gods are one, but they don't want to fully accept the concept of one god.
- Muslim traditional Mirasi people believe in Muslim belief system.
- Hindu traditional Mirasi people believe in gods and goddesses.
- ✓ Sikh traditional Mirasi people believe Guru Nanak as their god.

As they believe in three major religions, spiritual confusions are very common among them.

Ministry Among Mirasis:

FMPB started its ministry among the Mirasi People Group in July 2008 and Rev. Sanjah Kumar is the first pioneering missionary along with his family members. Then Rev. Y. Justin is placed to work among them along with his family since 2017. The first believer is Seema who accepted Christ as he got deliverance from the possession of evil spirit and then got healing from stomach pain which prolonged for six years. After experiencing the miracle, he proclaimed the Gospel to his own people and brought many to Christ. He went to be with the Lord three years back. Following Seema, Deep Singh accepted Jesus Christ and at present he leads the congregation. One Church is built among this people group Dharamkop and approximately 750 persons from 45 families have come into the fold of Christ.

Generally this people group is not receptive to the Gospel. Through Satsang, personal evangelism, house visiting etc., they are reached with the Gospel. The community leaders become a hindrance to the people in accepting the Gospel. Mostly ladies are receptive to the Gospel and the believers' children are reading the Bible regularly.

- Pray to have an open door for the Gospel among this People Group.
- → Pray for the redemption of the families which are under the bondage of alcohol and tobacco.
- ✓ Pray for the children to get a good education.
- ✓ Pray for the needs of community development programs.
- Pray for the people's family problems they are facing and to get true peace in their lives.
- Pray for the people to get suitable jobs.
- ✓ Pray for the believers who are not coming for Sunday service and those who have backsliden to be restored to the faith in the Lord.

KATHARA CHURCH **HISTORY**

GHATAMPUR FIELD. KANPUR REGION. NORTHERN ZONE


✓ athara is a large village located in Kanpur Tehsil of Kanpur Nagar district, Uttar Pradesh with a total of 1719 families. The Kathara village has a population of 9462. It has a higher literacy rate compared to Uttar Pradesh. As per the constitution of India and Panchavati Rai Act, Kathara village is administrated by Sarpanch (Head of Village) who is the elected representative of the village. Schedule Caste (SC) constitutes 21.83 % of the total population in Kathara village. The village Kathara currently doesn't have any Schedule Tribe (ST) population. Out of the 3515 workers engaged in Main Work, 1122 are cultivators (owner or co-owner) while 941 are Agricultural labourers.

Beginning of Ministry:

The Ghatampur mission field was opened in March 1991. The pioneer missionaries of Ghatampur mission field were Mr. Azariah Rai Kumar and Mr. Raia Edwin Moses. The Kathara village was reached with the Gospel during the period of Mr. Peter Hariram. The first local evangelist of Ghatampur field, late Mr. Kamlesh brought the Gospel to Kathara village. The first believer of Kathara village, Mr. Ashok Kumar narrates his testimony



"In 1994, local evangelist Kamlesh Bhai came to our village for outreach ministry. It was election time then, as I was involved in politics, our house was crowded with people. In the evening he was passing through our house, he saw the crowd and spoke to me privately. He told me about Christ. That time I was under the bondage of Satan. My elder sister passed away because of demon possession. My mother was also tormented by evil spirits and so was my wife. We were able to see the demons with our naked eves. Through Kamlesh Bhai I came to know that it was Jesus Christ who made us. He also told me to pronounce the name of Jesus to get away from demons. When I started to do so the demons were afraid and moved away from us. I started to put my faith in the Lord but not wholeheartedly. Twice or thrice I went to Ghatampur to attend the worship and met missionary, Mr. Peter Hariram



One day our son Rahul (2 years) was at the verge of death because of witchcraft done against him. He was unable to see and his eves were closed. We took him to a magician but he advised us to take our son to someone greater than him. That day Mr. Peter Hariram and Kamlesh Bhai had come to Badera village for a night meeting and on their return, they stopped at our house. They heard about our son's condition and took him in their hands and praved for him. Within a few minutes, he started playing. Then and there I accepted Jesus Christ as my Saviour whole heartedly. Kamlesh Bhai took me to Jhansi. Upper bungalow to confess the faith openly on 29.11.1996. I started attending the worship at Ghatampur, Shastri Nagar, I was addicted to alcohol and was a slave to gutkha. I chewed 70 to 80 sachets of autkha every day. God delivered me from all these sinful habits."

In May 1997, at Badera village a woman was brought to a tantrick named, Badalu Balak to cast some magic spells on her because she was dumb for 8 years and was terminally ill. At that time, believers, Mr. Kishanpal and Keval prayed for the woman. She got up and sat on the cot. A word was sent to Mr. Ashok Kumar to pray for the woman. He too went to Badera and conducted a prayer meeting. They sang a song and said "Bolo Parmeshwar ki Naamki" everybody said "Jai" and the lady too said "Jai". Everybody were astonished because she was dumb for 8 years. The next day she was taken to the Ghatampur Church where prayers were offered for her by the local evangelist Ram Lakhan. Three demons fled from her and she was completely delivered from all the sicknesses. This incident brought many people to Christ.

This incident made an impact on believer, Ashok Kumar also. He decided to serve the Lord. Earlier, he accompanied the local evangelist, Kamlesh for outreach ministry. In 1997, he joined FMPB as a local evangelist.

After Mr. Ashok Kumar joined as local evangelist, in July 1997 a worship service was started at Badera village (4km from Kathara village). The worship was started at Badera because Mr. Ashok Kumar's family was the only family in faith at Kathara whereas, at Bandera, there were nearly 9 believers (earlier they went to Shastri Nagar, Ghatampur for the worship). One among those 9 believers was Mr. Shripal. He describes his testimony-



"I am Shripal from Badera village. In 1992 I was staying in Punjab, running a tea shop. I received a New Testament which I started to read. When I came back to my village, missionaries Mr. Peter Hariram and Kamlesh came to my village to pray for my brother who was sick because of demon possession. My family had accepted Christ and confessed our faith in 1993. When I came home, I noticed a small book in the loft. When I enquired about it they told me that they had already accepted Christ and confessed our faith in the Church

Church Growth:

The worship at Badera was conducted

at the house of Mr. Keval. Mr. Shyamlal from Badera village joined FMPB as local evangelist and he was placed at Pukhrayan mission field. Since his house was vacant, the worship was shifted to his house. Later, as per the desire of the believers, the worship was conducted at the houses of Badera believers in turns till the Church was built in 2008. Many people received deliverance from demon possession and sickness through prayers. People from the neighbouring villages like Daheli. Champatpur and Jamu were responding to the Gospel.

Later people from many more villages surrounding Kathara village accepted Christ and confessed their faith. Apart from the Sunday worship at Kathara Church, small group prayer and follow up meetings were conducted at every village. By 2017, 245 persons joined the Kathara congregation.

The Church Land:

Through prayers, on 28.3.2007, 5 biswa lands were purchased worth Rs. 75,000/from Phool Singh Yadav at Kathara in the presence of the Central Region Secretary, Rev. Azariah Raikumar.

The Congregation:

The Kathara congregation members are from the following villages: Kathara, Kanpana, Manetu, Badera, Daheli, Katerua, Champatpur, Jamau, Udaipur, Kushalpur, Ratanpur, Chattapur, Kurvakeda, Rae Bareli and Gansiyanpur. All of them are from Sankhwar, Sonkar, Kori, Paswan, Yadav, Kateria, Rajpoot and Pandit communities.

The Kathara Church was named as St. John's Church and the foundation stone was laid on 8th May 2007. The total cost of construction is Rs. 4,32,410 (local contribution - Rs.42.410 and from FMPB Rs.3,90,000). The believers helped in the labour work by taking less wages. The compound wall of Kathara Church was built only with the help of local contribution. On 1.3.2008, the Kathara Church was dedicated by the PPA Secretary, Rev. G Kingsly. God's word was shared by Rev. R.K Nair (ECI Church - Regional Co-ordinator, Panki, Kanpur). The Central Regional Secretary - Rev. N. Rajadurai & family were also present. The believers contributed table and pulpit for the Church. There was no opposition during the time of construction. However, when the village head was approached for a 5 ft pathway for the Church, there was guarrelling. Some people wanted to beat the believers. The police personnel gave protection. Through prayers and recommendation of the Health Minister (he was familiar to the local evangelist Ashok Kumar), a 22 ft pathway was allotted for the Church.

Men of God Who Served in **Kathara Congregation:**

Mr. Ashok Kumar from Kathara village works with FMPB as local evangelist. Mr. Shyamlal from Badera village worked with FMPB as local evangelist in Pukhrayan mission field but later he resigned. Also. Mr. Ashok Kumar's eldest daughter, Mrs. Manjusha and family work with FMPB as cross-cultural missionaries.

We praise God for the congregation at Kathara Village and the believers are active in outreach ministry also. May God bless this congregation to the glory of His Namel





Rev. Mathew Jebaraj

(03.01.1954 - 26.03.2022)

Mr. Mathew Jebarai was born in a Christian family in Athichaperi village near Kalakad on 3rd January 1954. His parents Mr. Koilpitchai and mother Mrs. Jeyamani were teachers in the TDTA Primary School. He was the first born of the family, nurtured Christian teachings, and parents encouraged him to attend Sunday school and Church Service regularly. Both the parents passed in his early years, leaving him along with her sister. Then, he moved to the town of Kalakad and lived with her sister

Mr. Mathew Jebaraj came to know about Friends Missionary Prayer Band through Mr. Henry Jacob, who was the catechist in the CSI Church, Kalakad, In 1981 he had an opportunity to attend a missionary meeting conducted by FMPB at Courtallam. In that meeting he committed himself for the full time ministry. In the meantime his younger sister got married. With the encouragement of our prayer group leader Mrs. Jeevalakshimi teacher, he joined FMPB on 3rd July 1982.

After one year of training at Bethel Bible Institute, Danishpet Bro, Mathew Jebarai was sent to Gonda for Hindi language training in 1983. After finishing his language training, he was sent to the Hindi speaking area for the Church planting ministry. He served the Lord based at Madhubani, Sitamarhi, Mairwa and Siwan in the State of Bihar, On 13th January 1986. he married Ms. Nagomi of Idaiyangudi, whose parents are Mr. Devapitchai and Mrs. Jebamani. As a family they were sent to the Southern Zone for Church Planting ministry. They started the ministry from Anchetty, then Pennagaram, Krishnagiri children home, and Denkanikottai. Then they shifted their base to Hosur and served the Lord to bring many people to Christ. and nurtured the new believers spiritually.

God blessed this family with a boy Sam Joshua and a girl Sheeba Gracelin. At present they both are employed and married and settled in different places with their families. Rev. Mathew retired from the service of FMPB in the year 2019. After retirement also he continued to do the ministry in the Hosur area. Rev. Mathew Jebaraj was suffering with many ailments and the sickness made him very weak. He received the home call from the Lord on 26th March 2022 and his mortal remains were buried with the hope of resurrection at Hosur. Pray for his wife and children and their families.

TRAIL BLAZERS

Evangelisation of the world in our generation!



Arthur T. Pierson

rthur T. Pierson best exemplifies the Aintegrity of the Nineteenth century missionary Era. His preaching (over 13,000 sermons), extensive writings (over fifty books which also includes the classic biography, "George Muller of Bristol"), and Mission messages made him widely known in America and around the world. He was also a consulting editor for his friend, C. I. Scofield for the original Scofield Reference Bible. His association with D. L. Moody and his Northfield Conferences were the breeding ground for Pierson's determination to see the world being evangelized in his generation. In one of these conferences when "Student Volunteers Movement" (which sent over twenty thousand missionaries all over the world) was born, he coined their watchword "evangelisation of the world in our generation."

Arthur Pierson was himself a regular speaker at these conferences and also at the Keswick Conventions which became the breeding ground for missionaries in Europe. He attended the Keswick Convention in England, more often than any other speaker from America. attending regularly from 1897 to 1909. He dominated the Convention with his unique abilities of spiritual and intellectual power. Thousands listened with intense interest for help and instruction and were never disappointed. He was lithe, tall, stern, and even a strict person in appearance, with the burning eyes of a prophet. But behind his formidable appearance, was a heart of concern for missions and prayer. When he spoke a hush fell over all in the tent, and the convicting work of the Spirit was felt.

He pastored many Churches in America and also the Metropolitan Tabernacle during Charles Spurgeon's last illness and for a couple of years after his death. In 1889 he went on a missionary tour all over England, and met C.H. Spurgeon, In 1891-2, he lectured on missions at Edinburg, and in 1891. Spurgeon became too weak to continue preaching, so Pierson filled his pulpit. Spurgeon died soon afterwards. and Pierson remained in his pulpit till 1893. During this time, among his many activities, he was an outspoken defender of the fundamentals of the faith

He also lectured at Moody Bible Institute and at Finney's Oberlin college. He was friendly with many famous pastors of his day on both sides of the Atlantic. His quotes about some of these friends would be worth noting. About George Muller he said "When George Mueller trusted the blood for salvation, he took Abel's position: when he undertook a consecrated walk he took Enoch's: when he came into fellowship with God for his life-work he stood beside Noah; when he rested only on God's Word, he was one with Abraham; and when he died to self and the world. he reached the self-surrender of Moses "

Speaking about Charles Finney he said, "His preaching was spiritual in power as well as tone. He depended on the Spirit. whose blessed unction led the people to understand the Gospel. With the agony of Jacob at Jabbok, he sought the power to witness. 'Honor the Holy Spirit and He will honour you,' was his maxim; and he taught that without the habitual recognition of dependence on the Spirit, revivals are not possible. If any one secret of Mr. Finney's ministry be powerful, it is this: he gave his whole soul to God."

The Missionary Review of the World which he edited (1888-1911), became the most important non-denominational mission iournal of its day. In that capacity he acted as elder statesman to the emerging "faith mission" movement, influencing people about the China Inland Mission, the Africa Inland Mission and the Oriental Missionary Society. Today almost all the missionary organizations operate on the principle of "faith mission."

In 1910 Pierson set out to tour missions in East Asia, but he grew ill and returned home to Brooklyn, where he died. He influenced hundreds of men and women to go as missionaries. All seven of his children did missionary work, and legendary mission leaders like Robert. E. Speer, Samuel Zwemer, and Stephen Niell, traced their inspiration for missions to him or to his writings. His favorite Bible verse was Philippians 4:19, and he gave away over 50.000 bank "checks" that were engraved with "My God shall supply all your needs according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus." He died on June 3, 1911.

It is always useful for us to be impressed by the Holy Spirit about the fact that the Saints who came before us were only "men of like passions" (Acts 14:15); and, the God that gave A. T. Pierson his victories is the same God available to us today. "Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and today, and forever" (Hebrews 13:8). Like many of us, Pierson began his Christian life with the motto "to live is Christ." (Phil. 1:21). Growth taught him the importance of the "Sword of the Spirit" (Eph. 6:17). Maturity taught him that the soon return of the Lord Jesus Christ is the atmosphere for the best life and service of Christ, "Blessed is that servant, whom his Lord when He cometh shall find so doing" (Lk. 12:43). Thus an active and fruitful life resulted in the cause of Christ and of saving the lost souls. May we too be found faithful to be called "blessed of the Lord."
